LUCKY STRIKES AGAIN IN HASKELL

★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ and GI Preakness S. hero **Lookin At Lucky** (Smart Strike) made it clear who the best three-year-old in the country was with a four-length tour-de-force over **Trappe Shot** (Tapit) in Sunday's star-studded GI Izod Haskell Invitational S. at Monmouth Park. "At the 3/8ths pole, that's when you know you've got a good horse, because they'll be pulling you," trainer Bob Baffert said after saddling his record fourth Haskell winner. "Martin [Garcia] was still sitting, but when he pushed the button, this horse really took off. Today he was phenomenal." **Cont. p2-3**

FASIG-TIPTON SARATOGA SALE BEGINS TODAY

Fasig-Tipton's 90th renewal of the Saratoga Selected Yearling Sale begins this evening, with the first of 202 catalogued hips scheduled to go through the ring at the newly renovated Humphrey S. Finney Pavilion at 7 p.m. Sales officials and consignors alike are guardedly optimistic, despite the shaky economy. "We have a very good catalogue, both physically and pedigree-wise," confirmed Fasig-Tipton President Boyd Browning. "We had a strong sale last year, and we are hoping for the best." Reiley McDonald of Eaton Sales echoed those sentiments. "I think you always have to go in optimistically," he said. "I guess that we'd be a little more reserved this year, just with the state of the economy in general, and the horse industry to an extent." During last year's sale, Fasig-Tipton sold 160 yearlings for \$52,549,500. The average was \$328,434, up 11.1 percent from the 2008 figure, while the median rose 9.9 percent to \$250,000. Browning admitted matching those figures this year would be acceptable. "Most of the people in this business are competitive, and you're always hoping for better," he said. "I think our hope would be that we would show some increases. I think the realistic approach would be that numbers similar to last year would be, in all likelihood, satisfactory." **Cont. p4**

Lucky Combination...

Hall of Fame trainer Bob Baffert made the tough decision of replacing top-class rider Garrett Gomez with the up-and-coming Martin Garcia aboard Lookin at Lucky following *another* nightmare trip when sixth in the GI Kentucky Derby, and the bold move continues to pay off. Following a flawless ride in the Preakness, Garcia was at it again on the \$475,000 KEEAPR graduate at the Jersey Shore oval yesterday. The juvenile champion bobbed slightly after exiting from the one hole, and Garcia quickly guided him off the rail and into the four path. Settled just off the pace in fourth as **First Dude** (Stephen Got Even) rattled off fractions of :23.52 and :47.95 with **Our Dark Knight** (Medaglia d'Oro) and Derby hero **Super Saver** (Maria's Mon) in hot pursuit, Lookin at Lucky impressively catapulted himself to reach even terms entering the far turn. It looked like it was going to be showdown for the ages between the Derby and Preakness winners on the turn for home, but Lookin at Lucky quickly put an end to that as Garcia shook the reins, and began to spread eagle the field. **Trappe Shot** (Tapit) came running late to complete the exacta.

First Dude, who appeared to be backing out of it on the turn for home, was all heart to nose out Super Saver for third. "He didn't stumble coming out of the gate, he broke fine," Garcia offered of the winner. "I just moved him to the outside because I knew I was on a super horse, and I wanted to keep him out of trouble. I knew I was on the best horse. This is just a very powerful horse. I'm very appreciative to be able to ride this horse. I'm lucky." As for what's next, Baffert added, "I don't know yet about the [GI] Travers [at Saratoga Aug. 28]. We'll decide whether he stays east and goes to Saratoga or we bring him back west. Right now, I'm not sure." "He ran well very well. We were second to a top horse. We're disappointed because we think an awful lot of this horse. But this race is the best of the best, and right now, we're in second place."

Conditioner Dale Romans on third-place finisher First Dude:

"He got challenged a little earlier on the lead than I would have liked, but I guess every trainer with a horse on the lead says that. I was happy with the way he dug in."

Trainer Todd Pletcher on Derby winner Super Saver:

Calvin Borel on Super Saver:

Uptowncharlybrown Scratched...

Fantasy Lane Stable's **Uptowncharlybrown** (Limehouse), DQ'd from fifth and placed 12th in the GI Belmont S., was an early scratch in the Haskell. Trainer Kieran McLaughlin said, "He was running a 103-104 fever this morning. The timing was terrible. It's unfortunate for the owners, another bit of bad luck for this horse." He added, "We'll see how he comes out of this, and then regroup."

Last year's catalogue was some 30 horses larger than the 2010 version, but Browning is happy with its size. "We don't ever approach a sale with an artificial target in mind or number of horses that we're going to catalogue," Browning explained. "Would I rather have 212 of the right horses in the catalogue than 202 of the right ones? Probably. But we selected the horses that we thought would fit very well. And we're confident it's a really good group of horses. We've seen some trends from throughout 2010, and even in 2009, of some diminution in numbers, and it's not a surprise that the catalogue is a little smaller."

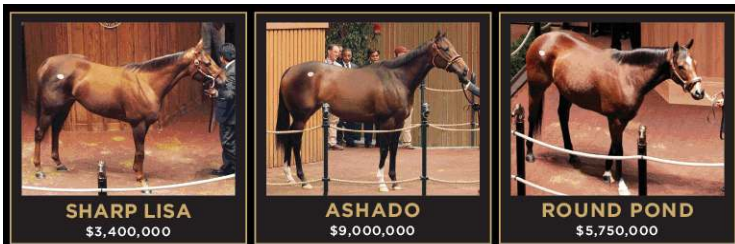
Consignor Reiley McDonald is impressed by what he has seen of this year's catalogue. "From the looks of it, they've done a great job selecting the sale again," McDonald observed. "It's a fairly typical Saratoga catalogue. I'm glad that they've gone back in numbers a little bit. I think the catalogue is strong, but what will really make or break the sale is what they are like conformationally. That is how I judge a sale. If my consignment is any measure of it, we've got a lot of good horses on the grounds--and I mean all the consignors have a lot of good horses on the grounds."

Sheikh Mohammed's Darley operation was a major presence at last year's auction, so consignors were likely thrilled to see the Dubai ruler personally inspecting horses on a sun-dappled morning at the Fasig-Tipton sales grounds yesterday. "It will be great if Sheikh Mohammed comes," said Denali Stud's Craig Bandoroff. "He was a big part of the sale last year." But Bandoroff added the top of the market seems to be holding its value. "I think the market has definitely shown that there is good demand for the top-quality horses," he said. "And Saratoga has been known to have quite a few top-quality horses. So I don't think there is any reason not to be cautiously optimistic. It is difficult times, and I think everybody holds their breath a bit. I thought July was a very good sale for the horses that they want, and I don't think anything is going to change."

McDonald agreed. "It does seem that good horses are selling very well, which was the case at Fasig-Tipton [July]," he said.

The Saratoga sales grounds underwent a major renovation before the 2009 auction. The sales pavilion itself was the focus of renovations this year. "It was an update to the facility," Browning explained. "The actual shell is unchanged, but it was a 40-year-old facility and it needed a little modernization and a little facelift."

The Saratoga sale continues with a second and final session Tuesday evening, also beginning at 7 p.m.

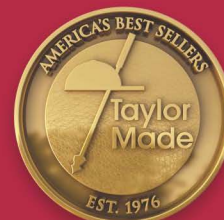

She already boasts an outstanding record, but the Wertheimers' **Goldikova (Ire)** (Anabaa) seems to be getting better with every race, and made light work of her latest test in Deauville's G1 Prix Rothschild. With the effort, she equalled the accomplishment of the great Miesque (Nureyev) in reaching double figures at the top level. Sent off the 2-5 favorite to bring up a trio of wins in this race, the bay was content to track her rabbit **Only Green (Ire)** (Green Desert) and **Music Show (Ire)** (Noverre) before easing to the front passing the quarter pole. The champion drew away under hand riding to beat the latter by three lengths. "She is a fantastic filly and I have said that many times, but it is the plain truth," trainer Freddy Head commented. "It looks like nothing can stop her, and it is obvious that she enjoys Deauville a lot--running here and training here every morning. It was the same in America, where she loved training on the track before her two Breeders' Cup Mile wins."

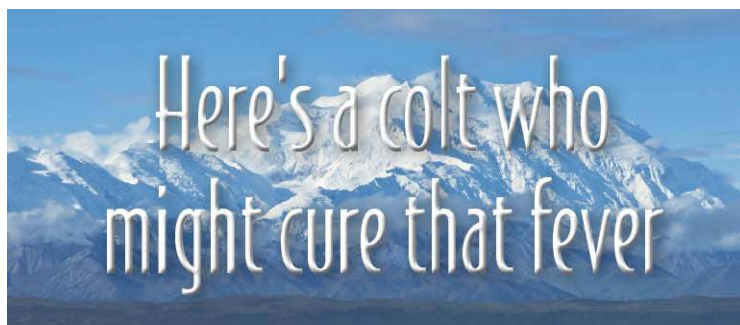

Her trainer, Freddy Head, piloted Miesque throughout her esteemed career. Head has refused to be drawn on comparisons with Stavros Niarchos' leading light, but a further Group 1 victory or another Breeders' Cup score would surely grant elevated status to Goldikova. Dahlia registered 11 wins in the best company from 1973 to 1976, and Goldikova belongs in that sphere following an almost effortless trio of successes in this race, which saw her spring to prominence two years ago. Despite two tough races this term in the May 23 G1 Prix d'Isipahan at Longchamp and June 15 G1 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot, the homebred showed no ill effects, and was always comfortable under Olivier Peslier while taking a lead from the recent impressive G1 Falmouth S. winner Music Show. Goldikova rolled by that rival without being extended, and the writing was on the wall before she reached the 300-meter marker. There was no stress from there to the line. "She had a perfect race today, and it was an excellent preparation ahead of the Jacques le Marois," Head remarked. "Her earlier races this year were much harder than last year, and I don't think there is a lot of improvement to come, so it is just a case of keeping her like this for the next two weeks. She is at the top of her game at the moment." Trainer Mick Channon said of the runner-up, "We got beaten by an exceptional filly, and I am very pleased with her run. We now have several options, including the G1 Matron S. [at Leopardstown Sept. 4], G1 Sun Chariot S. 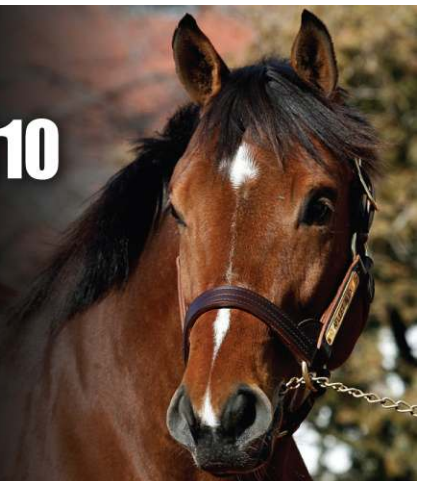

is the way he's moving, and how effortlessly he did it. He's pretty amazing."

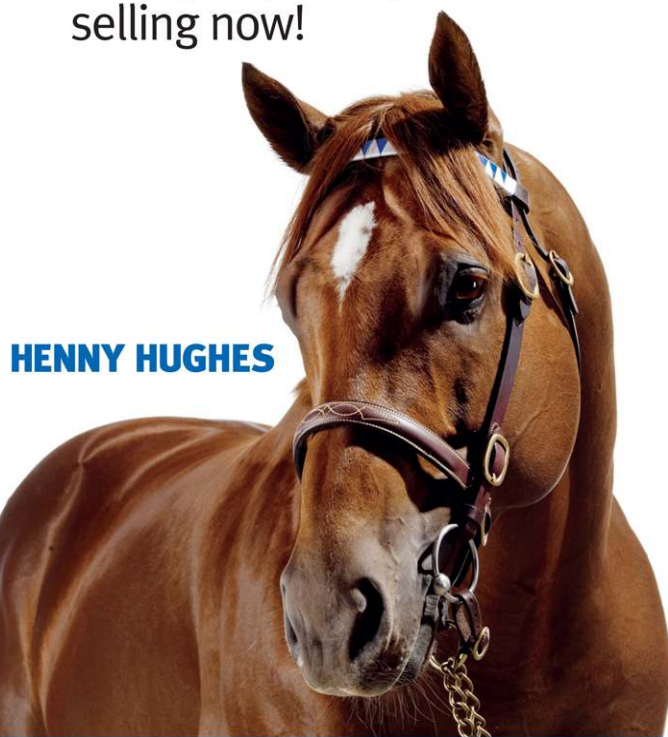

"The horse looks really well, and Sir Michael reports that he has now put back all of the weight that he lost during the race," Harry Herbert said.
