## MIDSHIPMAN RETIRED

**Midshipman** (Unbridled's Song--Fleet Lady, by Avenue of Flags), the champion two-year-old of 2008 after taking the GI Del Mar Futurity and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, has been retired and will stand at Darley in America in 2011. "Midshipman defeated the best of his generation while proving himself on both dirt and synthetic surfaces," said Oliver Tait, Darley's chief operating officer. "We couldn't be more excited to have a champion two-year-old with his kind of looks and pedigree joining our roster in 2011." Bred by Stonerside Stable, Midshipman broke his maiden at first asking at Del Mar and came back to take the GI Del Mar Futurity by a nose. A three-quarter length runner-up to Street Hero (Street Cry {Ire}) in the GI Norfolk S., he was acquired by Darley when they bought the Stonerside assets in the fall of 2008, and carried the maroon and white silks to victory in the Breeders' Cup. The chestnut captured an optional claimer at Belmont Park and was a close-up third in the GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile during an abbreviated sophomore season, and closed out his career with a Meydan conditions win this February. He retires with a record of 8-5-1-1 and earnings of \$1,584,600. "We look forward to showing Midshipman and fellow new recruit for 2011, Desert Party (Street Cry {Ire}), to breeders during Keeneland September and in the months to come," Tait added. A stud fee for Midshipman has not yet been announced.

## GUSTO HEADS DEL MAR'S CLOSING DAY

**J P's Gusto** (Successful Appeal) will try and collect his fourth straight victory in today's feature event on Del Mar's closing card, the GI Del Mar Futurity. Sixth in his career bow at Hollywood May 9, the bay--who is campaigned by Dr. John Waken--won his next two starts at the Inglewood oval, including the six-furlong GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship July 5. Most recently, the David Hofmans-trained colt marked his debut at Del Mar with a front-running victory in the GII Best Pal S. Aug. 8., and will try to extend his speed an extra sixteenth of a mile this time. "He found himself on the lead by default, because of the lack of speed in the race," said Hofmans regarding the colt's Best Pal score. "He'll be able to lay off the lead this time and track the leaders, and then make his run." Iggy Puglisi, who accompanies the juvenile in the morning, added, "He shows in his works that he'll be able to stay off the pace and be comfortable. I think he can sit maybe fourth and still make the same winning move he has made before." Among those likely to inherit the lead are **McKinzie's Way** (Wildcat Heir) and maiden **Riveting Reason** (Fusaichi Pegasus). Both colts have been supplemented to the seven-furlong event for \$10,000.

**Road Ready** kicked off his career the right way, scoring by 3/4 of a length in the Lost in the Fog S. at Golden Gate Fields June 12. An April foal, the juvenile was purchased by a partnership consisting of Jim Vreeland, Murray Smith and trainer Jeff Bonde for \$300,000 at the Barretts March sale. "He was the best-looking and had the best preview of any of the horses at the sale," recalled Bonde. "It wasn't just about speed. It was about the way he moved." In regard to the colt's progress since the sale, Bonde added, "In his first race, he overcame trouble and won against older horses in [the Lost in the Fog] and he's been training well here. He's 100 percent good right now and ready to go. I wouldn't trade places with anybody."

Since 2005, three Futurity winners, including the last two, have gone on to win the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. Stevie Wonderboy (Stephen Got Even) won the 2005 BC Juvenile en route to a juvenile championship, as did Midshipman (Unbridled's Song) in 2008 and Lookin at Lucky (Smart Strike) again in 2009.

Ground conditions for Saturday's G1 Boylesports.com Vincent O'Brien National S. look set to be on the testing side after significant rain fell on The Curragh yesterday. Officially, the going was described as yielding on the round course and good-to-yielding in the home stretch, with more rain due in Kildare. "We've had a mixed day, with sun, wind and some showers," Course Manager Paul Hensey told *Racing Post*. "That is pretty much how it is forecast for the rest of the week, too. There will be good drying spells, but showers probably every day, too."

"It is difficult to predict what the ground will be like. It might be something similar to how it is now." Ballydoyle's running plans could depend on the likely surface, with **Zoffany (Ire)** (Dansili {GB}) already proven on yielding going when capturing the G3 Tyros S. at Leopardstown July 22 and G1 Phoenix S. at The Curragh Aug. 8. Whether Johnny Murtagh will resume his partnership with Michael Tabor's colorbearer depends on plans at Doncaster, as the St Leger clashes with this card. Four of the other entries from Ballydoyle--the Phoenix S. fourth **Emperor Hadrian (Ire)** (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}), G2 Futurity S. fourth **High Ruler** (Mr. Greeley), G3 Acomb S. fourth **Lake Ontario** (Johannesburg) and the G2 Railway S. runner-up **Samuel Morse (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire})--are also engaged in that track's G2 Champagne S. The potential Aidan O'Brien's sextet is completed by Susan Magnier's impressive June 26 course-and-distance maiden winner **Roderic O'Connor (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and Derrick Smith's **Rudolf Valentino (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}), who was a latest fifth behind **Pathfork** (Distorted Humor) in the Futurity here Aug. 21.

MID also announced that it will pay all reasonable shipping costs for any west coast-based three-year-old filly eligible for the Black-Eyed Susan 2.2 to compete in the GP Oaks and/or the Black-Eyed Susan.

*A filly must win the Apr. 2 GII Gulfstream Park Oaks in addition to a designated race(s) from participating tracks:*

**GULFSTREAM PARK** - GII Forward Gal S. Jan. 29 *plus* the GII Davona Dale S. Feb. 26.

**SANTA ANITA PARK** - Feb. 5 GI Las Virgenes S. *plus* the GI Santa Anita Oaks Mar. 5.

**GOLDEN GATE FIELDS** - Jan. 1 California Oaks *plus* the GI Santa Anita Oaks (at Santa Anita) Mar. 5.

**PORTLAND MEADOWS** - Jan. 29 Portland Meadows Oaks *plus* the GI Santa Anita Oaks (at Santa Anita) Mar. 5.

In addition to the Black-Eyed Susan 2.2, there will be an AmTote Jockey Bonus worth \$50,000 awarded to the rider who wins one of the aforementioned qualifying races--and compete in at least one other qualifying race--before taking the GII Black-Eyed Susan S.

**Avid Sore After Debutante; to Have Nuclear Scan**

**Avid** (More Than Ready) will undergo a nuclear scintigraphy scan after showing signs of soreness following an eighth-place finish in Saturday's GI Darley Debutante S., reports the *Daily Racing Form*. "She had muscle spasms and cramps," trainer Richard Mandella told *DRF*. "She was in a lot of pain cooling out for about 45 minutes after the race. She's ok [Tuesday], but we're going to have the nuclear scan done, just to make sure there's nothing else going on." Campained by Ramona Bass, the \$525,000 OBSMAR juvenile won her career debut going six furlongs at Del Mar Aug. 1.

**Lost Soldier Dead at 20**

**Lost Soldier** (Danzig--Lady Winborne, by Secretariat) died of an apparent heart attack in his paddock at Buck Pond Farm Tuesday morning, according to a farm release. Lost Soldier, who was 20 at the time of his death, will be buried at Buck Pond Farm. "It looks like he went down for a nap and simply didn't get back up," said Doug Arnold, owner of Buck Pond Farm and Lost Soldier. "He didn't have a mark on him, there were no signs of any struggle. He went peacefully." Bred by Winborne Farm in Kentucky, Lost Soldier raced for five years for Sheikh Mohammed, who purchased him as a weanling at the 1990 Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale for \$500,000. **Cont. p6**

**Lost Soldier Dead cont.**

Lost Soldier, who made 45 starts from ages two to seven, campaigned in England, Dubai and North America. He won 11 times, was second on seven occasions and was third five times before retiring with earnings of \$434,089. His biggest win came in the GIII Louisiana Downs H. and in the Maxxam Gold Cup, where he set a new track record for the nine furlongs. After his racing career, Lost Soldier was purchased privately by John Franks to stand at his Franks Farms in Ocala, Florida. Following Franks' death in 2004, the stallion was purchased by Arnold and moved to Kentucky for the 2005 breeding season. His most notable runner was the ill-fated Lost in the Fog, who won the Eclipse Award as champion sprinter in 2005 after recording his biggest win in the GI King's Bishop S. at Saratoga. To date, Lost Soldier has sired 10 crops of racing age with 17 stakes winners, including Grade III winners Soldier's Dancer, Lush Soldier and Lost at Sea.

**SECOND-WEEK SIRES**

After the first week of the Keeneland September sale ends Friday, Sept. 17, there will still be eight days of selling and around 3,300 yearlings left to sell, beginning Sunday, Sept. 19. As with the first week, though at a lower level, once again the keyword will not be 'profitability' but 'survival.' The lethal combination of high stud fees and low prices--often half of what the same sires and pedigrees were bringing when these yearlings were conceived--means cash flow is just as important for the lower two-thirds as it is for the upper third, which sells next week.

No fewer than 284 individual stallions have yearlings catalogued in Books 3-6, of which 31 sires have 30 or more yearlings catalogued, totaling 1,141 among them, roughly a third of the yearlings catalogued for week two. These days, proven is better, and unproven is suddenly unfashionable, but at the beginning of 2008 the reverse was true, so it's no great surprise that 11 of the 31 sires with 30 or more catalogued are first-crop yearling sires, while another six have their first two-year-olds; so 17 of these 31 sires have no runners, or just two-year-olds.

The overall leader in number of yearlings catalogued in Books 3-6 is Lane's End's After Market (49), by Storm Cat out of \$1.6 million-earner Tranquility Lake. He won six graded races on the grass from nine to 11 furlongs, including wins in the GI Eddie Read H. (9f) and the Charles Whittingham H. (10f). He's a full brother to Grade II winner Courageous Cat, who was also second in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Mile; and he's also a full brother to the \$9.7-million yearling Jalil, who won a Group 2 in the UAE, and the dam is a half-sister to the successful California sire, Benchmark. Moreover, as Tranquility Lake is by Rahy, After Market is bred on the exact cross as Giant's Causeway; between that and his good grass form, he should appeal to any European buyers who still come to town, as well as to Americans who remember him as a top-class competitor.1

Ashford's Grand Slam (Gone West) and Walmac's Songandaprayer (Unbridled's Song) are represented by 48 yearlings each, followed by two younger stallions with 45 each, first-year sire English Channel (Smart Strike), now at Lane's End; and Darley's Henny Hughes (Hennessy), whose first crop are now racing at two. Like After Market, English Channel has a lot of reasons to appeal to Europeans, so consignors will be hoping there are a few of those still around in the second week.

English Channel won six Grade I races on the grass, ranging from nine to 12 furlongs, and earned over \$5.3-million. Ashford's Scat Daddy (Johannesburg), winner of the GI Champagne S. and GI Florida Derby, has 44 yearlings catalogued in the 'back books,' while

Lane's End's Langfuhr (Danzig) and Adena Springs' Macho Uno (Holy Bull) each have 42 catalogued. Darley's first-crop sire Discreet Cat (Forestry), now a half-brother to the GI King's Bishop S. winner Discreetly Mine, rounds out the top 10 by number catalogued in Books 3-6, in tandem with

Juddmonte's Mizzen Mast (Cozzene), each with 38 catalogued.

Other first-crop sires with 30 or more catalogued include: Woods Edge Farm's Latent Heat (Maria's Mon, 37), winner of the seven-furlong GI Malibu S. for Juddmonte; Taylor Made's Master Command (A.P. Indy, 37), who unfortunately died earlier this year; the top handicap horse Lawyer Ron (Langfuhr, 36), who has also died; Gainesway's Corinthian (Pulpit, 35), who, like Discreet Cat, has already been selling well at the earlier sales; Claiborne's Political Force (Unbridled's Song, 33); Pin Oak's Bob and John (Seeking the Gold, 32); and Airdrie's Flashy Bull (Holy Bull, 32). The others with their first two-year-olds include the WinStar duo of Bluegrass Cat (Storm Cat, 34) and Sharp Humor (Distorted Humor, 33); Vinery's Silver Train (Old Trieste, 32); Airdrie's Badge of Silver (Silver Deputy); and Darley's Rockport Harbor (Unbridled's Song, 31). An interesting one with his first three-year-olds--and the only one from that age group with 30+ catalogued--is Adena Springs' North Light (Danehill), winner of the 2004 G1 Epsom Derby. From a female family of extreme stayers, he's been slow to come to hand, as you'd expect, but has come to life lately, and has one of the leading contenders in this Saturday's G1 St Leger S. in Arctic Cosmos.

The salient point has to be that there is a big difference between 'second-week' sires and 'second-rate' sires. There are an awful lot of stallions around with pretty serious credentials, and the fact that 25 yearlings by Tiznow are selling in the second week is a tipoff that there is going to be plenty of good stock, by very credible sires, on offer. It could be a real buyers' market, from the point of view of the selection available at reasonable prices--often below production cost, unfortunately for the breeders.

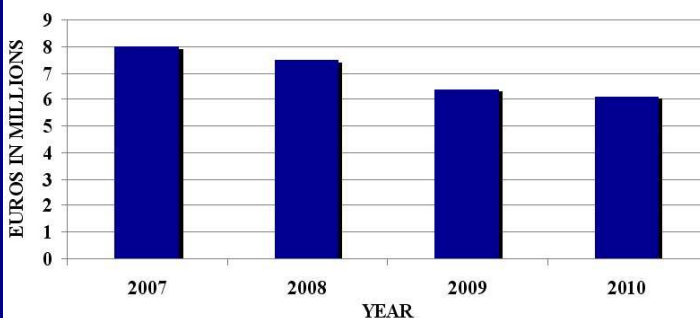

"With 12 percent fewer catalogued and 16 percent fewer sold (slight drop in the clearance rate), the German yearling sale in Baden-Baden very much held its own, with just a five percent drop in gross and a 12 percent gain in average. Meanwhile, Fasig-Tipton's Texas sale saw a nine percent improvement in the clearance rate from the catalogue, a 26 percent increase in gross, and a nine percent increase in average. At least the market isn't heading into Keeneland after a series of declines in the most recent smaller sales."

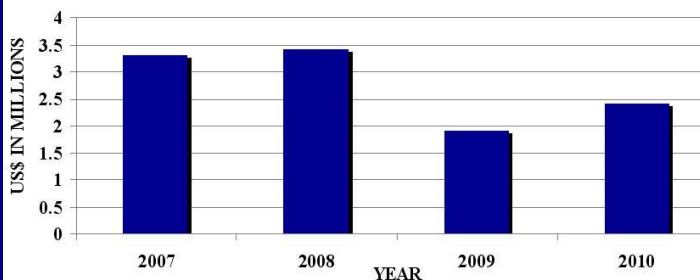
