Quickly out of the gate as the favored faltered, **Maybeso-maybenot**, who was tracked by **Another**

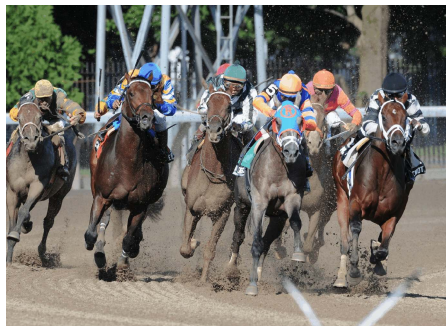

Given the opportunity to set the pace after a much improved break last time out, the bay responded by galloping home an easy six-length winner over the Louisville oval July 3. "The owners [Carolyn and Arthellor Scisney] are the nicest couple you'd ever want to meet," said winning trainer Mike Maker. "They've had some lesser horses who were stabled where I train my horses, and [Arthellor Scisney]d always tell me 'When I get a good horse, I'll bring it over to you.' He came over to me this spring, and said, 'I think I have a good horse for you.' Their daughter-in-law [Karen Scisney], who is part owner with them, is quite sick and in the hospital, and hopefully, it will be a good dose of medicine for her." Arthellor Scisney added, "We've worked hard all our lives, and this is a joy. My daughter-in-law [Karen] spoke to us on the phone. She just had bypass surgery on Monday and already has lupus. She has lost 60, 70 pounds. I hope this picks her up. If the Lord does nothing else for me, I'll be all right." According to Maker, the gelding's next appearance remains up in the air. "As for the horse's next start, anything's a possibility. We'll just play it by ear." Lady Jane Digby had previously found Germany to her liking when she took the G3 Walther J Jacobs-Stutenpreis at Bremen last August on what turned out to be her seasonal finale. Blowing the cobwebs away with a fifth place in the Listed Braveheart H. at Hamilton May 14, she went on to finish sixth in the G3 Brigadier Gerard S. at Sandown May 27 before opening her account for the year in the Listed Warwickshire Oaks at Warwick June 14. Runner up in the Listed Hoppings S. at Newcastle next time June 24, the bay homebred prepped for this with a third-place finish in the G2 Lancashire Oaks at Haydock July 3. Stalking White Lightning (Ger) (Sternkonig {Ire}) in second as he set an adequate early pace, she was relegated to third on the final turn, but was asked for her effort upon straightening for home. Grasping control with 1 1/2 furlongs to race, Lady Jane Digby was driven out by jockey Greg Fairley as last term's G1 Preis der Diana victress Night Magic kept her honest to the line. "It was a bit of a shot in the dark taking her to a Group 1, but she had been running really well," said trainer Mark Johnston. "She's a fantastically consistent and tough horse. It's wonderful for the owner[-breeder], who's been so patient with her. She broke the point of her hip at the end of last season and I think most people would have retired her then, but Kirsten [Rausing] decided to give her another go with the [GI] E.P. Taylor S. [at Woodbine Oct. 16] as the target, taking this race in along the way. Kirsten is a wonderful owner and it's great to have an owner-breeder like that. I've trained several of the family and it's smashing for the filly and the owner. Kirsten had a lot of faith in her and hoped for a Group 1 placing before she retired, and it has paid off handsomely." Unraced as a juvenile, Shimraan didn't make his race-course debut until May 11 this year, when he took a 12-furlong conditions event at this track before going on to finish a short-head runner-up to Air Trooper (GB) (Monsun {Ger}) in the Listed Prix de l'Avre at Longchamp May 23. Off the track since, he was content to sit at the tail of the field through the steady early fractions of this pattern-race bow. Nudged along to take closer order two furlongs out, the bay hit the front at the eighth pole and quickened clear as the Czech-trained Shamalgan came out of the pack late for second place. "Shimraan possesses a beautiful turn of foot and has a lot of class," said trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre. "The 10-furlong distance is a good option to have, but he will probably be better over a mile-and-a-half. Like many of his sire's progeny, he can go on soft ground and it is possible that we might target the [Oct. 3 G1] Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp." The runner-up's rider Ioritz Mendizabal added, "Shamalgan's a really good horse and he ran a great race. It was not a fast pace and I momentarily thought we might win. Irish Field took a four-furlong Madrid maiden first time up May 9, and followed that with an easy victory in a six-furlong conditions event back in the Spanish capital June 6. Shipped to Chantilly for the G3 Prix du Bois July 4, he only capitulated close to home to lose out by a nose to Keratiya (Fr) (Iron Mask). Tracking the early pace in third here, he was shaken up at the two-furlong marker and hit the front with a furlong to race before jockey Christophe Soumillon drove him clear to take the purse. "Irish Field is a horse with plenty of speed, but I also think he will stay seven furlongs," commented trainer Mauricio Delcher-Sanchez. "That was a very good victory and he's done nothing but improve since joining the stable. The [G1] Prix Morny [at Deauville Aug. 22] is a possibility, but he'll ultimately go to Hong Kong." If Irish Field does target Deauville, he will renew rivalry with the runner-up Broox, whose trainer added, "We're delighted with him and he ran a good race. He's our best two-year-old colt and is very brave. He led most of the way, but was beaten by a better horse on the day. The next step will be the Prix Morny at Deauville." Ready to take over from the latter approaching the stretch, Golden Moka was one-length clear with a sixteenth left to go and was ridden out to post a professional victory.
