Acoma (Empire Maker), who hadn't tasted victory at the Keeneland fall meet since 2008, marked her comeback in style with a gallant score at plump odds of 23-1 in Sunday's GI Juddmonte Spinster S. Settled in the

ROGUE ROMANCE POURS IT ON IN BOURBON

Rogue Romance (Smarty Jones) had to face a few challenges during Sunday's GIII Bourbon S. at Keeneland, but overcame the adversity to score a decisive 2 1/2-length victory over his game challenger **Cozy Kitten** (Kitten's Joy). Hopping slightly at the break, the

chestnut exchanged a few bumps approaching the first turn and appeared uncomfortable in the initial stages. However, once settled in a more fluid cadence through the second turn, the Runnymede Farm homebred came alive with a six-wide move at the head of the lane and swept to the fore

late to collect his first black-type victory. "I thought [the turf] might be a little easier, although I'm not convinced that grass is this colt's only game," explained winning trainer Ken McPeck. June 5, the Alexander-Groves homebred was a close-up fourth in the one-mile GIII Locust Grove H. July 3. Most recently, the mare failed to fire when seventh in the GI Beverly D. S. at Arlington Aug. 21.

Having appeared to benefit from that outing, he came from just off the pace to score in his most recent start at that oval Sept. 6. "Coming from off the pace wasn't a surprise," said Ken McPeek. "I had to make a decision whether I was going to run him in the [Saturday's GI Dixiana Breeders'] Futurity or here. In all honesty, I was going to lose [jockey] Julien [Leparoux, who rode Futurity fourth-place finisher Typhoon Slew] to another horse if I ran yesterday, so we decided to sit still and wait for this race today."

"We're going to the Breeders' Cup with this one," confirmed Ken Ramsey, who campaigned the colt's sire Kit-ten's Joy. "I'm really happy with how he ran. Obviously, I would be happier if he had won, but he still ran great and we're going to Churchill Downs." Rounding out the trifecta was **Ocasta** (Cherokee Run), campained by Bonnie

and Tommy Hamilton's Silverton Hill, which has been enjoying a banner year in 2010 with its juvenile team. The partnership is also responsible for G1 National S. hero and G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile hopeful Pathfork (Distorted Humor). "The horse ran pretty good, I just had a little bad trip," explained jockey Freddie Lenclud. "I got squeezed out of the gate, so I was kind of shuffled back and there was a little traffic on the backside. Then I got him clear down the lane and he really finished strong. I think this horse is promising." In regard to a trip to the Breeders' Cup, trainer Darrin Miller added, "We'll sit down and talk about it. Grass is where we need to be, so that makes it a little limited right now, but we'll see."

Casamento to Be Added to Trophy Mix...

Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **Casamento (Ire)** (Shamardal) is set to be supplemented for the Oct. 23 G1 Racing Post Trophy, trainer Mick Halford announced yesterday. Successful in the G2 Beresford S. at The Curragh Sept. 26, the colt will stay at a mile for the Doncaster contest after pleasing connections in his subsequent homework. "We're delighted with him and he's been in great form since the Beresford," Halford said. "He seems to have progressed from there, and although he's a lovely, laid-back horse and a lazy enough worker at home, when you ask him he always responds, which is the sign of a really good horse. His work has been good and, if all checks out well with him next weekend, we'll supplement him for the Racing Post."

Gio Ponti Fine After Shadwell Turf Mile Win

Castleton Lyons' **Gio Ponti** (Tale of the Cat) exited his victory in Saturday's GI Shadwell Turf Mile in good order and is expected to make his next start Breeders' Cup Day Nov. 6, according to trainer Christophe Clement. While the Frenchman did not specify which race the turf champion would contest, he did indicate that the winner of this year's GI Man o' War S. would contest either the GI TVG Breeders' Cup Mile or the 10-furlong GI Breeders' Cup Classic. When asked about dropping Gio Ponti back in trip for his latest, Clement said, "The distance was never an issue for us." Clement confirmed that the bay is expected to ship

back to New York today. Also expected to ship back to New York today is **Get Stormy** (Stormy Atlantic), fourth behind Gio Ponti. "He was bouncing me around the barn after the race," said trainer Tom Bush. "I should have put him on the lead; they were walking out there. It was not good strategy on my part. He would have been second, but Gio Ponti was impressive." Getting a head start back home was Turf Mile runner-up **Society's Chairman** (Not Impossible {Ire}), who was scheduled to return to Woodbine yesterday. "He came out of the race fine," said Sue Lorimer, assistant to trainer Roger Attfield. "He loves Keeneland. He's just a different horse down here."

Ballydoyle Quartet Face Cup Challenge

Aidan O'Brien yesterday revealed four names to represent the stable at Churchill Downs next month, with Susan Magnier's **Rip Van Winkle (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) under consideration for the Classic. Although the Mile is also on the agenda for the Aug. 17 G1 Juddmonte International winner, the Ballydoyle conditioner suggested that a switch to dirt could be in the cards. "Rip Van Winkle could go for the Mile or the Classic at the Breeders' Cup," O'Brien told *PA Sport*. "**Fame and Glory (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) could go for the Turf there, whilst **Bright Horizon (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) would be a contender for the Marathon. **Together (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) could be one for the Juvenile Fillies' Turf."
