LIBRETTIST COLT GOES THREE-FOR-THREE

Richard Hannon's team is simply dominating the major meetings this season, and it was a case of more of the same as **Libranno (GB)** (Librettist) defied a penalty for his success in Newmarket's G2 July S. to take the G2 Tanqueray Richmond S. at Goodwood yesterday. Off at 10-1 in the July S., the colt was 25-1 when he bested subsequent G2 Superlative S. runner-up Ecliptic (Kingmambo) in his career opener May 29, but there was no generosity in the starting price this time. Soon in front under Richard Hughes, the bay had all rivals working hard by the quarter pole, and only **The Paddyman (Ire)** (Giant's Causeway) could keep tabs from there. Despite his early exertions, the latest East Everleigh high roller was always holding that rival to score a shade comfortably. "I was a little bit worried at the start, as he was very tight and I couldn't feel his belly moving for about a minute," Hughes explained. "He jumped out extremely fast and I tried to lean against him, but that wasn't working, so I let him go to the front, and he was tanking down the hill. I was thinking of the three-pound penalty going downhill so fast, and this is not a nice place to be when you are alone in the centre of the track on a two-year-old, but the boss had said not to organise him and to let him use himself. He kills horses off by halfway with the speed he shows, and was gawping at everything in the final two furlongs, but grinds it out. I couldn't say hand on heart that he will stay a mile--it wouldn't matter if he dropped to five." RACHEL ALEXANDRA TO PERSONAL ENSIGN

Reigning Horse of the Year **Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro) will make her next start in the GI Personal Ensign S. at Saratoga Aug. 29. "Rachel feels very much at home among the great Saratoga fans," said majority owner Jess Jackson. "It's an historic race, named after a great champion. The timing is right for Rachel. She's been coming back into her stride, and this will help prepare for the rest of her campaign and the Breeders' Cup later this year." This will be the four-year-old's first try at 1 1/4 miles, the distance of the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, to be held at Churchill Downs Nov. 6. Conditioner Steve

Asmussen added, "The whole team is excited to have Rachel back at Saratoga preparing for this Grade I race. We all love the track and the fans at Saratoga, perhaps none more than Rachel herself." The bay is coming off back-to-back wins in the GI Fleur de Lis H. June 12 and the Lady's Secret S. at Monmouth Park last Saturday after running second in her first two 2010 efforts.

Redwood was a Derby hopeful after winning the Listed Feilden S. at Newmarket last April, but the wheels came off soon after, and he was having only his fourth career start when runner-up in Sandown's G3 Gordon Richards S. on his four-year-old debut Apr. 24. Following two off-the-board efforts in the May 6 G3 Huxley S. at Chester and G2 Hardwicke S. at Royal Ascot June 19, the homebred found only Sans Frontieres (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) too strong in the G2 Princess of Wales's S. at Newmarket last time July 8. After the withdrawal of Godolphin's Cavalryman (GB) (Halling), he had less to deal with here, but in the end ran out a clear-cut winner to open his pattern-race account. In rear early, the dark bay crept closer on the final turn and, after challenging widest of all, overhauled the penalised Sri Putra with a furlong remaining before asserting in the run to the line. "He ran a very good race at Newmarket and traveled a lot sweeter today," jockey Michael Hills said. "When he does that, he has a very good turn of foot, and is growing up and improving for racing. He got injured last year and had a long time off, so took a while to get back into proper form, but the better part of his season is to come." Connections are looking at an agenda that includes the Turkish G2 International Bosphorus Cup in September and GI Canadian International S. in October.

Tropical Paradise's first try at black-type yielded only a ninth placing in Ascot's seven-furlong Listed October S. in September, and she fared little better when sixth on her next start in this venue's Listed Conqueror S. May 1. The grey was back here for a handicap over this trip on the last day of that month, returning to winning ways, and she looked to have the Listed Pipalong S. in the bag until tiring late on to be third over Pontefract's stiff mile last time July 6. Securing a vital stalking position against the rail behind the pacesetting Pyrrha, she kicked into the lead with just over a furlong remaining and, after shrugging off a brief threat, asserted for a career high. "She wants much softer ground than this, but I couldn't believe her price, as she is a very good filly," trainer Peter Winkworth's assistant Anton Pearson said after a notable landmark for his small stable. a month later, he was beaten just 3/4 of a length when third in the GII Del Mar H. at the end of last August. The dark bay disappeared after that race, returning to be fourth in a Hollywood allowance June 6. He broke sharply to cut out the pace in the July 4 GII American H. at the Inglewood oval, and dug in gamely late before conceding the head decision to Global Hunter (Arg) (Jade Hunter). He was not so seriously challenged this time. Jockey Joe Talamo sent Temple City to the front right from the bell. The two

sailed along through a half in :50.53 and six panels in 1:16.19, and had plenty left when they hit the lane, drawing off to win handily. The final time established a new track record of 2:30.46, breaking the mark set by Zappa (Afternoon Deelites) in 2008. "He was just so relaxed today--going around there so easy," Talamo said. "[Trainer Carla Gaines] said just slow it down as much as you can. I thought it felt about right. He's got such a big, fluid stride on him. The last time I rode him, we went in :24 and :49 and I thought I went in :26. He just does it so easy. It worked out perfect. When they came to him, he just kicked away. Midday returns to the scene of her first Group 1 triumph 12 months ago, when she pierced through the gloom of one of this track's notorious sea frets. Subsequently third in the G1 Prix de l'Opera at Longchamp on Arc day, and successful in the BC Filly and Mare Turf, the homebred was runner-up attempting to give five pounds to Sariska (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) in York's G3 Middleton S. on her sole four-year-old start May 13.

"Her program has been geared towards a late summer and autumn campaign, with the Nassau, Yorkshire Oaks, Vermeille, Prix de l'Opera and Breeders' Cup in mind," Khalid Abdullah's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe commented. "She seems to have come on nicely, and everyone seems to be pretty pleased with her. She's worked pretty well and, although it's going to be a tough race, we are excited." She has to contend with a considerable French presence here in

Stacelita and ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Rosanara**. The former scooped a trio of top-level contests last term including the Prix de Diane (French Oaks), and was back on track last time when adding Longchamp's G3 La Coupe to her tally June 14. Last year's G1 Prix Marcel Boussac heroine Rosanara has yet to regain the winning thread, but was up against a formidable rival in stable companion Sarafina (Fr) (Refuse To Bend {Ire}) when second in the latest renewal of the Prix de Diane at Chantilly last time June 13. She was unable to travel for the G1 Irish Oaks when refusing to board the plane earlier this month, but trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre is hoping for a smoother passage this time. "She is in good form and, thankfully, she does not have a problem with the horsebox, she just has a problem with planes," he told *PA Sport*. "It is a very good race, but the filly looks well and had a good gallop on Monday. As long as she travels well, it will be a very interesting race. I don't think the ground will be a problem for her, and 10 furlongs is fine as well." **Contredanse** has to better the form of her latest win in the G2 Oaks d'Italia at the San Siro May 30, but jockey Kieren Fallon is hopeful. "I wasn't surprised to see her win in Italy, and she is going to have to step up again to win, but [trainer] Luca [Cumani] can do it," Fallon said. "She is easy to ride and straightforward--she's a lovely filly with a great attitude. It's a tough race, but I think she's up to it."

Juddmonte homebred **Proviso** bids for her third straight Grade I win here. The bay mare captured the GI Juddmonte Spinster S. at Keeneland last October, and came back to be fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff. 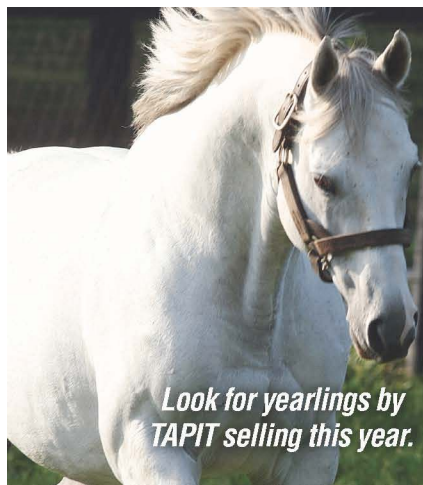
Aquarius Career Over...

Happy Broadbent has a busy week coming up in Saratoga, as he'll be represented both on the racetrack and in the sales ring. First up, **Phola** (Johannesburg), co-owned by Broadbent and a group of high school buddies, takes on a tough field in the GI Diana S. Then, on Tuesday evening, two yearlings co-bred by the Kentucky native will go through the sales ring at Fasig-Tipton.

Broadbent only has one other horse in training, and quickly acknowledges that Phola is the best horse he has owned. The filly won the GIII Hillsborough S. at Tampa Bay and the GII Churchill Distaff Turf Mile before a late-running second-place effort in the June 5 GI Just a Game S. at Belmont. She is the 4-1 third choice in the Diana and, if she comes home first in that race, it will likely be a crowded winner's circle.

"A couple of my high school classmates, Graydon and Bill Patterson, contacted me when she was a two-year-old after she had just run third in the [2008 GIII] Arlington-Washington Lassie," Broadbent recalled. "They had an opportunity to purchase her and wanted to know if I had any interest. And they brought in another one of our classmates. It was the first time the four of us had run a horse together. J.J. Pletcher owned

all of her at that time--we decided to buy 80 percent of her, and J.J. Pletcher kept 20 percent."

Broadbent added one more partner.

“I gave a part of my percentage to my father-in-law,” he said. “It’s been fun to share this ride with him. He’s 75 years old, and he’s never had a horse like this. To share the experience with him has been great. And it’s extra special because it’s a bunch of guys from high school who got together to buy her. These types of horses don’t come around very often--this could be my only opportunity. It’s a lifetime dream to be part of a horse like this.”

Racing has always been in the family for Broadbent.

His great grandfather was Keeneland founder Hal Price Headley. His grandfather, Louis Haggin, was president of Keeneland from 1940 through 1956. And his father Dick Broadbent founded Bloodstock Research Information Services.

The elder Broadbent, who died in March, sold BRIS to Churchill Downs Inc. in 2007, but the company continues to be

run by his son.

“With my family, all I’ve ever been involved with has been the Thoroughbred business all my life,” Broadbent said. “Everybody, from my great-great grandfather down through the generations, has been in the business. So it’s always been in the blood.”

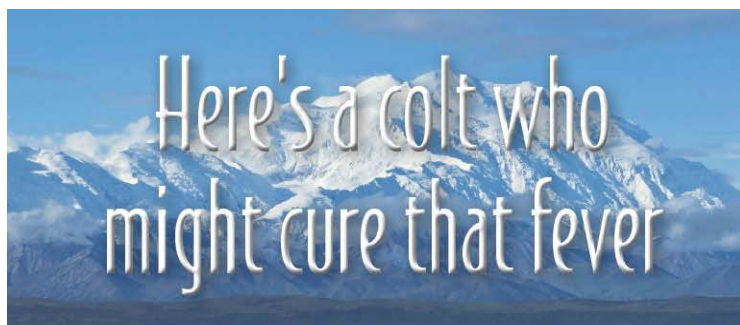
Phola faces a difficult task Saturday, but Broadbent remains optimistic.

“We have two outstanding yearlings at Fasig-Tipton,” Broadbent enthused. “Malibu Moon is absolutely on fire right now, so it couldn't be better timing to come in with a Malibu Moon colt.”

“We breed primarily to sell,” he confirmed. “We'll sell some of the mares in foal, a number of weanlings and a number of yearlings. It just depends on the situation.” His father was a pioneer in the industry, so it's only natural to ask what lessons have resonated with the son.

“This industry is all about integrity and working hard,” Broadbent said. “The horse industry has its ups and downs. You get on a high with a horse like Phola, and then you can be on a low with a horse running into a fence, or something. But if you work hard, it will pay off for you.”

He's a good stamp of a horse and has lots of scope--he's naturally strong and is a lovely athlete who has done things very naturally from the start. He was a little bit nervous at the beginning, but that is maybe a trait of Johannesburgs, so I minded him a little bit in his preparation and he's done this well. I believe he can go a long way and we had said if we were happy tonight we might think about the G3 Acomb S. [at York Aug. 17]. We'll get him home and see how he is, but it might be that we look for another novice race and if that goes well think about the G2 Champagne S. [at Doncaster Sept. 11]." **PETER MARTINS (Johannesburg)**

Last fall, Earle Mack headed to Keeneland September with his usual coterie of advisors, but his first major success out of the sale, Peter Martins, came as a result of an impulsive moment, with a horse he purchased sight unseen.

"I had never seen him, never heard of him, never knew he was in the sale," remarked Mack. "I was at the sale, and I saw Jeremy [Noseda] near the end of the third day and asked him if he wanted to go out to dinner. He accepted, and while we were riding into the city, I said, 'Do you see anything you like in the sale?'"

Noseda told Mack he would be bidding by phone on a Johannesburg colt selling at the end of the day's session. The colt, consigned by Denali Stud, was hip number 806.

"I said, 'Isn't Johannesburg a little cool?'" Mack recalled. "But he said, 'I really like this horse.' About three minutes later, he gets a call from the client, and the client says he's out."

Noseda had already had the horse vetted, and told Mack he was going to buy the horse himself. He proceeded to bid over phone through an associate at the sale, but when the bidding reached \$110,000, he told Mack he had gone as far as he could. Mack's interest was peaked.

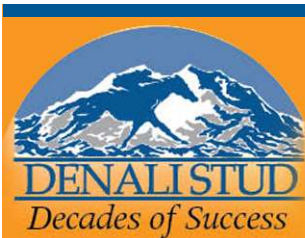
"I said, 'you really like this horse?' and he said, 'yes,'" Mack offered. "I said, 'go to \$120,000.'" The price drifted up to \$145,000, but Mack hung in there.

There was an immediate rush of buyer's remorse. "I had my whole team from the U.K. at the sales," Mack said. "I had Gary Contessa, who is a good selector of two-year-olds. We had done motion studies and pedigree studies, and I'm saying to myself, 'Earle, you can't be this impulsive. You can't buy a horse this way.'"

He phoned consignor Craig Bandoroff right after the sale. "I keep his mares at the farm," said Bandoroff. "He called me, and said 'Craig, I'm with Jeremy Noseda, and he just bought that horse, and I want to know if he's okay.' I said, 'Earle, Jeremy bought a really nice horse.' I gave him the thumbs up."

Mack originally named the colt Surface Tension, but changed it to Peter Martins, for the master in chief of the New York City ballet. Martins is the godfather of Mack's son Andrew, and Mack, who had named a couple of fillies after Martins's wife, ballerina Darci Kistler, without much success, had been looking for a colt to name after his good friend. As Surface Tension progressed, Mack decided this would be the one. "There's an old saying--you never know where your next best horse is going to come from," said Mack. "And he turned up today." **British Report cont. p7**

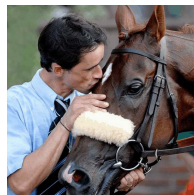
