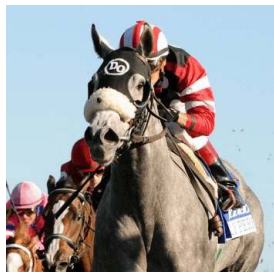

GIO PONTI, PROVISO set for
KEE FallStars Weekend
P4-5

PERFECT TRIP

STD Racing Stable and partners' **Wickedly Perfect** (Congrats) shipped in from California and led every step to annex Keeneland's opening day feature, the GI Darley Alcibiades S. Trying two turns for the first time, the grey filly bounced out of the gate alertly, had her ears pricked as she put up splits of :50.19 and 1:15.95, and pulled clear in the final furlong to punch her Breeders' Cup ticket. "Churchill Downs, here we come," confirmed winning trainer Doug O'Neill.

"[Jockey] Rafael [Bejarano] did such brilliant job of slowing everybody down and saving enough filly," O'Neill added, "She always trained like a filly that wanted to run long. That's why we put blinkers on her in her very first start. She's shown amazing speed in all her races, but she's always acted like a filly that would want to go a distance of ground." **Cont. p3**

THE CHAMPAGNE'S ON ICE...

Repole Stable has had more winners in New York this year than any other owner, but none of those victories has come in a graded stakes. However, that could all change this afternoon, when the highly regarded **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie)--1-4 on the morning line--goes postward in the GI Champagne S. at Belmont. A \$220,000 KEESAP yearling, the bay colt stamped himself as a

★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ when he aired by 14 1/4 lengths in his Aug. 28 unveiling at Saratoga ([video](#)), an effort that earned him a 102 Beyer Speed Figure. He stopped the clock in 1:09 1/5 for six furlongs that day, and tackles a mile this time. "I definitely think he can handle the stretch out, and [trainer] Todd [Pletcher] tells me he thinks he can handle the stretch out," said Mike Repole. "His gallop-out is as impressive as his works...just to watch him run alongside another horse, and then gallop out a furlong or two afterwards and go up by 10 or 15 lengths is pretty exciting." Repole has also entered GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. runner-up **Stay Thirsty** (Bernardini) as an "insurance policy," but he is not considered to be a likely starter. **Cont. p2**

Z Factor...

Six colts have used the GI Champagne S. as a springboard to success in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, most recently champion War Pass (Cherokee Run) in 2007. That colt also provided Nick Zito with his fifth winner of this Belmont feature, and the popular trainer fields **Meridian Magic** (Mineshaft) here. A troubled fifth behind Curlinello (Smart Strike) in his Aug. 21 opener at the Spa, the bay colt graduated going two turns at Delaware Sept. 18. There's also a Zito connection with **Mountain Town** (Cape Town). The bay colt--produced by a half-sister to 2003 Champagne hero Birdstone (Grindstone)--was saddled by Zito to victory in a \$75,000 maiden claimer at Saratoga Aug. 19. However, he was haltered that day by trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. on behalf of Paul Pompa Jr.

No Need to Settle...

Settle for Medal (Medallist), a non-threatening third to **"TDN Rising Star" Boys** at Tosconova (Officer) in his July 2 debut at Belmont, got the gold at Saratoga Aug. 14. He wound up fourth of four in his rematch with 'Boys' in the GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. on Labor Day, but trainer Mark Hennig feels this test sets up better for the dark bay colt. "I'm hoping that with the Champagne being longer, there will be a more realistic pace scenario," Hennig offered. "We're up against it a little bit, but perhaps the big, sweeping turns here will help him."

Indy) got nailed at the wire for second by the rallying Harlan's Ruby (Harlan's Holiday). "Hat's off to the Vinery; they have such a beautiful stallion in Congrats," trainer Doug O'Neill enthused. "He's a comer." O'Neill was quick to give credit. "I have to thank my brother Dennis. He's the one who helped pick her out. [Agent] Bob Feld...I got a laundry list of people that if they weren't involved, we wouldn't have gotten the filly." Wise Dan hadn't faced the starter since Kentucky Derby Day, but showed no signs of rustiness to prevail over a field of veteran sprinters here. After finishing fifth in his career debut on Turfway's Polytrack Feb. 26, the Morton Fink homebred aired by 15 1/4 lengths at the same track Mar. 27 ([video](#)). He added a 3 1/2-length allowance success under the Twin Spires May 1, but hadn't faced the starter since. Away alertly here under Rafael Bejarano, the chestnut settled inside just behind Goldzar (Cozar) and favored Hollywood Hit. He came off the rail turning for home and outfinished Hollywood Hit to earn his first black-type success. Warrior's Reward cabooseed the field through the opening half before rallying for third. "He's done some stuff in the morning here, so I knew he was going to be ready," said winning trainer Charles Lopresti, who also trains GI Forego winner Here Comes Ben (Street Cry {Ire}). "I just didn't know if he was going to be seasoned enough against these older horses. He's really, really fast." The Phoenix is a "Win and You're In" race for the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint at Churchill Nov. 6. "We'll make a decision about [the Breeders' Cup] in three or four days," Lopresti added. "We don't want to do wrong thing by the horse. He has a very bright future--he's only a three-year-old." **Click for the [brisnet.com chart](#) or the [brisnet.com PPs](#). Two-for-three at the distance, **Gio Ponti** drops back to a mile for the first time since defeating Ventura (Chester House) in the GI Frank E. Kilroe H. by a nose in March of 2009. Also the winner of the GIII Hill Prince S. going a mile as a three-year-old in 2008, he shortens up after taking the 11-furlong GI Man o'War S. by a neck July 10 and running second in the 10-panel GI Arlington Million Aug. 21. Connections opted to skip the GI Breeders' Cup Turf last year, and Gio Ponti rewarded the decision with a bang-up second behind Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}) in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. Where will he head after this race? "We might be leaning toward the Classic again, but it's not a decision we have to make today," trainer Christophe Clement told *Daily Racing Form*. **Courageous Cat** makes his first start since running ninth in the Mar. 27 G1 Dubai Duty Free S. at Meydan. "He seemed a little jarred up after Dubai," trainer Bill Mott said. "We just gave him some time off. He hadn't really had any kind of long break. We thought it was a good time to do it." First or second in five of seven outings last year, the four-year-old won the GII National Museum of Racing Hall of Fame S. at Saratoga, and nearly pulled off a major upset in the Nov. 6 GI Breeders' Cup Mile. Let go at 22-1, he had the lead at the eighth pole, but was caught by Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) in the final yards and was second by a half-length. He prepped for Dubai with a head score in the GIII Canadian Turf S. at Gulfstream in February. **Get Stormy** bids for his fourth win from five starts this term. The bay went gate to wire in the Aug. 1 GII Fourstardave H. at the Spa and came from just off the leader to win the GII Bernard Baruch H. 26 days later. Trainer Tom Bush acknowledged that this will be a tougher test. "I think the fields he has faced have been a little suspect," the conditioner admitted. "The Bernard Baruch and Fourstardave did not have fields as strong as they could have had for Grade IIs. Gio Ponti has been successful going a mile, so the turn back in distance won't be bad for him."

Proviso goes for a fourth consecutive Grade I score this afternoon. Disqualified to second after crossing the line best in the GI Juddmonte Spinster S. over the Keeneland Poly last fall, the bay weakened to be fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies Classic in her 2009 finale. The Juddmonte homebred ran second in the

Jan. 31 GI Santa Monica H. going seven panels on the all-weather, then switched to the turf and has been unbeatable since. She got the better of the boys when taking Santa Anita's GI Frank E. Kilroe Mile H. by a nose Mar. 6, was a game half-length winner of the GI Just a Game S. at Belmont June 5 and

most recently made it three in a row with a head tally in the GI Diana S. at the Spa July 31. "She works good anywhere--she acts like one of those that would run over broken bottles," trainer Bill Mott said, but added, "We feel she's better on the grass." It has not yet been decided where Proviso will head after this race. "The options are the [GI] Breeders' Cup Mile [Nov. 6] or the Matriarch [GI, Nov. 26 at Hollywood Park]," said Juddmonte Farm Manager Garrett O'Rourke. "We'll see."

Wasted Tears has an even longer winning streak to protect. The Bart Evans colorbearer was two-for-two while racing at Lone Star in 2009 and has hit the winner's circle in all five starts this year. After taking an optional claimer at Gulfstream in January, she reeled off front-running victories in the Feb. 28 GIII Honey Fox S. in Hallandale, Apr. 10 GII Jenny Wiley S. at Keeneland, May 31 GIII Oujia Board H. at Lone Star and Aug. 15 GII John C. Mabee H. at Del Mar. **Gotta Have Her** has won two of her last three, annexing the July 3 GII Royal Heroine Mile S. at Hollywood July 3. After running third by a half-length in the Mabee, she came back to take the Sept. 6 GII Palomar H. by a neck. As for what's next, trainer Jenine Sahadi said, "I am only thinking about this one."

Major Gain, second in his career opener going 5 1/2 furlongs at Arlington in August, came back to break his maiden by a length over **Rough Sailing** in the one-mile GIII Arlington-Washington Futurity S. Dutrow Stars Sidelined...

Jay Em Ess Stable's ♀ **"TDN Rising Star" ♀ Rail Trip** (Jump Start) will have a nuclear scan at Kentucky's Rood and Riddle Equine Clinic following a desultory fifth in the G1 Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont last Saturday, according to *Daily Racing Form*. That was the five-year-old's first outing for Dutrow, having previously been based in California with trainer Ron Ellis. He ran in the Gold Cup with an aluminum pad on his right front foot. "It's not the dirt," Dutrow told *DRF*. "I'm hoping it's his right front foot, but I can't guarantee anybody about that." Unbeaten **Trickmeister** (Proud Citizen) has been sidelined with a bruised cannon bone following an impressive tally in the Pleasant Colony S. at Saratoga on the eve of the Travers. He had been turned over to Dutrow prior to that race, and had made all three of his previous appearances for breeders Brereton C. Jones and Tim Thornton. The sophomore is currently spending 60 days at the In Front Training Center in upstate New York.

Twice Over Ready for Champion Bid...

Henry Cecil issued an upbeat bulletin yesterday ahead of the attempt by **Twice Over (GB)** (Observatory) to win back-to-back renewals of Saturday's G1 Emirates Airline Champion S. at Newmarket. After watching Khalid Abdullah's five-year-old--who also collected the G1 Eclipse July 3--work up the grass gallops in Newmarket, his trainer said, "He is in very good form and is very happy with himself. He has shaped up a lot--he is not a heavy horse--and he is squealing and bouncing. He loves Newmarket and should run very well."

'Voice' Enters Champion Picture...

Godolphin yesterday announced that the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. hero **Poet's Voice (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) would be supplemented for Saturday's G1 Emirates Airline Champion S. at Newmarket. Avoiding a tilt at the BC Mile, the three-year-old will be stepping up beyond a mile for the first time. "We have decided to supplement Poet's Voice for the Emirates Airline Champion S. at Newmarket instead of the Breeders' Cup Mile at Churchill Downs to limit his travelling at this stage of his career," Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford explained. "We also feel that 10 furlongs could be the best trip for him now that he is settled so well, and it is possible that a sharp mile around two bends could work against him."

St. Nick Return Postponed...

Aidan O'Brien has put the comeback of **St Nicholas Abbey (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) on hold after ruling him out of tomorrow's Listed Finale S. at The Curragh. Derrick Smith's G1 Racing Post Trophy winner reportedly needs more time as he prepares for his first run since finishing sixth as favorite in the May 1 G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket. "The original plan was to start him back over a mile and a half in the Finale S. at the Curragh on Sunday, but we then felt it was coming a shade too soon for him," the Ballydoyle conditioner told *Racing Post*. "We've decided to wait a bit longer, as we want to be completely happy with him. We haven't yet picked a race for his return, but there are a few possibilities before the end of the year. We still think the world of him and there is every likelihood he will remain in training next season, but we'll see how he is over the next couple of weeks."

HIGH HOPES FOR NEW OWNERS

In recent years, all three of the foundation pillars that support our industry--bettors, racetracks, and owners, have been crumbling. Our old reliable bettors are aging, pulling back or are moving to other games. Our race-tracks are under siege and many, even in big critical growth markets, are seemingly in danger of failure. And our racehorse owners have been reducing their stables, with some exiting our sport completely, or going on hiatus.

For the last group, the race horse owners, this past weekend has the potential to be a strong boost for the future of our sport. Why? Because the results of the best races in America, the Grade I's, and Grade II's were sprinkled with horses that sold at auction for modest prices. This could stand as proof to the millions of millionaires in America that they too, for a reasonable investment, have a chance to grab the gold ring and experience a once in a lifetime thrill.

All too often, our industry's sales-topper headlines trumpet the impression that folks traveling in less than a private 737 need not enter the racing arena, and that only million-dollar horses have a chance to win. But at a time when breeders and trainers and veterinarians and tracks all need new blood and new enthusiasm in the form of new owners, last weekend was a blockbuster. Look what you could have bought for \$100,000.

Governor Schwarzenegger first appointed Vice Chairman Israel and Commissioner Derek to the Board in July 2008 and then reappointed them in March 2010. All such appointments require Senate confirmation. The terms of the commissioners are: Chairman Brackpool through July 26, 2013; Vice Chairman Israel through January 1, 2014; Commissioner Derek through January 1, 2014; and Commissioner Rosenberg through July 26, 2012.

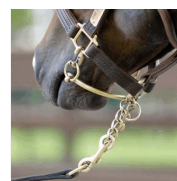
