

TUSCAN EVENING DEAD

GISW **Tuscan Evening (Ire)** (Oasis Dream {GB}--The Faraway Tree {GB}, by Suave Dancer) suffered an apparent heart attack after a six-furlong workout (1:15 2/5) on the turf at Del Mar Sunday morning and died. The five-year-old mare was perfect in six starts this year, most recently annexing the GIII Modesty H. at Arlington July 17. She was prepping for the Aug. 21

GI Beverly D S. In addition to the Modesty, she had reeled off wins in the 2010 GIII Monrovia H., GII Buena Vista H., GII Sana Ana H., GII Santa Barbara H. and GI Gamely S., scoring at distances from 6 1/2 furlongs to 1 1/4 miles. A 4,500gns TATOCT yearling purchase, Tuscan Evening started her career in the colors of Mrs. John J. Murphy, the wife of her trainer. Twice group-placed at two, she was still a maiden when she was acquired by a partnership headed by William deBurgh. The Irish-bred was sent to the U.S. and trainer Jerry Hollendorfer for her 2009 campaign, finally getting her first win when making her 12th career start at Santa Anita that January. She went six-for-10 last season, also capturing the GII Royal Heroine S. and GII Las Palmas H. DeBurgh bought out his partners when the mare went through the ring at the 2009 Fasig-Tipton November sale, bringing a final bid of \$650,000. Overall, she compiled a record of 28-13-4-5 and earned \$1,148,508.

A PARADE OF STRENGTH

Having caused a 14-1 upset when capturing the G1 Haydock Sprint Cup in September, Dab Hand Racing's **Regal Parade (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}) showed that was no fluke when adding Deauville's G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest to his tally yesterday. Sent off at 8-1 this time on the back of an authoritative win in Newbury's G3 Hackwood S. July 17, the chestnut was on hold early, but, after being brought to the fore by Adrian Nicholls inside the final quarter, overpowered the diminutive **Joanna (Ire)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) in the final 50 meters for a neck success. **Cont. p2**

SPEEDY PERFECTION IN THE VANDERBILT

The speedy **Majesticperfection** (Harlan's Holiday), sent off the crowd's even-money choice, blazed his way to a 2 3/4-length victory in yesterday's G1 Alfred G. Vanderbilt H. at Saratoga. The Padua Stables colorbearer broke like a shot and set fractions of :22.80, :45.60 and :56.89 while being stalked by **Big Drama** (Montbrook). He strode home under a vigorous hand ride to an authoritative victory. "He's been very fast, he's a very good horse, and I'm very proud that he ran this race on this level," said winning trainer Steve

Asmussen. "He was away very cleanly today and you could tell Shaun [Bridgmohan] was very comfortable. He had his chance to show who he is, and he got it done. I think he beat a very good group, but we've got to reproduce that performance again." As for what is next for the speedy colt, Asmussen said, "I would be very tentative, and it's just one of the suggestions, but it would most likely be the [Oct. 2 GI] Vosburgh and the [Nov. 6 GI] Breeders' Cup [Sprint]." **Cont. p4**

Regal Parade started out in the silks of Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum for the Mark Johnston stable and, despite showing initial promise at a modest level on the all-weather and turf at up to 10 furlongs, was soon deemed expendable. Snapped up by David "Dandy" Nicholls, long known in Britain as the "King of the Sprinters" for his uncanny talent at turning cast-offs into leading lights in that sphere, Regal Parade took time to develop his raw speed.

First signs that he was making the metamorphosis came when dropped to seven furlongs and duly garnering Royal Ascot's Buckingham Palace H. in June 2008 and the transformation was completed when he added the prestigious six-furlong cavalry charge of the Ayr Gold Cup to his resume in September. Kept at six and seven furlongs last term, he was ninth in the G1 Golden Jubilee S. back at Royal Ascot before winning the Listed City Plate at Chester and placing in both the G2 Lennox S. at Goodwood and G2 Hungerford S. at Newbury. Since signing off for 2009 after his career-best in the Haydock Sprint Cup, he had put in two unplaced efforts this season in the Mar. 27 G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen at Meydan and the latest renewal of the Golden Jubilee June 19. His surge from rear to outclass High Standing in the Hackwood last time scotched any doubts as to whether he retained ability, however, and he confirmed he firmly belongs in the best category with this follow-up. Held up early in the group racing up the center of the track, he traveled into contention alongside Joanna, and looked certain to miss out as that rival appeared to be pulling double inside the final quarter. She had the edge passing the eighth pole, but Regal Parade kept working, and in the end managed to master the Shadwell colorbearer with sheer will. "He's a really nice horse and, although the plan was not to ride him like that, he's very adaptable," trainer Dandy Nicholls said. "He showed today that he might stay a mile later on, but in the meantime he will go back to Haydock for the [Sept. 4] G1 Sprint Cup, and he could run in the G1 Prix de la Foret [at Longchamp Oct. 3]. Of all Aidan O'Brien's achievements since taking over at Ballydoyle, his record in this race is among his finest with 10 of the last 12 winners having emanated from Co. Tipperary, and Zoffany extended that remarkable sequence here. Despite a resume that boasted four wins from five starts, it was Zoffany's sole reversal when sixth in the June 15 G2 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot which influenced this market which leaned heavily in the favor of that race's winner Strong Suit. As that rival was taken up to race prominently by Richard Hughes throughout the early stages, Johnny Murtagh was intent on seeking cover for Zoffany despite the fact he had proven his stamina over seven furlongs when successful in Leopardstown's Listed Golden Fleece S. July 1 and G3 Tyros S. July 22. Needing room and hemmed in on the rail by the weakening Ballydoyle pacemaker Snow Mountain (Ire) (Danehill Dancer (Ire)) as Strong Suit hit the front passing the quarter pole, the bay quickened impressively when in the clear to chase down that rival and Glor Na Mara. The latter gamely responded to Kevin Manning's urgings to battle past the favorite in the dying yards, but it was Zoffany who arrived to split the duo in time and at the line had established some superiority.

"We said before Royal Ascot that he'd only had two very easy runs and that's obviously the trouble with going there as a baby," O'Brien explained. "He suffered from stage fright, so all we could do when he came back was step him up in trip so things would happen a bit slower and he would learn a little bit more. Everyone has done a great job with him and he won his last two races very easily.

"He's always had that unbelievable acceleration--we saw that in his first two starts and now he's starting to relax he's very exciting," O'Brien continued. "Johnny said he was going to relax him and that was the important thing, but obviously when you do that and the field closes in you have to be lucky. Johnny was very cool on him and that was a special ride. He's getting heavier all the time and that's a great sign--he's maturing and getting physically stronger, so while he's doing that we'll keep going forward. It's one race at a time and we'll look at the G1 National S. [at The Curragh Sept. 11] next." Jim Bolger revealed that the Oct. 16 G1 Dewhurst S. is the long-term target of the runner-up, while Strong Suit's trainer Richard Hannon said, "We are making no excuses--we'll take him home and have him scoped." 

Secret Gypsy, perfect in two prior starts on the main track at the Spa, ran her record to three-for-three over the oval here. The chestnut mare earned **TDN Rising Star** status when she romped by 6 1/4 lengths in her career opener at Saratoga three years ago, and took an optional claimer at the 2008 meet.

She entered this test off a decisive score in the Saylorville S. at Prairie Meadows June 25. The face of the race changed dramatically when the speedy Warbling was caught flat-footed at the start. One Smokin' Lady (Smoke Glacken) dashed out to set the pace, with Secret Gypsy tracking her in second. Assuming command while still on the bit at the top of the lane, she opened up at the top of the lane and kept her mind on business late to score by 2 1/2 lengths. "Her races and her confidence have been getting better," reported winning trainer Ronny Werner. "Sometimes it's hard to get fillies back--she's had some problems in the past and we were working through that, mentally and physically. She's done well [at Saratoga]. I wish it was a longer meet!" Werner added maturity has given Secret Gypsy a new dimension. "She's changed her style of running a little bit this year," he explained.
