CLIFFS TO MISSES QEII

Canford Cliffs (Ire) (Tagula {Ire}) has been forced to sidestep tomorrow's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot after a final scope proved unsatisfactory. The G1 Irish 2000 Guineas, G1 St James's Palace S. and G1 Sussex S. winner reportedly impressed in his work Wednesday,

but he will not be asked to confirm his crown as Europe's top miling three-year-old following the setback. "The scope was marginal, but Canford Cliffs is now such a valuable commodity that you cannot take any chances, so, having listened to veterinary advice from Mike O'Gorman, we have no option but to pull out,"

trainer Richard Hannon explained. "Everyone in the yard is absolutely gutted, and we realise that it could well cost us the trainer's championship, but the welfare of the horse comes first, and you need to be 100 percent to go into a battle for a Group 1." His absence leaves a final field of eight, headed by likely odds-on favorite Makfi (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) and Rip Van Winkle (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}).

Hannon has effectively ruled Canford Cliffs out of action for the remainder of the 2010 season. "I must stress that the tracheal wash was not terrible, but the reading was disappointing and, though he'd probably be fine if there was another race coming up in a week or so, the fact is there is nothing left over a mile, just the [G1 Prix de la] Foret over seven furlongs," Hannon explained. "However, the great thing is that we have him in training for next year--he has done us proud this season, and he'll be back better than ever as a four-year-old." Richard Hannon Jr. added, "It's a massive blow to the race, as Makfi, Rip Van Winkle and our lad would have been a hell of a race. I think it will clear up in a few days, and we are still looking at other options at the end of the year. If that doesn't pan out, we'll put him away until next year. There is the Breeders' Cup, and it is something that has always been in the back of our minds, so we might have a look at the race, but it is a long shot." Also missing at the declaration stage were the Ballydoyle entries Cape Blanco (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) and Steinbeck (Ire) (Footstepsinthesand {GB}), and Godolphin's G3 Strensall S. winner and G1 Prix du Moulin runner-up Rio de la Plata (Rahy), leaving just the supplemented Poet's Voice (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) to represent that operation.

ANOTHER MOONSHOT AT KEESEP

Spendthrift Farm's Malibu Moon has had a breakout season at the track, with the likes of Devil May Care, Life at Ten and Malibu Prayer all registering wins at the highest level in various filly and mare events. That momentum has carried over into the sales pavilion, and, for the third time in 11 days of trade at the Keeneland September Yearling Sale, the stallion has been represented by a session-topper. This time, it was a Gainesway-consigned daughter of Perdition (Dixieland Band) which topped the day's proceedings on a bid of \$95,000 from Barry and Shari Eisaman's Eisaman Equine. "She was a very racy and athletic-looking filly by a sire who is very hot at the moment, especially with his fillies," commented Barry Eisaman, who said his purchase, one of 37 for the operation (gross receipts of \$1,931,000) thus far, is likely ticketed for the OBS March sale. "Her broodmare sire is highly sought-after as well." Hip [3490](#), bred by Greg Goodman's Mt. Brilliant Farm, is a granddaughter of Snow Forest (Woodman), a commercially successful broodmare for Mt. Brilliant as the dam of \$420,000 KEESEP yearling and GISW Snow Ridge (Tabasco Cat) as well as three other September graduates that realized seven figures at auction. Eisaman has been pleasantly surprised with the energy at the sale, even if it hasn't always been smooth sailing. "It's definitely been tougher to buy than I expected," he admitted. "There's a very positive atmosphere here with a lot of people on hand to buy young racing stock, and that's a great sign. It has not been easy." Malibu Moon's other session-toppers include hip [658](#), a filly out of Erhu (Tactical Cat) which led the fourth session on Glen Hill Farm's bid of \$700,000; and hip [1774](#), a colt out of Meditations (Out of Place), which was purchased by Marc Keller (Nicoma, agent) for \$300,000 to lead Sunday's seventh day of selling. Gainesway was also the consignor of Thursday's top-priced colt. Hip [3310](#), a bay son of Mineshaft--Date Stone (Forty Niner), was knocked down to owner Jerry Romans for \$85,000. The Jan. 25 foal is a half-brother to MSW & MGSP Deputy Warlock (Silver Deputy). Equaling that price was hip [3593](#), who caught the eye of Jerry and Ann Moss, owner and breeder of the filly's Kentucky Derby-winning sire Giacomo (Holy Bull). A daughter of Tatiani (Fappiano), the gray or roan is a half-sister to the dam of GSW Behindatthebar (Forest Wildcat) and to the dam of SW Bear Holiday (Harlan's Holiday). She was consigned by Meg Levy's Bluewater Sales as agent. With three days to go in this year's September sale, last year's gross receipts of \$191,859,200 have already been surpassed, further hinting at lasting stability in the market. 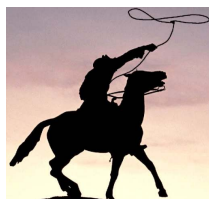

Afleet Express Out For Year...

GI Travers S. hero **Afleet Express** (Afleet Alex) will miss the rest of 2010--which would have included the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Oct. 2 and the GI Breeders' Cup Classic Nov. 6 at Churchill Downs if all had gone according to plan--after a small tear was discovered in the sophomore's upper suspensory ligament of his left foreleg. "He's not lame; he never took a bad step," said conditioner Jimmy Jerkens. "It's just a little tear, and we probably got it in time so there was no real lasting damage. It's disappointing because he was in great shape, but we want to have him back as a four-year-old, so we won't go on this year." Afleet Express, the Gainesway Stable and Martin Cherry runner, was an impressive debut winner in December at Aqueduct, overcoming a terrible start to win going away by 1 1/2 lengths. He was winless in two tries at Gulfstream after tardy beginnings, but returned to the winner's circle with authority in a Belmont allowance May 22, scoring by 7 3/4 lengths without any gate issues. The dark bay then annexed the June 19 GIII Pegasus S. at Monmouth in his first route and stakes debut before finishing a late-closing third in the GII Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga in his final prep for the Travers.

Breeders' Cup Wagering Menus Announced...

Officials at Breeders' Cup Limited have announced the wagering menus and post times for this year's championship event, to be held Friday and Saturday, Nov. 5 and 6 at Churchill Downs in Louisville. There will be a total of 10 races on Friday, culminating with the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic at 7:30 p.m. ET. There will be an Ultra Pick 6 wager with a guaranteed pool of \$750,000. The Saturday program kicks off at 12:05 p.m. ET and concludes with the \$5-million GI Breeders' Cup Classic at 6:45 p.m. The Ultra Pick 6 on that day will have a pool guaranteed at \$2 million and encompasses the races from the Turf Sprint through to the day's main event. "Year after year, racing fans around the world know they're going to find great horses on the track and exceptional value in the betting pools," said Ken Kirchner, president of FaKirk International and the manager of the Breeders' Cup wagering and simulcasting operations for the last 14 years. "The Championships give both the novice and the big player a chance to cash big tickets on their investment. With fractional bet levels at 10 cents for superfectas and 50 cents for trifectas, Pick 3s and Pick 4, this betting menu should appeal to fans at every level. In four of the last 11 years, Breeders' Cup has produced million dollar payouts in the Ultra Pick 6." In addition to those more conventional bets, there will also be a Jockey Bet to select the jockey to amass the most wins over the two days. There will also be a bet to connect Friday's Ladies' Classic with the Breeders' Cup Classic.

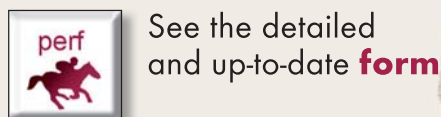

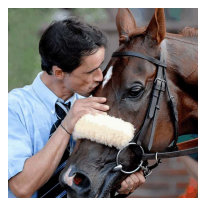

Potrillos, believes the two-year-old, owned by Tony Maawad's Stud Ehdn, can tackle his Northern compatriots. "He has what it takes to be successful in the States," Suarez remarked. Murjan has been perfect in three starts. The dark bay, who RNA'd at \$9,000 as a KEENOV weanling in 2008, broke his maiden by 10 1/4 lengths May 9 and came back to take a conditions race by 16 lengths Aug. 22.

Judge Upholds Stewart Suspension:

A Circuit Court judge in Franklin County, Kentucky, has upheld the legality of a suspension handed down by the Kentucky Racing Commission to Dr. Rodney Stewart, a veterinarian who was found to be in possession of cobra-snake venom in 2007, Daily Racing Form reports. In a ruling handed down earlier this week, Judge Philip Shepherd denied an argument by Stewart that the four-year suspension issued by the KHC was overly punitive, since the maximum penalty for the administration of a Class A drug in the Commonwealth is three years. The judge denied that claim, stating that the Commission has the right to consider other circumstances in assessing penalties and did nothing illegal in this instance. Stewart had previously appealed the suspension with the Commission, but in 2009, a hearing officer determined the penalty was warranted. During the same search which unearthed the cobra venom in a bag in a barn used by Patrick Biancone at Keeneland, the substances carbidopa and levodopa were also found. Citing the Food and Drug Administration's approval of those drugs for treating human patients and in the absence of any apparent evidence that those drugs can aid the performance of racehorses, Judge Shepherd ruled that the KHC could not impose an additional suspension for the possession of those drugs. As a result of the KHC search, Biancone was prohibited from holding a license in Kentucky for one year.

Kentucky Equine Networking Association Meets:

The Kentucky Equine Networking Association, a joint project of the University of Kentucky Equine Initiative and the Kentucky Horse Council, held its first meeting Sept. 16 at Spindletop Hall in Lexington in front of a capacity crowd of more than 140 equine professionals. "What we're trying to do is to unite all pleasure and performance horse professionals, who in some ways weren't connected... and educate them at the same time," said Ed Squires, executive director of the Gluck Equine Research Foundation and director of advancement and industry relations at the UK Gluck Equine Research Center. Ginny Gulke, executive director of the Kentucky Horse Council, sees the group appealing to a broader base of the public, including college-aged jobseekers. "Getting a job is all about networking, meeting people and telling them what you're looking for," Grulke said. "It's a really good thing for students." 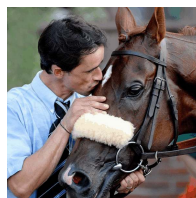

FIXTURE SHAKE-UP DUE TODAY

The British Horseracing Authority will unveil a radically changed end-of-season program for 2011 today. Following longstanding discussions, Newmarket is set to relinquish the Champion S.--inaugurated in 1877--to Ascot, who will stage a card featuring a rescheduled Queen Elizabeth II S. Despite a statement from France Galop that calls for a space of three weeks between Longchamp's Arc meeting and the new British finale, it is expected that the Champions' Day date of mid-October will be chosen by the masterminds behind the proposals. Initially, the revised program--which will also see Newmarket take Ascot's Fillies' Mile as part of a "Future Champions Day" staged Oct. 8--will be on a two-year trial basis.
