WHAT'S IN A NAME?

Khalid Abdullah's **"TDN Rising Star"** **Frankel (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) has that magic formula of the right breeding, connections, name and presence, and he showed in Saturday's G2 Juddmonte Royal Lodge S. that he has the talent to match with an awesome display of power to stun the expectant Ascot crowd with a dazzling 10-length victory. "He was very impressive," trainer Henry Cecil commented. "Over the last two months he has just improved and improved, and had been ticking all the right boxes. He has a lot of talent, and in the way he works, he's potentially the best two-year-old I've had since Wollow (Ire). I've had a lot of good ones since, but not of that class at two." **Cont. p5**

PRECIOUS STONE

After the amazing effort of Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) a half-hour earlier, the pressure was on Frankie Dettori to steer **White Moonstone** (Dynaformer) to glory in the G1 Meon Valley Stud Fillies' Mile and maintain the momentum on Ascot's star-studded card. At 4-5, Godolphin's charge was a confident choice and, although she had to dig in

to find more than had been required in Doncaster's G2 May Hill S. last time Sept. 10, she was equal to the task to take her record to a perfect four-for-four. Held up in last early, the bay challenged the eventual third **Theyskens' Theory** (Bernardini) wide out and, after leading with a fur-

long remaining, held the determined effort of **Together (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) to score by a neck. "I don't think she ran as well as Doncaster--it was only two weeks since, she was a bit fresh in the paddock and the turn of foot wasn't as good--but her class pulled her through," Dettori offered. "Now we are going to put her away for the winter, as she has a lot of filling out to do, and is quite light-framed." **Cont. p4**

NEW PLAYERS ON SOPHOMORE SCENE

Adele Dilschneider's **Apart** (Flatter) and Thoroughbred Legends Racing Stable's **Morning Line** (Tiznow) broke through with career highs in Saturday's GII Super Derby and GII Pennsylvania Derby, respectively. The latter, a runaway Saratoga allowance winner in his latest, was all heart to defeat **First Dude** (Stephen Got Even) by a neck in thrilling edition of the \$1-million Parx Racing feature. "I think he'll be a tremendous horse next year," trainer Nick Zito said of Morning Line. "I won my first race in Pennsylvania, way back when at Liberty Bell--back when my hair was black. The fans here are the best." **Apart** followed a success in Louisiana's Super Derby Prelude S. Aug. 28 with a flashy 1 1/2-length win in the big one yesterday. "He's an up-and-coming horse," trainer Al Stall Jr. revealed. "He had a little injury as a two-year-old, and that might have been the best thing that could have happened to him, because he got the time he needed. He's really found his stride, and I see more improvement down the road." Stall added that **Apart** would try his hand in the GII Fayette S. at Keeneland Oct. 30 and the G1 Clark at Churchill Nov. 26, races both won last year by stablemate **Blame** (Arch) following a runner-up finish in the Super Derby. **Cont. p6**

HIS MASTER'S VOICE

On a roll after wins in the Fillies' Mile and major handicap preceding the G1 Queen Elizabeth S. yesterday, Frankie Dettori carried his momentum forward to steer **Poet's Voice (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) to a nose victory over the defending champion **Rip Van Winkle (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) in a rousing renewal at his beloved Ascot. Starting at 9-2 as a result of sustained support despite mixed messages from the formbook, Godolphin's Aug. 28 G2 Celebration Mile winner picked up his rider's positive vibes, and delivered a last-to-first surge in the stretch to overhaul the Ballydoyle raider in the final yards. "This is my church," Dettori said as he was led back to a rapturous reception at the track at which he rode his famed 'magnificent seven' in 1996.

"I rode the winners of the QEII and Fillies' Mile 20 years ago and I am full of emotions," Dettori continued. "Saeed [bin Suroor] was very confident, but I thought he still had a few pounds to find with the big ones. It's been an unbelievable afternoon, and Ascot is a special place. It's been a supersonic day." The even-money favorite **Makfi (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) proved a major disappointment when only fifth.

Of the quartet of Godolphin winners of this prize prior to yesterday, Mark of Esteem (Ire), Dubai Millennium (GB) and Ramonti (Fr) held obvious claims, but Poet's Voice was more of an unknown quantity for this edition. Having only recently jump started a career that had threatened to derail due to an over-zealous racing style, he chose the biggest stage to provide the operation's backroom boys with the best return for their efforts to steady him at home. That notion seemed unlikely at two, when his natural exuberance had seen him break his maiden by 10 lengths at Newmarket in July and break through the stalls at the start of York's G3 Acomb S. the following month. Third there and only giving his best close home after being reloaded, the homebred demonstrated his raw ability again when seeing out the seven furlongs of Doncaster's G2 Champagne S. to record a first black-type win in September. Dropped back to six for Newmarket's G1 Middle Park S. in an attempt to maximize his enthusiasm, he was only fourth, and started back where he left off when overracing in Longchamp's G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains May 16 and G3 Prix de la Porte Maillot July 3. Sent back to school in Newmarket, he appeared a changed character in Salisbury's G3 Sovereign S., and duly lost out by a nose to Sea Lord (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}) while doing his best work at the close of that one-mile contest Aug. 12. He settled even more kindly in the Celebration Mile, and showed he was peaking at the right time with a 4 1/2-length dismissal of Main Aim (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) in the same Goodwood heat used to warm up Mark of Esteem 14 years ago.

As he had with White Moonstone (Dynaformer) in the Fillies' Mile, Dettori dropped out to last from the gates, and was only starting to make his move five lengths back as Johnny Murtagh took Rip Van Winkle past his pacemaker Air Chief Marshal (Ire) (Daneshill Dancer {Ire}) with a quarter mile remaining. Red Jazz (Johannesburg)

was in closest pursuit of the Ballydoyle raider, but he was always being held, and it was Poet's Voice who bore down on that duo at the furlong marker after rolling by the floundering Makfi. Gaining a narrow edge 100 yards later, he had to fight hard to repel the renewed effort of the rail-skimming Rip Van Winkle, but kept stretching in the run to the line. "I didn't have the best of draws and had to lose a few lengths to get him settled, then I had to go wide round the bend and lost a couple of lengths again, so it was a fantastic performance,"

Dettori said. Trainer Saeed bin Suroor added, "Poet's Voice has been a different horse since learning to settle and he ran a huge race. Frankie gave him a superb ride, and I am very happy that we have won two Group 1 contests here today. We will see how Poet's Voice comes out of today, but we will have a look at the [Nov. 6, G1] Breeders' Cup Mile at Churchill Downs." Aidan O'Brien was not downcast following the marginal defeat of Rip Van Winkle, who would have been the first since Rose Bowl in 1976 to win back-to-back renewals. "He's a great and courageous horse and was definitely coming back at the winner," O'Brien told *PA Sport*. Red Jazz's trainer Barry Hills told *Racing Post*, "He's probably run the race of his life. We rode him differently today, and he probably wants the mile now. He won't be traveling abroad this season, but he stays in training, and something like the Hong Kong Mile could be on the agenda next season." Makfi's rider Christophe Soumillon felt he was not the same horse as he had been when winning the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois. "He was really nervous and fractious and tried to get under the gate," he said. "He has never been like that before." 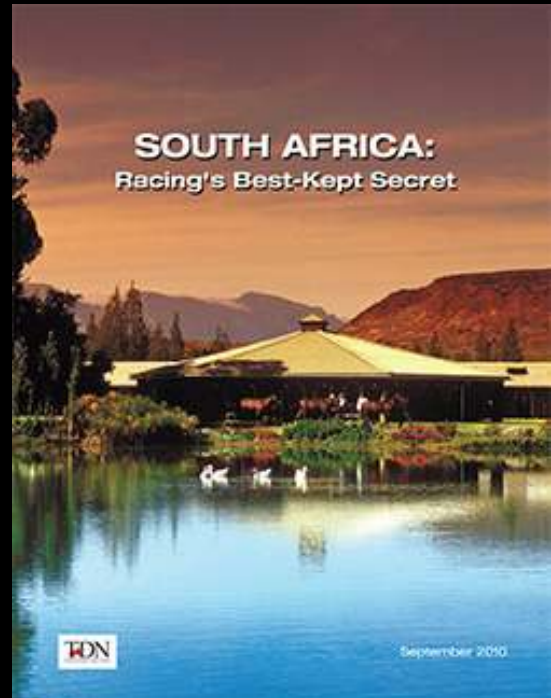

Unveiled over six furlongs at this venue July 23, White Moonstone raced away from the remaining runners towards the stand's rail there, but showed a professionalism and quality that set her apart to record a perfect opener. After extending her tally with comfort in Newmarket's Aug. 7 G3 Sweet Solera S.--also won by 2002 Fillies' Mile heroine Soviet Song (Ire) (Marju {Ire})--she was sent to Doncaster to tread the footsteps of Rainbow View (Dynaformer), who annexed the May Hill en route to victory here two years ago. Like that precocious talent, White Moonstone raced away with that mile contest without any stress, and duly entered this greater test with the ideal warm-up under her belt. Switched off by a confident Dettori as Fork Handles (GB) (Doyen {Ire}) provided the pace, she was asked to quicken wide off the bend as Theyskens' Theory kicked on past the long-time leader. So impressive when winning virtually on the bridle on debut over a mile at Newmarket Aug. 13, Frankel was allowed some rein by Tom Queally on his second start in a seven-furlong Doncaster conditions event, and reacted by storming to a 13-length win to start the ante-post rumblings. Coming here just 15 days later, the imposing bay bettered that eye-catching display to prompt the bookmakers to shorten him to 2-1 for the 2011 2000 Guineas and 4-1 for the Derby. He was anchored last of the five runners by Queally off the steady early gallop, and produced a rarely seen middle move to circle all rivals in a matter of strides racing wide on the turn for home. Losing little energy with that maneuver, he was quickly in command after his rider took a leisurely look round at the quarter pole and used hands and heels only to push him out to this resounding success.

"They didn't go very fast, as I think they hoped he wouldn't settle, but he relaxed very well and when pulled out, went straight from second gear to fifth--Tom [Queally] says he does that in his work at home," Henry Cecil said. "He has scope, too, and I've brought him along gradually, as he's bred to be a three-year-old." Despite that fact, Cecil refused to guarantee he'd make an appearance at Epsom come next June. "He has the right temperament to go on and improve, but a lot can happen between now and the Classics, and I'd question if he will get the Derby trip, as the dam was very fast, and that side has come out a lot in him even though he's by Galileo. His three-parts brother Bullet Train (GB) (Sadler's Wells) doesn't stay much further than a mile and a quarter, so he could be a mile or mile-and-a-quarter horse, but he has a lot of class. He could easily be a Guineas horse, and we have to decide whether to go for the G1 Dewhurst S. [at Newmarket Oct. 16] or the G1 Racing Post Trophy [at Doncaster Oct. 23], and it depends how he does. Giving Jesse Campbell's arms a good workout while racing under a tight hold for most of the way, the rider finally said go on the turn for home, swung his charge out four wide, and came charging late to reel in Distorted Economy. "I don't know if that was a real good ride, but that is a real good horse," Campbell said with a laugh. "They made it tough for us, but that's what they're supposed to do. For a second, I thought, 'Can I get a do-over? Because this is not cool.' But my horse ran a tremendous race, and they've done such a good job with him." She is one of a host of Coolmore representatives, and it may be significant that Johnny Murtagh has stayed with **Wild Wind**, who beat Laughing Lashes (Mr. Greeley) in a course-and-distance maiden June 26 before finishing fifth behind stable companion Misty For Me (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) and that rival in the same track-and-trip G1 Moyglare Stud S. Aug. 29.

GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner Wilko (Awesome Again) out of Miss Attractive (Running Stag) brought a final bid of \$40,000 to top the penultimate day of trading at the 14-session Keeneland September sale.

The January foal was bred and consigned by Frank Stronach's Adena Springs and purchased by Texas-based Preston Stables LLC. Preston Stables is owned by Arthur and Stephanie Preston, who also race under the stable name Oxbow Racing LLC. The Prestons campaigned GISW Ermine (Exchange Rate), a \$45,000 OBSAUG yearling who earned \$880,134 and sold, in foal to A.P. Indy, for \$1.3 million at FTKNOV 2008.

Miss Attractive, the dam of hip 4296, was bred and raced by Adena. The dark bay showed promise in three starts, breaking her maiden by 11 1/2 lengths in her career opener and adding an allowance score, both at Woodbine, as a juvenile in 2005. She started just once at three, running second in a Monmouth allowance test, before joining the Adena broodmare band. Adena acquired Miss Attractive's dam, Marquise Miss (Marquetry), in foal to Holy Bull, for \$135,000 at Keeneland November 2007. She has produced SW Miss Tizzy (Cee's Tizzy). 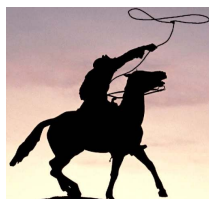

Godolphin yesterday supplemented **Ragsah (Ire)** (Shamardal) and **Al Aasifh (Ire)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) to Friday's G1 Cheveley Park S. and G1 Shadwell Stud Middle Park S. respectively. The former, who is a half-sister to Dubai Millennium (GB) and was runner-up in last Saturday's G3 Firth of Clyde S. at Ayr, makes for a potential field of 15 for the fillies' contest while the addition of the July 16 Listed Rose Bowl S. winner Al Aasifh and also the July 25 G2 Prix Robert Papin winner Irish Field (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}) swelled the Middle Park to 14. Richard Hannon is set to saddle Highclere Thoroughbred Racing's July 7 G2 Cherry Hinton S. scorer **Memory (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) in the Cheveley Park, which could also feature Michael Tabor, Derrick Smith and Susan Magnier's Aug. 29 G1 Moyglare Stud S. heroine **Misty For Me (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}). In the Middle Park, David Simcock looks set to unleash Khalifa Dasmal's Aug. 22 G1 Prix Morny winner **Dream Ahead** (Diktat {GB}) and he said of him, "Dream Ahead worked over five-and-a-half furlongs on the Peat Moss gallop and we were delighted with him. That will be his last serious piece of work before the Middle Park S., although we will look to give him a breeze next Monday or Tuesday. We are very happy with how his preparations are going. The Middle Park is going to be a better race than the Morny, no question about that. But we'd like to think that hopefully he has improved a little bit. What will be massively in his favour is if there is significant rainfall, and the forecast suggests an unsettled picture." Others in the mix to oppose him are Julie Wood's June 15 G2 Coventry S. winner **Strong Suit** (Rahy) and John Fretwell's Sept. 18 G2 Mill Reef S. scorer **Temple Meads (GB)** (Avonbridge {GB}).

It was getting late in the day at OBS March and Leah Gyarmati and her owner Jeff Treadway, who got

started in the business several years ago as part of a partnership but has begun to purchase horses on his own, were looking like they might leave the sale empty-handed. But Gyarmati wouldn't depart without taking another look at a grey Yes It's True colt that had caught her eye.

"There were some things going on with the horse's x-rays, so he ended up being a buy-back," recalled Gyarmati. "But, we really liked the way he looked, and at the end of the day we hadn't gotten anything so I said 'let's go back and check out that horse' and then we bought him privately."

"He's a beautiful horse. He's very, very impressive-looking and he moves really well and I thought he worked really well for the sale (1/8 in 21.3). The only reason he was a buy-back was because he had some issues, but we decided that if we paid the right price he'd still be worth it," said the Queens native.

Mythical Truth hasn't quite put it all together yet, but the flashes of brilliance he has shown give the impression that Treadway and Gyarmati might have gotten a pretty good bargain.

The grey's debut came against a salty group of juveniles at the Spa July 24, which included Wine Police (Speightstown), who earned ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ status for his 7 3/4-length romp in that event before running third of four in the G1 Hopeful S.; and Soldat (War Front), who broke his maiden impressively next out in the GIII With Anticipation S. on the grass Sep. 3.

Mythical Truth dashed out of the gate to attend a pace of :22.22 and :45.50 with that duo before fading to fifth, beaten 20 1/4 lengths ([video](#)). Gyarmati admits that she was expecting a better finish, but offered up several factors that could have contributed to the relatively disappointing performance.

“First of all, it was a very tough race,” she said “He ran great, but I think he was hustled off of his feet a little bit. He broke third and if he would have just sat there and waited to run, he would have been right there. We probably wouldn’t have beaten Wine Police, but I think he’s second or third if he just sits chilly instead of dueling. He also came back pretty dehydrated. It was a hot day and he didn’t handle the heat so well.

“I’ve never had a horse with the thumps before, but it seemed like he came back with something like the thumps, so I took him off Lasix [for his second start] in case that was a factor.”

Mythical Truth’s second trip at Belmont Sep. 18 was even more eventful, and he overcame extreme adversity in a way that few horses ever do. He also left bettors scrambling for tickets they had ripped up or tossed away when it looked like the grey had no chance to hit the board.

The colt tried to wheel at the start, spotting the field an insurmountable 17-length head start, but he regained his composure and settled back into stride, overcoming his disadvantageous break without ever really being asked for run, somehow managing to secure the show spot, less than 10 1/4 lengths behind good-looking winner Justin Phillip (First Samurai) ([video](#)).

“He’s never done anything like that before,” said Gyarmati of her charge’s gate antics. “He’s all business, always does the right thing. I don’t know why he did that. The horse inside of him broke a little slow and he had to wait a long time--there were some horses to his outside that were acting up and not wanting to go in the gate, but I have no idea [why he did that]. He’s also a ‘no handle’ in the gate. He’s very good in the gate by himself, but he likes to play if you get in there with him. Maybe between all those things that’s what did it.

She added, “I thought if Edgar didn’t just totally give up on him I thought he could get up there for something, but I didn’t think he’d get up for third. I was just hoping, ‘please, just do something good!’ He galloped out so hard after that, he went another three-eighths of a mile after the race.”

Those who are curious to see what Mythical Truth can do with a clean break will have to be patient, however.

“He has a couple of issues coming out of it, so I think what we’re going to do is stop on him for a little bit. It might have been partially because of that little U-turn he made that he’s got some little things going on with his legs,” revealed Gyarmati. “I know he’s a really nice horse and I’m not going to test it by pushing him right now. We’ll give him the time, do the right things and we’ll have a nice three-year-old.”

Conditioner Seth Benzel, who went out on his own in 2008 after working as an assistant for Todd Pletcher and Bill Mott, enjoyed a break out Saratoga meet this year. The upstate New York native sent out 10 winners from 32 starts at the Spa, good for a lofty 31-percent win rate. He also got his first Grade II win with Dynaslew (Dynaformer) in the Ballston Spa H.

One of Benzel’s more interesting prospects moving forward after Saratoga, however, is not one of the horses that found the winner’s circle.

Mister Pippit, a chestnut son of Tapit from the female family of Ogygian and Honour and Glory, turned in a solid second-place debut going 1 1/16 miles on the sod in the last race of the meet on Sept. 6, and looks like a colt with a bright future.

Benzel, who picked out the horse as a yearling for Jim Pippo’s Whitehall Stable partnership at Fasig-Tipton July, recalled, “He was kind of a scopey horse with a very nice walk, intelligent-looking head and just seemed to have a lot of energy. Those sales can tend to be tiresome on the horses because they’re brought out so much and they go back-and-forth, but he seemed to be a horse that just thrived during the whole sale and didn’t let anything tamper with his high energy level. Also, Tapit has done some great things early on, so we were happy to get him.”

Benzel did not originally have the turf in mind for Mister Pippit, but discovered the juvenile’s affinity for grass during morning works.

“We found that he preferred the turf through training. We were hoping that--as with all horses--he would be able to run on the dirt, but as we started to get closer to race time, you could see an immediate difference from the way he was covering ground on the dirt versus the turf,” explained Benzel.

One of those training sessions--a five-furlong drill in 1:01.70 over Saratoga’s Oklahoma Training Track grass course Aug. 20--came in company with sophomore Souper Spectacular (Giant’s Causeway), a \$1.15 million half-brother to Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}), who broke his maiden impressively in his first turf try Sep. 4.

On how Benzel pairs his horses in the morning, he explained, "It's partially timing. It also depends on what I'm looking to achieve--either a certain time or a certain kind of effort. At that particular stage I wanted a good work from both horses, I thought both were ready to do that and I thought they could give each other ample competition to get done what we wanted to get done. Fortunately for us it paid off with both horses."

Benzel was pleasantly surprised with Mister Pippit's debut, however, he thought that he would still need a race before being at his best. The colt was well out of it early, but finished with a rush on the rail to best all but one, loose-on-the-lead Shug McGaughey trainee Voodoo Storm (Storm Cat), a son of MGISW Voodoo Dancer (Kingmambo) who won by 1 1/4 lengths. The speed-favoring turf bias that was prevalent all meet made Mister Pippit's against-the-grain run that much more impressive ([video](#)).

"Down the backside I was very confident because he looked like he was going along so easily, but he was one of those horses in the morning that didn't necessarily impress you," Benzel reflected. "It doesn't seem like anything has changed. I don't think he gets geared up for the morning workouts like he does for the races. He goes over there and kind of puts his 'game face' on. I thought we were in good shape by the time we saddled him in the paddock because he just seemed to handle the experience so well and seemed to be on his toes and he just reacted to the limelight in a positive way."

The insight Benzel gained about his charge from that first run has left the conditioner excited and hopeful about what's to come.

"For him to run like that right off the bat means we've got an awful lot of extra headway to make with him. I think he'll really bounce out of that race well and take a step forward off of that effort," he commented.

Mister Pippit exited his debut in excellent shape, and Benzel is pointing him to another 8 1/2-furlong grass event at Belmont Oct. 2.

THIS DATE IN HISTORY...

September 26, 1942...The Jockey Club stewards revoked jockey **Eddie Arcaro**'s license for one year after a display of "rough riding" aboard odds-on favorite Occupation in the Cowdin S. September 19. In the race, Arcaro deliberately drove his horse into another, Breezing Home, knocking jockey Vincent Nodarse into the infield. Nodarse and his mount had crowded Arcaro at the start, almost causing him to be unseated.

September 27, 1894...**Aqueduct Racetrack** opened its doors. The building was torn down in 1955 and the new Aqueduct was reopened September 14, 1959.

September 27, 1947...**Armed**, then the world's leading money-winning Thoroughbred, met 1946 Triple Crown winner **Assault** in the first \$100,000 winner-take-all match race, held at Belmont Park. Armed won easily over a less-than 100 percent Assault.

A STORY OF REVENGE (Tale of the Cat)

There was no more-coveted offering at the Barretts March Sale this past winter than hip [6](#), David

Lanzman's Tale of the Cat half-sister to GISW I Want Revenge (Stephen Got Even). The bay with the long white blaze down her face, who had breezed an eighth of a mile in [:10.2](#) ahead of the sale, stood intently by as bidding climbed past \$900,000. But interest stalled out at \$975,000, just shy of Lanzman's \$1-million reserve, and the filly was

headed back home.

Lanzman bred and raced I Want Revenge, but sold a majority interest to IEAH Stables after he won the GI Gotham S. The colt went on to win the GI Wood Memorial S., and was the morning-line chalk for the GI Kentucky Derby, but had to be scratched the morning of the race. There ensued a dispute over the terms of the partnership, with both sides filing lawsuits, but ultimately IEAH bought out Lanzman's share.

A Story of Revenge--the "last connection to I Want Revenge," as the owner put it--was ultimately turned over to Mike Trombetta, and began working with regularity in early July over the gallops at Fair Hill. The daughter of Meguial (Arg) (Roy) really began to pick up the pace over the last handful of weeks, turning in a pair of strong drills over five-eighths of a mile before heading to Monmouth Park for her final breeze.

Sent out for a half-mile tightener from the gate Sept. 19, she just missed the bullet while outworking some 102 other horses, stopping the timer in :47 3/5.

Unfortunately for Trombetta, his filly drew the dreaded inside stall for her debut.

"It's always a bad post for a first-time starter," the conditioner commented. "It seems that all the horses that I like draw the one hole."

Trombetta, who strikes with just over one of every four of his debuters, knew his filly had a world of talent, but wasn't exactly sure that Saturday would be the day.

"I was always concerned that she might not be at her best sprinting," he offered. "She always acted like a filly that wants two turns. I think the owner was very understanding that it wasn't a have-to-win kind of day today. As long as she got a good first run and showed us some promise, we would have all been happy."

And that she did. Away without incident from the one hole, she took pressure from her outside every step of the six furlongs, but dug in determinedly in the final 100 yards and held on for the victory.

"We'll reward her for that and give her plenty of time before we start her back, because she was under the gun from the get-go, but still got it done," Trombetta explained. "I'd like to see her have the benefit of four to six weeks before I run her again."

Given his hunch that A Story of Revenge will relish a route of ground in the future, Trombetta is inclined to stretch her out next time. But how far is as-yet undetermined.

"Generally, I like to give her two sprints before I stretch them out, but I think this filly will appreciate the added distance," Trombetta offered. "I don't know if it will be two turns right away, but I think she'll go on."

The trainer, who saddled Kentucky Derby favorite Sweetnorthernstain to a seventh-place finish in 2006, believes the sky is the limit.

"What I like about her is that we didn't put a ton of pressure on her getting her ready for this race," he stated. "She came into it and was able to get it done when she was vulnerable, and that means a lot to me."

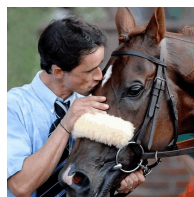

Allevamento Le Gi's hip [187](#), an Orpen half-sister to the Listed-placed Private Dancer (Fr) (Green Tune) from the extended family of the 1995 G1 Racing Post Trophy winner Beauchamp King (GB) (Nishapour {Fr}), was knocked down to Antonino Bosco for €30,000.
