

PERSISTENCE PAYS OFF

When **Rachel Alexandra** (Medaglia d'Oro) put away **Life At Ten** (Malibu Moon) in upper stretch, it looked like the reigning Horse of the Year was home free in yesterday's GI Personal Ensign S. at Saratoga, but 20-1 longshot **Persistently** (Smoke Glacken) closed relentlessly to overtake the tiring champion in the final strides for a one-length victory in the 10-furlong event. Alexandra, sent off at 1-2, broke sharply and went right to the lead where she was hounded by 8-5 second choice Life At Ten through fractions of :23.66, :47.73 and 1:12.02. John Velazquez began asking Life At Ten for more turning for home, but the chestnut mare couldn't match strides with Rachel Alexandra and a near motionless Calvin Borel. Rachel Alexandra quickly opened a 3 1/2-length advantage, but began to tire visibly in the final furlong as Phipps

homebred **Persistently** grinded out her first graded victory. "I thought that [Rachel Alexandra] might be a little vulnerable going a mile and a quarter, and I knew we'd run a mile and a quarter," explained winning trainer Shug McGaughey, who also conditioned Personal Ensign for the Phipps family. "We're just tickled to death to win the race, particularly with it being the Personal Ensign. My hat's off to Rachel Alexandra. She runs her heart out every time. She made a beautiful presence in the paddock today. We were just lucky enough to pick up the pieces." *Cont. p2*

MISTY TOO MUCH IN MOYGLARE

Misty For Me (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), runner-up to **Laughing Lashes** (Mr. Greeley) in the Aug. 8 G2 Debutante S., turned the tables on that rival with a front-running one-length victory in yesterday's G1 Moyglare Stud S. at The Curragh. Sent straight to the front from the outset, Misty For Me set a stern pace and was threatened by **Laughing Lashes** inside the final quarter. As the Debutante winner flashed her tail with the whip applied, Misty For Me was game for pressure and gave extra in the closing yards as **Kissable (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) flew late to be third. "She's very progressive and her dam is a half-sister to Fasliyev, so there is speed there and the Galileos don't know when to give up," trainer Aidan O'Brien commented after greeting his fifth winner of this prize. "We'll have a look at the G1 Fillies' Mile [at Ascot Sept. 25] and the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac [at Longchamp Oct. 3]." **Memory (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}), sent off the even-money favorite, surrendered her unbeaten record in tame fashion when trailing in sixth. Highclere's Harry Herbert was taking Memory's eclipse on the chin. "Richard Hughes got off her and said she was just never going at all today--there's definitely something not quite right with her," Herbert told *PA Sport*. "She just wasn't up for it at all today, she didn't travel and ran very, very flat and Richard looked after her after that. I will have to speak to Richard [Hannon], but I think we will probably look to drop back in trip now and the G1 Cheveley Park S. [at Newmarket Oct. 1] looks a likely target." *Cont. p2*

Persistently Wins Personal Ensign (cont. from p1)

Persistently (Smoke Glacken), a Phipps homebred in a race named for one of the stable's greatest champions, was second in the 2008 GI Frizette S. and fifth in that year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. After making just two starts last term, she had two allowance tallies in six previous starts this year, most recently capturing a nine-furlong optional claimer at Saratoga July 30. "My filly kept responding when I was asking her," said winning rider Alan Garcia. "She was the best. This was a big victory in my career. I didn't talk to anyone after the race; I was too excited. I can't even explain the emotions--to beat the Horse of the Year, at Saratoga--it was amazing."

Connections Still Proud of Rachel

Despite suffering her third loss of the year, connections were still proud of Rachel Alexandra. "We are disappointed in the result, as we are sure her countless fans are, but we are certainly not disappointed in her," Jess Jackson said of his beaten favorite. "She is still a superstar in our hearts and minds. The old sports adage applies...on any given Sunday, anything can happen." Trainer Steve Asmussen added, "I thought [Rachel] put a very good mare [Life At Ten] away. It obviously took more out of her on the front end than we would have hoped for. When she moved away from [Life At Ten], that's what you were hoping to see. Then she got run down late. I'm very disappointed that she lost, but I am always very happy with Rachel. It hurts to lose and you're disappointed for it, but if that's the case, just think about how happy she's made you and all the things she has done for us. She's a tremendous mare. If she isn't exactly where she was last year, hopefully she can get back there." Jockey Calvin Borel offered no excuses. "She just got outrun," Borel said. "I had everything my way, and she just got outrun. After we put away Life At Ten at the quarter pole, I didn't feel any acceleration and I got worried. She wasn't really there. I knew if anyone was running behind us, we were in trouble. If you can't take the losing with the winning, you can't be in the game." 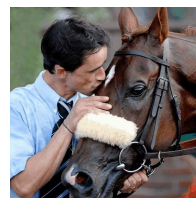

Led out unsold at the Arqana Arc Sale in October, Marinous took the Listed Grand Prix du Nord at Le Croise-Laroche a month later before enjoying a spell under the auspices of Musabah Al Muhairi in Dubai this spring. After two winless starts at Meydan, the bay took the H H The Emir's Trophy over 1 3/8 miles at Dohar Mar. 25 before returning to Freddy Head to be third in the Listed Prix de Reux over this track and trip Aug. 8. Racing close to the steady early pace in fourth, he was in prime position as the field turned into the home straight and in a slow-motion finale edged ahead with a furlong remaining before holding off Redwood and the bunch. "This is the first horse for his owner from Abu Dhabi and it is a very pleasant surprise," his trainer commented. "I trained him last year, he was then sent to Dubai for the Carnival, but he failed to do well there and was sent back to me. He ran a good race here on his return three weeks ago and I was hoping for a good run as I knew he had improved quite well, but I couldn't be confident he'd win. He's not in the [Oct. 3] Arc and I'm a little puzzled as to what to do next with him. We have no firm plans at this stage." Just Jenda, making the final start of her career here, began the year with fourth-place efforts in the Mar. 6 GIII Azeri S. and Apr. 9 GI Apple Blossom S. She took her Monmouth Park record to a perfect three-for-three with a 1 1/2-length victory in the May 30 Monmouth Beach S., but suffered her first loss at the Jersey shore with a third-place finish in the June 26 Lighthouse S. last time out. Malibu Prayer took control early on the turn yesterday, but her advantage was short-lived as Just Jenda moved to challenge entering the stretch and quickly asserted control before drawing clear for a confident score. "What a way to go out," trainer and co-owner Cindy Jones said. "She was on top of her game and the race just worked out perfectly. This was a real tough field and we couldn't be more proud of her." Co-owner and former trainer Larry Jones explained, "This was our Breeders' Cup. We've already thrown her to the wolves and run against Rachel and Zenyatta, so we really didn't have any races for her going forward. She'll go to Kentucky and will be bred to Proud Citizen." Champ Pegasus graduated in his fourth start, racing nine furlongs over the Santa Anita turf Apr. 14. He resurfaced to take a grassy 10-furlong allowance at Hollywood Park June 12 before running second in his stakes debut in the July 18 GIII Sunset H. Allowed to rate well off a runaway leader, the bay produced a powerful turn of foot along the rail in the final furlong to win going away. "My horse was nice and relaxed; running easy," explained winning rider Joel Rosario. "He's an easy horse to ride and, when we came for home, I was looking for a place to go--outside, inside. A spot opened inside for me and I went for it. Easy enough." As for what is next for Champ Pegasus, trainer Richard Mandella said, "I'll probably run him in the [GI] Clement Hirsch at Hollywood Park [Oak Tree meet] and then we hope we'll be looking at the Breeders' Cup Turf. I don't know if the mile and a half wouldn't be a problem, but it's something to dream about and that's what this game is all about." The gray launched a determined stretch rally to just nail the pacesetters on the line in a blanket finish. "I was happy to see Patrick [Husbands aboard Jungle Wave], put the pressure on Fatal Bullet or I would have had to do it," said winning rider Jono Jones. "If Patrick hadn't done it, we would have been in trouble, I think. It worked out perfect for me after that. This horse knows where the wire is. He was determined to win." "I thought she was a mile-and-a-half filly earlier in the year, but every time she's worked she's got sharper and a mile is probably her optimum trip," winner trainer Joanna Morgan commented. Hopefully, she stays in training next year, but she's in the [Sept. 11] G2 Blandford S. and the G3 Denny Cordell Lavarack S. [at Gowran Park Sept. 25]." Lush Lashes (GB) (Galileo {Ire}), making her first start back since retirement, was the 7-2 favorite, but looked to need the experience when staying on at the one pace out wide, finishing fourth. 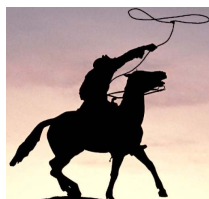

AFLEET EXPRESS FINE AFTER TRAVERS WIN

Afleet Express (Afleet Alex) exited his narrow victory in Saturday's GI Travers S. in fine shape, but connections have not yet discussed the colt's next start. Trainer Jimmy Jerkens admitted yesterday that the race may have taken more out of him than it did out of Afleet Express. "I was knocked out," Jerkens said. "I slept pretty good. I was hoping I wouldn't wake up and learn it was all a dream. It was a big thrill for all of us, the whole crew. That's why we work seven days a week, 365 days a year, so that once in a while, something like that will happen." Travers runner-up **Fly Down** (Mineshaft) was also doing well Sunday, although trainer Nick Zito couldn't help thinking of what might have been after watching his charge barely miss the win. "It's frustrating, but we've got to be grateful to be in these races, that's for sure," Zito said. "Fly Down obviously ran a winning race. A nose here or there, that's all. I watched the replay in the grandstand with a lot of fans, and that replay shows he won. In the clubhouse, it looked like it could have gone either way, but it didn't look as good as it did in the grandstand." Zito also reported that **Miner's Reserve** (Mineshaft), seventh after setting the pace in the Travers, came out of the race with a bruised right front foot. "He walked back fine, and maybe a half-hour after, he started favoring it," Zito said. "Hopefully, he's going to be all right, but it looks like he has a severe bruised foot." Zito's other Travers runner, **Ice Box** (Pulpit) finished eighth. "Ice Box came back good," Zito said of the GI Kentucky Derby runner-up. "I don't know what it is. We scoped him and didn't find any displacement or anything. I don't know what it is, to be honest with you."

Travers Numbers Up

Figures for Saturday's Travers card at Saratoga showed an increase from the Midsummer Derby's 2009 running. A crowd of 45,764 turned out to see Afleet Express (Afleet Alex)'s dramatic victory in the Grade I event, up 33.7 percent from last year's attendance of 34,221. On-track handle for Saratoga's races was \$8,218,975, an increase of 19.9 percent over the 2009 figure of \$6,853,155. Total all-sources handle was \$33,890,996--up 11.3 percent from last year's \$30,449,575.

Pletcher Patter

GI King's Bishop S. winner **Discreetly Mine** (Mineshaft) came out of his front-running victory Saturday in good order and will now likely train up to the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint. "He came out of it very well," trainer Todd Pletcher confirmed. "We felt kind of handcuffed in the way we were going to approach the race, based on the way the track seemed to be playing, so it was a pretty courageous effort to go as fast as he did and keep going." ... Pletcher said tests were on order for GI Kentucky Derby winner **Super Saver** (Maria's Mon) after his disappointing 10th-place effort in the GI Travers S. "We're going to do some diagnostics, either here or at a clinic," Pletcher commented. "Obviously that was not up to standards. Maybe there is something going on that we can't see. He seems OK this morning, nothing dramatically wrong, but maybe there is something underneath that we are not seeing." ... Pletcher is excited about the prospects for two-year-old **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie), who debuted with an impressive 14 1/4-length victory at Saratoga Saturday. "He had trained really, really well all summer and we were encouraged by some of his workmates running well, and we expected him to run well, but that was even more than we anticipated or hoped for." Uncle Mo will likely make his next start in the Oct. 9 GI Champagne S. at Belmont.

The Fasig-Tipton Texas Summer Yearlings sale gets underway today at 10 a.m. at Lone Star Park. A total of 363 youngsters have been catalogued for the one-session auction. "Although our home base is Texas, this sale has become the dominant market in the southwest for several regional breeding and racing programs," said local director of sales Tim Boyce. "This year's catalogue includes 101 Texas-breds, 159 Louisiana-breds and 33 Oklahoma-breds. Our sire power is impressive, too, with many high-profile proven stallions such as Candy Ride (Arg), Cuvee, Forest Wildcat, Holy Bull, Mineshaft, Stormy Atlantic, Tale of the Cat and Tiznow." During last year's sale, 185 horses sold for \$1,889,400. The average was \$10,213 and the median was \$5,000. There were 134 yearlings reported not sold. Top price was the \$87,000 which Midwest Thoroughbreds paid for a son of Purge.

AFTER LATER (Orientate)

Shortly following Monmouth's Sunday feature race, the GII Molly Pitcher S., Walmac Farm's Robert Trussell could be forgiven if he was feeling a little down. His four-year-old filly Queen Martha (Rahy) could finish no better than fourth in the short five-horse race, which was won by Just Jenda (Menifee). But as is often the case in horse racing, hopespringseternal, and in Trussell's case, it was due to a homebred juvenile filly named **After Later** (Orientate), who won the first race on the card. Sent off the even-money choice to take her debut, the chestnut never let the early pacesetters out of her sight, took over with little trouble turning for home and waltzed under the wire an impressive 7 1/4-length winner. Although her final time of 1:05.67 was not blinding, it was exactly the type of performance one wants to see from their juveniles at this time of year. **Cont. p3**

Trussell, who certainly is no stranger to the sport, was surrounded by some of racing's great equine luminaries, while receiving some of his earliest education from Hall of Fame trainers John Nerud and Woody Stephens. He tried his own hand at training for a time, and in September 2004, Trussell, also president of Tempur-Pedic International, purchased historic Walmac with John T. L. Jones III.

Trussell, who admitted he didn't have much prior luck in the breeding game, appears to have drawn aces with After Later.

"We had this filly in the September sale last year and she basically didn't get a bid," recalled Trussell. "So I sent her to [trainer] Patrick [Biancone], and he said they would be able to tell me by Christmas if she's any good. He called me in the middle of December and told me she had some potential. I had her entered in the [Keeneland] January sale by that time, so I decided to scratch her and send her to Florida instead. Now she is one of Patrick's best two-year-olds."

Trussell, who also worked for a time at Gainesway Farm and helped syndicate and market a host of that stud's top stallions, including Lyphard, Riverman and *Vaguely Noble, explained the decision to send his mare Time for Jazz to one of Gainesway's resident stallions.

"I really liked Orientate," Trussell said of the champion sprinter. "We measure the mares and fit them to the appropriate sire. We like to breed like to like. We thought the mare would fit from a conformation standpoint, and I think they fit from a pedigree angle as well. I think Orientate, like his sire Mt. Livermore, is a very versatile sire. It seemed like a good fit."

While Trussell, who currently owns a small group of 12 broodmares, gets to cash in as the owner of the filly, he also is very invested in the After Later's female family. At the 2006 Keeneland November Sale, Trussell purchased the fillies' dam Time for Jazz (Kentucky)--who was in foal to Elusive Quality--for \$275,000. The resulting foal, who is now a three-year-old, was named Aunt Bee.

"She had been put in training this year and she was training really well, but she got hurt, so we'll have to see if we are going to bring her back," he explained. "Before that, the mare also produced Elusive Jazz [Elusive Quality], who won the GIII Phoenix BC S. at Keeneland. So the mare definitely gets runners."

A yearling colt by the 16-year-old mare is catalogued in this year's Keeneland September Sale, and she has a weanling foal by Candy Ride (Arg).

"She is barren this year, but I might try to breed her back to Candy Ride, because I really love her foal," confirmed Trussell.

Trussell, who currently has 10 horses in training in the United States, has an additional 10 in Upper Lamborn, England, with trainer Michael Magnus.

"[Magnus] was my partner in the mattress business and now he is my partner in the horse business," explained Trussell. "We own the horses 50-50."

According to Trussell, his European division includes Bridge of Gold (Giant's Causeway), who is being pointed toward the GI Canadian International in October and juvenile filly named Secret Love (Ire) (Dalakhani {Ire}). The highly regarded two-year-old ran second, beaten only 1 1/4 lengths, in her career debut at Kempton Aug. 13.

With a little bit of luck, and a lot of time and dedication, things appear to be moving in the right direction for the operation and connections are understandably high on the current American team, led by After Later.

"She is a very good filly, we like her very much," Biancone said. "She won very easily, but we'll have to see how she comes out of it before we make a final decision as to where she will go next. Maybe we'll send her to the GI Frizette S. [at Belmont] in six weeks, which would be perfect."

Biancone, who decided to bring his first string to Monmouth this summer, has been enjoying a profitable meet on the Jersey Shore, to be sure, but why didn't the Frenchman--bolstered with confidence in his filly prior to the race--send his up-and-coming star to hallowed ground of the Spa?

"75,000 reasons," he laughed. "We love the sport, but money is also an important part of our sport, so my clients were very happy to participate at this big meet. The company was a little tougher this year, and maybe we had a few too many seconds, but we did well. Because of the bigger purses, we made more money here, with the same winners, than we would have made somewhere else. It's as simple as that."
