FIRST DUDE GETS BLINKERS FOR TRAVERS

First Dude (Stephen Got Even), third behind winner Lookin At Lucky (Smart Strike) and Trappe Shot (Tapit) in the Aug. 1 GI Haskell Invitational S., will be equipped with blinkers for the first time in Saturday's GI Travers S., according to trainer Dale Romans. Runner-up in the GI Preakness S. May 15, the powerfully built bay was also third in this season's GI Blue Grass S. and GI Belmont S. "I'm afraid to put him in a non-winners-of-two allowance and he loses at 1-9," joked Romans at his barn Thursday

morning as First Dude was led out for a walk. "As long as he's competitive, I'm going to keep him in these races. We're waiting for him to break through and win one of these babies." Often used to sharpen speed, Romans indicated the equipment would be used as a tool to increase the colt's focus. "We're not putting a big cup on; it's a half-cup," confirmed Romans. "[Jockey] Ramon [Dominguez] says it helps him focus on accelerating when he calls on him." Explaining the decision to make the switch before the big race, Romans added, "It's frustrating. We're trying to think of things different. The blinkers took a lot of consideration before doing it." According to Romans, First Dude has breezed twice wearing blinkers, but how the handsome sophomore will react in an actual race is anybody's guess. "You can't simulate racing conditions with these horses," assured Romans.

Zito to Name Travers Lineup today...

Trainer Nick Zito indicated he is going to make a decision today whether all three of his entrants will compete in tomorrow's GI Travers at Saratoga. Front-running **Miner's Reserve** (Mineshaft), runner-up to A Little Warm in the July 31 GII Jim Dandy S., drew the rail in the 11-horse field; GI Florida Derby winner **Ice Box** (Pulpit) will break from post six; and GII Dwyer S. winner **Fly Down** (Mineshaft) will exit the eight hole in the 10-furlong race. "The horse is doing well, no question," Zito said of Miner's Reserve, who, along with Ice Box, is owned by Bob LaPenta. LaPenta is expected to arrive in Saratoga Springs and visit Zito's barn on Friday morning. "When I looked at the draw, I wasn't too happy, but who knows. We'll see." On the morning line, Miner's Reserve has been set at 12-1, the highest of Zito's Travers trio, while Fly Down is 8-1. GI Kentucky Derby runner-up Ice Box is listed at 10-1. "People are saying that it's a wide open race," said Zito. "Obviously, if it's a wide open race, maybe Miner's has a shot, too. We'll figure it out. You never say never, and it's a good possibility I'll run him. If at the last minute, I think it's not the right thing to do, I'll talk to Bob about it and see what it is. It is the Travers, so we'll see what happens."

Baletti, winner of the May 1 GIII Fort Marcy S., failed to make an impact when sixth in his most recent start in the GIII Monmouth S. June 12. However, according to trainer Angel Penna Jr., the \$450,000 KEESEP yearling had an excuse that day. Dehydrated due to excessive heat and shipped in close to the race, the bay was beaten seven lengths by Get Serious (City Zip) in the nine-furlong event. "He was out of his mind," Penna told *Daily Racing Form*. "I've got to throw that race out. Penna added, "He's fine now, back to himself. [I don't think] a mile and an eighth will bother him."

Stidham Appeals Positive...

Trainer Michael Stidham is appealing the 15-day suspension he was given by the Illinois Racing Board after GIII Arlington Oaks winner **Upperline** (Maria's Mon) tested positive for the non-steroidal anti-inflammatory etodolac. Upperline was one of eight horses, all under the care of Dr. James Gilman, who tested positive for the drug at Arlington Park. Nick Canani trained six of the horses, while Stidham and Ingrid Mason each trained one. Canani and Mason are also appealing. Stidham's appeal includes a request that a split urine sample be sent to Louisiana State University for testing. A post-race blood sample will also be sent to the University of Kentucky to ensure a genetic match. "I just wanted people to know that I am appealing it. The way it all went down at Arlington isn't right, and we're going to fight it," said Stidham, who is also facing a \$1,000 fine. The spate of positives occurred when Arlington made a change in its testing protocol and began specifically targeting etodolac, a Class 3 medication under Association of Racing Commissioners International guidelines. According to those familiar with the case, the sensitive tests can reveal trace amounts of the drug unlikely to affect performance. Illinois has a zero-tolerance policy for etodolac. Sold to humans under the brand name Lodine, etodolac falls in the same class of drugs like ibuprofen and naproxen, according to medicinenet.com.

Dr. Gilman told *Daily Racing Form* that he has used etodolac on horses for eight years using a five-day withdrawal period without a positive. Upperline is owned by Stidham, Stone Farm, John H. Adger and Oakcrest Farm. Stewards initially ruled that **Snowtop Mountain** (Najran) would be awarded the victory and the first-place purse of \$59,400 in the Arlington Oaks, but that decision is now on hold pending the appeal of the case to a hearing officer to be appointed by the IRB.

Goodwood Saturday Card in the Balance...

Heavy rain has led to an inspection this morning ahead of tomorrow's card at Goodwood, which features the G2 Celebration Mile and G3 Prestige S. Yesterday's action was lost as a result of the waterlogging and Clerk of the Course Seamus Buckley is hoping for a recovery in conditions. "I've never known anything like it," he told the *Racing Post*. "It was like a biblical storm, with thunder and rain coming straight down on us and just hanging over the Downs without moving. By the end of it, we'd had nearly 50mm of rain in 24 hours. We'll have another look in the morning, but if the forecast is right and the weather settles down we should be okay."

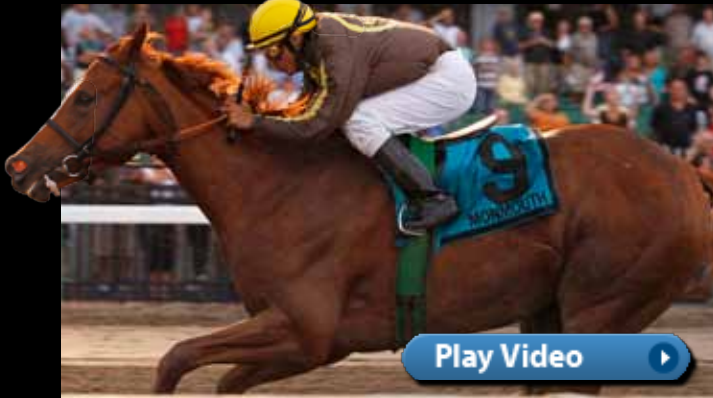

A filly by freshman sire Congrats (A.P. Indy) realized the top price of \$64,000 to close out the third and final session of the OBS August Yearling Sale in Ocala, Florida. Offered by Perrone Sales Ltd., agent, the Apr. 25 foal is out of the 13-year-old, stakes-placed mare Singingasong (Sultry Song). Purchased by Hal Hatch's H. H. T.S., [hip 727](#)

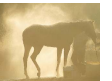

is a granddaughter of stakes-winning Donttellefluff (Dixieland Band). The second highest price of the session was secured by Riley James. Offered as [hip 645](#), the bay filly by Trippi is out of

Ohio Debutante H. winner Pyrite Bonds (Formal Dinner) and is from the extended family of Elusive Diva (Elusive Quality).

For the two Open sessions, 478 horses sold for a total of \$4,214,850 compared to 541 horses bringing \$3,789,200 in three Open sessions. The average price was \$8,818, up 25.9 percent from \$7,004 last year, while the median price rose 60 percent to \$5,600 compared with \$3,500 median figure in 2009. The buyback percentage was 24.6 percent; it was 33.2 percent a year ago. At Tuesday's Selected session, 137 horses sold for a total of \$4,890,500, compared with 110 yearlings grossing \$3,632,500 in 2009. The average price was \$35,697, up 8.1 percent from \$33,023 last year, while the median price was \$26,000, up from \$25,000 in 2009. The buyback percentage was 24.3 percent; down from 39.9 percent a year ago. For complete results visit www.obssales.com.

Trickmeister garnered  **"TDN Rising Star"**  status two back when he took a six-furlong optional claimer wire-to-wire by 4 3/4 lengths at Delaware June 19, upping his record to two-for-two. He successfully stretched out to annex the Barbaro S. in the slop July 10, and was subsequently purchased by IEAH Stables and transferred to Rick Dutrow. The undefeated sophomore was considered possible for tomorrow's GI Travers S., but will instead try this much softer spot. **Our Dark Knight** looks to be Trickmeister's main danger. He finished last in the GI IZOD Haskell Invitational S. most recently, but was second in the May 23 Spend A Buck S. and looked good when taking a Monmouth allowance by three lengths June 19.

We even collect Mexican folk art, and have visited many local Mexican artists all over the country.

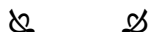
