THREE CHEERS FOR CHEVELEY PARK S.

Today's wide-open G1 Adnams Cheveley Park S. at Newmarket is almost a rerun of York's G2 Lowther S. Aug. 19, when a positively ridden **Hooray (GB)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) was 3/4 of a length too good for **Margot Did (Ire)** (Exceed and Excel {Aus}), with **Rimth (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) and **Maqaasid (GB)** (Green Desert) at safe distance back in third and fourth, respectively. Taken to Kempton for the G3 Sirenia S. on Polytrack Sept. 4, the winner followed up in authoritative style, but encounters

ground softer than ideal on this occasion. "Hooray has been a very progressive filly all through the season, and we hope she continues to surprise us," Managing Director Chris Richardson, whose Cheveley Park Stud was successful with Gay Gallanta (Woodman) in 1994 and Regal Rose (GB) (Danehill) in 2000, told *PA Sport*. "We are still intending to run, but the forecast is a concern. She's not the same filly on soft ground. If she were not to run, there are other options, and I suppose the G2 Rockfel S. [at Newmarket Oct. 16] could be one of those." Ed Dunlop saddles an intriguing runner in the Aug. 14 Lingfield maiden winner **Sharnberry (GB)** (Shamardal). "We had the option of the Oh So Sharp or the big sales race, but she shows plenty of speed and worked well on Tuesday morning, so we have decided to let her take her chance in the big one over six furlongs," Dunlop said. "The ground was on the soft side when she won so impressively at Lingfield, so I would hope that she would cope with the conditions, though we feel that she will always be more effective on a good surface." **Cont. p2**

DREAM ON

Dream Ahead (Diktat {GB}), so impressive when a nine-length debut winner on good-to-soft ground at Nottingham July 16, bids for a third consecutive win in today's G1 Shadwell Middle Park S. at Newmarket. The colt proved up to being pitched into the deep end in Deauville's G1 Prix Morny last time Aug. 22, where he had the re-opposing **Irish Field (Ire)** (Dubawi {Ire}) and **Al Aasifh (Ire)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) back in fifth and 10th, respectively, and the rain has come to strengthen his already rock-solid claims. "This is the obvious route and is the weaker of the two Group 1s next to the Dewhurst," trainer David Simcock explained. "If he was to win, we'd half-think about that race, but he does need cut in the ground, as he has a big action and hits the ground very hard. He's a big horse and although he's very mature now, he's got plenty of scope. He will definitely stay seven furlongs in the future, is very talented, and his first two runs have really matured him. We are very positive about him and, hopefully, we'll have a long winter to dream about him." **Cont. p2**

Newbury maiden May 14 and G2 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot June 15 won by Canford Cliffs (Ire) (Tagula {Ire}). Like that illustrious stable companion, the wheels came off on his travels next time and, while his predecessor, let favorite-backers down when third in the G1 Prix

Morny in 2009, Strong Suit disappointed when filling the same spot in the Aug. 8 G1 Phoenix S. at The Curragh. "We have more strength in depth in the youngsters than we have ever had, but if pushed I'd still say that this fellow was the best of them," Hannon said. "He had to be special to do what he did at Royal Ascot, but, for whatever reason, he didn't fire in the Phoenix S. in Ireland, and the form has to be wrong as we beat the winner Zoffany (Ire) (Dansili {GB}) seven lengths in the Coventry. Hughesie is adamant that he is better dropped out, so we will probably revert to those tactics and, though it looks a hot renewal, we have certainly not lost faith that Strong Suit is the real deal."

Temple Meads, who was another flopping favorite when only fourth behind Approve in the Aug. 18 G2 Gimcrack S. at York, rebounded with a convincing success in the G2 Mill Reef S. at Newbury Sept. 18. Trainer Ed McMahon told *PA Sport*, "We're going into a Group 1 with hopefully all the credentials. It's probably a stiffer race. I'm going there hopeful and hoping there is no more rain. He deserves every chance in a Group 1, and nobody would deny him that. It's just a shame it went a bit the wrong way in the Gimcrack, but even so he has proved a point that he got the six furlongs very well."

Easier conditions may bring stamina into play and **Wild Wind (Ger)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) stayed every part of the seven furlongs of Sunday's G3 C L Weld

Park S. at The Curragh when a head second to Chrysanthemum (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}). That represented an improvement on her previous fifth behind stable companion Misty For Me (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) and Laughing Lashes (Mr. Greeley) in the Aug. 29 G1 Moyglare Stud S., having beaten the latter when opening her account over the same track and trip June 26. Dubai Millennium (GB) relished soft ground and, although his half-sister **Ragsah (Ire)** (Shamardal) has yet to race on it, she at least showed that she sees out this trip well when a strong-closing runner-up after being stopped in her run at a crucial stage during Ayr's G3 Firth of Clyde S. last time Sept. 18. "Ragsah ran a very good race to take second at Ayr and she always tries in her races," trainer Saeed bin Suroor commented. "She has been working well and looks in good condition. It's a big step up in class for her, but she deserves a chance in a Group 1 contest, and I am hopeful that she can run another nice race."

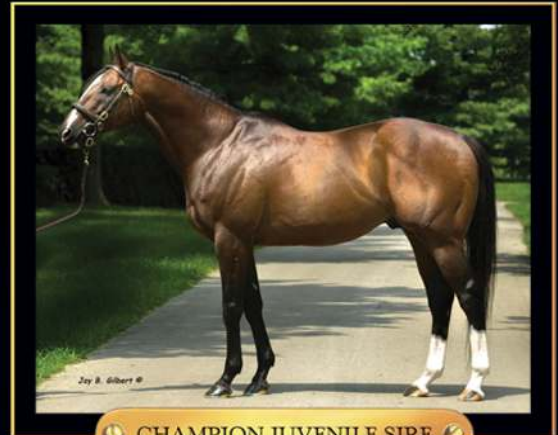

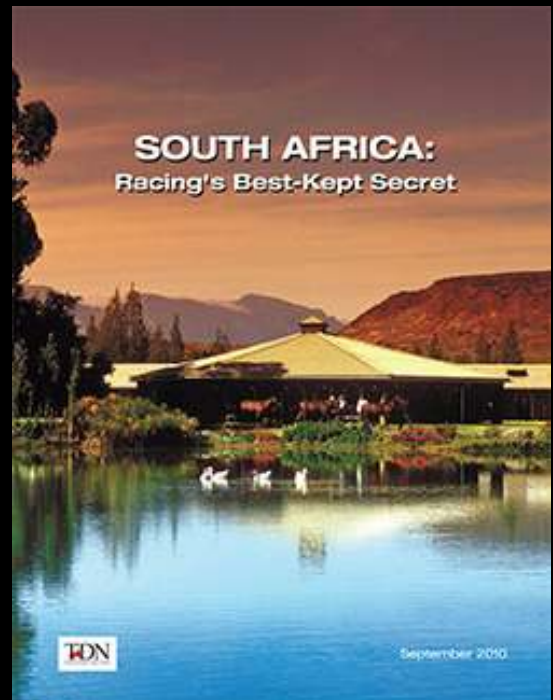
WORKFORCE GETS GREEN LIGHT

While the overall average of €47,800 was down by four percent, the €29,000 median was up by the same. Indeed, we have received countless compliments about our marketing of the sale, although a lot of that is down to the superb racetrack results of Goffs graduates over the last 18 months. Those results flow from the excellent yearlings we have selected with our vendors each year, and the payback is that those Irish breeders who have supported us with their best stock have been well-rewarded in the sales ring. On the facts there is no denying that the market has been selective, but there have been plenty of success stories and happy breeders/pinhookers, especially on days one and two. That has been endorsed by the general consensus that the good ones have been as hard to buy as ever, and we are grateful to the vendors who have stepped up to the mark with us. This year's sale has been a consolidation of our 'Focus is the Horse' policy that we introduced last year with a smaller catalogue that placed the emphasis well and truly on the individual. That policy has certainly met with the approval of the buying bench, which has been as strong as ever at any sale. The statistics may well show a slight fall in turnover and average, but there are so many positives from the 2010 Orby Sale--a top price that was double last year's, two lots realizing over €500,000 compared to none last year, a 3.6-percent rise in the median price, some significant new buyers who have vowed to return having been very impressed with all aspects of the sale and a really positive atmosphere from start to finish."

It's Dubawi Again...

It was no surprise that Dubawi (Ire) would dominate yesterday's much lower-key proceedings, and the sire of Makfi (GB) and Poet's Voice (GB) supplied the top-priced colt and filly. Hip 601, from Ballybin Stud, is a May-foaled half-brother to the 2002 G2 German 1000 Guineas winner Portella (Ger) (Protektor {Ger}) and her listed-placed brother Predator (Ger) who was snapped up by John Ferguson for €80,000. Darley's Mick Buckley, who bid for the colt, said, "He's a May foal, but we've seen him a few times and he's progressing and maturing all the time. He's bred along similar lines to Poet's Voice, as he's a son of Dubawi from a Danzig-line mare." Stamina Turf SI was the name on the docket for his filly offered by John Jones and Kildangan Stud. Out of an unraced half to the 2002 G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest winner May Ball (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) and Godolphin's listed-winning Rampallion (GB) (Daylami {Ire}), hip 515 fetched €56,000. Ten lots earlier, Anthony Stroud Bloodstock paid €60,000 for Windgates Stud's son of Marju (Ire). His dam is a full-sister to the listed-placed Approval (GB) (Royal Applause {GB}) and half to the German champion and sire Sharp Prod, as well as to the dam of the 2006 G2 Mehl-Mulhens Rennen (German 2000 Guineas) scorer Royal Power (Ire) (Xaar {GB}).

From Barnane Stud, she is a half-sister to a Scandinavian champion in Xstase (Swe) (Tremolino). Ross Doyle also paid €40,000 for J K Thoroughbreds' hip [509](#), a colt by Choisir (Aus) from the immediate family of the Listed-winning and group-placed Becomes You (GB) (Lomitas {GB}). "He's a fine, big, good-looking colt who will be joining Richard [Hannon] for the Byerley Racing Syndicate," Doyle said. "He's by a sire that we have enjoyed a lot of luck with already through the likes of Fat Boy (Ire)." Morrinstown Lattin Stud's Dark Angel (Ire) is another whose yearlings have been well received so far this year. He was responsible for a Barrettstown Farm House-consigned colt who sold to Bobby O'Ryan for €40,000. Hip [483](#) is a half-brother to the 2001 Windsor Castle S. winner and G2 Mill Reef S. runner-up Irony (Ire) (Mujadil) and this year's listed scorer Carioca (Ire) (Rakti {GB}). "He's a good-looking colt with a good step to him," O'Ryan commented. "He has been bought to go to Dermot Weld."

Europeans Ready for Sunny Skies...

A pair of European imports are set to have their U.S. debuts for familiar connections Saturday. Godolphin's **Hibaayeb (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}) is expected to relish the

firm going in the GI Yellow Ribbon S. The dark bay filly, who broke her maiden in the G1 Fillies' Mile last September, captured the G2 Ribblesdale S. at Royal Ascot in June, but has been

unplaced in three subsequent starts. "She likes the fast ground," said assistant trainer Claire Sparks. "We're hoping for a quick surface. She shipped well and arrived Monday." The three-year-old is coming off a seventh to Middy (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) in the G1 Yorkshire Oaks Aug. 19. J. Paul Reddam's new acquisition **Boxeur des Rues** (Smart Strike) acquainted himself with the local Cushion Track Wednesday ahead of the GI Norfolk S. The juvenile went three-eighths in :37.60. The bay colt made an eye-catching debut on Kempton's all-weather track Sept. 3 ([video](#)). "He walked out of the gate in his debut and came flying," said new trainer Doug O'Neill. "He was bought privately after that. He just cleared quarantine a few days ago."

Snow Fairy out of Opera...

Citing unsuitable track conditions, Newmarket trainer Ed Dunlop yesterday revealed dual Classic heroine **Snow Fairy (Ire)** (Intikhab) will not run in Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Opera at Longchamp, and will instead point to the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket Oct. 16. Dunlop also offered the same reason for why G3 Solario S. winner **Native Khan (Fr)** (Azamour {Ire}) will not contest the G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere on the same card. "It was an easy decision in the end, the ground is soft at Longchamp and getting softer by the minute," Dunlop explained. "It looks like being the most testing conditions they have had on Arc day since 1999, so there is no point in us travelling. Snow Fairy will be kept in reserve for the Champion Stakes at Newmarket, while Native Khan still has two options, the [G1] Dewhurst [at Newmarket Oct. 16] or the [Oct. 23 G1] Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster."

Brazilian Import to UAE Derby Via Indiana Derby...

If nothing else, F. Thomas Conway's **Uareoutlaw (Brz)** (Christine's Outlaw) adds some intrigue to Saturday's GII Indiana Derby. The colt makes his first start in the U.S. in the nine-furlong race for Conway and trainer Mike Maker, who teamed to win last weekend's \$150,000 Ontario Derby with Stately Victory (Ghostzapper). Stately Victor brought Conway and his son, Kentucky senatorial hopeful Jack Conway, national attention earlier in the year when he punched his ticket to the GI Kentucky Derby with a 40-1 upset of the GI Blue Grass S. at Keeneland. He ran eighth in the "Run for the Roses."

Uareoutlaw is a Brazilian-bred acquired by Conway privately this spring. The colt, a newly turned three-year-old in Southern Hemisphere time, was purchased off a win in the G2 GP Presidente Jose De Souza Queiroz S. at Cidade Jardim Mar. 13. Because of his birthday--he was born in August of 2007--he will be eligible for next season's \$2 million G2 UAE Derby in Dubai.

"Mr. Conway has a few friends down in Brazil, and they recommended the horse," explained Maker. "They bought him with the UAE Derby in mind."

Uareoutlaw raced twice in Brazil for his new connections. He was second as favorite in the G1 GP Juliano Martins S. May 16, and won the G1GP J. Adhemar De Almeida Prado S. by 3/4 lengths June 26. The victory, over 1600 meters on the grass, came in a sharp 1:33 1/5. Conway then shipped the colt to the States, to Maker's base at the Trackside Louisville training center. Maker said there have been mixed signals in the morning, but the colt's worktab reads like that of a good horse. Uareoutlaw has six recorded works, four of them bullets, including five-furlong drills in :59 4/5 Sept. 8 and 1:00 4/5 Sept. 20, and a best-of-18 four furlongs in :47 4/5 in his latest Monday.

"He doesn't give you a great impression galloping--he's very lazy," said Maker. "But he's been deceptively good in his works. It doesn't look like he's doing much and, though I'm not one to put a lot of emphasis on time, he's recorded some impressive times."

One of several questions surrounding Uareoutlaw is how he'll handle the dirt in a race conditions. His lone start on dirt was a well-beaten runner-up effort in his debut. But Maker isn't worried.

"He trains here over the dirt fine, and that's why decided to take a shot," said the trainer. "We'll throw him at the top horses and work our way down if we have to."

Maker added that the map to Dubai has yet to be plotted beyond Saturday night. "We'll play it off this race and get a feel for him and where we should go next," he said. -LM

Saamidd Books Dewhurst Date...

Impressive G2 Champagne S. winner **Saamidd (GB)** (Street Cry {Ire}) is to be supplemented, at a cost of £20,000, for the G1 Dewhurst S. at Newmarket Oct. 16 after pleasing connections in a pre-racing gallop at Newmarket's Rowley Mile racetrack yesterday. Partnered by Frankie Dettori, the unbeaten juvenile worked seven furlongs in the company of two stablemates. "We were very pleased with Saamidd's work today, and we are looking forward to running him in the Dubai Dewhurst S. next month," said racing manager Simon Crisford.

GRAND COUTURIER Seven-year-old **Grand Couturier (GB)** (Grand Lodge--Lady Elgar {Ire}, by Sadler's Wells), two-time winner of the G1 Sword Dancer Invitational S. at Saratoga, has been retired after a recurrence of an ankle injury.

"We were getting ready to go to Canada a few weeks ago [for the [G1 Northern Dancer S. at Woodbine], and his ankle flared up," trainer Bobby Ribaud said. "Although the tests are fine now, we didn't think it would be worth the risk of

continuing to race him." Campaigned by Marc Keller, Grand Couturier took the Sword Dancer in 2007 and 2008, and also captured the '08 GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic Invitational S. and '09 GII Bowling Green BC H. A listed winner and group placed in France, the bay retires with a record of 28-8-1-6 and earnings just shy of \$1.5 million. "He lived and trained here in New York the last five years," Ribaud said. "Marc and I are New York guys and we wanted him to run here as much as possible." Stud plans have not been determined.

Santa Anita Track Renovation Begins Oct. 11:

The process that will return Santa Anita to a natural dirt track surface will begin Oct. 11 with the removal of the current synthetic material. Track officials said yesterday that the main track will be completed by Dec. 6, giving horsemen the opportunity to train over it before the Santa Anita meet starts Dec. 26. Project Manager Ted Malloy remarked, "The surface will be similar to those at Gulfstream, Churchill Downs and to the Oklahoma track at Saratoga. We're going to put nine inches of a mixture of sand and clay on top of an eight-inch base." Malloy continued, "The dirt surface that was here a few years ago had quite a bit of clay in it and, when it was sealed, it became very hard--which is something we want to avoid."

SACRED KINGDOM RESUMES IN SHA TIN TROPHY

He hasn't raced in over seven months and hasn't won off an extended break in over three years, but **Sacred Kingdom (Aus)** (Encosta de Lago {Aus}) should prove a warm item when he makes his return in today's Sha Tin Trophy up the 1000-meter straight course. After winning the G1 Hong Kong Sprint for the second time in three years last December, the gelding added a pair of domestic Group 1 events in January and February, then was stricken by a near-fatal bout of colic when just about ready to take off for the G1 Takamatsunomiya Kinen in Japan. He's been nursed back to 100-percent health by trainer Ricky Yiu, who expects a top performance this afternoon. "He looks very healthy on the track in the mornings, his trial was very good and I think he will come back to the same form he was in at his peak," the conditioner told *South China Morning Post*. "He had a very good rest and we took our time, but he is back to his normal training now." Sacred Kingdom spots his rivals, including Hong Kong Sprint runner-up **One World (Aus)** (Daneshill Dancer {Ire}) eight to 20 pounds. In the day's co-feature, three-time G1 Hong Kong Mile hero **Good Ba Ba** (Lear Fan) squares off with and is in receipt of three pounds from two-time G1 Champions Mile victor **Able One (NZ)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) in the National Day Cup H. over Sha Tin's metric mile.

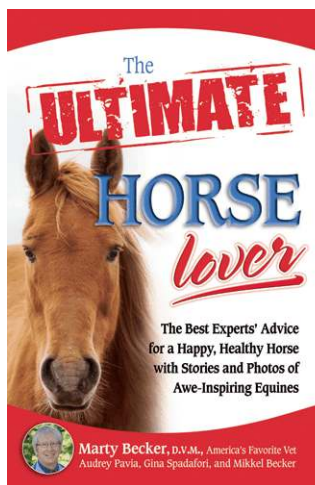
