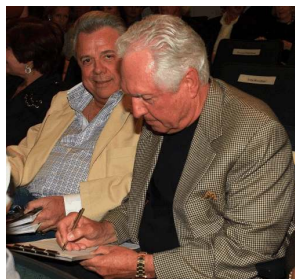

KEENELAND SEPTEMBER CONCLUDES

The Keeneland September Yearling Sale concluded its two-week run in Lexington yesterday with stronger results than its lackluster 2009 predecessor. Through 14 sessions of the auction, 3,059 yearlings sold for \$198,257,900. The average rose 6.7 percent to \$64,811, while the median increased 13.6 percent to \$25,000. The buy-back rate was 26.7 percent, down from 27.5 percent a year ago.

"Our goal going into the sale was to try to build some stability in the market that we could grow on," said Keeneland's Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell. "I think we've successfully done that. I think the sale met and exceeded the majority, if not all, of our consignors' expectations going in--I think they realized it was going to be a tough 2010, and I think that we met and surpassed all their expectations."

Opening night of the Keeneland auction saw a son of A.P. Indy bring a sale-topping \$4.2 million--the highest

price paid for a yearling at the sale since 2006. The colt was one of three yearlings to bring over seven figures, compared to the four who topped \$1 million during the 2009 sale. While Sheikh Mohammed's Darley operation did not figure into any of the sale's top lots, new buyers, including Benjamin Leon, Jr., who purchased the sales topper, populated the toppers list.

"Going in, I think everyone was concerned about the top end of the market, because there was concern about certain buyers pulling back, but I think that created an opportunity for more people to participate," Russell said. "I think that makes it a healthier market for everybody. We were very pleased with the first week. Obviously, starting off Sunday night with a \$4.2-million horse didn't hurt." *Cont. p9*

CASAMENTO WINS BERESFORD

Casamento (Shamardal) forged to a four-length success in yesterday's G2 Juddmonte Beresford S. at The Curragh. While it might be unfair to describe a four-length success as workmanlike, the Sheikh Mohammed runner took a while to exert his superiority and shake off rivals who seemed vastly overmatched on paper.

Racing freely early before taking a lead from **Robin Hood (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), he passed that rival with a quarter-mile remaining and gradually extended his advantage from the staying-on **Mawaakef (Ire)** (Azamour {Ire}) for a hard-earned, but ultimately convincing success. "Everything went really well today--he settled well and idled a little bit in

front," said trainer Mick Halford. "Some wonderful horses have won this in the past, and if he goes on to be anything like them, we'll be very happy. He's very laid-back at home, but had done one bit of work since the National S., and we were very pleased with it so we let him take his chance. We have no plans at the moment--we'll see how he comes out of it and talk to the team. He's the best horse I've had by a long way." *Cont. p2*

Scalo can now lay claim to being his country's top three-year-old after adding this blitzing of his elders to wins in the G3 Fruhjahrspreis des Bankhauses Metzler and G3 Bavarian Classic. An unlucky fifth in the G2 Oppenheim-Union-Rennen, he was unplaced again when ridden with exaggerated restraint in the July 18 G1 Deutsches Derby, but he reverted to a mile and a quarter to garner Deauville's G2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano last time Aug. 15. Handed an easier task with the scratching of **Wiener Walzer (Ger)** (Dynaformer), Scalo was waited with in rear initially before making a smooth move on the approach to the straight. Challenging wide to lead passing the quarter pole, the bay produced too many guns for **Night Magic**. Trainer **Andreas Wohler** said, "He is a great stayer who also possesses great speed. We had picked out this race for him a long time ago and now we are so happy that everything worked out so well. We don't yet know whether he will run again this year, there is an option for the GI Canada International and he will stay in training." One of a handful of Irish-trained runners to carry the famed Sheikh Mohammed silks this term, Casamento made an instant impact with a debut win over an extended seven furlongs at Tipperary Aug. 26. Backing up quickly in the G1 National S. at this track, the bay was the only rival capable of taking Pathfork (Distorted Humor) all the way before losing out by a head in that Sept. 11 contest. "He's a nice horse, and although he was a little bit aggressive out of the gates as he was in the National S.--when Seamus [Heffernan, on Robin Hood] went on--he dropped the bridle," jockey Pat Smullen said. "It was important for the future that he did that, and as a result, he got very relaxed, so I had to stoke him up to go, but he won with plenty in hand. He's a very immature horse mentally, but he will improve over the winter and has the makings of a very good horse." Casamento was bred by Dermot Cantillon and his son Jack. The juvenile's dam, **Wedding Gift**, is back in foal to **Shamardal**.

Earmarked as a **TDN Rising Star** on debut at Leicester last May, Lady of the Desert repaid that compliment by taking the G3 Princess Margaret S. over this track and trip in July and the G2 Lowther S. again over six furlongs at York in August. Third to Special Duty (GB) (Hennessy) in the G1 Cheveley Park S. at Newmarket on her final juvenile outing in October, the chestnut was tried beyond sprint trips for the first time in the G3 Fred Darling S. at Newbury on her sophomore debut Apr. 17 and created stamina question marks by pulling hard and fading late into third in that Guineas prep. Sent to Longchamp instead of Newmarket for the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches May 16, the homebred was one of the chief sufferers of the late-race scrimmaging which contributed to the disqualification of the first-past-the-post Liliside (Fr) (American Post {GB}) and received only minor compensation by being promoted to fifth from sixth. Finally settling the issue of her staying power when only sixth over the mile of this venue's G1 Coronation S. at the Royal meeting June 18, the chestnut returned from a break with sprinting firmly on the agenda in the G1 Haydock Sprint Cup. Excelling when runner-up to Markab (GB) (Green Desert), she may not have been helped by her draw away from the eventual winner in that Sept. 4 dash, but Richard Hughes ensured she had dead aim on chief market rival Dalghar in the initial stages of this affair. Full of run inside the final quarter, she was switched onto the rail, and after squeezing through a gap, swamped that rival 150 yards from home before scooting away to a resounding success.

"It was a lovely race to ride, because it was so easy," Hughes commented. "When a horse has the speed she has, any gap is big enough, because she's in and out so quick. She has a great attitude and, if anything, she appreciated the ease in the ground." Trainer Brian Meehan added, "She's a wonderful filly, has been throughout and I'm really pleased. We thought she had a big chance, as it was perfect timing after Haydock. We did some other things with her in the spring and it didn't quite come off, but she's had the summer off and she's come back as good as ever. She's quite versatile and seems to handle any ground--she had to cope at Haydock and it's better here today. The rain in the last 45 minutes probably freshened the ground up. Laaheb's fruitful season kicked off with a third place in the G3 Gordon Richards S. at Sandown Apr. 24 and a second in the Listed Festival S. at Goodwood May 31 before he was off the mark in the Listed Fred Archer S. at Newmarket June 26. 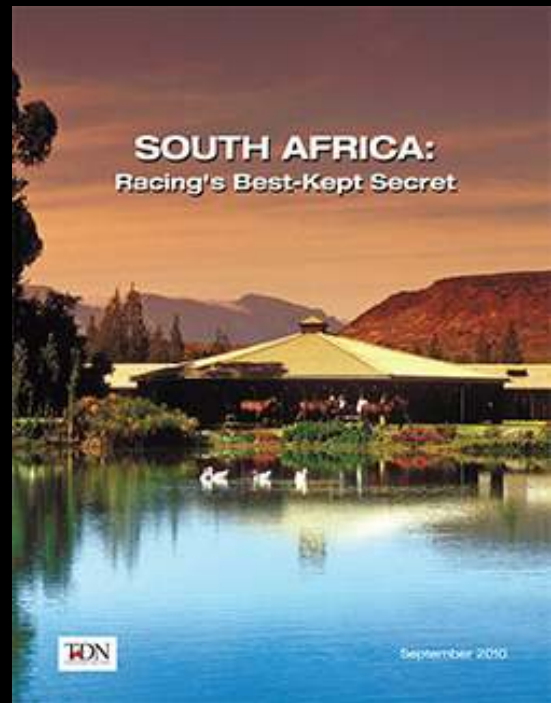

This year's September auction featured a new format that included a slimmed-down select section held during two evening sessions, followed by a more comprehensive Book 2 comprised of four sessions of more evenly matched quality.

At the conclusion of business yesterday, Geoffrey Russell declared the new format a success.

"The idea behind the new format was to start the sale off with excitement and momentum, and hopefully, that would carry through," Russell said. "It certainly

carried through the first week and then Books 3, 4 and 5 were all excellent. We saw a great mix of old and new faces, both domestic and foreign, and they stayed longer into the sale. Trading was very evenly spread among a number of buyers. That is a very healthy sign."

Buyers from around the U.S., as well as 39 other countries, participated in the September sale.

"The sale has been very positive," confirmed Tom Eastham of Legacy Blood-

stock. "We've had a lot of volume at the barns. Different buyers from different regions with different business plans stayed around to see these horses. [The new format] allowed us to spread interest throughout our consignments."

For the seventh straight year, Taylor Made Sales Agency ranked as the leading September consignor, selling 341 yearlings for \$28,873,800. Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's Shadwell Estate Company Ltd. was the sale's leading buyer, purchasing 22 yearlings for \$8,230,000.

During Sunday's final session of the sale, top price of \$37,000 was paid for a filly from the first crop of Flashy Bull (Holy Bull). [Hip 4564](#), consigned by Dixiana, is out of Dream City (Carson City) and from the family of Igotrhythm and Slew Gin Fizz. She was purchased by Sunset Stables LLC. For the session, 197 horses sold for \$957,200. The average was \$4,859 and the median was \$3,000.

Trainer Bob

Baffert was not concerned about the incident. "He had a good warm-up," Baffert told *DRF*. "He never really got into the workout. He went about an eighth of a mile. It worked out all right." Lookin at Lucky has been off since winning the Aug. 1 GI Haskell Invitational and is expected to start next in Saturday's Indiana Derby at Hoosier Park.

MAKFI FLOP PERPLEXES CONNECTIONS

Trainer Mikel Delzangles was not making any excuses yesterday for the below-par effort of **Makfi (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) in Saturday's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot. Only fifth as the even-money favorite following his impressive defeat of Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville Aug. 15, Mathieu Offenstadt's colt remains unbeaten outside of Ascot and his conditioner is putting his flop down to a dislike of that circuit. "He's okay--we didn't find anything wrong with him," Delzangles told *PA Sport*. "The jockey never felt well on him during the whole race. I think he doesn't like Ascot. The horse was nervous and he never travelled well. The jockey never felt happy any time in the race that he was well. It was very disappointing, but we can't see anything other than he didn't like the track. He has had two defeats at Ascot while everywhere else he has been great. Last time, [when seventh in the June 15 G1 St James's Palace S.] he had a throat infection and maybe he remembered it. That could be an explanation."

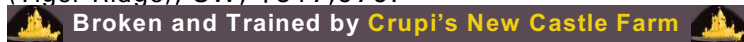
