## EIGHT LEFT IN KING GEORGE

Ascot's midsummer showpiece, the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth S., will see a maximum of eight runners go to post after 11 horses were taken out of Saturday's contest at yesterday's declaration stage. Khalid Abdullah's G1 Epsom Derby victor **Workforce (GB)** (King's Best) will be joined by the Ballydoyle pair of

**At First Sight (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), runner-up at Epsom June 5, and **Cape Blanco (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), who won the G1 Irish Derby at The Curragh June 27, to take on the older generations. Sir Michael Stoute, who saddled the first three home in last year's re-

newal, may also be represented by G2 Hardwicke S. hero **Harbinger (GB)** (Dansil {GB}), who is set to be partnered by Olivier Peslier; and **Confront (GB)** (Nayef), who, like Workforce, is owned by Khalid Abdullah. The field of possibles is completed by three-time G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe runner-up **Youmzain (Ire)** (Sinndar {Ire}), His Highness The Aga Khan's G1 Hong Kong Vase victress **Daryakana (Fr)** (Selkirk), and Lady Lloyd-Webber's three-time Group 1 heroine **Dar Re Mi (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}).

## GENERAL QUARTERS SUFFERS ANKLE INJURY

**General Quarters** (Sky Mesa), sixth in Saturday's GIII Arlington H., exited the race with a sore ankle. "He came up with a bum ankle," confirmed owner-trainer Tom McCarthy. "The jock [Rafael Bejarano] said he thought the ground was too hard for him, but the ankle was probably already bothering him during the race. We'll take some x-rays when we get him home to see what they show, but I would say the [Aug. 21 GI] Arlington Million is out.

## RACHEL TUNES UP FOR LADY'S SECRET

Reigning Horse of the Year **Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro) worked a half-mile at Saratoga yesterday in advance of her start in Saturday's Lady's Secret S. at Monmouth Park. The four-year-old filly went four furlongs over the Oklahoma training track in :49.60. "She's had three moves [at Saratoga] and things have gone as smoothly as we were hoping for," trainer Steve Asmussen told *Daily Racing Form*. "She looked great on the track, just appeared to be nice, loose and happy, and I thought she moved very well. She had a lot of energy and looked confident." Asmussen also sent

out **"TDN Rising Star"** **Kantharos** (Lion Heart) to work five furlongs yesterday in 1:02.45. The juvenile, coming off a 9 1/2-length romp in the July 3 GIII Bashford Manor S., could appear in any of Saratoga's major two-year-old stakes, beginning with Sunday's GII Sanford S.

## NO SIGNIFICANT INJURY FOR DROSSELMAYER

WinStar Farm's **Drosselmeyer** (Distorted Humor) will likely not race again this year, but tests on the G1 Belmont S. winner's ankle did not reveal any serious injury. In his only work since the June 5 Belmont, Drosselmeyer went four furlongs in :49.2 July 4 at 'Big Sandy,' but exited the drill with a sore ankle. "He's doing well," WinStar racing manager Elliott Walden said of Drosselmeyer yesterday. "He had a bone scan done over the weekend and kind of just had some hot spots, but nothing that was lit up more than something else, so we feel like he's going to come out just fine. We just need to give him some time off. He'll go back in training before the end of the year, but I don't think he'll make a race before the end of the year." Walden confirmed Drosselmeyer would be aimed at next year's G1 Dubai World Cup.

**SMOOTH AIR RETIRED** Three-time Grade II winner and twice Grade I-placed **Smooth Air** (Smooth Jazz--Air France, by French Deputy) has officially been retired

from racing. As a three-year-old, Smooth Air captured the 2008 GII Ohio Derby and GII Hutcheson S., was second in the GI Florida Derby and third in the GII Pennsylvania Derby. Last term, he won the GII Gulfstream Park H. and was second in the GI Metropolitan H. The bay was last seen finishing sixth of six as the favorite in the GI Whitney H. at Saratoga last August. He exited that effort with a foot injury. On the board in 14 of 17 starts, Smooth Air won six times

and earned \$1,117,200. Brian D. Burns of owner Mount Joy Stables said, "Smooth Air has been fantastic to us and deserves to be turned out to stud at this time." Stud plans for the five-year-old have not been finalized.

G1 Darley July Cup.

**BLIND LUCK WORKS FOR ALABAMA** Multiple Grade I winner **Blind Luck** (Pollard's Vision) worked a half-mile in :49.20 at Del Mar yesterday. "It was just a maintenance work," explained trainer Jerry Hollendorfer. "She always works really well." Winner of the GI Kentucky Oaks this past spring, Blind Luck is coming off a narrow victory in the July 10 GII Delaware Oaks. She is expected to make her next start in the Aug. 21 GI Alabama S. at Saratoga. "I would much rather run her here, but there isn't anything for her at Del Mar,"

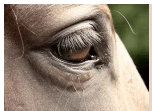

When the great Danzig was mated to daughters of the 2000 Guineas and Derby winner Sir Ivor, breeders had every right to feel confident, as this cross produced a magnificent 24-percent stakes winners from 37 foals. One thing they couldn't feel confident about, though, was the distance the foal would need. The nine stakes winners from this cross were a very varied bunch, as its two Grade I winners highlighted.

At one end of the distance scale was Danzig Connection, who showed Sir Ivor's Classic influence in winning the 1986 Belmont S. At the other extreme, showing the speed which Danzig became celebrated for in Europe, was Green Desert. This tough colt reverted to six furlongs with considerable success after performing very creditably in a couple of top mile events.

I mention this simply because there is a growing trend for Green Desert's stallion sons to sire top winners over distances we wouldn't normally have associated with Danzig's fast son. We have seen the sprinter Desert Style sire winners of the German Derby and Prix Vermeille, Invincible Spirit sire a winner of the Prix du Jockey-Club, and the very fast Oasis Dream sire several Group 1 performers over a mile and a quarter or more.

And then there's Cape Cross, the Kildangan Stud resident who scored a magnificent graded/group treble in the space of four days last week. Behkabad set the ball rolling with his fine win in the G1 Juddmonte Grand Prix de Paris and then the ex-French Treat Gently confirmed that she is back to her best by giving weight and a beating to some accomplished rivals in the GIII Robert G. Dick Memorial H. The treble was completed when the ex-English Mekong Melody just held on to take the GII Dance Smartly S. These victories were respectively gained over 1 1/2 miles, 1 3/8 miles and 1 1/8 miles.

Cape Cross now has 19 group winners from his northern hemisphere crops and no fewer than nine of them have gained at least one of their group successes over a mile and a half or more, one of the latest examples being Corsica, winner of the Bahrain Trophy over 1 5/8 miles. The most famous, of course, are his outstanding Classic winners Ouija Board and Sea the Stars, but Behkabad is progressing at such a rate that he may one day be mentioned in the same breath as the other two. His performance on his first attempt at a mile and a half was comfortably his best, and he could develop into an interesting candidate for the Arc--a race which Sea the Stars won five years after Ouija Board had finished a fine third.

If I am labouring the point about the widespread stamina in Cape Cross's progeny, it is because he seemed better qualified to become a fertile source of sprinters and milers. Cape Cross only once attempted more than a mile during his 19-race career and all three of his group successes were gained at a mile.

I have already mentioned his sire Green Desert, whose stock have an average winning distance of just under a mile. Cape Cross's dam Park Appeal also possessed plenty of speed--enough to win all four of her starts over six furlongs on her way to becoming champion two-year-old filly. She later managed a stakes win over 1 1/16 miles at Hollywood Park.

Park Appeal was the product of a mating between a specialist sprinter, Ahonoora, and a daughter of another specialist sprinter, Balidar. However, her pedigree was more complex than that might suggest. For all his speed, Ahonoora was by Lorenzaccio, conqueror of Nijinsky in the Champion S., and the mix of speed and stamina in Ahonoora's pedigree enabled him to sire a wide range of good winners, including a Derby winner in Dr Devious and a champion middle-distance filly in Park Express.

It was a similar story with Park Appeal's dam, the phenomenally successful Balidaress. She too had a pedigree combining a sprinter with some staying blood, as her dam Innocence was by the stamina-packed Sea Hawk II. This grey son of Herbager was perhaps best known as the sire of Bruni, winner of the St Leger, and Matahawk, who took the Grand Prix de Paris in the days when it was over 1 15/16 miles. Sea Hawk was also responsible for Erimo Hawk, winner of the Gold Cup over 2 1/2 miles, and for two other sons, Hawkberry and Irvine, who stayed well enough to finish third in the same marathon. In other words, Sea Hawk was a tremendous influence for stamina, and this allowed Balidaress to win at up to a mile and a quarter.

The four stallions in the third generation of Cape Cross's pedigree include Northern Dancer, Sir Ivor and Lorenzaccio, with Sea Hawk present in the next generation, so it perhaps isn't so surprising that his own speed is often overruled when he is mated to mares with staying blood.

His trio of big winners last week are all examples of this. Mekong Melody, who is a stakes winner at up to a mile and a half, is out of a mare by Niniski, winner of the Irish and French St Legers, while Treat Gently is out of an 11-furlong winner by the stoutly bred In The Wings.

Behkabad also comes from a female line noted for its stamina--and for its quality. His third dam, Borushka, enjoyed her finest moment when she won the G2 Park Hill S. over the same course and distance that her sire Bustino had won the St Leger. Borushka's first mating was to Mill Reef, another stallion who didn't lack stamina, and the result was the top-class filly Behera. American racegoers may remember Behera for her good fourth to Prized in the Breeders' Cup Turf, but in Europe she will be best remembered for her excellent effort in the 1989 Arc, in which she finished second of 19.

This former Boussac family has continued to flourish under the Aga Khan's guidance. Behera produced a pair of group-winning daughters, both of whom relished a thorough test of stamina. The first, her Kahyasi filly Bayrika, won the G3 Prix Berteux over 1 15/16 miles. Even better was her Kris filly Behkara, winner of the G3 Prix Hubert de Chaudenay over 1 7/8 miles at three, before finishing runner-up to the redoubtable Westerner in the G1 Prix Royal-Oak over a similar distance at four.

Bayrika is now the second dam of Vital Equine, runner-up in the 2007 2000 Guineas, and Behkara could hardly have made a better start to her broodmare career. Her first two foals, the Peintre Celebre colt Beheshtam and Behkabad, both took fourth place in the Prix du Jockey-Club and Behkabad has now become her first Group 1 winner. Behkara also has an interesting prospect in her 2008 colt, a son of Cape Cross's sire Green Desert. What's the betting that this colt will also stay much further than the average son of Green Desert?
