MOTT NOT RESTING ON HIS LAURELS

It's been a banner year for trainer Bill Mott. The Hall of Famer earned his first win in a Triple Crown race when Drosselmeyer (Distorted Humor) captured the GI Belmont S. in June, and became the ninth conditioner in North American history to saddle 4,000 winners when Mystic (Unbridled's Song) came home first in an allowance test at Saratoga in August. He is currently the fifth-leading trainer in the country, with more than \$5 million in purses to his credit, and could add significantly to that total if Juddmonte Farms' homebred **Treat Gently (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) can get the job done in the GI Beverly D. S. at Arlington today. Good enough to finish third behind Zarkava (Ire) (Zamindar) and Dar Re Mi (GB) (Singspiel {Ire}) in the 2008 G1 Prix Vermeille, the five-year-old mare made just two starts last year, taking an optional claimer at Belmont in July before tiring to sixth in the GI E.P. Taylor S. in October. Mott picked up the bay at the end of the season, but, after running second in the GII San Gorgonio H. in January, Treat Gently was off the board in the Mar. 21 GII Santa Ana H. and Apr. 10 GII Jenny Wiley S. She has hit her best stride after stretching out to 11 panels in her last two starts, however, winning the May 22 GII Sheepshead Bay H. and July 17 GIII Robert G. Dick Memorial H., and will be well backed to make it three in a row in the 1 3/16-mile Beverly D. Mott took the race last year with Dynaforce (Dynaformer). **Cont. p3**

TITLE BOUT IN 'BAMA

Forget about the "Thrilla in Manila." Today's GI Betfair/TVG Alabama S. at Saratoga features a clash between division heavyweights **Blind Luck** (Pollard's Vision) and **Devil May Care** (Malibu Moon). Local starlet Devil May Care sports a stylish win over the track in the GI CCA Oaks July 24, while California girl Blind Luck has criss-crossed the country for last-gasp victories in the GI Kentucky Oaks and GII Delaware Oaks. "I think this is a race that the fans want to see," said Blind Luck's trainer Jerry Hollendorfer. **Cont. p5-6**

POWER SURGE

While the winner of yesterday's G1 Coolmore Nunthorpe S. coming from Ireland was no surprise, few would have predicted it would be the 100-1 outsider **Sole Power (GB)** (Kyllachy {GB}) in the hallowed spot afterwards. Coming into this on the back of an inauspicious fifth in Tipperary's Listed Abergwaun S. Aug. 6, the bay took a leap into the dark against esteemed opposition, but there was no fluke in his clear-cut success in front of a stunned Knavesmire crowd. Settled off the murderous pace set by the flying filly **Rose Blossom (GB)** (Pastoral Pursuits {GB}), he moved into contention with the 6-4 pick **Starspangledbanner (Aus)** (Choisir {Aus}) to his right and quickened the better to win by 1 1/4 lengths, with another 100-1 shot **Piccadilly Filly (Ire)** (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) making the frame. Trainer Eddie Lynam was not as surprised as many. "We've always rated this horse, and he is very fast, but is just mentally a bit immature, and in sprints in Ireland they go too slow and we can't get him to relax," Lynam said. Finding Sole Power in this puzzle was made all the harder by a paucity of black-type in his resume. Runner-up in The Curragh's Listed Grangecon Stud S. over five furlongs on heavy ground last July, he was third in this meeting's £300,000 St Leger Yearling S. before running eighth in the G3 Cornwallis S. at Ascot in October. Dundalk's Polytrack was the surface on which he started to metamorphose over the winter and early spring, and he cracked the track record in a five-furlong conditions event there Apr. 3 before going back to turf. His fourth in the May 1 G3 Palace House S. at Newmarket promised much, but he took a step back on the formbook when he ran unplaced in the June 7 Listed Naas Sprint S., the June 27 G3 Sapphire S. at The Curragh and the Abergwaun. Able to rate here for Wayne Lordan as Rose Blossom tore up the grass on the front end, he had the same ground to make up as the lone stand's-side runner Starspangledbanner inside the final quarter, but found an extra gear to outstay the hot favorite close home. In doing so, he was emulating his sire's success in this contest eight years ago. "We weren't thinking he would win, but we knew today we could get him relaxed, and if he'd have been third or fourth, we'd have been happy," trainer Eddie Lynam admitted. "He is a very good horse, but he could go for a Listed race in Ireland in three weeks' time, and if they messed around, he'd run as free as a bird and not finish. This will be his race every year, and if we get a nice sunny day in France [for the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp Oct. 3], he'll go, but if it's typical French ground he won't. He'll be a better horse next year."

Acoma (Empire Maker) and **Ave (GB)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) lead the pack alphabetically, and it would be no surprise if either filly hit the wire first. Three-for-six last term, five-year-old Acoma capped off the season with a win in the Nov. 21 Gill Cardinal H. on the Churchill lawn. She was off for more than six months after that effort, returning to finish a rallying second behind **Hot Cha Cha** (Cactus Ridge) in the June 5

Gill Mint Julep H. under the Twin Spires. Fourth, but beaten just a neck, in the July 3 Gill Locust Grove H., she should appreciate the stretch-out off that one-mile affair. "She's been training very well lately," trainer David Carroll said. "I think she's going to give us a big effort Saturday. I'm looking forward to the race." Ave, a Group 3 winner in Ireland last fall, is looking to break through after hitting the board in her first three U.S. appearances. Third by a half length in the May 15 Gill Gallorette S. at Pimlico, she filled out the triple once again in the June 19 Gill New York S. at Belmont, and just missed in her latest, running second by a nose in the July 18 Gill Dance Smartly S. at Woodbine. Hot Cha Cha followed up on her Mint Julep score with a third in the local prep for this, the July 17 Gill Modesty S.

REMATCH IN THE MILLION

They finished 1-2 in the 2009 GI Arlington Million, and **Gio Ponti** (Tale of the Cat) and **Just As Well** (A.P. Indy) will face off once again in the 2010 edition of the race. Gio Ponti rode a three-race winning streak into the 2009 Million. After besting Just As Well by 1 1/4 lengths that afternoon, he ran second in four of his next five tries, including the GI Breeders' Cup Classic and, as the 1-5 chalk, in his seasonal bow in the Feb. 20 Tampa Bay S. The bay ran fourth in the Mar. 27 G1 Dubai World Cup, then was

runner-up again after a troubled trip in the June 5 GI Manhattan H. As he did last year, Gio Ponti used the GI Man o' War S. as his final Million prep and he broke his losing skein with a neck score in that July 10 test. "Without a doubt he is similar to last year," trainer Christophe Clement told *Daily Racing Form*. "What he has lacked is a little bit of racing luck." Just As Well is looking for his first win since taking his 2009 Million prep, the GIII Arlington H. Off the board in the GI Canadian International S. and G1 Japan Cup at the end of the campaign, he missed by 3/4 of a length when completing the exacta in his second start this term, the May 15 GII Dixie S. Fifth after checking sharply in the Manhattan, he exits a second behind **Rahystrada** in this year's Arlington H. A pair of six-year-old geldings fly the flag for Europe this year. Group 3 winner **Tazeez**, second or third in four starts this year, comes off a third in the July 8 G2 Princess of Wales's S. at Newmarket, while **Summit Surge** captured the July 24 G2 York S. in his latest. Both get Lasix for the U.S. bows.

Paddy O'Prado is even-money on the morning-line, and deservedly so. After finishing third in the GI Kentucky Derby, the grey was unplaced in the GI Preakness S., but has been most impressive since returning to his preferred surface. He captured the GII Colonial Turf Cup June 19 over the consistent **Workin for Hops**, and added the GII Virginia Derby for good measure at Colonial Downs July 17. He is following the same path as Kitten's Joy, another son of El Prado (Ire) who took the Virginia Derby and Secretariat en route to champion turf male honors for trainer Dale Romans in 2004. Workin for Hops is unbeaten in two appearances over these weeds, with victories in the May 22 Arlington Classic and July 17 GII American Derby sandwiching his second to the favorite in Virginia. Trainer Mike Stidham is realistic about his charge's chances in this 10-furlong affair. "For us to win, we need [Paddy O'Prado] not to run his best and for our horse to run his very best," he admitted to *Daily Racing Form*. English shipper **Wigmore Hall** adds Lasix following wins in York's John Smith's Cup July 10 and a conditions race Newmarket Aug. 6. "This horse has good tactical speed," trainer Michael Bell told *DRF*. "He's very handy, very nippy. Paddy O'Prado is worth a lot of respect, but it's impossible to know the form lines across the two countries."

Devil May Care bounced back from a creditable 10th in the GI Kentucky Derby May 1 to post handy victories in the GI Mother Goose S. at Belmont June 26 and the GI CCA Oaks during Saratoga's opening weekend. The additional furlong here shouldn't pose a problem, and her stalking tactics will give her first run over **Blind Luck**, but she'll need to brace for the Californian's relentless final furlong. So who else can make an impact? Jim and Susan Hill's **Tizahit** is a bit of a dark horse that is bred to relish these 10 furlongs. After sealing her juvenile campaign with a success in the GII Demoiselle S. at Aqueduct, the dark bay didn't see action again until June 18, when she ran fifth as the favorite in a Monmouth allowance. She improved to be runner-up in local optional claimer July 30, and her Calgary-based owners are on a bit of a roll. The Hills' Miami Deco (Limehouse) picked an opportune time to break his maiden last Sunday in the C\$500,000 Breeders' S. at Woodbine, and Running Tap (Tapit) made a successful debut for the couple at Saratoga this past Thursday. "It'd be really exciting and incredibly lucky to win both the Breeders' and the Alabama, luckier than most people will ever be," said Jim Hill. "I think she is going to run better than people expect her to do. I'll be disappointed if she doesn't outrun her odds." Hill, who runs the oilfield-supply company Pason, got into the racing game in 2004. "We have an interest in art, and we attended the show of a dealer whose husband was involved in racing," Hill explained. "He talked me into a 50/50 partnership on four horses." That dabbling has grown significantly. "We own 40 to 50 horses and are active buyers at the sales, so we were hoping something like winning the Breeders' S. would eventually happen," Hill commented.

There will be no waiting involved to determine Ice Box's status, who worked five furlongs in 1:00.09 (2/26) ([video](#)) over the main track. With Julien Leparoux aboard, the G1 Kentucky Derby runner-up breezed in company with GSW Cool Coal Man (Mineshaft), who covered four furlongs in a bullet :47.66. "It looks like he has a little more strength, would be my guess," Zito said of Ice Box, who was last seen placing a lackluster sixth in the G1 Haskell Invitational S. at Monmouth Aug. 1. "It takes them a while to recover from [the Triple Crown] races. Hopefully, he comes with a great run next weekend. If he runs to the Derby race, he'll be right there." **Fly Down** (Mineshaft), the G1 Belmont S. runner-up and fifth-place finisher as the favorite in the Jim Dandy, is scheduled to have his final pre-Travers work today.

In other Travers news, owner/trainer Leon Blusiewicz's **Admiral Alex** (Afleet Alex) breezed six furlongs beneath Kent Desormeaux in 1:14.02. The \$260,000 KESEEP yearling enters off a winning debut at the Spa July 31. "It was a beautiful work," Blusiewicz said. "He didn't turn a hair. He finished really well--he finished stronger than he started. That's what I wanted. Now, he'll just gallop into the race."

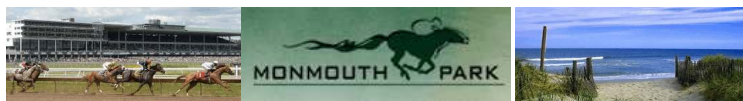

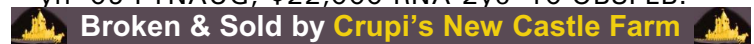

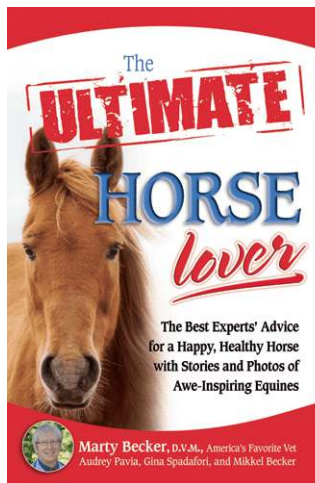
