Snow Fairy (Ire) (Intikhab) was the spellbinding victress of yesterday's G1 Darley Irish Oaks at The Curragh, adding to her victory in last month's G1 Epsom Oaks. Taking over from eventual third **Lady Lupus (Ire)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) 1 1/2 furlongs from home, the 7-2 second choice surged clear to win by eight lengths from Godolphin's **Miss Jean Brodie** (Maria's Mon). QUALITY ROAD PUTS IN 'MONSTER' WORK

Tightening the screws in advance of the G1 Whitney H. at Saratoga Aug. 7, Ned Evans homebred **Quality Road** (Elusive Quality) fired a five-furlong bullet in :58 3/5 over Belmont Park's main track yesterday. The four-year-old, who won the G1 Met Mile in his most recent at Belmont May 31, was scheduled to work in company, but his workmate wheeled and dropped his rider just before they were to break off. That horse was quickly gathered in by the outriders, and trainer Todd Pletcher made the decision to just work Quality Road by himself. "He actually worked faster on his own than he would have in company," Pletcher told *Daily Racing Form*. "[The exercise rider] wanted to make sure she got him into the bridle and focused, and he was very focused. I think he worked as well as a horse could possibly work. It was a monster work." Also on Belmont's worktab was the Pletcher-trained **Super Saver** (Maria's Mon), who is readying for the G1 Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Aug. 1. Working with GII Jim Dandy S.-bound **Aikenite** (Yes It's True), the G1 Kentucky Derby winner breezed five panels in 1:00 flat. Aikenite was timed in 1:00 3/5. "He needed a good solid work today," Pletcher said of Super Saver, who rallied from just off his barnmate to finish 1 1/2 lengths in front. "I thought today was the best I have ever seen him work since we got him. He's filled out well, he's matured, [and] he seemed settled more in the breeze. He delivered a good finish and a strong gallop out."

Snow in the Forecast...

Snow Fairy gave little indication of how high she would fly in her juvenile campaign, but took a Lingfield maiden on her second outing in July and recorded her best effort when she finished fast for a narrowly beaten third in the G3 Prestige S. at Goodwood Aug. 29. Only ninth in the Listed Radley S. at Newbury in her final two-year-old start Oct. 24, her sophomore campaign commenced with a win in the May 19 Listed Height of Fashion S. at Goodwood that was sufficiently impressive to persuade connections to supplement the filly for the G1 Epsom Oaks June 4. She repaid that faith, and quiet market confidence, by collaring Meeznah--in opposition again here--inside the final eighth there. Trainer Ed Dunlop was on a roll, and the owner's purse strings were loosened again to supplement for this, as her handler had done with both Lailani and Ouija Board. Racing in mid-division as Ice Empress towed the field along at a good clip, Snow Fairy crept ever closer on the home turn as Akdarena (GB) (Hernando {Fr}) and Lady Lupus picked up the baton and most of her rivals came under pressure. She swept to the front 1 1/2 furlongs from the line and quickly put daylight between herself and the rest of the field. Further improvement can be expected as Dunlop revealed, "[Jockey] Ryan [Moore] said she got bumped at one stage, and she'd be better on better ground. We were very confident she'd go well on decent ground. It was the owner who decided to take the plunge and said go. She is stronger than she was at Epsom, and she has a huge heart."

Regarding future plans, Dunlop mused, "The [G1] Yorkshire Oaks [at York Aug. 19] is a possibility now. I persuaded the owner to supplement her twice for the Breeders' Cup, and I don't know if I'll ask her to do it again. We'd have to start to think of going down a similar road to Ouija Board, and I'm reliably informed that, once everything is okay, she'll stay in training as a four year old." Jockey Ryan Moore revealed his trip through the race wasn't all plain sailing and added, "She wasn't a better filly today and she wasn't enjoying the ground. They went quick and she wasn't enjoying going up and down the hill, but she's a fighter and she got through it although we arrived there earlier than I would have liked. She's really come on from Epsom in her work and on better ground she'll be even better. I got two bumps early on, which is never good on a filly, especially one her size. She's obviously by far the best three-year-old filly, and she showed that today. She's a bit of a freak, but I'd imagine that she'd stay against the girls just now." The crowd's 10-3 choice Hibaayeb (GB) (Singspiel {Ire}) demonstrated that the Godolphin team's fears regarding the ground were well founded, as Frankie Dettori reported that she didn't handle the terrain and struggled throughout.

O'Brien Happy with Lupus Run...

Ballydoyle conditioner Aidan O'Brien, who saddled five runners in the contest, was satisfied with the performance of third-place-getter **Lady Lupus (Ire)** (High Chaparral {Ire}). "She ran a very good race and kept going when a lot of the others were stopping," O'Brien told *Racing Post*.

Meeznah Compromised by Ground...

Newmarket-based conditioner David Lanigan disappointed in his attempt to garner a first Classic win with **Meeznah** (Dynaformer), who failed to build upon her second in the G1 Epsom Oaks last time by finishing fourth here. "We were a bit apprehensive about the ground, and she was labouring on it over the last couple of furlongs," Saif Ali and Saeed Altayer's racing manager Bruce Raymond told *Racing Post*, adding, "She gets the trip well, but not on that ground."

Buzzword enjoyed a busy juvenile campaign and backed up a victory in the Sept. 6 G3 Prix La Rochette at Longchamp by running third in the Oct. 4 G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere back there next time. He slipped to fifth in the Oct. 17 G1 Dewhurst S. at Newmarket and occupied the same berth in the GII BC Juvenile Turf, his final start in the care of Saeed bin Suroor. Buzzword disappointed when off the radar in the May 1 G1 2000 Guineas back at Newmarket, but fared better with a fourth in the May 16 G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains back at Longchamp before dropping to eighth in the June 5 G1 Epsom Derby. He was allowed off at large odds here off a third in the G2 King Edward VII S. at Royal Ascot, and belied that price with a tenacious stretch run to become the first foreign winner of this prestigious event. Keeping the leaders within range in fifth, he was pushed off the home turn to challenge and was driven out once taking over approaching the final eighth to repel leading domestic hope Zazou, who ran out of gas nearing the line. "We were quite confident beforehand, as Buzzword is a really high-class horse," Godolphin's Diana Cooper told *Racing Post*. "He had been freshened up by a break since Royal Ascot and [jockey] Royston [Ffrench] gave him a peach of a ride." Ffrench added, "My main concern was to get a decent position in such a big field. [GII Dance Smartly S. \(6th-WOX\)](#) 5yo mare **Mekong Melody** (Cape Cross {Ire}) gets her nose down.

David Egan homebred Mekong Melody shook off the cobwebs to register her fourth victory in five starts in North America--and her first graded victory--in Sunday's feature at Woodbine. Beginning her career in Britain, Mekong Melody won once during a busy 12-start sophomore season back in 2008. Shipped to these shores for her four-year-old campaign, she won her first two starts here facing allowance company at Woodbine last summer--one on the turf, one on the Poly. She could do no better than fifth to Ginger Brew (Milwaukee Brew) in the Belle Mahone S. over the main track in August, but rebounded with an initial black-type tally in the 12-furlong Flaming Page S. on the sod in late September. Making her first start since then, she pulled her way up to press after a quarter in :24, continued to shadow as things sped up through :46 1/5 and 1:09 splits, then forged to the front in mid-stretch. Favored Ave came charging in the dying strides, but Mekong Melody gamely held by a nose while giving trainer Roger Attfield the exacta. Assistant trainer Nancy Sullivan was confident before the race despite the lengthy break. "It's Roger Attfield off the layoff, long on the grass. How could you worry?" asked Sullivan. Based in the United Kingdom, owner David Egan was on hand to watch his filly. "It's absolutely fabulous," said Egan. "It's a lot of fun. I look forward to keeping her and breeding from her. I have friends of mine here. They've watched all of her races. They're lucky charms." Egan said he was attracted to Canadian racing by Woodbine's lucrative stakes program. 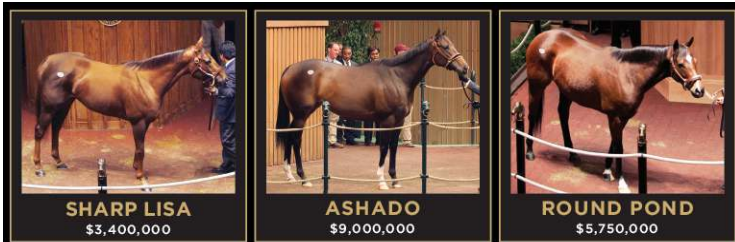

Rosario was the leading jockey at the Hollywood Park
spring/summer meet, which wrapped up last evening,
and showed why in the closing-day feature. Giving a
heads-up ride aboard lukewarm
chalk Marlang, Rosario pointed
his mount to the fore in the early
going, and the pair cruised along
through :24, :48, 1:12 4/5 and
1:37 2/5 splits while leading by
daylight. Second choice Champ
Pegasus challenged in upper
stretch, but a brave Marlang
kept finding more. "He went to
the post quiet, but he was
sweating a little," said Rosario,
who also won the GII Swaps S.

lead, and he got a little tough after that. He's a long-
striding horse and, about halfway through the race, he
came back to me real nice. That's why he finished
better today. I want to thank all the people here for all
the kindness and all the owners here at Hollywood Park
for supporting me. Everything worked out real nice."
Rosario finished the meet with 79 victories, four more
than runner-up Rafael Bejarano. Marlang, hero of the
third leg of Canada's Triple Crown, the Breeders' S., in
2008, hadn't won since taking that year's GIII Saranac
S. at Saratoga. Blanked in four starts in Canada last
year, he was moved from Deborah England's barn to
Neil Drysdale's California digs for the 2010 season. He
ran fifth in a one-mile optional claimer in his first start

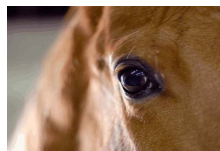
Dunboyne Express carried significant stable confidence into a Leopardstown maiden first time up June 10 and showed that he was not lacking in guts as

he edged out a Ballydoyle hotpot to get off to a winning start. Tracking the early pace in third here, he took over going well after halfway and powered clear in the final eighth when jockey Declan McDonogh applied the persuader. "He's a smart horse and maybe the opposition didn't handle the ground, but he likes it, it was nice steady ground," trainer Kevin Prendergast told [irishracing.com](#). 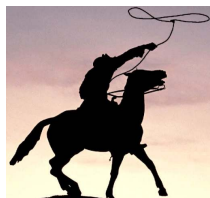

Campaigned in Dubai and Europe last year, J J The Jet Plane bagged a third-place finish in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket and ended the season with a ninth in the G2 Diadem S. at Ascot Sept. 27. He registered a second win in the G1 Golden Horse Sprint upon his return to Southern Hemisphere action at Scottsville last time May 29, and trounced the opposition in track-record time here to claim a fifth top-level score. Racing on the front end from the outset, he surged ever clear of his rivals inside the final quarter mile to register a second triumph in this event.

Kaleem Shah's Smash was heavily touted before his debut and lived up to the hype in a "TDN Rising Star" performance. Cool and collected in the paddock and post parade, Smash opened at 2-5 before going postward as the 1-2 pick. Breaking from post nine under Martin Garcia, the bay was up to shadow Doughboy (Wildcat Heir) through :22.76 and :46.05 splits. Asked to quicken at the eighth pole, he unleashed an eye-catching turn of foot to easily take command and power home 2 1/2 lengths clear. Doughboy held well for second, with another 4 1/2 lengths back to third. Baffert was saddling his seventh first-out winner in 15 debuters at Hollywood. A \$400,000 juvenile-in-training purchase, Smash was the co-third-highest-priced youngster at the OBS March Sale. He was produced by the 16-year-old Dixie Holiday and is thus a half to Holiday Runner (Meadowlake), MSW & GSP, \$232,073, who is the dam of MGISW Seventh Street (Street Cry {Ire}) and GSP Reynaldothewizard (Speightstown). Dixie Holiday produced a Henny Hughes colt in 2009 and had a Malibu Moon filly this past spring. Lifetime Record: 1-1-0-0, \$24,600. SMASH (Smart Strike)

The Empire Strikes Back...

Niall Brennan flipped on the TV last evening to just catch the finish of the seventh race at Hollywood, but was plenty familiar with the colt streaking clear to the line. Brennan broke and trained Smash on behalf of breeder Peter Blum, and subsequently sold the son of Smart Strike for \$400,000 to Kaleem Shah at the OBS March Selected Sale of Two-Year-Olds in Training. Hill 'n' Dale's Donato Lanni selected the colt and signed the ticket on trainer Bob Baffert's behalf.

Lanni and Baffert had teamed to buy Lookin at Lucky for Mike Pegram and partners at the previous year's Keeneland April Sale for \$475,000, and, following that one's championship exploits at two, were looking for lightning to strike twice with a similarly priced (and bred) son of Smart Strike. (Both horses are out of Northern Dancer-line mares; Lookin at Lucky is out of Private Feeling, by Belong to Me.)

"This horse reminded me a lot of Lucky," Lanni said shortly after signing the ticket for Smash. "He has a lot of class and a great disposition. He handled himself well, and he's a really laid-back horse. He obviously worked very well, and Smart Strike/Dixieland Band? That's worked before. He's a well-bred horse and has a stallion's pedigree. Hopefully we get lucky."

Smash gave every impression yesterday that he indeed would prove a lucky charm for Team Baffert, and Brennan wasn't surprised to see his former pupil put forth such a big effort.

"I'd been contacted and told he was training very well," said Brennan. "He went right out to California, and Bob liked him from Day 1. He was always such a professional. He was very impressive at the sale and worked super, and he's a very good individual."

Brennan said that the colt's \$400,000 price tag at OBS March might well have been higher if Smash had been a tad bigger, but considering Baffert and Lanni's success with Lookin at Lucky--another horse with a medium build--size wasn't an issue.

"Donato had mentioned that," said Brennan. "When they bought Lookin at Lucky as a two-year-old, he wasn't an overly big horse, either. He was a tidy, well-made colt with a lot of balance. It's was the same with this horse and, being by the same sire and all, I think, in their minds, this colt appealed to them."

Brennan added of Smash, "He's got great balance, and everything's in the right place. He's very agile--he's one of those smaller athletes who's just very good. And he's got a great mind--he was always very sharp. It was easy to like him, and a lot of people had shortlisted him. Donato looked at him several times, and bought him for Bob and those guys, and he was a good buy for them. He was mature by that point and very sound, and he has a fabulous pedigree. Smart Strike is a great sire, and if you see one perform at the two-year-old sales like this one did, it's not brain surgery." **Cont. p4**

As mentioned, Smash was bred by the Atlanta, Georgia-based businessman Peter Blum, a commercial breeder who more often than not sells his horses as yearlings.

"[Smash] was an immature yearling, and I think Peter decided to give him a chance to grow up a little more and offer him as a two-year-old," explained Brennan. "Obviously, it was the right call."

Brennan estimates he sold five or six horses this spring for Blum, including another son of Smart Strike who realized a big price. At the Keeneland April Sale, Knockout, a colt by the Lane's End sire out of Topsom (Red Ransom), was hammered down to Paul Pompa, Jr. for \$300,000. Knockout, a half-brother to MGISP Silver Swallow (Alphabet Soup), has not yet started.

"Peter knows the business so well, and he's been in it so long, that he's a great guy to work for," said Brennan. "And it's a pleasure getting horses like [Smash] to work with. He's from a great family. Peter's pedigrees are so strong, it makes our job a little easier. We sold several this year for him that did very well."

Brennan and Blum also partnered to sell the colt Powerman (Lemon Drop Kid--Cheerful, by Dixieland Band) for \$240,000 to Mark Casse at this year's OBS March. -L Marquardt
