A FORCE TO BE RECKONED WITH

Khalid Abdullah's **Workforce (GB)** (King's Best) had to wait out a stewards' enquiry, but after the tension came the joy as Khalid Abdullah's G1 Epsom Derby hero was hailed victorious in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp yesterday. Sent off at a generous 15-2 as a result of a tame effort when fifth in the July 24 G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. at Ascot, the brilliant homebred put the dark

day behind him when denying the Japanese a historic first with a head defeat of **Nakayama Festa (Jpn)** (Stay Gold {Jpn}). In doing so, he became only the sixth winner of Epsom's blue riband to follow up here, and gave Sir Michael Stoute a long-awaited first renewal of this great race. "If you have any ambition from the time you start training, you want to win the Arc de Triomphe," Stoute commented. Buried in mid-pack early, Workforce was in proximity to the hampered **Lope de Vega (Ire)** (Shamardal) as they neared the furlong pole, but emerged from the crowd in the straight and fought off the runner-up to prevail by a head. Work in Progress...

Only a handful of horses have won the Epsom Derby by as much as Workforce's seven-length margin, and none had covered the mile-and-a-half distance faster, but such brilliant displays have proved to be false dawns in the past. He needed to reproduce that level of form to enter championship territory. The three-year-old had hung and looked uncomfortable when runner-up in the G1 Dante S. at York May 13 and, when he dropped out in Ascot's home straight to finish nearly 17 lengths behind Harbinger (GB) (Dansili {GB}) in the King George, the vibes became increasingly negative. With that in mind, the Stoute stable went down to brass tacks, and Workforce's recent racecourse spin at Sandown--which did not receive glowing reports from those present--was the only subsequent public sighting of the Classic hero. But those who kept the faith in the time-honored Stoute magic were rewarded with a starting price that looked impossible in the immediate aftermath of the Derby. Kept tight to the rail by Ryan Moore early, Workforce had only a handful of rivals behind at the top of the "false straight," but had gone the shortest way round, and that proved a crucial factor as he started his challenge before the quarter pole. Lope de Vega, who headed the field at the top of the stretch, was tiring when getting the worst of the interference that caused the lengthy enquiry, and eventually was judged to have been caused by the subsequently disqualified seventh Planteur (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}).

Avoiding the tangle, Workforce surged past to engage Nakayama Festa and Masayoshi Ebina of El Condor Pasa fame. He had to grind it out, but the colt got his head in front before answering every call from his rider in a pulsating finale. "He was back to his best today," winning jockey Ryan Moore said. "We got a nice run through and, when it all got a bit tight at the top of the false straight, there was half a gap there and he was very brave and really quickened into it well. The Japanese horse kept at him, but he kept doing enough and has a great attitude. Ascot wasn't him; this was only the fifth race of his life, and he's won a Derby and an Arc." Moore added, "To me, winning the Derby and the Arc in the same year is obviously something exceptional. The Derby is the race I always wanted to win, but winning a race such as the Arc is probably more important for the horse. Everyone knows how good a trainer Sir Michael is and he's done a great job with Workforce. After the King George, he always said that if the horse was well he would run in the Arc and he brought him along progressively. We were very happy with him when he worked at Sandown and, since then, he has not stopped improving, so I was confident he would run a great race today." **Cont. p3**

Trial, Error & the Arc...

Sir Michael Stoute was quick to shoulder the blame for Workforce's disappointing run at Ascot. "Ryan blames himself for Ascot and felt he should have switched him off more, but I think I may have trained

him too hard for the race. I said that to Prince Khalid afterwards, and I think I was proved right on that, so we took a different path this time. I don't know if I'm likely to train him next year, but I'd love to." Workforce's win represented a fourth for his owner after Rainbow Quest in 1985, Dancing Brave a year later and Rail Link (GB) in 2006. Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe paid tribute to the trainer when saying, "It's a great moment. The first two, Rainbow Quest and Dancing Brave, were horses we bought but the last two, Rail Link

and Workforce, are both homebreds and that is a great achievement for Juddmonte and everyone involved. There aren't words strong enough to describe the quality of the work Sir Michael Stoute and his team have done with this horse--to bring him back at the top after his moderate effort in the King George and after such a long break between the two races--it really is a great training feat. His future will now be discussed by Prince Khalid and Sir Michael and he will most likely stay in training as a four-year-old. It is unlikely that he will run again this year."

So Near, So Far (Again)...

Eleven years ago, Nakayama Festa's jockey Masayoshi Ebina was cruelly denied an Arc victory on El Condor Pasa (Kingmambo) by Montjeu (Ire) close home and it was a case of history repeating yesterday. As he had on that occasion, he adopted positive tactics in early stretch and once again was run out of it by an elite three-year-old. The runner-up's trainer Yoshitaka Ninomiya said, "We're very proud with the way the horse has run. He had come on a lot for his last race in the G2 Prix Foy and we're very happy. It is most likely we will take him back home now and try to have him ready to run in the [Nov. 28] Japan Cup." That is also the target of compatriot **Victoire Pisa (Jpn)** (Neo Universe {Jpn}), who was eighth before being promoted to seventh. Sarafina, who was seriously impeded at the end of the false straight as **Midas Touch (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) back-pedaled, looked unlucky after delivering a telling burst of acceleration to swamp her better-fancied fellow Aga Khan-bred and owned **Behkabad (Fr)** (Cape Cross {Ire}). Her rider Gerald Mosse was not using that as an excuse, however. "It didn't really bother me, as it gave me the opportunity to let her catch her breath," he told *PA Sport*.

Mosse continued, "She had a good spurt on her second wind and I'm very pleased." Behkabad's trainer Jean-Claude Rouget said of the G1 Grand Prix de Paris winner, who was sent off the 9-2 favorite, "He had a wall of horses in front of him at 400 meters and was blocked in, but you know you need luck in this race and I'm not disappointed. It is likely that he will go to stud at the end of the year, but there is a good chance that as long as we are invited, he will have one more race in the [Dec. 12] Hong Kong Cup at Sha Tin."

On the card in which Zarkava (Ire) (Zamindar) entered legend two years ago, Goldikova was carving her own special mark into history with a record-equaling victory at the top level. Were it not for His Highness The Aga Khan's greatest distaffer, the extraordinary Wertheimer homebred would have the 2008 G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches to her name, and that missing Classic win would mean she would have already surpassed Dahlia. As it is, Churchill Downs will be the stage for her bid for immortality as she attempts a third consecutive BC Mile, which could well be run on her favored fast surface. Beaten by Makfi (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) over soft turf in the Aug. 15 G1 Prix Jacques le Marois last time, her trainer had some major concerns whether to chance her again in ground so testing, but gave Paris what it wanted when committing to run. Straight into the lead and traveling with all her usual gusto in front, she allowed Regal Parade (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) past at the quarter pole with Peslier sitting tight in a masterclass of cool. As Dick Turpin (Ire) (Arakan) and the later-closing Paco Boy were delivered out wide, it was time to go and she duly went through the gears with the minimum of fuss. "Olivier gave her a great ride and she has such a heart for the fight," said Freddy Head. "Once again, I'd like to thank her owners, who have sportingly kept her in training this season. That was most probably her last race in France and the plan has always been to attempt a third Breeders' Cup Mile, so that is where she goes now." Trainer Richard Hannon was again playing second fiddle to Goldikova and told *PA Sport*, "It was a bit unfortunate coming into the straight that we lost ground, because from stall one, she [Goldikova] had such a massive advantage. We were boxed in stalls nine and 10. Dick Turpin ran a great race and there will be another day for him. And with Paco, we'll sleep on it and see about the Breeders' Cup Mile. The trouble is, wherever we go, Goldikova keeps turning up."

PAS DE PROBLEME

Prior to yesterday's G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere at Longchamp, the unbeaten **Wootton Bassett (GB)** (Iffraaj {GB}) had a lack of black-type purely due to the riches on offer in Britain's major sales races, but he showed he was of the highest caliber with a dominant front-running performance here. Tough as well as classy when annexing the Aug. 19 DBS Premier Yearling S. at York and Doncaster's Weatherbys Insurance £300,000 2-Y-O S. last time Sept. 9, the bay never needed to reach into his reserves to land the odds of 5-1 by 2 1/2 lengths from the dead-heating **Tin Horse (Ire)** (Sakhee) and **Maiguri (Ire)** (Panis) under a perfectly judged ride from Britain's champion jockey-elect Paul Hanagan.

Wootton Bassett's quality was in evidence from the word go and after beating subsequent winners with authority on debut over six furlongs at Ayr June 19 and in a novice event at Doncaster July 15, added near £150,000 to his earnings when getting the better of Galtymore Lad (GB) (Indesatchel {Ire}) in the DBS Premier Yearling S. over that trip at York's Ebor meeting. It was that rival who was forced to succumb again over an extra half-furlong despite an eight-pound turnaround in the weights, as owners Frank Brady and the Cosmic Cases syndicate swelled the coffers by almost £200,000 in the Weatherbys Insurance 2-Y-O S. Resisting the temptation of more gold in Redcar's valuable Listed Two-Year-Old Trophy staged 24 hours earlier, connections pointed at the Group 1 here and never had a moment to regret that choice. Soon in a clear lead, he traveled enthusiastically without over-racing and as soon as he had kicked inside the final quarter had put his seal on the contest. "This is by far the best two-year-old I have ever trained," trainer Richard Fahey said. "I have had this race at the back of my mind for a long time, but before that, I took the liberty of running in sales races. He had banked more than £350,000 before coming here, so we can be pretty happy with how the season has panned out."

Fahey added, "We will put him away now and I think he'll stay a mile next year. We'll put him in all the Guineas and all the top Group 1 races." The Aug. 22 G1 Prix Morny runner-up Tin Horse was the only rival to stay on to real effect when he was freed from a pocket late on. ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ Moonlight Cloud (GB) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) failed to threaten in fourth.

Michael Tabor, Susan Magnier & Derrick Smith's **Misty For Me (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) had upstaged more fancied rivals when making all to land the odds at 10-1 when last seen in the seven-furlong G1 Moyglare Stud S. on good-to-firm at The Curragh Aug. 29, and showed the same never-say-die attitude yesterday to follow up on testing ground in Longchamp's G1 Prix Marcel Boussac. Sent off the 4-1 second choice in the face of strong support for the 7-10 crowd's choice **Helleborine (GB)** (Observatory), the bay moved from second to first at the top of the stretch and, despite being headed by that rival for a few strides soon after, kept stretching for Johnny Murtagh to go away and win by a length.

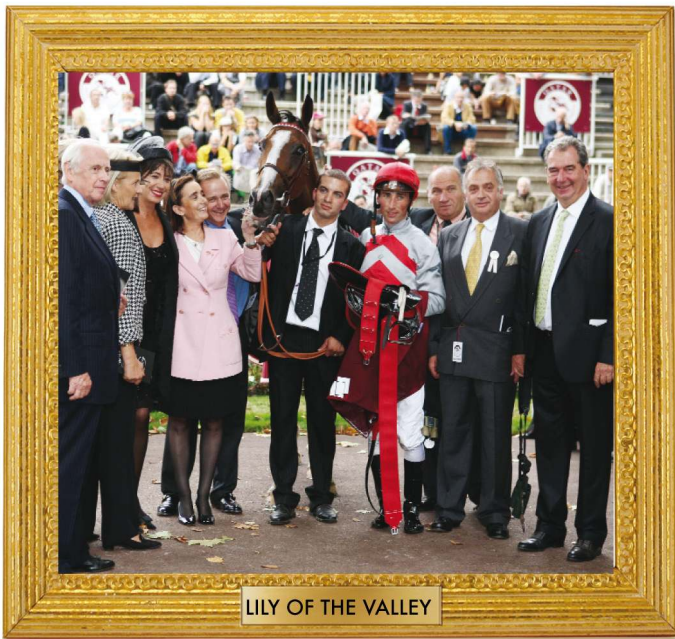
Down in trip once more and off the board in the July 29 G2 King George S. at Goodwood, Gilt Edge Girl looked to have the six-furlong G2 Goldene Peitsche wrapped up until caught late by Amico Fritz (Ger) (Fasliyev) and Contat (Ger) (Diktat {GB}) there Aug. 29. Gentoo entered the Sept. 12 G3 Prix Gladiateur a virtual unknown in the staying category, and his win in that near two-mile contest had a flukish whiff about it with some high-profile rivals running into traffic in behind. One of those had been France's top marathoner

Kasbah Bliss, and he was widely expected to reverse that form in his attempt to go one better than his second in this 12 months ago, but Gentoo had other ideas, and readily confirmed the form fair-and-square for a career high. Claimed by his current owner after winning at Vichy in July 2007, the bay progressed steadily as he plied his trade in the Parisian handicaps and conditions events over mainly middle distances, and finally earned a tilt at black-type after pushing

the smart all-weather specialist Dansant (GB) (Danili {GB}) to a short neck in a conditions event over a mile and a half at Deauville Aug. 14. This time Kasbah Bliss had a clear run and no excuses, and it was that rival who had the bullseye on his back as Gerald Mosse waited in rear on Gentoo. Switched on during the final turn, he produced a sustained surge down the outside to pass his archrival with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining, and pulled clear for a resounding success from the staying-on Winter Dream. "This is the greatest moment of my career," beamed trainer Alain Lyon. "It is the first time I had a runner in a Group 1 race, and I had to wait so many years for the opportunity. It is quite exceptional for me. Gentoo was doing very well at home and confirmed that his win in the Gladiateur was no fluke. He was given a brilliant ride by Gerald Mosse, and the owner is so happy. It is just a magic moment. He's had two tough races within three weeks and we'll have to see how he recovers before we make a decision whether we keep him for next year, or run him back in the G1 Prix Royal-Oak [at Longchamp Oct. 24]." Coming off a third-place effort to Tell a Kelly in the GI Darley Debutante S. at Del Mar, Rigoletta sat in second a few lengths off :23.70 and :47.50 fractions. She rallied three wide into the stretch as Tell a Kelly slipped between her and the pacesetting Indian Gracey. It was three in a line a furlong out, but Rigoletta proved gamest, surging late to become the biggest longshot to ever win the race. Rigoletta opened up her career with a fifth going 5 1/2 furlongs at Hollywood July 15, then rallied to win a race going the same distance at Del Mar Aug. 8. This was her first two-turn test. "I think the reason she was a big price is she's more of a grinder, but going two turns sometimes that grinding works very well," said trainer Dan Hendricks. "She let the speed out ahead, and closers can't get to you all the time." Connections are now faced with a nine-percent supplemental fee if they choose to go on to the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Nov. 5, as Rigoletta is not currently nominated to the championship event. "My vote is we run," said Hendricks. "No guts no glory. You're going for the championship. I'd love to go." In an interview on TVG, Hendricks was quick to give credit to agent Marette Farrell, whom he said kept dragging him back to see the filly at the OBS April Sale. "After the third or fourth time, I finally said yes," said Hendricks. Trainer John Sadler was content with the runner-up's effort. "Maybe she was little compromised by the trip, but we thought she ran a good race," he said. "We're disappointed not to win, but we'll probably go on to the Breeders' Cup." Champ Pegasus needed four attempts to break his maiden--accomplished at Santa Anita in April--but he's quickly developed into one of the top turf horses in California. "I worked him the other morning and he went great, like he was really ready to go." Trainer Dick Mandella was happy with the effort, but noncommittal about a tilt in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf. "He showed that style at Del Mar that he was kind of believing in himself to do it," said Mandella. "He just kind of keeps improving and getting better as we go. We'll probably have to get a little bit better than this to win the Breeders' Cup." :51.11 and 1:16.17 splits. Air Support came through between rivals in mid-stretch, bumped with the odds-on Soldat, then edged away late to win by daylight. Alan Garcia, on the chalk, lodged an objection, but stewards let the result stand. Trainer Shug McGaughey was hoping

the move downstate could help Air Support turn the tables on his rival. "[The course in Saratoga] was like a conveyor belt, and I thought he ran a good race--he just couldn't catch up, it was so speed conducive," said the Hall of Famer. "The winner showed he was a nice horse, but I thought if I got him back to Belmont, we'd catch a little bit fairer track, and we obviously did." So is the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf at Churchill Nov. 6 in the cards? "If he comes out of it OK, why not?" said McGaughey. "Unless somebody says no, we'll see." Kiaran McLaughlin, who conditions the runner-up, said his charge will likely head to the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf, as well. "We'll probably continue on," he said. RACETRACK Round-Up

Blame Heads to BC Classic; Haynesfield Possible

The connections of the top two finishers of the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup--**Haynesfield** (Speightstown) and **Blame** (Arch)--discussed their options in regard to a possible start in the Breeders' Cup Classic at Churchill Downs Nov. 6. According to Haynesfield's trainer Steve Asmussen, the New York bred may make his next start in the 10-furlong GI BC Classic, but a final decision would not be made until connections had a chance to assess how the chestnut emerged from the 10-furlong race. The beaten favorite in Saturday's race, Blame, was scheduled to fly back to Kentucky today and will train at Keeneland prior to an intended start in the Classic, according to trainer Al Stall Jr. Sunday. "We're disappointed that we didn't win, but he's still on track for the Breeders' Cup," confirmed Stall. "We're going to keep doing what we had been doing with him. He didn't run his 'A' race, but we believe having him compete on his home track will help."



Girolamo to BC Sprint

Girolamo (A.P. Indy), who collected his first Grade I victory in Saturday's Vosburgh, will now point toward the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint at Churchill Downs Nov. 6. "We have multiple horses who could go in the [GI BC] Dirt Mile, so we're likely to send him to the Sprint," said Rick Mettee, assistant to trainer Saeed bin Suroor.

On to Ladies' Classic for Beldame Winner Life at Ten

According to trainer Todd Pletcher Sunday, GI Beldame Invitational winner **Life at Ten** (Malibu Moon) will make her next start in the Nov. 5 GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic. Candy DeBartolo's five-year-old, who is not Breeders' Cup nominated, will have to be supplemented for \$160,000 to compete in the \$2-million contest. "We had talked about running in the Breeders' Cup a while ago, and it was decided that she had earned much more than the supplemental fee this year and deserved a chance," explained Pletcher. "The owner was more than willing to put up the fee." Also scheduled to move on to Churchill for the Ladies' Classic is **Unrivalled Belle** (Unbridled's Song), runner-up in the Beldame. "She's good," confirmed trainer Bill Mott Sunday. "She's lying down [yesterday morning], but she ran hard." Winner of the GIII Rampart S. and GII La Troienne S. earlier this season, the grey finished second her last three starts while racing in Grade I company.

Pletcher Tightens the Screws on Juvenile Team


Trainer Todd Pletcher sent out likely favorite **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie) for a preparatory breeze yesterday ahead of Saturday's GI Champagne S. at Belmont. The Repole Stable-owned colt negotiated the half-mile in :49.86 over Belmont's training track. Also sent to the track Sunday morning was stablemate **Stay Thirsty** (Bernardini), who covered the same distance in :49.70. According to Pletcher, both horses will be entered in the eighth-furlong event, however, Uncle Mo is expected to line up. Additionally, Pletcher had all four of his GI Frizette S. hopefuls on the worktab yesterday. Also preparing over Belmont's training track, **R Heat Lightning** (Trippi) covered a half-mile in :50.06 and **Valiant Passion** (Lion Heart) completed the task in 1:02.98. At Saratoga, **Tap for Luck** (Tapit) went five panels in 1:02.55, while his fourth entrant, Maple Forest (Forestry), worked the same distance in 1:01 at Monmouth Park. 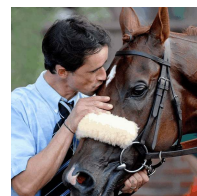
