Dude, Where's My Grade I?

Donald Disney homebred **First Dude** (Stephen Got Even) gave **Lookin At Lucky** (Smart Strike) all he could handle when second-best in the GI Preakness S., and gets another crack at the champion juvenile in Sunday's GI Haskell Invitational S. at Monmouth. The massive bay returned three weeks later in the GI Belmont S. with a strong third behind Drosselmeyer (Distorted Humor) and Fly Down (Mineshaft). First Dude has been training well at Churchill Downs since, firing a five-furlong bullet in 1:00 2/5 July 16, and an easy six furlongs in 1:14 1/5 July 22. "He was doing great before the Belmont, and he's doing just as well heading into this race," trainer Dale Romans said of the GI Blue Grass S. third-place finisher. "We'll be running against the best three-year-olds in the country in this race. But to be the best, you have to beat the best." The Florida-bred was the controlling speed in the Preakness and Belmont, but can be just as effective coming from off the pace, according to Romans. "He's always been able to rate if he's had to," he said. "We just thought in the Triple Crown races that he would do better on the lead." Despite a trio of Grade I placings, First Dude remains eligible for a first-level allowance. His lone career win came in a Gulfstream maiden heat Jan. 30.

Canford Cliffs was one of the first of a wave of horses to begin what would become an irresistible tide of success for his East Everleigh stable when unleashed at Newbury last May, and added fuel to the fire with a scintillating success in Royal Ascot's G2 Coventry S. the following month. After a relatively disappointing third in Deauville's G1 Prix Morny in August, and a further defeat at the hands of stable companion Dick Turpin (Ire) (Arakan) when veering late on in the G3 Greenham S. at Newbury Apr. 17, early talk of greatness looked to have been misplaced. The colt regained some shine with a fine third in Newmarket's G1 2000 Guineas May 1, and the pieces fell into place with a three-length victory in the Irish Guineas at The Curragh May 22 and a revenge victory over Dick Turpin in the G1 St James's Palace at Royal Ascot June 15. Slowly away in his bid for a celebrated hat trick here, he was allowed to find his feet as Ballydoyle's rabbit Encompassing (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) enjoyed isolation in front, and Rip Van Winkle led the main field under Ryan Moore. That rival was sent to the front inside the final three furlongs, but Canford Cliffs was able to cut him down with a withering late effort. "He's a superstar, and when I rode him recently, I said he had improved nearly 10 pounds," jockey Richard Hughes said. "I had a sleepless night worrying about the tactics, and he was a bit rusty there...he walked out of the stalls and never got into full flight. He did relax beautifully and, although the pacemaker was going fast, we weren't. Ryan [Moore] kicked and got a length, but I knew how good my horse was. After he switched leads in the last 100 yards, I was in command." Trainer Richard Hannon added, "I was impressed by the way he has improved since Ascot. A good galloping track will suit him better, but I don't know what we'll do with him now. We've got him in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois [at Deauville Aug. 15] and G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. [at Ascot Sept. 25], but I want to send him to a stud which will let us race on next year...he'll be awesome next year." A Holy Roman Emperor (Ire) half-brother to Canford Cliffs is slated to sell during Book 1 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale this fall; Redpender Stud consigns. Rip Van Winkle's trainer Aidan O'Brien was far from downcast about the failure of his runner to become the first to win two renewals, and said, "He just got tired and is not really there yet, so we are happy with him. He did progress since [running sixth in his seasonal opener in the June 15 G1 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot], and the rest of the season is there to look forward to. Last year, he tailed off after a tough early part of the season, so we made a decision to go gently and let him progress as the year goes on to finish off well. Having picked up a three-pound penalty when winning the G2 Superlative S. at Newmarket July 9, King Torus made light of that extra burden to brush aside his rivals here. His tendency to veer right in his races may

have cost him any meaningful chance in Royal Ascot's Listed Chesham S. June 19, where he finished fourth, and was in evidence again last time on Newmarket's uphill finish. Quickly to the lead here, the bay was soon passed and was provided with a lead by the aggressively ridden Stentorian. Dashing by that rival approaching the quarter pole,

he scooted clear to establish his dominance, with stable companion Major Art almost providing the all-powerful Hannon stable with a one-two. "That was a serious performance," jockey Richard Hughes explained. "We were flying, and when I picked him up with two and a half to run, he absolutely sprinted down that rail. I haven't been as quick over the last two of a seven-furlong race on a two-year-old in a long time. He was a big dope for a long time, and at Ascot was so raw I ended up racing on my own, so I begged the boss to put a ring bit on him, as he's heavy in your hands and leans right. I couldn't pull him up, and he was very impressive with that rail to help him. He definitely won't be running on a left-handed track, as it would be against the grain for him, but he's a decent horse."

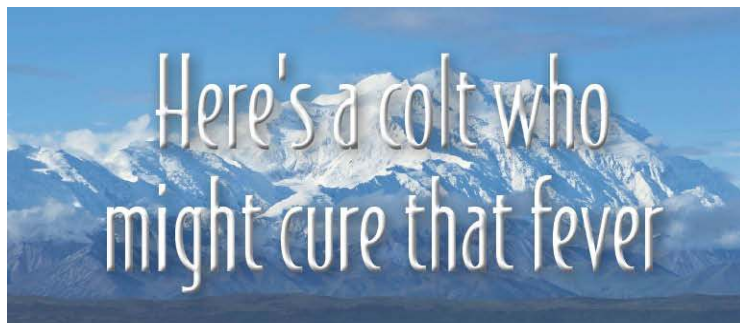

She is so versatile that it will be fairly easy to place her."

by the proven stayer Rite of Passage (GB) (Giant's Causeway) in the June 17 Royal Ascot marathon. It is a measure of the form that **Purple Moon**, who was runner-up in the 2007 G1 Melbourne Cup and 2008 G1 Hong Kong Vase, was six lengths back in third and **Kite Wood** a distant seventh. "Age of Aquarius is in good form, but he had a tough enough race at Ascot, so we did leave him down a little bit," Aidan O'Brien said. "He's a lovely balanced horse. He's just ready to run again now, and we're looking forward to seeing him."

Tactic has come from left field as a staying presence, but there was no arguing with the merit of his two-length defeat of the high-class mare Profound Beauty (Ire) (Danehill) in The Curragh's G3 Curragh Cup June 26. The runner-up had previously subdued Age of Aquarius in the May 30 Listed Saval Beg S. at Leopardstown, which puts the John Dunlop trainee firmly in the picture here. "He's progressing very quickly and has been impressive so far," owner Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's Racing Manager Angus Gold told *PA Sport*. "He was always a nice horse, but an immature horse--both mentally and physically--as he's quite a late foal. The potential was always there, and it's nice to get it out of him. Interestingly, for a Sadler's Wells, he likes fast ground." Godolphin have warned that last year's G1 St Leger runner-up Kite Wood, who carries a penalty as a result of his success in the G2 Prix Vicomtesse Vigier at Longchamp May 23, may miss the gig if the ground is too quick. "Kite Wood didn't stay the two-and-a-half miles at Royal Ascot, and the step down in distance will suit him well," trainer Saeed bin Suroor said. "He won nicely over a similar trip in France on his seasonal return, and he has been working well recently. I wouldn't want to run him on going that was too fast, and he prefers some cut in the ground." Last year's G2 Prix Hocquart and G3 Prix de Lutece winner **Wajir** also represents the operation, and he needs to rebound from a last-out eighth in the G2 Hardwicke S. at Royal Ascot June 19. "Wajir came up against some very good horses in the Hardwicke S., and I have been pleased with him since that outing--he is in good form at the moment. He has won a Group 3 in France over just short of two miles, and the step up in distance should not be a problem."

Starfish Bay, who set a new course record for 5 1/2 furlongs at Monmouth Park in June 2009, marks new territory as the first American-trained runner at Goodwood and first representative on these shores for her trainer. Michael Hernon, director of sales at Kentucky-based Gainesway Thoroughbreds, said, "She will run, and then we will evaluate where to go with her. She is in very good form at the moment; she is a very quick filly and we are hopeful she will give a very good account of herself. We have been thinking about sending over horses to Europe, and this filly seemed a suitable candidate, so we decided to take a shot with her." Everything has to fall right in these races. He's older now, but he still retains his ability." **Triple Aspect** holds **Group Therapy** on the form of the G3 Sandown Sprint S. July 3, and is a typical improver from William Haggas' Newmarket base.

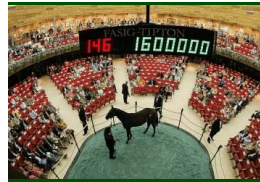

The Feb. 10 foal is by one of Europe's leading sires, the Green Desert stallion Oasis Dream, who is responsible for a host of Group 1/Grade I winners, including Middy (GB), Tuscan Evening (Ire), Aqlaam (GB), Arcano (Ire) and Naaqoos (GB).

"Oasis Dream looks a lot like his grandsire Danzig, who I was very familiar with," explained Taylor. "Oasis Dream is a very typical Northern Dancer-type horse. He's about 15.3, very well balanced, great muscle pattern to him, and was a very good sprinter. Much like Danzig, he's thrown fast horses who are precocious, but he has also produced horses that could win going 1 1/2 miles. He's an interesting throwback to the Northern Dancer-line horses that we had in America like Lyphard and Danzig, who were not huge horses themselves, but they weren't one dimensional. They could get stamina or early precocity. They were very prolific stallions; it just depended on the type of mares you bred them to."

Offered on the first day of selling, the smart-looking filly is out of Siena Farm's seven-year-old Devout, who

was purchased privately by the operation. Devout, a daughter of the unraced Sadler's Wells mare Park Heiress (Ire), was previously purchased by Australian bloodstock agent Jon Freyer for A\$240,000 at the Inglis Easter

Yearling sale in 2005. A half-sister to Silent Heir (Aus) (Sunday Silence), dam of French Group 3 winner Young Pretender (Fr) (Oasis Dream {GB}), Park Heiress is out of the top-class race mare Park Express (Ire) (Ahoonora {GB}), who was a co-champion filly at two, and a Group 1 winner and divisional champion at three. In the breeding shed, Park Express was able to reproduce her Group 1-winning form with Epsom Derby hero New Approach (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), who was a champion and divisional highweight at two and three, and Irish highweight filly Dazzling Park (Ire) (Warning {GB}). The Irish-bred mare also produced Shinko Forest (Ire) (Green Desert), a multiple stakes winner in Japan and earner of over \$2.7 million.

"[Devout] was out of a registered failure of a broodmare, but was simply gorgeous and therefore irresistible," recalled Freyer. "She kicked off whilst I was at the [Keeneland] September sales [in 2005], and ran well when only half fit in a strong maiden on a very wet track. She had previously trialed in superlative fashion, and we knew she was really smart. So when I got back [to Australia], I insisted she run in [the Listed Select Heritage S.], and she stormed home to run second, and would have won in a couple more strides. Her jockey, Glen Boss, told me she would be the best filly in the country--but not until the autumn. Nevertheless, we ran her back two weeks later in the G1 Flight S., and she never got a crack at them. She was midfield throughout and, in a field of 20, got hopelessly boxed up and went to the line under a hold [finishing 17th]."

Sent on to Melbourne's carnival in November of 2006, the filly ran back a week later and came home in fourth, beaten 2 3/4 lengths.

"She was a little flat, so she went for a spell," added Freyer. "She came back in the autumn [February, 2007] and smashed a good maiden field, but then had a few issues before El shut racing down. We then got an offer to sell her to Siena Farm through agent James Keogh for about A\$500,000. We sold her, as we didn't quite know when racing may resume, and with fillies, you never know if they'll hold their form."

Freyer, who has already received positive reports about his former charge's first foal, added, "Bottom line, [Devout] was way more talented than her record might indicate."

Armed with an international pedigree, in addition to her conformational appeal, the yearling filly was expected to give a good account of herself if showcased on a European arena. However, her connections opted to keep her in the U.S., where she would have the opportunity to stand out in the local market, and with the backing of Fasig-Tipton.

"The Fasig-Tipton reps went out to see her on and off throughout the winter," Taylor confirmed. "There was some thought put into taking the filly to Europe to sell, because Oasis Dream is such an up-an-coming super sire over there. At the end of the day, for a lot of different reasons, we decided to take her to Saratoga, but I think the biggest reason was that Fasig-Tipton was able to convince the principles of Siena Farm [Manganaro, Patino and Pope] that she was going to be the poster child for what they're trying to make the Saratoga sale in the future, which is a boutique international sale of really top yearlings. I think she is the prototype of what they have been trying to attract more of to the Saratoga sale." -C Bossinakis

NTRA REPORT FROM CAPITOL HILL



INTERNET GAMING BILL PASSES OUT OF FINANCIAL SERVICES COMMITTEE

By a vote of 41-22, the House Financial Services Committee approved the "Internet Gambling Regulation, Consumer Protection, and Enforcement Act" (H.R. 2267), a bill introduced by chairman Rep. Barney Frank (D-MA).

H.R. 2267 would establish a structure to regulate and tax all forms of Internet gambling and create a mechanism for federal licensure of Internet gambling operators. If passed, the bill would open the U.S. market to all forms of online gambling.

Among the several amendments made at the markup were:

- Prohibition of the use of credit cards for online gambling
- The granting of one full legislative session for individual states to opt out of the legislation
- A requirement that operating corporate entities must be U.S.-based

Rep. Frank's bill does not provide the same broad protections for online pari-mutuel wagering offered in the Senate bill (S. 1597) that authorizes online "games of skill" like poker. The NTRA will continue its effort to ensure that online pari-mutuel wagering as authorized by the Interstate Horseracing Act (IHA) is exempt from this tax-and-license structure, which applies only to future entrants into the gaming market.

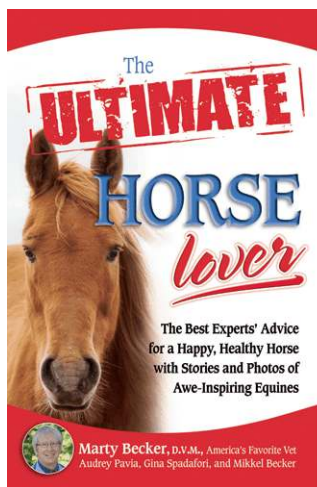
