Elle Shadow closed out a two-race juvenile program with a second in October's G3 Preis der Winterkonigin at this track and opened her sophomore campaign with victory in the Listed Grosser Preis der Sparkasse Mulheim May 2. Third in the G2 Diana-Trial at Hoppegarten May 23, she improved one spot in the G3 Jungheinrich Gabelstapler at Hamburg July 11, and also ran second in the G1 Preis der Diana at Dusseldorf last time Aug. 1. Positioned in fourth until inching into third at halfway, she was coaxed to the front off the home bend and kept on well under final-furlong urging to comfortably hold the vain bid of Empire Storm. "I settled behind the leaders and was able to bide my time," explained rider Andrasch Starke. "I took her to the outside and she responded very well to my asking. This victory is even more special for me because I also rode her dam Elle Danzig to many great victories." 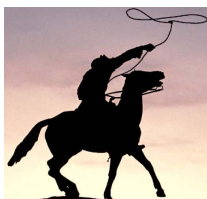

RACETRACK Round-Up

Paco Goes to Longchamp...

Richard Hannon yesterday ended speculation as to the weekend target of **Paco Boy (Ire)** (Desert Style {Ire}) when committing the five-year-old to Sunday's G1 Prix du Moulin. Despite earlier suggestion that the Highclere Stud-bound triple Group 1 winner would tackle the six-furlong G1 Haydock Sprint Cup, it has been decided to stick at a mile for the Longchamp contest. "We have weighed up the options and, while we don't have to declare until tomorrow, it now looks almost certain that we are going to give the Sprint Cup a miss and wait for the Prix du Moulin at Longchamp," his trainer commented. "I have always favoured France, but I have spoken to part-owner Derek Lucy-Smith, and he agrees the Moulin is probably the right race for him. My worry about Haydock is that it could develop into a messy race, as there will be a big field and they will most certainly split into two groups, so if you are drawn in the wrong place you could be in trouble. They will also go off very fast and, while Richard Hughes makes the point that Paco Boy was quick enough to finish best of all in the July Cup at Newmarket last year, Equiano and Starspangledbanner are likely to go five-furlong pace at Haydock, and we won't be able to ride a race on our fellow."

Workforce Eases Back...

★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ **Workforce (GB)** (King's Best) has returned to work as connections eye options before the end of the season. Following an easy spin on Newmarket's gallops yesterday, Khalid Abdullah's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe issued an encouraging bulletin about the Derby hero who has to bounce back from a disappointing effort when fifth in Ascot's King George. "There is nothing really planned at the moment, but he did some gentle piece of work this morning and it was nothing searching," Grimthorpe explained. "He was moving nicely and stretching out well over the ground. We wanted him to show us that he was back in good form and we're trying to be fair to the horse, but he looks like he's coming back into decent shape. There is certainly a reasonable chance he'll run again this season, but we'll have to see how he is. Obviously, the Arc is an eminently suitable race for him, and if he were to go there, he would probably have a racecourse gallop beforehand."

Letters TO THE EDITOR

I read with interest Mark Johnston's statements regarding the surgeries performed on American-bred sales yearlings as a sign of unsoundness in the horses we breed here (Andrew Caulfield, *TDN*, August 31, 2010). I think these surgeries have to be analyzed in their two separate cases--by those that are caused by trauma, and by those that may be a result of something else, or, as Dr. Johnston references, an unsoundness in our horses. Hard ground from dry or frozen conditions can cause many of these incidental traumatic injuries to foals and yearlings. The individual never goes lame and the defect isn't identified until X-rays are taken. As many vets will tell you, these surgeries are cosmetic surgeries performed to make the X-rays that are required to be submitted in the repository look better. In many cases, they are not performed because the horse's health or future suitability for athletic performance requires them to be done.

Pre-repository, these surgeries never were performed because we never knew the problem existed since the horse shows no visible change to its joints or lameness. While that certainly may be a time and era to which breeders would love to return, we realize it is gone forever. I believe to say that the number of surgeries performed reflect an unsoundness in our horses is not an accurate assessment of the situation.

Fancy Point, a troubled fourth in her six-furlong dirt debut at Saratoga Aug. 1, was bet down strongly from her 12-1 morning-line odds to go off as third-choice. On the engine through fractions of :23.67 and :48.29, Fancy Point cornered nicely and opened a clear lead in the stretch and had enough left in the tank to hold the rallying Kathmanblu safe. "She looked like she was on her toes today," jockey Javier Castellano said. "As soon as they opened the gate, she broke like a shot. Boom! I tried to settle her a little bit and I was wishing somebody else could go on the lead just to keep track, but she just galloped along. At the eighth pole, turning for home, it looked like some horses on the outside were going to go by. But, when I asked her a little bit, she gave it to me and took off again." SHORTER SESSION EQUALS BILL LOGJAM

When Congress returns from summer recess on September 13, lawmakers will have only about 20 days remaining in the regular legislative session. Congress is slated to re-adjourn on October 8, when both chambers will take a month off to campaign in advance of the November 2 general election. Some pundits suggest that the session will end even sooner.

A shortened schedule impacts the amount of legislation acted upon by Congress. More than 370 bills passed by the House await action by the Senate when it returns - a 28 percent increase over the number of bills that awaited Senate action in February. The logjam is likely to result in numerous bills being shelved until the post-election Lame Duck session that starts in November or until the next Congress.

Primary elections continue through September. Seven states - and the District of Columbia - will hold theirs on September 14th. Included in this list are Delaware, New York, Maryland and Massachusetts.

NYCOTB Cans Early-Retirement Plan:

Officials at the New York City Off-Track Betting Corporation have canceled an offer to permit its unionized employees to take part in a state-sponsored early-retirement program after an agreement could not be reached with the union prior to a Tuesday cutoff, *Daily Racing Form* reports. The idea of early-retirement was part of a reorganization plan under which the state's racetracks, the OTB's biggest creditors, would have taken over the account-wagering business from the corporation in exchange for the dismissal of \$65 million in debt. Under the plan, unionized workers would have been subjected to cuts in double-time pay for Sundays as well as the loss of 400 jobs, according to *DRF*. An alternative plan would see NYCOTB invalidate all of its collective bargaining agreements in an effort to restructure labor costs. Under that plan, OTB would retain its account-wagering business.

Hawthorne Cuts Stakes Purses, Live Dates:

Hawthorne Race Course in suburban Chicago has received permission from the Illinois Racing Board to slash the purses in many of its stakes events and reduce its live race week to four days from five. The Grade II Hawthorne Gold Cup, for many years a half-million dollar event, will go this year with a purse of just \$250,000, while the Grade III Hawthorne Derby will be reduced from \$250,000 to \$150,000. The Robert Carey H. will go from \$150,000 to \$100,000. Eliminated from the schedule for 2010 is the \$100,000 Indian Maid S. Racing will be conducted this fall on a Wednesday-Saturday schedule, as Sundays have been cut. Additionally, overnight purses will be about 10 percent lower than they were at the beginning of the 2009 meet and will average \$125,000, excluding stakes.

California Takeout Bill Passes:

The California state legislature has approved a bill which will increase the takeout on exotic wagers on California races in order to fund an hike in overnight purses, according to published reports. The legislation, which has been sent to Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger, will take effect Dec. 26, pending his approval. Late Tuesday, the state Senate approved a two-percent raise in the takeout on two-horse exotic bets from 20.68 percent to 22.68 percent, while the takeout on wagers involving three or more horses was hiked by three percent to 23.68 percent. Flat-bet takeout remains steady at 15.43 percent. The legislation mandates that revenue from the higher takeout be funneled to overnight purses and also includes a provision which would legalize exchange betting in 2012.

Tuscan Evening Death Result of a Hemorrhage:

The sudden death of Will de Burgh's top West Coast turf mare **Tuscan Evening (Ire)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) was caused by an acute pulmonary hemorrhage, Dr. Rick Arthur, equine medical director of the California Horse Racing Board told *Daily Racing Form*. Arthur stated that the diagnosis is a rare one. "We get a few each year, as many in training and racing," he said. "This does happen." Prepping for the GI Beverly D. S., Tuscan Evening was galloping out following a six-furlong workout when she collapsed on the track.

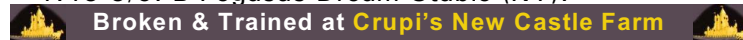
