THE SUMMER PLACE TO BE

The GIII Schuylerville S. for two-year-old fillies headlines Saratoga's opening-day card. The expanded 40-day meet kicks off its 142nd season with free grandstand and reduced clubhouse admission. Trainer Wesley Ward has entered unbeaten multiple stakes heroine **Final Mesa** (Sky Mesa) and debut winner **Spa Sunrise** (Eddington) in the feature, but will only run one as Eibar Coa is listed on both. The former is untested in three career attempts, including runaway tallies in Delaware's Polly Drummond S. May 15 and Woodbine's My Dear S. June 26. Spa Sunrise held on after opening a big lead in the stretch to defeat Empire-breds at Belmont July 8. "Right now, I'm leaning toward running Spa Sunrise," Ward revealed. "They're both talented fillies with similar physical attributes. The good thing about Spa Sunrise is her mind, and I think that will help her go a little longer." Todd Pletcher, a six-time winner of the prestigious Saratoga training title, sends **Stopspendingmaria** (Montbrook) off a dazzling maiden victory downstate July 1. The Repole Stable colorbearer earned a 91 Beyer that day. "We were very pleased with her maiden win," Pletcher offered. "She came out of the race in good order, has been training well, and we're excited about running her." Klaravich Stables and William Lawrence's **Let's Get Fiscal** (Bandini) drew off like a good thing to record a 5 1/2-length victory in her Belmont unveiling June 17. "She breezed very well the other day, and she's been very professional since the day we first put tack on her," trainer Rick Violette said. "It's time to get the show on the road."

Zenyatta Works Six Panels for Clement Hirsch...

Jerry and Ann Moss's **Zenyatta** (Street Cry {Ire}) breezed six furlongs at Hollywood Park yesterday as she prepares for a probable tilt in the Aug. 7 GI Clement Hirsch S. at Del Mar. Under regular rider Mike Smith, the big mare stopped the clock in 1:12 2/5 while working in company with stablemates Sarbonne (Seeking the Gold) and Green Cat (Stormin Fever). It was the fastest of eight moves at the distance. "t was brilliant," Smith told *Daily Racing Form*. "It reminded me of her work before the [GI Breeders' Cup] Classic [last year]. She seems to be really back on." Zenyatta returned from her historic win in the Classic to take the GI Santa Margarita H. at Santa Anita in March and the GI Apple Blossom S. at Oaklawn in April. In her latest, she needed to dig deep to fight pas St Trinians (GB) (Piccolo {GB}) in the GI Vanity H. at Hollywood June 13. "The other day was the first time she had to lay it down a little bit," Smith said of the Vanity. "I think it did her a world of good." Zenyatta is unbeaten in 17 races. She won the Clement Hirsch in both 2008 and 2009.

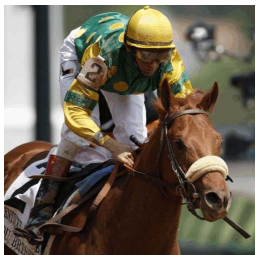

RACETRACK Round-Up

Del Mar Cancels Morning Training...

(Edited Press Release) Del Mar closed its main track to training Thursday morning when it was determined that there had been some separation of its Polytrack materials in the stretch area, causing some inconsistencies in the surface

makeup. Despite the concerns, yesterday's afternoon card was conducted in its entirety.

A handful of horses had galloped or exercised on the track following its usual opening at 4:30 a.m. When the apparent inconsistencies were noted to track officials--

and following consultations with the track's outriders and track superintendent Richard Tedesco--the decision was made to close the track and immediately perform additional procedures planned for next Monday rather than attempt to quickly reopen it for further training. No injuries to any horses were reported.

"We are taking a cautious path here and leaning strongly on the side of safety," Track President and General Manager Craig Fravel said Thursday morning. "We fully expect to have this track in proper order in a few hours and are planning to run our racing card this afternoon." **Cont. p3**

Track crews had scheduled a full rototilling procedure for the surface Monday following the conclusion of the first week of racing. That procedure was moved up to Thursday morning to return the track to its proper balance.

New maintenance procedures put in place this summer by Tedesco had seen his crews perform a procedure called power harrowing each morning from 1-3 a.m. in which the track's top surface was turned over and loosened to ensure consistency for training each morning. That procedure had balanced the morning surface to that of its afternoon presentation and, according to Del Mar, had drawn positive feedback from horsemen. The power harrowing had started July 10 and gone on for 12 days through yesterday morning.

"We believed we wouldn't need to get in and do our rototilling until this coming Monday," Fravel stated. "But now it appears we overestimated how long we could go without turning the track fully over. We'll rototill this morning and be back on schedule in time to race [Thursday]."

In the rototilling procedure, equipment that digs deeper into the track materials is used to totally remix its various elements, which are primarily sand, fiber, rubber and wax. The remixed matter is then fluffed and smoothed by other equipment to give the track its consistency.

"If we go the traditional route, he could run in the [GII] La Jolla [H., Aug. 14] and then into the [GII] Del Mar Derby [Sept. 5]. Also, we have another horse for that series --[GI

Santa Anita Derby hero] **Sidney's Candy** (Candy Ride {Arg})--who could run in the La Jolla and let Twirling Candy wait for the Derby." Sadler added that Sidney's Candy is no worse from the wear following his second-place finish in Saturday's GII Swap S.

Friend Or Foe Gearing Up for Jim Dandy...

Chester and Mary Broman's unbeaten New York-bred **Friend Or Foe** (Friends Lake) remains on target for Saratoga's GII Jim Dandy S. July 31. The chestnut was last seen annexing Belmont's seven-furlong Mike Lee S. June 20. The Jim Dandy marks his first attempt against open company as well as around two turns. "He's been doing everything very well," trainer John Kimmel said. "Nice, healthy, sound, eating well, looking good, all positive.

He's always had a lot of talent--he's a great-moving horse. He's 17 hands tall, and the horse has just been doing everything right. He's a pleasure to be around." Friend Or Foe is scheduled for his final tune-up for the traditional GI Travers S. prep Saturday. "He's a little light on experience, but all the little things that I look to evaluate a horse's potential to do it, I see in this horse," Kimmel continued. "He gallops out well and he's got speed, but he's not a run-off kind of a horse. He'd be very easy to place where you'd want to place him. I'm kind of excited about it."



Oak Tree Lease Agreement Deadline Today...

The California Horse Racing Board mandated Thursday that Magna International Developments sign a lease agreement with the Oak Tree Racing Association for its fall meeting at Santa Anita by this afternoon, *Daily Racing Form* reports. If not, Magna International may risk losing its license to operate Santa Anita, Golden Gate and XpressBet, according to *DRF*. Frank Stronach, Magna International chairman, and Oak Tree reached a verbal agreement to conduct the Oak Tree meeting at Santa Anita at a board meeting last month after voiding the lease earlier this spring. Both sides told *DRF* that they expect the deal to be reached by the deadline. Magna requires a waiver from the CHRB in order to operate two racetracks in addition to XpressBet. CHRB Chairman initially gave Magna and Oak Tree a July 30 deadline in order to reach an agreement, but Oak Tree's Executive Vice President Sherwood Chillingworth moved to have an earlier deadline.

Premio Loco Added to Sussex Dozen...

Trainer Chris Wall has supplemented recent G2 Summer Mile S. winner **Premio Loco** (Prized) for Wednesday's G1 Sussex S. at a cost of £19,500. The six-year-old joins a mouthwatering cast for Glorious Goodwood's meeting highlight, which currently includes G1 Irish 2000 Guineas and G1 St James's Palace winner **Canford Cliffs (Ire)** (Tagula {Ire}), recent G1 Prix Jean Prat victor **Dick Turpin (Ire)** (Arakan) and defending champion **Rip Van Winkle (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), who will bid to become the first dual winner of the one-mile contest. "We have supplemented Premio Loco for the Sussex, and it is his most likely target at Glorious Goodwood," commented trainer Chris Wall. "We gave him the option of the [July 27 G2] Betfair Cup as a fall-back, but this looks a good opportunity for a chance in Group 1 company. He won well at Ascot and one could argue that he could have done it rather more convincingly with a clearer run. He has continued to be in good form at home since that race and he has also won the Listed On The House S. on his only previous start at Goodwood. We looked at the last forfeit stage for the Sussex and we had finished in front of the vast majority of the entries. We haven't come up against Canford Cliffs nor Rip Van Winkle and, on their day, they are proper horses so they won't be easy to beat, but we might as well have a crack at the them while we are fit and well and everything is in our favour." The remaining entries also include last year's G1 Dewhurst S. winner **Beethoven (Ire)** (Oratorio {Ire}), and Group 1-placed candidates **Alexandros (GB)** (Kingmambo) and **Dream Eater (Ire)** (Night Shift), as well as last night's G3 Meld S. winner Famous Name (GB) (Dansili {GB}).

Having bagged seven victories in Listed and Group 3 company prior to this engagement, 2008 G1 Prix du Jockey Club runner-up Famous Name conceded weight all round and extended that record in impressive style to maintain his unbeaten start to this campaign. Runner-up in last year's G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup and G1 Prix du Moulin, he came back this term to claim the Apr. 18 Listed Heritage S. at this track, and was the narrow winner of the G3 Amethyst S. back here once more last time May 9. Breaking well to stalk the leader in second, he was sent to the front in early stretch and kept on strongly thereafter to register an eighth black-type success in impressive fashion. "Famous Name is probably the most consistent group-performing horse in Europe," trainer Dermot Weld told [irishracing.com](#). "That's his ninth win, he remains unbeaten this year and he's an absolute joy to train. The ground conditions were ideal for him and, when conditions are right, he is extremely hard to beat. He's better than ever, and [jockey] Pat [Smullen] said the same, he's better as a five-year-old. 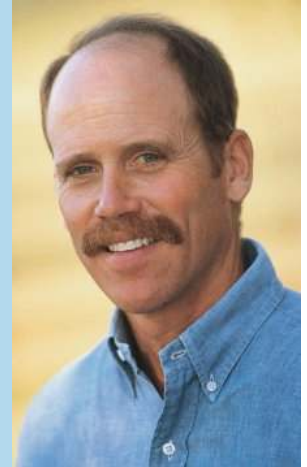

How did you first get into racing? I grew up around horses. I developed an interest in Thoroughbred racing probably starting with Secretariat or even earlier with Riva Ridge--in the early 70's. Then I moved to Kentucky in 1978 [to work for Dr. Smiser West's Waterford Farm].

What types of duties and responsibilities does your job entail?

From January to July 4 your days are spent mostly dealing with foaling and reproductive work on the broodmares trying to get them back in foal and keeping the mares and the foals healthy. Then, as spring and summer rolls around, your focus starts shifting towards getting your keeper yearlings organized to send off to be broken, but mainly the emphasis is on sale preparation for yearlings. The year is broken into two parts between yearling sales and the mixed stock sales from November to January.

What was your reaction to being named farm manager of the year? I was quite surprised and pleased.

Of all the horses you have been around, who are some of your favorites? It's mostly broodmares for me: Rosetta Stone (Round Table), Weekend Surprise (Secretariat), Bold Bikini (Boldnesian) was always a favorite and Miesque (Nureyev). I could name lots of mares.

You also own your own farm--Caldara Farm--what's that operation like? It's quite small and the mares are moved to Oak Tree for most of the year. I just keep them at Caldara up until they get close to foaling. I do all of the reproductive work at Lane's End.

Besides GSW Breakwater Edison and MGSP C P West, who else have you bred? Recently, there's a decent little racehorse that's running named Latigo Shore (Malibu Moon) (second in GIII Chick Lang S. at Pimlico May 15)--I still have his mother. Charitable Gift (Spend A Buck) was a stakes filly and The Cynic (Leo Castelli) was a stakes winner from years ago.

Favorite racehorse of all time? Secretariat.

Favorite racetrack? Saratoga and Keeneland in a tie.

What track would you like to visit that you haven't been to before? I've been to a lot of tracks in a lot of countries. I've never been to Chile. I've never been to Woodbine either--that's probably the next track I'd like to visit.

Other hobbies? My main hobby is polo. I still play as much as I can [with the Lexington Polo Club].

Favorite food? Ribeye steak.

Drink of choice? Beer.

Lightly raced six-year-old **Whatsthescript (Ire)** (Royal Applause {GB}), third in the 2008 GI Breeders' Cup Mile, resurfaced with a third-place finish in Monmouth's Battlefield S. "I know it is a difficult task to return a horse to racing after he's stood at stud, but he's been 100 percent racehorse since I got him. He's the consummate professional and he's quickly become one of my favorite horses." Whatsthescript is pointing for Saratoga's GII Fourstardave S. Aug. 1. Contessa added that  **"TDN Rising Star"**  **Eightyfiveinafifty** (Forest Camp), a disappointing fifth in the GII Woody Stephens S. on the GI Belmont S. undercard, has been sidelined with a case of pneumonia and will likely be out until the winter.

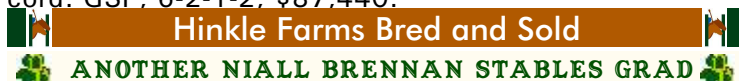

July 22, 1994...Full card simulcasting began in **Kentucky**, allowing bettors to wager on races throughout the United States.

July 24, 1994...Popular gelding **Fourstardave** won for the 21st and final time in his career when he took a Saratoga allowance race by five lengths. He'd retire a year later with a final record of 99-21-18-16 and over \$1.6 million in earnings.
