## STARS OUT FOR SATURDAY'S ACTION

One of the busiest days on the North American racing calendar is on tap Saturday, when a total of nine Grade I events will be contested between Belmont and Oak Tree. Not to be outdone, divisional leaders **Blind Luck** (Pollard's Vision) and **Lookin At Lucky** (Smart Strike) will also be in action at Parx Racing and Hoosier Downs, respectively. Belmont's "Super Saturday" card will feature five top-level races, headed by the clash between **Blame** (Arch) and **Rail Trip** (Jump Start) in the \$750,000 GI Jockey Club Gold Cup. The latter will be making his first start in the white bridle of Rick Dutrow Jr., and it will be his first appearance since coming up a half-length short as the 2-5 chalk in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup July 10. The five-year-old gelding breezed a half in :49.38 at Aqueduct yesterday prior to having his name dropped in the entry box. "The clock starts ticking now," Dutrow said. "He's been training well at Saratoga, and at Aqueduct, for the past month, and we're hoping he runs his race. He hasn't been getting tired with those fast works, and we're happy with where we are with him."

## KILCARN'S LEGEND LIVES ON AT GOFFS

There were remarkable scenes at the Kill venue of Goffs yesterday when Pat O'Kelly's Kilcarn Stud supplied a ninth top-priced yearling in the last 18 renewals of the famed Orby Sale. **Lot 386** was the central focus of the day and had all the ingredients to make waves, being by the rising international influence Dubawi (Ire) and, as a son of Spirit of Tara (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), a three-parts sibling to Godolphin's Group 2 winner Echo of Light (GB) (Dubai Millennium {GB}). It was that operation's John Ferguson who saw off the British-based owner Andrew Tinkler and a discreet undisclosed bidder for the February-foaled bay, having the final say at €950,000. "This filly comes from a great nursery and full credit to Pat



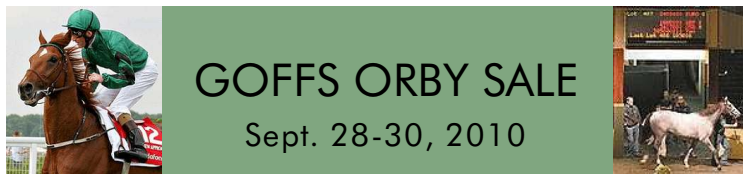

O'Kelly, as she sent this wonderful mare to Dubawi at a time when he was still an unproven sire," Ferguson said. "Echo of Light was a very good horse and a real favorite of ours, and for us to be able to buy his three-parts sister is very special."

Trained by Michael Grassick, Spirit of Tara, a full-sister to Salsabil (Ire), was a talented performer who finished her career as runner-up in the G2 Blandford S. in 1997. But it was at the paddocks in County Meath that she started to excel. Her Kingmambo pair Multazem and Akarem (GB)--who fetched €500,000 here in 2002--held their own at listed level for Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum. Her next foal was Echo of Light, from Dubai Millennium's lone crop. Having dominated the '03 renewal of this auction when selling to John Ferguson for €1.2 million, that high-class Godolphin stalwart went on to score five times at group level, including in the 2006 G2 Prix Daniel Wildenstein on the upcoming Arc weekend. Her four yearlings to sell here subsequently totaled just over €2 million, and included the €900,000 purchase and last year's G2 Ribblesdale S. runner-up Flame of Gibraltar (Ire) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}). **Goffs cont. p2-7**

### Super Saoire...

Twelve months ago, the 2005 G1 Irish 1000 Guineas winner Saoire (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) provided the sale topper here after Jim and Fitri Hay paid €475,000 for the recent winner Pink Diva (Ire) (Giant's Causeway). It was that owner who was out to get her latest offering



by Invincible Spirit (Ire), consigned by Cahermorris Stables as [lot 354](#). Hay had already given up after a brief battle with John Ferguson, but the latter eventually relinquished to Demi O'Byrne, who stepped in to secure the February-foaled colt for €550,000. "He's a good-looking colt out of a superb Guineas-winning mare who produced last year's sale topper," explained O'Byrne.

The Coolmore rep went on to pay €260,000 for a colt by Galileo (Ire) consigned as [lot 408](#) by Ciaran Conroy's Glenvale Stud. Out of another Irish 1000 Guineas heroine in Tarascon (Ire) (Tirol {Ire}), the April-foaled bay is a half-brother to this year's Listed Woodcote S. winner High Award (Ire) (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}), as well as the broodmare Mayano Sophia (Ire) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}).



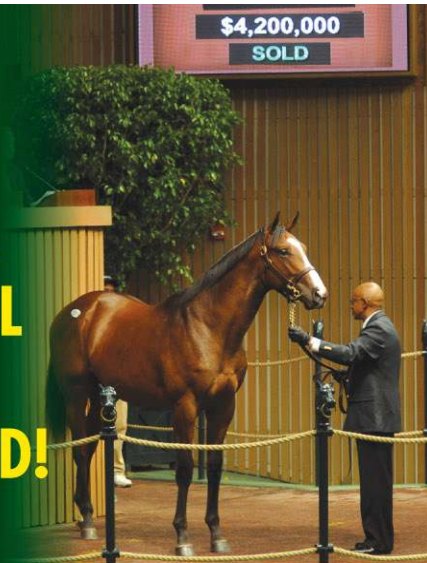

By the time that yearling had sold, Galileo was responsible for four of the top 11 lots at this year's edition. Just seven lots earlier, Coolmore's leading sire was responsible for a full- and three-parts brother to the listed-placed Dermot Weld trainees Sense of Purpose (Ire) and Dance Pass (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), respectively, who was knocked down to Sir Robert Ogden for €215,000. Bill Dwan's Castlebridge Consignment offered the colt was [lot 401](#).

That followed the purchase by Cheveley Park Stud of a Marlhill House Stud-consigned filly by Galileo for €200,000. [Lot 389](#) is out of an unraced sister to the 2005 GI Garden City H. victress Luas Line (Ire) (Danehill), and is from the extended family of Prince Arch and his half-brother Kingsfort (War Chant), winner of last year's G1 Vincent O'Brien National S.

**Red-Letter Day For Camas Park...**

As the Saoire colt was leaving the ring, a son of Holy Roman Emperor (Ire) from Camas Park Stud stepped in as lot 355 and maintained the momentum, selling to Sir Robert Ogden for €220,000. The bay colt became one of a quartet of six-figure lots for Timmy Hyde's Cashel establishment in the process. A March-foaled full-brother to the smart Richard Hannon-trained two-year-old Jollywood (Ire) from an American family including the 1990 GI Top Flight H. heroine Dreamy Mimi (Naska), he had cost just €36,000 here in November. "He was a very athletic horse, which Sir Robert liked in particular," Racing Manager Barry Simpson said. "He's an own-brother to a two-times winning two-year-old and he was just a very good individual who seemed to be very popular."

Another of the draft to be snapped up by Ogden was lot 339, a colt by Excellent Art (GB) who hails from Edmund Loder's family of champions Marwell (Ire) and Marling (Ire). Despite his half-brother Silly Billy (Ire) (Noverre) having only won a seller, his natural presence was enough to ensure a final price of €170,000. "He's by an exciting young stallion, and he's from a decent family," Simpson added.

That followed hot on the heels of the sale of lot 338, a Danehill Dancer (Ire) half-sister to the talented Australian performer Skiddaw Peak (Aus) (Generous {Ire}), to Cheveley Park Stud for €155,000. Stud Manager Chris Richardson, who has made an impact over the two days, was set on adding the relative of Landseer (GB) to David and Patricia's legions. "She's a nice filly, and the two-year-old sister [Shelley Beach (Ire)] has been placed and looks promising," said Richardson. "We've had a good Danehill Dancer filly already in Danehill Destiny (GB) and [last year's G1 Nassau S. third] Moneycantbuymelove (Ire) is in the family. She's by Pivotal, so that could be an interesting cross in the future. We've bought a few here this week, and we are always on the lookout to refresh our families."



Danehill Dancer had also been responsible for kick-starting the Camas Park success story early in the session when his January-foaled half-brother to the 2004 G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup runner-up Livadiya (Ire) (Shernazar {Ire}) fetched €200,000. Alex Cole, who had paid €250,000 for a son of Oasis Dream (GB) from the same consignment on Tuesday, was not to be denied for [lot 231](#) from the immediate family of Linnigari (Ire). "He's a fine colt and, with the pedigree that he has, I think that you have a chance of getting a stallion," Cole said.

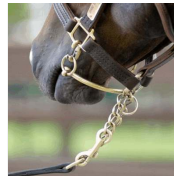

**A Fleeting Opportunity...**

Despite being one of the world's hottest properties at present, Dansili (GB) had just two representatives in this catalogue. That included a sole yearling on offer yesterday that had obvious potential for headlines, being a close relative of the 2007 G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains hero Astronomer Royal (Danzig). [Lot 367](#), from David and Diane Nagle's Barronstown Stud, is also a half-sister to the 2005 GII Pan American H. winner Navesink River (Unbridled) and was bought by Hugo Merry Bloodstock for €180,000.

Alex Cole was again in the thick of the action immediately afterwards when paying €160,000 for Norelands Stud's [lot 368](#), a Cape Cross (Ire) colt whose dam is closely related to the 1999 Epsom Derby hero Oath (Ire) and champion Pelder (Ire).

Earlier, Aidan O'Ryan had secured [lot 332](#), a Shamardal colt from the extended family of sires Thrill Show, David's Bird and Walim from the consignment of Gay O'Callaghan's Yeomanstown Stud for €155,000.

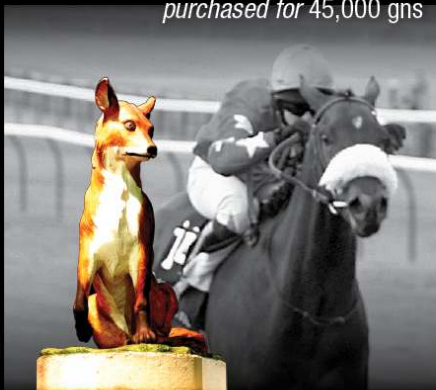

Darley's Teofilo (Ire), who was responsible for the top-priced colt and overall joint-topper of the first session, continued in the same vein yesterday when a pair of yearlings provided an early focus. [Lot 294](#), a filly from Seamus Burns's Lodge Park Stud out of the group-placed Park Romance (Ire) (Dr Fong) from the family of Winchester (Theatrical {Ire}), was knocked down to John Ferguson for €140,000 after he had seen off Sir Robert Ogden.

Meanwhile, a colt by Teofilo out of the 2005 G3 Prix du Petit Couvert winner Nipping (Ire) (Night Shift) sold to Shadwell for €130,000. Consigned by his breeder Kilfrush Stud, [lot 280](#) is the latest part of the Strauss dynasty of Zipping (Ire) (Zafonic) and Last Tycoon (Ire). "He's by a very exciting young stallion and comes from a very good Kilfrush family," Shadwell's Stephen Collins said. "It's a family that Sheikh Hamdan has been very lucky with before through the likes of The Perfect Life (Ire) and Rabah (GB)." That operation later paid the same amount for Grove Stud's [lot 333](#), an Oasis Dream (GB) colt whose dam is a half to the 2003 G1 Moyglare Stud S. scorer Necklace (GB) (Darshaan {GB}) from the Meon Valley family of sires Opera House (GB), Kayf Tara (GB) and the 2003 G1 Prix de l'Opera winner Zee Zee Top (GB) (Zafonic). "Obviously, he's by an outstanding young stallion who has already produced two Group 1 winners for Sheikh Hamdan," Collins added. "He looked an obvious two-year-old, and Sheikh Hamdan liked him particularly."

Shadwell's other purchases included Tinnakill House's [lot 410](#), an Acclamation (GB) half-brother to the listed-placed Unquenchable Fire (Ire) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) for €140,000; and Ballylinch Stud's [lot 334](#), a Lawman (Fr) colt out of a half to the sire Swift Gulliver (Ire) for €120,000. "We are very taken with the quality of Lawman's stock," Collins continued. "We have a very nice one at home in Derrinstown, and we were underbidder on a Lawman filly out of Gilded yesterday."

Overall, the average of €65,415 was down by 3.7 percent on 2009, while the median suffered a 10-percent drop, to €45,000. "It has been a consolidation from last year's sale, as we are within a bid of last year's average." the auction house's Henry Beeby told *Racing Post*. "The drop in median highlights the selective nature of the market. The market has become increasingly selective, but there have been some notable successes. Save the Table (Tale of the Cat) was unplaced in a single stateside start, then ultimately made her way across the pond. She was RNA'd for just €17,000 as a racing/broodmare prospect at GOFNOV in 2006, then was purchased a few months later by Tony O'Dwyer for that same pricetag. She was sent to this Coolmore inmate in each of her first two years at stud, and this colt, her second produce, realized €36,000 from Pier House Stud as a foal last November. His sire has had a good run this season and it carried over into the Goffs ring yesterday.

## NTRA REPORT FROM CAPITOL HILL



### TAX BENEFITS RETURN FOR THOROUGHBRED INDUSTRY

The Small Business Jobs Act of 2010 is now law and authorizes larger write-offs for horses and other property for the Thoroughbred industry.

#### Small-Business Expensing Doubled

- Expensing allowance for horses, farm equipment and most other depreciable property is \$500,000 for 2010 (and 2011)
- Property must be placed in service in year purchased
- Expensing allowance reduced by one dollar for each dollar of eligible property purchased during the year that exceeds \$2 million
- Applies to new or used property

#### Bonus Depreciation Re-instated

- 50 percent bonus first-year depreciation returns for 2010
- Applies to horses and most other depreciable property with depreciation life of less than 20 years
- Property must be placed in service in 2010
- Property must be new - the original use of horse or other depreciable property must commence with taxpayer
- Can be used in conjunction with expensing allowance

**Three Drop Out - Ground Still Soft...**

There were three defections following yesterday's second forfeit stage for Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp, leaving 23 still engaged. Those withdrawn were the Pascal Bary-trained **Dariable (Fr)** (Highest Honor {Fr}), the Neil Drysdale-trained **Marsh Side** (Gone West) and the Gerard Butler-trained **Tinaar** (Giant's Causeway). The race may yet be over-subscribed beyond the safety limit of 20, as numbers are expected to be bolstered by two when **Lope de Vega (Ire)** (Shamardal) and **Marinous (Fr)** (Numerous) are added, at a cost of €100,000 each, at today's supplementary stage. Khalid Abdullah's **Workforce (GB)** (King's Best) has yet to be confirmed a definite starter, but a decision is expected after the G1 Epsom Derby hero completes a morning spin on the Newmarket gallops today. "From what I'm told, he's due to have a blow-out on Thursday," the owner's racing manager Teddy Grimthorpe told *PA Sport*. "It's not going to be anything major, and there will be no decision until then." Track conditions are currently described as soft, but Longchamp's clerk of the course, Christian Delporte, fears continued adverse weather will cause further deterioration to the Bois de Boulogne turf. "We have had a shower today, with some sun, but it is not great for the weekend with rain [forecast]," Delporte said. "The ground is soft and, with the rain Saturday, it will probably be very soft. The condition of the track is not good--I think it is soft, but it will be okay."

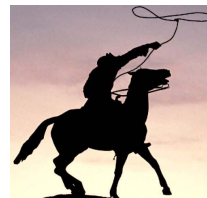

**Markab & Borderlescott out of Abbaye...**

The Tight Lines Partnership's **Markab (GB)** (Green Desert), winner of the Sept. 4 G1 Haydock Sprint Cup, has been forced out of Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Abbaye following an unsatisfactory scope, it emerged yesterday. "It's obviously very disappointing," trainer Henry Candy told *PA Sport*. "Markab worked this morning by himself and looked absolutely fine, but it's one of those things." This month's career high may also turn out to be Markab's last run for Candy, as he explained, "That's him done for the year now, and the leading member of the Tight Lines Partnership, Ed de Giles, is taking out a training licence himself next year. The horse is going to the horses-in-training sale at Tattersalls at the end of October to dissolve the partnership. Goodness knows after that, but we've had a fantastic time with him this year." **Cont. p11**

Trainer Robin Bastiman has also ruled out dual G1 Nunthorpe S. hero **Borderlescott (GB)** (Compton Place {GB}), who he feels has not fully recovered from a muscle injury sustained when garnering the G2 King George S. at Goodwood in July, despite having raced twice since. "Borderlescott is okay, but he seems to have this muscle problem, it's lurking somewhere," Bastiman told *PA Sport*. "He's still sound, but something is not quite right. In hindsight, maybe we shouldn't have run [in the Aug. 20 G1 Nunthorpe S.] at York and [the Sept. 4 G1 Sprint Cup at] Haydock, but sometimes you let your heart rule your head. He's fine, so we'll give him some physio and give him the rest of the year off. We'll have another go with him next year. I don't think age will be a problem, as he hasn't got many miles on the clock. As long as his heart is still in it, we'll keep going."

**Strawberrydaiquiri Sold...**

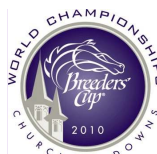

With Darley's spending reduction, I think some Americans were energized and got stronger than they had been in a long time.

**Were you happy with the new September format?** On the whole I believe it was an improvement. It created some inconvenience for both buyers and sellers, but it also got the sale started with a bang instead of a bust.

If racehorse owners came together (similar to the player's union in the NFL) to collectively bargain and the racetracks operated like the NFL owners, there would be some structure.

We need an over-arching governing body which establishes basic rules the two sides can negotiate within and facilitate agreements on key issues like medication, take out, creation of race series leading to Championships, etc. The Jockey Club is the ultimate authority as they control black-type on pedigrees. They would be the logical governing body. Until we get structure, all we are doing is hacking at the limbs of our troubles. Lack of structure is the root of the problem.

**What is your favorite racetrack and why?** Keeneland is incredible, but I think Del Mar would have to be #1. It has great atmosphere, great racing and the Pacific Ocean, which is a pretty unbeatable trifecta!

**What is playing on your CD player right now?** The Gourds. They are an Austin Texas band that features some of the best song writing I've ever heard combined with a sound that is 40% rock, 20% country, 20% Bluegrass and the rest is a strange mixture of blues, funk and disco. Seeing them live is my favorite pastime!

**Favorite actor and movie?** Actor--Clint Eastwood. Movie--*The Last Waltz*.

**Childhood ambition?** My brothers had Taylor Made starting up when I was still a kid. It was not really on many people's radar at all. I can remember asking my Dad if he thought there would be a place for me at Taylor Made when I grew up. It seemed like all the jobs were covered to me. He asked me what my favorite thing was. INTERNATIONAL SIMULCASTING CONFERENCE DRAWS FROM NEAR AND FAR

The 2010 International Simulcasting Conference, sponsored jointly by the Thoroughbred Racing Associations and the Harness Tracks of America, was held Sept. 20 through Sept. 22 at the Sheraton Sand Key Resort in Clearwater, Florida, and attracted horse racing officials and horseplayers from every corner of the world. The very first panel, entitled "International Simulcasting: Dynamics, Issues and Opportunities," featured representatives from racing jurisdictions in the United States, Dubai, Latin America and South Africa, and demonstrated the difficulties and obstacles that exist in opening simulcast signals to locations abroad. While there is agreement on the desire to expand simulcasting, fundamental problems exist, including the incompatibility of technology, differences in past performance data from jurisdiction to jurisdiction and a variety of take-out rates. For example, takeout in the United States is generally around 20 percent, while in Latin American countries, it can vary from 28 to 35 percent. And while the export of major racing programs to overseas recipients has proved popular and has been well-received, there is a widespread belief that more frequent exports could over-saturate customers. Alex Dadoyan, assistant vice president of the Meadowlands, explained that the track's Hambletonian program has been exported successfully to European markets, but questioned how it would be received on regular days. A Tuesday session on "Computer Modeling in Pari-Mutuel Wagering" focused on the growth of betting via Internet platforms and outlined the concerns of those who wager in that fashion and of those who offer the services. Also invited to the conference were Monmouth Park Vice President and General Manager Bob Kulina and Dennis Drazin, chairman of the New Jersey Racing Commission, who explained to the attendees the mechanics of putting together this summer's elite 50-day meet, which was a wild success by all accounts.
