TALENTED OCTET ASSEMBLES FOR HASKELL

Super Saver (Maria's Mon), the reigning GI Kentucky Derby hero and **Lookin At Lucky** (Smart Strike), the last-out winner of the GI Preakness S. May 15, are the marquee attractions in Sunday's GI Haskell Invitational S., one of the deepest renewals, top to bottom, in many years. The former will be looking to give Bill Casner and Kenny Troutt's WinStar Farm its third winner in the last five years to go along with Bluegrass Cat (Storm Cat) and Any Given Saturday (Distorted Humor) in 2006 and 2007, respectively. The homebred bay was no match for Lookin At Lucky in the Preakness, fading to eighth as the 9-5 favorite, but has

done well in the interim, reports trainer Todd Pletcher. "He's training exceptionally well," Pletcher said. "During the freshening, he's put on weight and gained strength. His mental outlook is excellent." Lookin At Lucky experience a year's worth of misfortune this spring. After getting stopped cold when third in the GI Santa Anita Derby, he drew inside in the Run for the Roses, and his race was done less than a furlong into it. He did well to finish sixth as the 6-1 favorite and atoned for the defeat with his 3/4-length score over **First Dude** (Stephen Got Even) at Old Hilltop. But it's back to the dreaded one hole Sunday afternoon. "His name has jinxed him all his life with the draw," said Baffert from his Southern California headquarters. "I can't believe how poorly this horse draws."

First Dude, fifth to **Ice Box** (Pulpit) in the GI Florida Derby in March, improved to third in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. the following month, then ran a crackling race to finish closest to Lookin At Lucky in Baltimore. He set a leisurely pace in the GI Belmont S. June 5, but yielded to be third, beaten a length. Expect him to be prominent in the running come Sunday. "He doesn't have to be on the lead, but if he breaks sharply, he'll be there," said trainer Dale Romans. "If someone wants to go, then he can sit off."

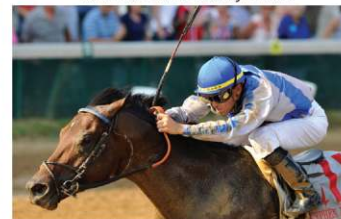

Lookin Not So Lucky...

The Bob Baffert-trained **Lookin At Lucky** (Smart Strike) got the rail, yet again, for Sunday's GI Izod Haskell Invitational S. at Monmouth Park. The Preakness winner also broke from the one hole in this year's Kentucky Derby, eventually finishing sixth to **Super Saver** (Maria's Mon), who re-opposes. "He is the most poorly drawn horse I have ever had," explained the Hall of Fame trainer. Baffert, who trained Point Given (2001), War Emblem (2002) and Roman Ruler (2005) to Haskell success, remained in good spirits despite his horse's continued misfortune. The horse shipped to New Jersey yesterday, arriving at Monmouth in mid-afternoon. "He is going by FedEx, so someone will have to sign for him when he arrives," said Baffert of the champion juvenile's traveling arrangements. The one hole has supplied six previous winners of the Haskell, so it's not all doom and gloom for the morning-line favorite. WinStar Farm's Kentucky Derby winner Super Saver was allotted stall six for Sunday's renewal. "It's a perfect draw," stated trainer Todd Pletcher, who reported his charge to be in fine fettle leading up to the race. Pletcher and WinStar have fond memories of Monmouth Park, with Bluegrass Cat (2006) and Any Given Saturday (2007) having previously tasted Haskell success. The Derby-winning conditioner was full of praise for his jockey Calvin Borel, who won the race last year aboard Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro). "Calvin's style suits Super Saver very well," stressed Pletcher. Kieran McLaughlin was not overly concerned, despite getting the outside post for **Trappe Shot** (Tapit). "He is the 'now' horse, winning four in a row, and we are ready to see how good we really are," said a confident McLaughlin. Dale Romans was more than pleased, as the ultra-consistent **First Dude** (Stephen Got Even) was allocated hole four. "I am happy in the middle, it's probably the best spot," said Romans. First Dude, who shipped in on Wednesday, will hope to get his head in front on Sunday for a deserved first Grade I victory.

Illustrious Blue is a renowned Goodwood specialist, having notched up six wins here before a career-best in this race marred by the injury to the 4-6 favorite Age of Aquarius (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}). Since he broke his maiden here in May 2006, Illustrious Blue has enjoyed some of his finest hours in Sussex when garnering the Listed Festival S. the following season and G3 Glorious S. 12 months ago. Stepped up to marathon distances this term, he had captured Ascot's G3 Sagaro S. Apr. 28 and finished fourth in Sandown's G2 Henry II S. May 27 and runner-up in the Listed Sandown Marathon last time May 3. Switched off in rear early as Johnny Murtagh sent Age of Aquarius straight to the lead, the dark bay was arriving on the scene at the top of the stretch as Ballydoyle's favorite broke down. With Electrolyser left in front, the eventual winner hooked up with a furlong remaining and gained the edge in the run to the line for a notable success for locally based connections. Jockey Jim Crowley was savoring the moment afterwards. "He settled lovely and at the top of the hill he was traveling nicely and coming there so well, I thought he'd go away and win quite easily, but he took a bit of time to grind down the other horse," Crowley said. "He's so tough and is a legend for me around here. He could even be a Melbourne Cup horse, as this is his trip now and he seems to keep on improving even at that age. That's a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity and he loves fast ground and travels well, so he's earned the right to go." Age of Aquarius was sent to Arundel Equine Hospital, where X-rays revealed ruptured ligaments below the fetlock of his off-fore. Dr. Paul Dupreez, senior partner of the hospital, commented, "He is fine and is on his way home, supported by a splint and bandages. It is not a catastrophic injury, but there are huge doubts as to whether he will be able to get back to competitive action. He's a very valuable horse and I'm sure they will have plans for him."

King George S. cont.

Bought for just 13,000 guineas seven years ago, Borderlescott has weaved some considerable magic during the interim and was adding this prize to two renewals of the G1 Nunthorpe S. under first-time pilot Kieren Fallon. Having won this meeting's feature handicap, the Stewards' Cup, in 2006 and finished runner-up and third in the next two renewals, the veteran broke through at the top level when taking the Nunthorpe transferred to Newmarket two years ago. His follow-up win in that contest back at York last August was the reward for a scarcely believable spell of consistency and he was in the placings again on all four starts this term, with a third in the June 15 G1 King's Stand S. at Royal Ascot the highlight. Beaten when dropped in class for Chester's Listed City Wall S. last time July 10, the bay showed that he had lost none of his momentum here after arriving from mid-pack to assert in the final 100 yards. "He's been a great servant for the Bastiman family and all the jockeys who have ridden him," commented Fallon, who was deputising for the suspended Neil Callan. "I was stuck in a pocket and had to wait, but he made it easy for me and won comfortably in the end. He doesn't use any gas at all and I nearly had to push him down to the start, but as soon as he gets in the gate, he lights up." Trainer Robin Bastiman paid further tribute to his evergreen flagbearer, adding, "They've got to go fast and he needs to be up against top-class horses, as he idles in front. He takes a bit longer to wind up now, but the engine is still there and bring on the Nunthorpe now [at York Aug. 20]. He'll run his race there, win or lose." Successful in the Listed Prix Joubert at Saint-Cloud in September and fourth in the GI E.P. Taylor S. the following month, Eastern Aria took time to warm up this season and followed a fourth in Cologne's G2 Gerling-Preis May 9 with an unplaced effort in Royal Ascot's Listed Wolferton S. June 18. Bouncing back to winning ways last time in the Listed Plantation Stud S. over a mile and a half at Newmarket July 17, the bay carried on in the same vain here by swooping off demanding fractions to dominate the last three furlongs and set a new track record. "They went fast and I let her slot in where she was happy," jockey Richard Hills explained. "She's tough and really battled at Newmarket last time and has come on again. We weren't sure she would stay and I rode her like she did. She has a great attitude and is coming right." Trainer Mark Johnston is looking at a return visit to Woodbine. "I was thinking Group 1s at the start of this year, and that wasn't looking likely for a while, but it is back on the cards again now she is blooming," he added. "I said last year when she ran so well in the E. P. Taylor she would hopefully come back for the Canadian International over a mile and a half this year and that's on my mind." **Click for the [Racing Post chart](#). 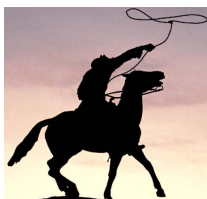

Mine That Bird Drills for Whitney...

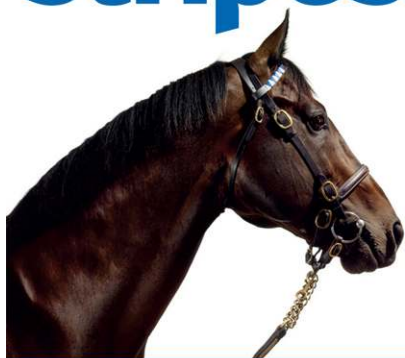

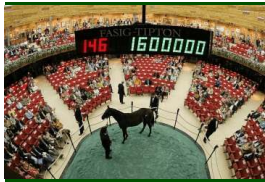

Lantern Hill Farm heads into this year's edition of the Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Select Yearling sale with only two yearlings. However, the size of this year's consignment is by no means

indicative of the quality. Both yearlings offer plenty of draw from an international perspective, including hip [195](#), a colt by Cape Cross (Ire), whose top progeny include a pair of Horses of the Year--Sea the Stars (Ire) and Ouija Board (GB). Out of the stakes-winning mare Two Clubs (GB) (First

Trump {GB}), the Highfield Farm-bred colt is a half-brother to G1 Sprint Cup hero Red Clubs (Ire) (Red Ransom).

"He has the most amazing walk of any yearling I have prepped in a very long time," said Lantern Hill Farm's Suzie Shoemaker. "He's very smooth, very confident, has a huge overstep and very relaxed and loose way of walking through his hip and shoulder."

Highfield Farm principal Dr. John Fike, who is based just outside Cleveland, Ohio, has had a presence in the horse racing industry for over a quarter of a century. A client of Lantern Hill through most of the last decade, Dr. Fike currently boards seven mares at the Midway-area farm and has one sole representative, Two Clubs, boarded at Islanmore Stud in Ireland.

"Dr. Fike decided to keep him here, partially because of financial reasons, and also because he felt he would be showcased better at Saratoga," explained Shoemaker. "There are far more Cape Cross yearlings in Europe, so to bring a really nice horse by the Darly sire over here, we thought this horse had a really good chance to be successful in the [United States]."

No matter what side of the Atlantic you're on, a yearling like that is very compelling. I think it figures to be a good showcase for the stallion's progeny, as well as for the sale of this particular horse."

Also enjoying recent overseas updates is hip [164](#), a bay filly by Distorted Humor out of the Sadler's Wells mare Sand Pebbles (Ire). The Apr. 2 foal is owned and bred by Russell L Reineman Stable Inc.

Out of the Secretariat mare Clandestina, the filly's 13-year-old dam is a full-sister to G2 Royal Lodge S. winner Desert Secret (Ire); Bineyah (Ire), runner-up in the G1 Yorkshire Oaks; and Group 3 placed In Camera (Ire).

"She takes a bit more from the Sadler's Wells side of the family," Shoemaker pointed out. "She has a bit more scope than Distorted Humor and a very big walk. Also, she is bred along a similar cross to a very impressive maiden winner [Pathfork, out of the Sadler's Wells mare Visions of Clarity {Ire}] at the Curragh [July 18]. There is also a Group 3 winning filly--Radharcnafarraige (Ire) (out of the Storm Bird mare Extraterrestrial)--that is bred along a similar pattern."

Adding further luster to the filly's bottom side is her third dam--My Charmer (Poker)--who is responsible for Triple Crown hero Seattle Slew (Bold Reasoning), G1 2000 Guineas winner Lomond (Northern Dancer) and \$13.1-million yearling purchase Seattle Dancer (Nijinsky II), a Group 2 winner in Ireland and Group 1 placed in France.

"This filly comes from a very big female family that has a lot of quality," remarked Shoemaker. "Distorted Humor hasn't had a lot of notable success in Europe before this year, but he has two really top runners there this season and who are bred very similarly to this filly."

Beacon of Light...

After graduating from Cornell University's College of Agriculture and Life Sciences with a Bachelor's Degree in Animal Science in 1978, Shoemaker leased a small tract of land and christened the new operation Lantern Hill, which was named in honor of Prince Edward Island's fictional lighthouse in the 1937 Lucy Maud Montgomery novel, *Jane of Lantern Hill*. Steadily building a successful operation through the 1980s and '90s, Shoemaker was able to secure a 75-acre farm in Scott County in 1989, before purchasing 144 acres of the former Parrishwood Farm in Woodford County in 1995. Already of historic significance as the birthplace of the 1984 Eclipse Award-winning older mare Princess Rooney (Verbatim), the latter property would become the launching pad for a recent champion; 2006 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies heroine Dreaming of Anna (Rahy), who was also foaled and raised at the nursery. Lantern Hill, which expanded to 185 acres following the purchase of an adjacent 40-acre tract of land in November in 2005, is now comprised of six barns with 62 stalls, and a late Victorian home which is listed on the National Register of Historic Places as the Cooper House. Other notable Lantern Hill pupils who got their early start with the operation are Grade I winners Ordway (Salt Lake), Pampered Princess (Indian Charlie) and Capt. Candyman Can (Candy Ride {Arg}), a Keeneland September yearling grad who collected last year's GI King's Bishop S. at Saratoga.

While Shoemaker confirmed that the majority of her current yearling crop is slated for Keeneland's September sale, she is confident that her current consignment has what it takes to make a splash at the Spa.

"Keeneland September tends to fit a wider range of our yearlings," explained Shoemaker. "Any of our earlier maturing yearlings, like the ones we have this year, have always done well at Saratoga. The nice thing is that these yearlings fit a market that encompasses European trainers and end users that might not be present at some of the more regional sales. We think these are two very special horses and think they should do well here."--Christina Bossinakis

ALL IN THE FAMILY AT STONE FARM

Stone Farm will offer three yearlings at this year's Fasig-Tipton Saratoga sale, and all three were bred by Arthur Hancock's Paris, Kentucky farm. Hancock thinks bringing horses to market that he has known since the day they were foaled.

"We sell only what we raise," Hancock explained. "We know our product. That's a benefit. You know exactly what you have. When you stand behind your horses like we do, you know the people are getting a good product with no flaws and no problems. Hopefully, the buyers have more confidence in us, too."

Stone Farm, which has been consigning at Saratoga for much of the last decade, has produced Kentucky Derby winners Fusaichi Pegasus, Sunday Silence and Gato del Sol, as well as Preakness and Belmont winner Risen Star. Cont. p13

Owsley has proven popular in the sales ring, as well. Her first foal, War Hoot (War Chant), sold for \$220,000

as a Keeneland September yearling in 2007. The following fall, her filly Senada (Pulpit) brought a final bid of \$800,000 at Keeneland.

The Hancock family is steeped in racing tradition and Arthur Hancock is a fourth-generation horsemen. His grandfather Arthur Boyd Hancock Sr. established Claiborne Farm in 1908 and his father Arthur "Bull" Hancock Jr. built Claiborne into one of the preeminent farms in the country. But the Stone Farm maestro does have concerns about the long-term viability of the industry.

"Across the board, because of the fact that they are breeding huge numbers of mares to one stallion, it seems to me there is a big oversupply for the number of buyers," Hancock said. "The oldest law in the world is supply and demand."

"And we need to clean up drugging these horses, because it's affecting the breed, it's affecting public opinion and the vet bills are driving owners out of the business," he added. "I don't think we have a future unless we stop it."

AQUEDUCT CASINO BID CHALLENGE DENIED

According to published reports, a legal challenge to halt the current bidding process for the casino at Aqueduct Racetrack in New York has been tossed out of New York state court. Aqueduct Entertainment Group was one of the original bidders on the project, and was granted the contract at first before being stripped of their award when it was ruled that members of the group were not licensable in the state of New York. AEG filed suit, alleging that they were illegally eliminated from the bidding process, and recently asked for an injunction to stop the state lottery--in charge of awarding the casino contract--to discontinue its review of Genting New York, a Malaysian-based company which is the lone remaining bidder in the process. But Justice Barry D. Kramer, from the state Supreme Court, dismissed the case. Daryl Davis, an attorney for AEG, indicated that the decision could be appealed.

Internet Gaming Bill Passes House Committee:

Daily Racing Form reports that a bill that would result in the legalization of Internet gambling passed the U.S. House of Representatives Financial Services Committee by a vote of 41-22 Wednesday, but does not specify what types of gambling would be permitted while specifically excluding gambling on sporting events. With the exception of horse racing, Internet gambling is currently prohibited. The racing industry was granted that exemption in legislation banning financial transactions with any Internet gambling site other than a horseracing site. Though the bill was introduced over a year ago, support has been difficult to come by despite claims by advocates of the bill that it could yield \$42 billion over 10 years. Under this legislation, operators of Internet betting exchanges would be allowed to apply for a license, even though betting on sports, the largest component of exchange betting, is excluded. A reported one-third of all bets placed through betting exchanges are made on horse racing. Betfair owns the Television Games Network and recently joined with racing interests in New Jersey in support of the legalization of exchange betting in the state. That legislation has passed the State Assembly and is awaiting a vote in the Senate.

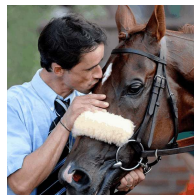
