KANTHAROS RETIRED

Multiple graded stakes winning juvenile **Kantharos** (Lion Heart--Contessa Halo, by Southern Halo) suffered a career-ending fracture while galloping out after a

workout Monday at Saratoga and has been retired. "This was a tragic and unforeseeable event," said trainer Steve Asmussen. "The brilliance that he had shown was a foretaste of his limitless potential. Right now, we are following his progress closely." Kantharos was tabbed a **"TDN Rising Star"** after an 11 3/4-length debut romp at Churchill Downs May 13. He followed that effort with a 9 1/2-length

victory in the July 3 GIII Bashford Manor S., and concluded his career with a 7 1/4-length triumph in the Aug. 16 GII Saratoga Special. "This horse is a magnificent athlete," said owner Jess Jackson. "We are stunned, shocked and terribly saddened by this awful event. At the same time, we are hoping that this injury will heal completely. At this point, his prognosis for a healthy recovery is good, but in any case, his racing career is over." Kantharos retires with three wins from three starts and earnings of \$185,213.

CASH FLOW

It's difficult to know what to expect with the new format for the first week of Keeneland September, the world's largest yearling supermarket. In most respects, it hasn't changed too much from the way the old four-day 'first week' (Books 1-2) was working out in practice: filling the first two days with true 'Book 1' horses became increasingly difficult, so that essentially, half of Book 1 had really become 'Book 2' pedigrees anyway. In that regard, the new configuration probably reflects existing reality better than the old format. Just to remind ourselves, Keeneland September kicks off with a very slimmed-down, two-night Book 1 Sunday and Monday, Sept. 12-13, followed by 1,302 yearlings catalogued over the next four days, Tuesday-Friday. Saturday, Sept. 18 will be the dark day.

What makes it actually a little confusing is that the 1,513 yearlings catalogued over the now six sessions of Books 1 and 2 are about 200 more than the 1,308 in Books 1-2 in the peak year by number, 2007, and exactly 301 more than the 1,212 catalogued last year. In other words, fully 25 percent more yearlings are catalogued in Book 1-2 this year than last. **Cont. p4**

Emerald Commander closed out his juvenile campaign with a runner-up finish in last term's G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud and opened this semester with a third in the June 13 G3 Prix Paul de Moussac at Chantilly. Having bagged the G3 Prix Daphnis at Longchamp next time July 3, he slipped to seventh in the July 25 G2 Prix Eugene Adam at Maisons-Laffitte, but bounced back to secure a career-high win in comfortable fashion here. Racing under a tight hold in fourth after the initial exchanges, he made smooth progress on the wide outside to lead into the straight and was coaxed clear in the latter stages to easily impose superiority. "Emerald Commander has really come to himself; he loves this soft ground, and we will look for a Group 1 race for him now," trainer Saeed bin Suroor told *Racing Post*. Jockey Frankie Dettori added, "I think he's up to Group 1 standard, providing the ground is soft. I'd like to thank the crowd and, folks, I'll be back on Sunday for the [G1] Grosser Preis [von Baden]. See you then." Emerald Commander was produced by a winning daughter of Group 3 winner Kanmary, also the dam of champion sprinter Lit de Justice (El Gran Senor), Group 1 winner Commander Collins (Ire) and two other black-type winners. G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot. Rested since his success in the G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood July 28, he is being prepared for the Sept. 25 mile contest. "He's in great form," Richard Hannon Jr. said yesterday. "I really do think he is getting

better. There are talks with Coolmore and, hopefully, it will all go through, but the plan is for the horse to stay with us. Sold or not sold, he's staying in training next year, and he should go from strength to strength. He's a very hard horse to beat, and he's exceptional." He also revealed that the G1 Prix Jean Prat winner **Dick Turpin (Ire)** (Arakan) was being rested for an autumn campaign. "He's just having a little break at the moment, and we'll aim for some nice races at the back-end of the year," Hannon added. "The plan is to keep him in training, and he'll be a hell of a horse next year." Of the G2 Coventry S. scorer **Strong Suit** (Rahy), who was a beaten favorite when third in the G1 Phoenix S. at The Curragh Aug. 8, Hannon said, "He wasn't at his best the other day, and it didn't appear to take too much out of him, so the easiest thing is to try and win a Group 2 under a penalty. He's a very good horse, and we'll get him back to winning ways."

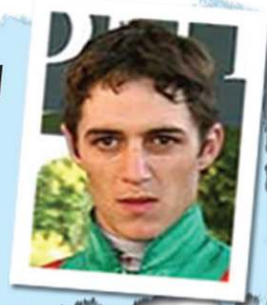

But, of course, in trying to predict what might happen, we have to account for the fact that Book 1 has essentially shrunk by half, while Book 2 has expanded by 64 percent!

So, yes, we've twirled the crystal ball, and, cloudy though it is, what can we divine? Here are a couple of predictions.

Assume half the horses as in Book 1 last year average the same as Book 1 did in 2009 (about \$264,000).

Then assume 64 percent more horses than last year average the same as last year's Book 2 (about \$122,000). Add it all up and multiply by 60 percent, assuming 60 percent of those catalogued

will sell (possibly an optimistic assumption, since only 53 percent of those catalogued in Book 1 sold last year). It could all add up to about 900 yearlings selling for around \$129-million in this year's first week. Should it pan out that way, we would see about a 10-percent gain in the gross, but with 200 more yearlings selling, the projected first-week average of \$142,273 would be about a 15-percent drop compared to the 703 yearlings which averaged \$167,368 in last year's four-day Books 1-2.

It may be brave to assume Book 1-2 yearlings will average the same as last year, though it is worth noting that the first-week gross last year dropped by 43 percent compared with 2008, and, with 16 percent fewer actually listed as sales in 2009, the Book 1-2 average dropped by a third from 2008. The way it reads is, though the global financial meltdown began in September 2008 and lasted for exactly 12 months, almost to the day, the big impact on the September sale was in 2009, not in 2008. There was a 15-percent drop in the gross in September Books 1-2 from 2007 to 2008, but a further 43-percent drop from 2008 to 2009. Hopefully what that means for the new-look first-week September 2010 is that the worst is over. There is also the question of Maktoum buying involvement: John Ferguson, Shadwell, and Rabbah, signed for right around \$20-million of yearlings last year, exactly a sixth of the Book 1-2 gross. But there are indications that other buyers are willing to step in, maybe not to the extent the Maktoums have supported the market for the last thirty years, but certainly enough so that substantial trade is taking place at perfectly acceptable price level--at Deauville there were plenty of horses selling for €200,000--€300,000 and up.

That leads me to the second prediction, which isn't controversial or, unfortunately, open to much debate: at the September sale, as at all the sales this year, it's not about showing a profit on your investment, it's about generating cash flow. Everyone knows by now that this year's crop of yearlings was produced from record 2008 stud fees, though, on the whole, they are only worth half as much as they would have been in 2008. It's a bitter blow at best, and it's driven a lot of people out of the business for financial reasons, and sometimes with grim financial consequences. For the survivors, trading has resumed at a much lower level--half of what it was three years ago--but there is still trade taking place and, as Arqana showed at Deauville, even in the teeth of their steep overall declines, really good yearlings are still selling for pretty decent money.

There are 121 sires with yearlings catalogued in September Books 1-2, but what is really significant is that the 34 stallions with 20 or more catalogued, combined, sired no fewer than 1,162 of those 1,513 catalogued in the first week. That's an average of 34 yearlings for each of those 34 sires, and a whopping 77 percent of the catalogue. I found it quite surprising that, of over 1,500 of the top yearlings in North America, 77 percent of them are by just 34 stallions. Here's the other sobering statistic: the combined retail stud fees for those 1,162 yearlings is \$91 million--over \$78,000 per yearling. That's not even adding in the stud fees for the 23 percent of the yearlings that are by the other 87 stallions--and compares to an estimated \$130 million in revenues that could be generated by the 900 yearlings that actually might sell in the sale's first week. The estimates are hazy enough, but the reality is that, after the \$91 million in stud fees are paid, there isn't going to be much profit left over. So, as much as possible, after the banks and liens are paid off, anything that remains will be very welcome cash flow. And if there isn't a bank or a stallion manager waiting in line for the proceeds, even better. At least 2011 stud fees will be even lower, though I was also surprised to find the combined stud fees on the 34 sires were actually down by just 21 percent between 2008 and 2010. It could be that stud fees have further to fall.

Sixteen stallions have 35 or more catalogued--combined, they have 708 yearlings in Books 1-2, which is almost 47 percent of the total. You won't be surprised to hear that Coolmore's Giant's Causeway is the overall Book 1-2 leader in yearlings catalogued, with 59. Second is Gainesway's Mr. Greeley, with 57. Other established sires with 35 or more catalogued include (alphabetically): Darley's Elusive Quality (44); Juddmonte's Empire Maker (43); Airdrie's Indian Charlie (39); Lane's End's Lemon Drop Kid (40); Spendthrift's new 2010 sire sensation Malibu Moon (48); Darley's Medaglia d'Oro (35); Lane's End's two-time leading sire, Smart Strike (36); Ashford's Tale of the Cat (42); WinStar's Tiznow (46); and Taylor Made's Unbridled's Song (46). **Cont. p4**

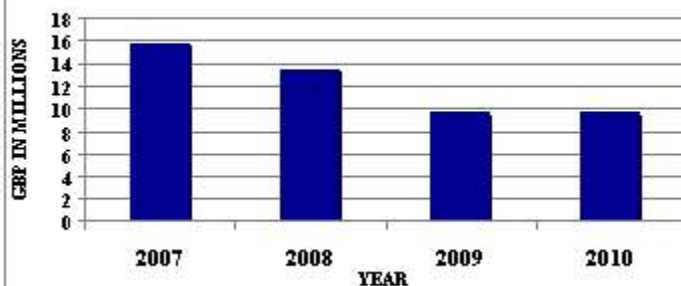
Weekly Sales Ticker

"Finally, a week with two good sales at the same time. Doncaster's Premier sale held its own, with minute movements in gross and average, but with no Maktoum involvement whatsoever; and the OBS August Yearling sale was up 20 percent on gross and 29 percent on average in spite of a another drop in the number catalogued (still 900) and sold. OBS also had a huge jump in percentage sold from those catalogued, from 58 percent to 69 percent. These are both genuinely positive upticks, albeit in the middle- and working-class ranges of the market."

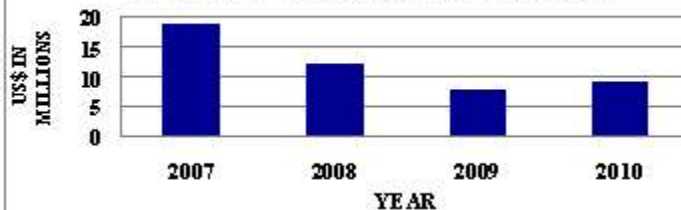
DONCASTER ST LEGER SALE

First-year sires in this group include Darley's Hard Spun (48) and Street Sense (43); and Gainesway's Corinthian (44). Darley's Bernardini (38) is the only sire with first two-year-olds among those 16.

An astute bloodstock veteran asked me the other day if conditions aren't different now than they were 20 years ago, when, as he put it, nobody wanted horses at any price. That was pretty much the case, and why the Maktoums and the Japanese were able to buy so much of America's top bloodstock then--Sunday Silence being just one example. In a way, yes, it is different today. There will be tremendous competition for the yearlings that clear the bar. Yes, the bar is high, but it isn't as if there is zero demand. It's much lower than it would be if the industry is able not just to rebuild, but to build a better model, but there is demand. It will definitely be a buyers' market, but, cut in half though it has been in the last three years, it still won't be that easy to buy the ones you want!

LOMITAS EUTHANIZED Gestut Fahrhof's resident and flagbearer **Lomitas (GB)** (Niniski--La Colorada {Ger}), by Surumu {Ger}) was euthanized following complications during colic surgery on Monday night. The 22-year-old, who spent five seasons at Darley's Dalham Hall Stud this decade, had returned to his breeder's operation in 2007, but had been restricted by declining fertility. A close relative of the Deutsches Derby winners and fellow sires Lagunas (GB) and Lavirco (Ger), Lomitas was a leading juvenile before progressing to win three times at the highest level and run a close second in the renewal of the 1991 German Derby. He was rated the third-best European three-year-old colt of his year behind Generous (Ire) and Suave Dancer despite his well-documented issues with the starting gate which led Monty Roberts to become involved with his training. His successes in the G1 Grosser Preis der Berliner Bank, G1 Grosser Preis von Baden and G1 Europa-Preis of that year preceded a spell in California, but it was at stud that he excelled again, with 15 individual group winners to date, including the Champion and prolific sire Silvano (Ger), the 1999 Deutsches Derby hero Belenus (Ger), and 2009 G1 Prix de l'Opera heroine Shalanaya (Ire), as well as the Classic-winning German Champion Sumitas (Ger). He was also in the process of making a name for himself as a damsire, with his leading performers including the Classic-winning champion miler Santiago (Ger) (Highest Honor {Fr}), the 2008 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe third It's Gino (Ger) (Perugino), and this year's leading German three-year-old colt Zazou (Ger) (Shamardal).
