**Court Vision** (Gulch), who hadn't hit the line first in four prior starts this season, obviously appreciated the cooler climate in Toronto to take Sunday's GI Woodbine Mile. Sent off a healthy 7-1 odds for his fifth try at the highest level this season, the bay assumed his customary place near the back of the pack through opening fractions of :23.55, :46.53 and 1:10.36. Angled out for the stretch

drive, Court Vision was momentarily blocked, but once clear, he stormed up from the outside to hand California shipper **The Usual Q.T.** (Unusual Heat) a 1 1/4-length defeat. **Woodbourne** (Danzig), a 52-1 longshot, was third. *Cont. p2*

**'WOOD' RED HOT IN NORTHERN DANCER**

Sent off at 9-5 for his North American debut, Juddmonte Farm's **Redwood (GB)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) took advantage of a pristine rail trip to record a 1 1/2-length victory over **Fifty Proof** (Whiskey Wisdom) in Sunday's GI Northern Dancer S. at Woodbine. Off a beat slowly, the handsome dark bay was allowed to settled in the second flight as leader Fifty Proof reeled off modest opening splits of :25.24, :51.20 and 1:16.25. Closing the gap on the pacesetter on the far turn, the English-bred drove up the inside to collar his rival in midstretch, and inched clear late to collect his first victory at the highest level. "When I got to the rail, it was lovely," said Michael Hills. "I took the inside run. The English horses like that. It was a perfect passage. I just told him, 'Go do your thing.' **Court Vision Best in GI Woodbine Mile...**

Court Vision, a dual graded stakes winner at two, earned his first career Grade I victory in the 2008 Hollywood Derby. After adding another to his resume in last fall's Shadwell Turf Mile, the dark bay came home a respectable fourth in his seasonal finale in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile in November. The five-year-old launched his 2010 season by running behind Take the Points (Even the Score) in the Feb. 6 GI Gulfstream Park Turf H. over nine furlongs, but was granted the victory after the disqualification of that rival. Runner-up in Keeneland's one-mile GI Maker's Mark S. Apr. 9, he was outgunned late by General Quarters (Sky Mesa) in a soggy edition of the nine-panel GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic at Churchill May 1. After encountering some early trouble in his latest start, Court Vision had to settle for sixth in the June 5 GI Manhattan S. over 10 furlongs at Belmont. "Court Vision is such a cool horse to ride," said Robby Albarado. "I just wanted him to settle in early. I know he's been off awhile, but he was training forwardly at Saratoga this summer. You give him a good trip, he's going to come home and he did." Trainer Rick Dutrow Jr added, "He had been training really good and he comes off a freshening pretty good, so we felt confident that he was going to show up. He really showed up the right way today. We're really excited right now. We thought, if he can take to this course and the one-turn mile, we're going to be in good shape. Robby gave him an unbelievable ride, too." At two, Redwood launched his career with a victory at Newmarket before sitting out the rest of the season. A winner over that course in his 2009 return, the bay tired to ninth when moved up in class for the G2 Dante S. at York. Back on the sidelines after that effort, he was a good second in the 10-furlong G3 Gordon Richard S. at Sandown Apr. 24 before failing to hit the board in two subsequent starts, including the G2 Hardwicke S. at Royal Ascot June 19. However, the four-year-old's fortunes began to change with a runner-up effort in Newmarket's G2 Prince of Wales's S., followed by a score in the G3 Glorious S. July 30. Most recently, the Juddmonte homebred was a close-up second in the G2 Grand Prix de Deauville Aug. 29.

Miss Keller, runner-up in last October's GIII Valley View S. at Keeneland, kicked off the season with a narrow score going a mile against allowance foes at the Lexington oval Apr. 7. Third in a soggy edition of the GII Distaff Turf Mile at Churchill May 1, the Irish-bred was second behind Simply Splendid (Maria's Mon) in Woodbine's June 5 GII Nassau S. Given some time off following that effort, the four-year-old returned with a score in the restricted De La Rose S. at Saratoga Aug. 4 before closing late to be third in her most recent start in the 8 1/2-panel GII Ballston Spa H. Aug. 28. Strike the Bell finished in the money in four of six starts in 2009, but only one of those was in the win column, recorded in the seven-furlong Chaldea S. in September. Seventh in her seasonal bow in the GIII Beaugay S. here May 1, the chestnut appreciated the drop to allowance company to score in an 8 1/2-furlong test at Monmouth May 30. A close-up second behind Maram (Sahm) in the Miss Liberty S. July 4, she came home sixth--beaten 3 1/2 lengths--last time out in the GII Ballston Spa S. Aug. 28. Reserved off the early pace while saving ground, Stike the Bell was asked to pick up the tempo on the backstretch, swung out four wide turning for home, hit the front midstretch and drew clear to post the comfortable score. "I've ridden this filly twice before, so I knew her coming into this race," said winning rider Ramon Dominguez. "I felt pretty confident after the first quarter of a mile. She fell into the bridle nicely, and I could tell we were going to have a good run. When I started to angle out and pass horses, I could feel that I wasn't going to have to go to the whip because she was rolling. I could see on the big screen that they were behind me and trying to pressure me, but I felt like we were home free."

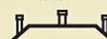

yesterday, Ferrell purchased a filly by Mr. Greeley ([hip 1527](#)) for \$50,000 and a daughter of Lemon Drop Kid ([hip 1589](#)) for \$60,000. "We're building a farm here in Versailles and it will be a full service operation," Ferrell explained. "We'll be in business in the springtime. So we're here to buy some fillies to run and to be broodmares and also some nice colts. At this point we're going to be strictly racing." Ferrell's bloodstock advisor John O'Hara added, "We'll race the fillies to make them into broodmares." Ferrell, senior vice president and chief operating officer of Vista HealthCare in California, has been in racing for only about three years and has already campaigned Well Deserved (Cactus Ridge), winner of last year's Cinderella S. and third in the GIII Sorrento S., Goldsville (Successful Appeal), who won the GIII Excelsior S. in April, and Tidal Dance (Pleasant Tap), winner of a pair of Aqueduct stakes last winter. Expect to see Ferrell in action again soon. "We have a few more on our radar over the next couple of days," he said. "We've been here since day one and it just hadn't come together for us before."

The Lawyer Ron colt will be the first Kisber horse in Brown's barn. Among the horses Kisber has in training with Midwest trainer Ken McPeck is stakes performer Positive Split (Repent). "He is still with Ken McPeck, but he is also looking to have some horses in New York and spread out a little bit," Brown added. Shortly after purchasing the Lawyer Ron colt, Brown was in action again. Sitting alongside longtime client Ron Brown, the New York native bid \$120,000 to secure [hip 1720](#), a filly by Scat Daddy, and \$70,000 for a filly by Thunder Gulch ([hip 1758](#)). "Ron Brown (no relation) is a client I've had horses for for a number of years," Brown said. "We're hoping to upgrade and get him some better horses." Brown, a former assistant to the late Bobby Frankel, admitted bidding has been competitive at the September sale. "The end of book two was tough," he said. "We started looking there. I thought the prices were fair. The Lawyer Ron was a little expensive, but I knew he was popular, but the other two prices were fair."

The cumulative average is \$129,489 and the median is \$80,000. The September sale continues this morning at 10 a.m.

NOBLE THREEWITT DIES AT 99

Trainer Noble Threewitt died Thursday in West Covina, California, according to published reports. He was 99. Threewitt celebrated his 77th wedding anniversary with his wife Beryl, who died July 12 at the age of 98. In lieu of flowers, donations may be made to the California Thoroughbred Horsemen's Foundation. Funeral services will be private. Threewitt, who took out his training license at the age of 21 in 1932, launched his career at Agua Caliente in Tijuana, Mexico. Over the course of his 75-year career, the native of

Benton, Illinois, won three successive training titles at Hollywood Park from 1959-1961 and at Golden Gate Fields in 1970. Arguably his best horse, Correlation won the 1954 GI Florida Derby and GI Wood Memorial S. Also listed among his graded stakes winners are King Cricket, Honeys Gem, Devoted Brass, Hula Baze, Sea Eagle, Hairless Heiress, Old Topper, Debonaire Junior and Theresa's Tizzy. Threewitt, who served six terms as the president of the California Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association and 16 years as a national vice president of the CHBPA, also served as president of the California Thoroughbred Horsemen's Foundation. Threewitt was also a director emeritus of California Thoroughbred Trainers. With over 2000 winners to his account, Threewitt retired on Feb. 24, 2007 at the age of 96.

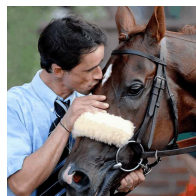
