**Wickedly Perfect** (Congrats) made the most of a fast early pace to make it two in a row in Friday's GIII Sorrento S. at Del Mar. Allowed to settle in third behind

Ready to take command at the head of the lane, Wickedly Perfect was three wide around the turn, took control in the stretch and had enough left in reserve to hold off the late closing **A Z**

**Warrior** (Bernardini) by one length at the wire. **Izshelegal** (Maria's Mon), sent off the 3-1 second choice, was a head back in third, while Final Mesa, winner of Woodbine's My Dear S. last time out, tired to sixth.

## DESERT PARTY RETIRED TO DARLEY STUD

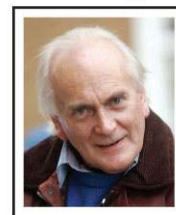
**Desert Party** (Street Cry {Ire}--Sage Cat, by Tabasco Cat) has been retired due to a soft tissue injury. The \$2.1 million Fasig-Tipton Calder purchase, who won six of 10 starts, amassed \$928,467 over three seasons. He took the 2008 GII Sanford S. as a juvenile for trainer Eoin Harty and Darley. Transferred to Saeed bin Suroor and Godolphin as a sophomore, he won the G3 UAE Guineas and the G3 Mahab Al Shimaal at Meydan in March. Desert Party returned to the U.S. for what would be his last start in the Donald Levine Memorial H. at Philadelphia Park June 26, scoring by 3 1/2 lengths. "I always liked this horse, he always showed his class, I thought this year he'd be ready to win a Group 1," trainer Saeed bin Suroor told *Daily Racing Form*. "Everything was good, he was in form. When he won last time, he was very good. Sadly, the horse got injured and it came now at the end of the season where he is not going to make it back this year so we decided to retire him." The four-year-old will enter stud next year at Darley's Jonabell Farm in Lexington, Kentucky for a fee that has yet to be determined. Darley Chief Operating Officer Olly Tait said, "This is a horse that we felt was headed for Grade I success. Physically, he is a fantastic individual and we're very excited to have him join our roster."

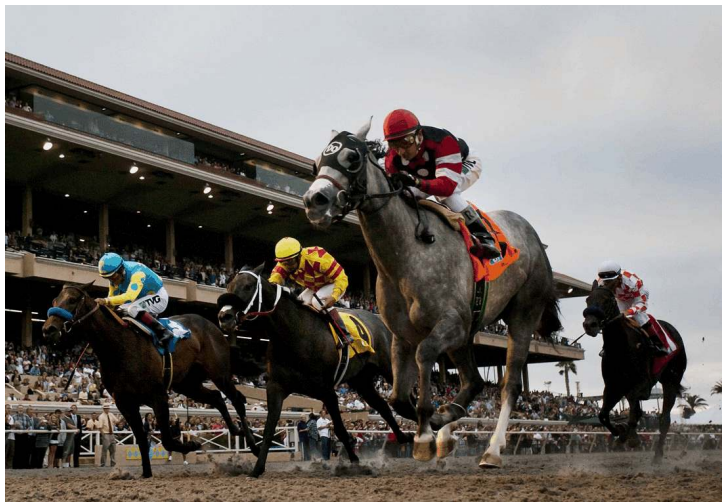

"She broke well, but I didn't want to be up on the lead," explained winning rider Rafael Bejarano. "They were going too fast. I had a strong hold on her; I had to wait. But at the three-eighths [pole], when I saw the favorite go inside, I knew I had to go, too. She got running and stayed strong. She's game."

Winning trainer Doug O'Neill added, "She's a beautiful filly. We've been a little concerned at times, because she's so quiet around the barn. She's just a very professional filly, but you never know how they're going to run on the track until they run. Rafael was up pretty close early, and when I saw the fast fractions, I figured Rafael must feel like he's really loaded. He's a world-class rider so you go with that. He knew he had a lot of horse."

In her career debut, Wickedly Perfect pressed the early pace before rolling home late to post an easy 4 3/4-length victory going five panels over Hollywood's Cushion Track June 27. Bejarano, who was aboard for her victory that day, was back in the irons yesterday to record his fourth victory on the card. "Right now I'm feeling good," said Bejarano. "Last week, I had some bad luck. Things weren't going my way, but that's the business. That's how this game is. It goes up and it goes down. But you always have to stay up. That's the way you have to think about it. Right now, my confidence is up and it is getting better."

Also basking in Wickedly Perfect's Sorrento victory was O'Neill's brother, Dennis, who helped pick out the filly earlier this season. "We bought her at the OBS April sale [2-year-olds in training]," confirmed Dennis O'Neill. "[Bloodstock agent] Bob Feld helped me pick her out. He liked her and I just fell in love with her. The first time we worked her, we were just smitten with her. We're very excited about her. She's very professional." **Pica Slew** has been ultra-impressive in three starts at Calder this year following a solid sixth on debut in the loaded My Dear S. at Woodbine last June. The bay was transferred to conditioner Joseph Calascibetta for her three Florida outings, first breaking her maiden by 10 1/4 lengths May 7, then scoring without ever being asked in the June 12 Leave Me Alone S., and finally annexing the GIII Azalea S. by two lengths July 10 with a 101 Beyer Speed Figure. Pica Slew rated kindly in second behind runaway train

Rapport (Songandaprayer) in the Azalea, but may find herself on the lead here breaking from the one hole. This will be her first start for Michael Hushion, who boasts a 23-percent win percentage with new acquisitions over the past five years. **Tidal Pool** has run well in route races this season with a second in the GII Fantasy S. and third in the GI Kentucky Oaks behind divisional leader Blind Luck (Pollard's Vision), but there is reason to believe that sprinting is her best game. She broke her maiden at 4 1/2 furlongs at Churchill last May and duelled and drew off to a three-length score in a six-furlong Spa allowance that August.

Musket Man, second behind Quality Road in the Met Mile for his fourth career Grade I placing, annexed the 2009 Illinois Derby at today's distance of nine furlongs.

Undefeated supermare **Zenyatta** should have little trouble bringing her record to 18-for-18 against five vastly overmatched foes. The six-year-old star was all-out to beat St Trinians (GB) (Piccolo {GB}) last time in the GI Vanity H. June 13, but no filly or mare of that one's quality is signed on here. It would seem that the only way to beat the late-runner is to build up an insurmountable lead, leaving her with too much to do late, but if several here employ that tactic they

may end up setting the race up perfectly for the big favorite. **Princess Taylor**, who opened up as many as five lengths early in the GIII Beverly Hills H. over 10 furlongs on the turf June 26 before getting passed late for the top spot; **Dance to My Tune**, who was second to Zenyatta in the GI Santa Margarita H. in March; and the stretching-out **Rinterval** all look to have their eye on the early lead, but for one to give Zenyatta a scare, two must hang back.

**Concord Point** stretched out effectively and took to the dirt last time for an 8 1/2-length triumph in the GIII Iowa Derby at Prairie Meadows June 26. He earned a 107 Beyer Speed Figure for that effort, second only to Eskendereya's (Giant's Causeway) 109 for the GI Wood Memorial S. in route performances by sophomores this year. Winslow Homer (Unbridled's Song) exited his third place finish behind Concord Point in Iowa with a nine-length victory in the Curlin S. last Sunday. **Exhi** has won four stakes in a row over synthetic surfaces, including the GII Lexington S. at Keeneland Apr. 17, but it remains to be seen if he can perform at the same level on conventional dirt. He is 0-for-3 on dirt, most recently second, beaten 15 lengths, by well-regarded Derby trail casualty Odysseus (Malibu Moon) in a Tampa Bay allowance in February. **Nacho Friend** put it all together last time when second behind Trappe Shot (Tapit), who came back to run second in the GI Haskell Invitational S. last weekend, in the Long Branch S. at Monmouth July 10. He should get plenty of pace in front of him.

He is currently plotting a steady course back up the ladder and bagged a first win in 10 starts in a June 2 Nottingham conditions event, and comes here off a dead-heat win in the Listed Pomfret S. at Pontefract July 25. His rivals include **Green Moon**, whose unbeaten sophomore streak came to a halt when he ran fifth in the G2 King Edward VII S. at Royal Ascot last time June 18.

I would imagine that it would take a lot to outsprint our horse, especially early in the race. This horse has an incredible stride." For his part, trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. has been impressed with what he's seen in the few days he's had Trickmeister under his care. "We like him," Dutrow told the *Form*. "He's a good-looking horse, he's got plenty of size to him. Iavarone bought him for the Travers. Right now, I certainly can't argue with him. I like the horse, I think we're in pretty good shape with him."

Also expected for the nine-furlongs race are **I Want Revenge** (Stephen Got Even) and **Redding Colliery** (Mineshaft).

Always First was off the board in six of seven starts last year, including a fifth-place finish as the favorite in this event, but did pick up a win in an optional claimer going 11 furlongs at Delaware Park in June. The gelding was given a go over fences in his 2009 finale, beating only one home over Florida's Palm Beach course Nov. 28, and disappeared for six months. Now nine, he made his return in a \$50,000 claiming event at Delaware June 8, where he ran second by a nose, and he was given little chance in his second stab at the John's Call. Content to rate near the back of the pack in the early going of this extended route, Always First gained ground on the far turn, rallied in the four path when they hit the lane and took over late to score the upset. Winning trainer Tom Voss also conditioned John's Call (Lord at War {Arg}), who captured the GI Turf Classic Invitational S. and GI Sword Dancer Invitational S. at the age of nine. "I should just train nine-year-olds--if you have any nine-year-olds, send them to me," Voss said. "Winning this race was a great thrill, considering all that has happened, and it felt great." John's Call had to be euthanized early this year after fracturing a leg in a paddock accident. He was 19. Voss had a moment of deja vu as the field for this race headed for the stretch. "[Always First] looked like John's Call coming around turn in the Sword Dancer," he remarked. "I just knew he was going to win. I knew he would take to the mile and five-eighths, and he got a beautiful ride. When he can get a clear run at the end and doesn't have to come through anybody, he runs much better." 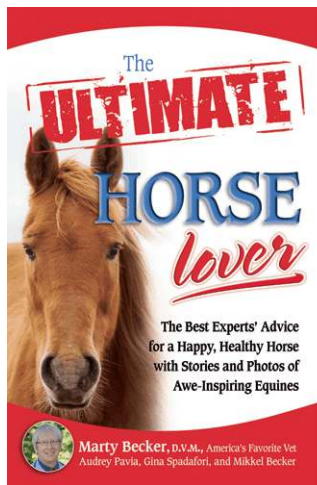
