### SNOW IN THE CURRAGH FORECAST?

Trainer Ed Dunlop is looking forward to supplementary entry **Snow Fairy (Ire)** (Intikhab) following in the immediate hoofprints of Sariska (GB) (Pivotal {GB}), who backed up success in the G1 Epsom Oaks last year with an impressive victory in last year's renewal of the G1 Irish Oaks at The Curragh. The Newmarket handler believes the omens are good as his two previous winners--Lailani (GB) (Unfuwain) in 2001 and Ouija Board (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}) in 2004--were both supplementary entries. Snow Fairy was added to the June 4 Epsom field at a cost of £20,000, and the outlay has been €42,500 this time around. "This has been the plan since Epsom, she's in good form and we're very happy with her, so we'll just have to see how we get on," Dunlop told *Racing Post*. "I'm sure there'll be a good pace and now we know how many runners there are and where we're drawn, we can start to talk about what we're going to do. It's good ground and good-to-soft in the straight. They had quite a lot of rain on Thursday night, but they apparently needed that. There is a little bit more forecast [Saturday night], but the Curragh does dry out very fast, and I think there are plenty of horses who wouldn't want it too soft. We'll just keep our fingers crossed they don't get a great deal more rain. We've had our day at Epsom, and if we get another one it would be great. We supplemented to win the Oaks and she did it, so she's an English Classic winner now. We've supplemented twice before to win the Irish Oaks [with Lailani and Ouija Board], and whether we can do it a third time is in the lap of the gods." Snow Fairy's task has been made that much easier with the surprise defection of His Highness The Aga Khan's G1 Prix de Diane runner-up **Rosanara (Fr)** (Sinndar {Ire}), who did not leave France after taking issue with attempts to get her onto her intended flight. "We tried to load Rosanara on the plane at Le Bourget [airport], but she became frightened," trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre told *Racing Post*. "After the second try, we decided it was too dangerous to fly her to Ireland, so we abandoned the trip."

### PADDY POWER

He may be Grade I-placed on dirt and synthetic, but it is on the turf that **Paddy O'Prado** (El Prado {Ire}) excels.

The imposing grey came rolling through along the rail to pick up his third straight graded win on the grass in yesterday's GII Virginia Derby at Colonial Downs.

"He's the best," said Jerry Crawford, representing the Donegal Racing partnership that owns the three-year-old. Donegal consists of nine partners, all from Iowa, and the group filled the winner's circle after the race. "We travelled pretty well," quipped Crawford. **Cont. p4**

Aidan O'Brien has registered three previous wins in the contest--with Alexandrova (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) in 2006, Peeping Fawn (Danehill) in 2007 and Moonstone (GB) (Dalakhani {Ire}) in 2008--and saddles a team of five this time. The Ballydoyle conditioner's best chance rests with G1 Epsom Oaks third **Remember When**, who ran fourth in the June 26 G1 Pretty Polly S. at this venue. "Remember When is in good form and she ran a lovely race at Epsom," O'Brien said. "We were a little

disappointed with her run back here in the Pretty Polly; if she came back to her Epsom form, we'd be really looking forward to her run. We think the track will suit her well." **Hibaayeb**, winner of last term's G1 Ascot Fillies' Mile, ran a lifeless race

in the May 2 G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket, but bounced back to form when third in the May 23 G1 Prix Saint-Alary at Longchamp, and bettered that effort with a stylish victory in the G2 Ribblesdale S. at Royal Ascot last time June 17. She, along with fellow Godolphin supplementary entry **Miss Jean Brodie**, will attempt to become the operation's first winner of this race. Newmarket-based Irishman David Lanigan has yet to win a Classic, but has solid claims with **Meeznah**, who failed by just a neck to land the spoils in the Epsom Oaks.

Campanologist closed last semester with a ninth in the Oct. 17 G1 Champion S. at Newmarket, and came back this year to land the G2 Dubai City of Gold at Meydan Mar. 4. Remaining in Dubai to finish ninth in the Mar. 27 G1 Sheema Classic, he ran fourth in the May 16 G1 Premio Presidente Della Repubblica at Rome and was a last-out third in the June 13 G1 Gran Premio di Milano. Campanologist stalked the pacesetter Wiener Walzer in a close third going by the judge first time, and remained in situ going down the back straight. Set alight by jockey Frankie Dettori turning for home, he made his bid in early stretch and stayed on strongly under a final-quarter drive to register a career high in determined fashion. "Campanologist was in great form today and he really deserved his Group 1 victory," said jockey Frankie Dettori. "By the way, I won my first race in this category at Hamburg in 1991 when winning the German Derby on Temporal." Skipshot had little success in three starts last year, but he kicked off 2010 with three straight wins at Golden Gate, capping the streak with a nose decision in an allowance test Mar. 14. The chestnut pressed the pace in the GI Santa Anita Derby Apr. 3 before fading to fifth, and was done for the year. Making his return in the May 22 GIII Laz Barrera Memorial S. at Hollywood, he weakened late to be fifth again. He improved to be second in the June 19 GIII Affirmed S., and was the 4-1 second choice in this four-horse field. Skipshot hounded 1-5 Sidney's Candy through a half in :48.78 and three-quarters in 1:12.82. He let the chalk open up a little in midstretch, but came at him relentlessly in the final furlong and got his head in front in the final strides. The runner-up was making his first start since getting dusted over a sloppy strip in the May 1 GI Kentucky Derby. Winless in three starts as a juvenile, Paddy O'Prado was second by a neck in a turf maiden at Saratoga in August and ran third behind Interactif in the GIII With Anticipation S. at the end of the meet. Put away after that effort, he was third once again in his return in a maiden test on the turf at Gulfstream Feb. 10, then graduated in style with a 2 1/2-length score in the Mar. 6 GIII Palm Beach S. His connections switched gears in the spring, putting the colt on the Triple Crown trail, and he rewarded their faith with a second in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. on the synthetic and a third in the GI Kentucky Derby in the slop.

Paddy O'Prado did not fare as well on a fast track in the May 15 GI Preakness S., finishing sixth, and it was back to the lawn. He was the 3-2 chalk in the June 19 GII Colonial Turf Cup and carried Kent Desormeaux to a three-length triumph. Donegal Racing founder Jerry Crawford was full of praise for Colonial Downs. "They have the best turf series in America," Crawford said. Hammered down to 3-5 to take the second leg in the series, Paddy O'Prado had just one horse behind him as they negotiated six furlongs in 1:13.23. Left with no options as they hit the turn, Kent Desormeaux drove his mount between horses at the three-eighths pole, then slipped inside the leader in the stretch and drew clear. "It was kind of a forced issue," Desormeaux admitted. "To tell the truth, I didn't want to be down there, but that was the line I was offered. He got me through with a massive turn of foot--without his talent, I wouldn't be here [in the winner's circle]." Trainer Dale Romans said the Aug. 21 GI Secretariat S. at Arlington would be next. "That worked for [champion] Kitten's Joy, and we're following the same pattern with this horse," Romans said. "Both are by El Prado, both are rugged horses who love to win with a big turn of foot. First or second in six of his first seven starts, Workin for Hops was the crowd's choice in quest of his first graded score. He rewarded their faith in style. A seven-length winner when in against \$40,000 maiden claimers on the Arlington Poly last September, the chestnut came back to be second in a starter allowance at Keeneland the following month. He switched to the turf after shipping to the Fair Grounds for the winter, taking an optional claimer Dec. 28 and the Grindstone S. Mar. 27. Fifth after breaking awkwardly in the Apr. 30 GII American Turf S., Workin for Hops finished fifth, but he rebounded with a decisive score in the May 22 Arlington Classic. He earned the role of favorite off a second behind Paddy O'Prado (El Prado {Ire}) in the June 19 GII Colonial Turf Cup. 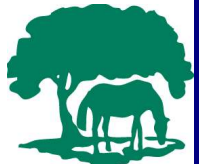

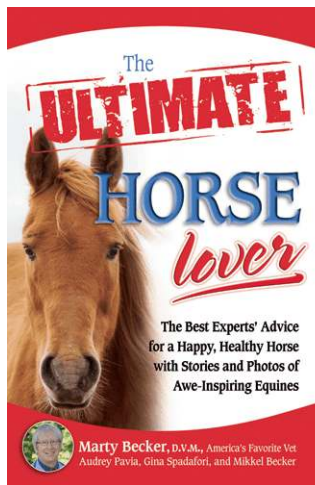

In yet another open renewal of this contest, which occupies a later date in the calendar due to the staging of soccer's World Cup, Germany's racing authorities have taken the unusual step of allowing reserves after the maximum field of 20 was oversubscribed. WH Sport International's **Zazou** has already competed twice at the highest level, finishing third in last term's G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud and sixth in the May 16 G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains at Longchamp. He lines up here coming off a comfortable win in the June 13 G2 Oppenheim-Union-Rennen at Cologne where he had **Lindentree**, **Baschar**, **Next Hight**, **Scalo** and **Nordfalke** in arrears, but will need to up his game for this first try at 12 furlongs. **Russian Tango** is another attempting this trip for the first time, and he too holds several reopposing rivals on his win in the June 18 Listed Derby-Trial at Bremen. **Seventh Sky**, who won the June 26 Listed Derby-Trial at Hannover, is a half brother to two previous winners of this contest--**Samum** (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}) and **Schiaparelli** (Ger) (Monsun {Ger})--and is his dam Sacarina's fourth representative in the contest. Guaranteed to relish this stamina test, he merits the utmost respect, and is the choice of trainer Peter Schiergen's go-to jockey Andrasch Starke. Trainer Mark Johnston's progressive **Monterosso** stepped up from an early-season handicap campaign to garner the June 18 G2 King Edward VII S. at Royal Ascot, and backed that up with a three-length fourth in the June 27 G1 Irish Derby at The Curragh. He will attempt to become the first overseas raider to prevail since the restriction on non-German-bred horses was lifted in 1993.

**BILL ALLEN DIES** Owner/breeder Bill Allen, who campaigned inaugural GI Breeders' Cup Classic hero Wild Again (Icecapade) in partnership, passed away July 16 at his home in Las Vegas, Nevada. He was 84. Born in Texas, Allen served in the Navy during World War II before going into the insurance business. He eventually became CEO of Academy Insurance Group. A tournament-class, scratch-golfer, Allen helped build five courses with Sam Snead. "He was beloved for his kind demeanor among all race track employees and track devotees from parking lot attendants to track presidents," John Perrotta recalled. "He was well-known as a man who would bet with both hands whenever he had an opinion--which was quite frequently." Wild Again, a \$35,000 Fasig-Tipton yearling purchase, was supplemented to the Breeders' Cup for \$360,000 and, after a dramatic stretch run, withstood a claim of foul to take the \$3-million event ([video](#)). "There are very few people in this world who would have done with Wild Again what Bill did," Bryan Brown, his son-in-law and chief executive of Retama Park, told *Daily Racing Form*. "His appetite for risk and belief in the horse led him there, to the first Breeders' Cup Championships." Allen was responsible for opening Retama Park, located in San Antonio, Texas, in 1996. He is survived by his wife of 22 years, Nina, as well as his three daughters and a stepson, 11 grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren. A memorial service will be planned in Del Mar during the upcoming race meet.
