**DEWHURST THREATENS TO CUT UP**

Saturday's G1 Dubai Dewhurst S. could be a small-field affair after connections of two of the contenders appeared to be wavering yesterday. Trainer Michael Jarvis has yet to commit Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **Elzaam (Aus)** (Redoute's Choice {Aus}) for Newmarket's seven-furlong feature. If he lines up, he will have to defy a 100-day break, having flopped when only third as the 4-7 favorite in the G2 July S. on the other track at this venue. "I have yet to decide if we run him on Saturday," Jarvis told *PA Sport*. "I still have to talk to his owner and his racing manager, Angus Gold, and decide if he takes his chance. If he doesn't, we will go for the G3 Horris Hill S. [at Newbury] the following week. Those are the only two options for him. It's a very tough call. The Dewhurst looks a very hot race and he could run the race of his life and still finish fifth. Either way, I will run him in a pair of blinkers for the first time. I'm told that in Australia a lot of the sire's progeny seem to run better in them. It will just help him concentrate a bit." **Cont. p2**

Ed Dunlop has yet to commit the Aug. 21 G3 Solario S. winner **Native Khan (Fr)** (Azamour {Ire}), who also has a week-later option of the G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster. "It has been another lovely drying day up here and the ground looks as if it is no longer an issue, but there is no doubt that Native Khan would face very strong opposition, with three potential superstars in Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}), Dream Ahead (Diktat {GB}) and Saamid (GB) (Street Cry {Ire}) standing in our way, so we will sleep on it and I'll talk to the owners before pressing either the green or the red light on Thursday," Dunlop said. "Plan B remains the Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster on Saturday week, when we would come up against Casamento (Ire) (Shamardal) and Dunboyne Express (Ire) (Shamardal) amongst others, but, while initially I was worried about rain on Town Moor, I see that they are only forecast one day of showers between now and the start of the meeting, so with luck we could wait and still get our ground up there." Aidan O'Brien is also expected to cut his quartet, with Johnny Murtagh likely to ride the Susan Magnier, Michael Tabor, Derrick Smith and the Sangster family's impressive Curragh maiden winner **Roderic O'Connor (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), who has not been seen since that seven-furlong June 26 contest.

***Dream Gets Green Light...***

Trainer David Simcock yesterday announced that Khalifa Dasmal's unbeaten **Dream Ahead** (Diktat {GB}) would definitely be in the line-up for Saturday's G1 Dubai Dewhurst S. at Newmarket. After seeing the G1 Prix Morny and G1 Middle Park S. winner come through his crucial workout yesterday morning, Simcock told *PA Sport*, "He had a blow. It was very routine, but it went grand and he did what he was asked. It looks like it's all systems go for Saturday. We're looking forward to it and the distance won't be a problem at all."

In a press release, the team behind champion **Zenyatta** (Street Cry {Ire}) detailed the mare's anticipated work schedule as she prepares for a defense of the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Churchill Nov. 6. Trainer John Shirreffs hopes to get three more works into

Zenyatta before the Breeders' Cup, each spaced eight days apart. She is slated to work this morning in her first timed breeze since taking the GI Lady's Secret S. at Hollywood Oct. 2. Two more workouts will likely follow on Oct. 22 and Oct. 30. Shirreffs has Zenyatta booked on a

Tex Sutton charter that has the champ arriving in Kentucky Nov. 2. The six-year-old's regular exercise rider, Steve Willard, was aboard for a routine gallop over Hollywood's main track yesterday, and issued an upbeat bulletin. "She's got really good energy right now," he said. "She likes to train and she seems happy. Of course she is a lady, so she has a little bit of an attitude once in a while, but we try to do what we can so she doesn't mind so much." Zenyatta will head to the track around 9:00 a.m. daily and will spend some time around 3:00 p.m. each day grazing outside her barn, said the release.

## Musket Man Breeders' Cup Classic Bound...

Eric Fein and Vic Carlson's **Musket Man** (Yonaguska), runner-up to Etched (Forestry) as the 1-2 favorite in the GI Monmouth Cup Oct. 9, will make his next start in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic Nov. 6, trainer Derek Ryan confirmed yesterday. "He'll have a pair of works, and

then ship to Kentucky on Oct. 31," said the Irish native. "He came out of his last race fine and he's doing well." In the Monmouth Cup, Musket Man was kept down on the inside most of the way before angling four wide for the stretch drive and falling a neck short of Etched. "Everyone seemed to be riding Musket Man that day," Ryan

said. "I thought he'd be much the best, but that's part of racing I guess." Jockey Eibar Coa came out of the race with a similar evaluation. "I think, because I was the favorite, a lot of the other riders were riding me and keeping us on the inside," said Coa. Third in last year's GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness S., the four-year-old Musket Man has a record of 14-6-3-5, \$1,235,570.

**Paco Set for Churchill Challenge...**

Richard Hannon yesterday gave the go-ahead for **Paco Boy (Ire)** (Desert Style {Ire}) to contest the Nov. 7 GI Breeders' Cup Mile. Last seen finishing runner-up to Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) in Longchamp's G1 Prix de la Foret on Arc day, the five-year-old who is set to stand at Highclere Stud at the end of the term has given all the right signals for a rematch. "Paco Boy has a terrific turn of foot and the style of American racing should suit him, but there is a certain Goldikova standing in our way again," Hannon commented. "She is the dual world champion and we have yet to beat her in four attempts, but we got to within half a length of her at Longchamp last week and, with this being Paco Boy's final race before he starts his stallion career at Highclere Stud, I don't blame the owners for wanting to have a go at the big bucks."

Hannon added, "Paco Boy has had a long old year, and since he won the G2 Sandown Mile in April, he has raced every month apart from July, so you just hope we have not squeezed the lemon dry. However, he looks as good now as he did in the spring, so we have to go there fancying our chances of getting a slice of the pie, though I see the last four times the Breeders' Cup has been staged at Churchill, they have described the turf course as 'firm,' so it would be nice to think that they might get a drop of rain in the run up to the race." Also set for Churchill is Marc Keller's **Tale Untold** (Tale of the Cat), runner-up in both the Sept. 17 £100,000 Tattersalls Millions Fillies' Auction S. and Oct. 2 £300,000 Tattersalls Millions 2YO Fillies' Trophy. "Tale Untold, who was bought by American Marc Keller during the summer, will probably stay over in the U.S. after running in the Juvenile Fillies on the grass," Hannon added. "She was unlucky to be touched off in two valuable Sales races at Newmarket, yet she still picked up her new connections almost £94,000, which has paid for the trip. I don't know what the opposition will be like, but she is a decent filly who is well capable of getting in the money again."

## GISW Mistical Plan Retired

GISW **Mistical Plan** (Game Plan--Mistical Bel, by Bel Bolide), who was purchased privately by Blue Heaven Farm in mid August, has been retired and will be bred in 2011. "We are in the process of building our broodmare operation, so we are always looking for opportunities to add to the broodmare band," Blue Heaven's Adam Corndorf told the *TDN* yesterday.

According to Corndorf, the Versailles, Kentucky nursery currently serves as a home to 17 broodmares. "We bought her primarily to be a broodmare, but thought we might get a few races from her," explained Corndorf. "She is six years old, so she had some regular wear and tear, but she looks good and is basically sound." Shortly after her acquisition, Mistical Plan was sent to New York, where she joined trainer Todd Pletcher's string. "She was training well the last few weeks and we could have raced her, but after evaluating her for a few weeks, Todd felt she seemed ready to be a broodmare, so we decided to just retire her," offered Corndorf.

Campaigned by J. Paul Reddam, the Doug O'Neill trainee won her debut in August 2006 and added a victory in the Cal-bred Cover Gal S. at Santa Anita later that fall. At three, the filly won two of five starts-- the restricted Sunshine Millions Oaks at six panels at the Arcadia oval followed by the 8 1/2 furlong GII Fair Grounds Oaks--and was also third in the GIII Santa Ysabel S. "She wasn't a one-dimensional horse," pointed out Corndorf. "She won sprinting, but she also won going a mile and a sixteenth [in the 2007 GII Fair Grounds Oaks], so she showed versatility." During her four-year-old season, the California bred was third behind champion Ginger Punch (Awesome Again) in the GI Ogden Phipps H. at Belmont before romping in Calder's GI Princess Rooney. Mistical Plan, who was seventh in her sole start this season in Monmouth's six-panel Regret S. Aug. 1, goes to the breeding shed with five wins from 18 starts and \$816,790 in earnings.

"Obviously her race record was very appealing to us," said Corndorf. "Her Princess Rooney win was no fluke. She beat some very nice fillies, including [GI Darley Test S. and GI Prioress BC S. winner] Dream Rush [Wild Rush]. We have had success in the past with mares that performed well on the track, so we like to breed accomplished racemares. She is exactly the type of horse we are looking for."

In regard to her commercial appeal, Corndorf added, "She may not have the most fashionable pedigree, but she is a Grade I winner, is a gorgeous mare and exudes class. Pedigree is important, but looks sell. We are looking forward to breeding her."--CBoss

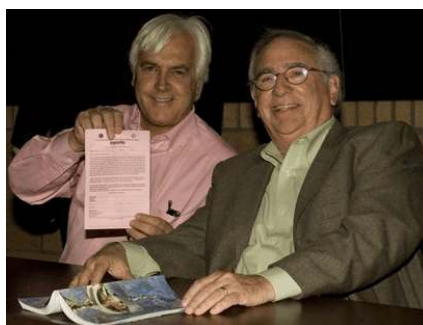
**BERTRANDO COLT TOPS BARRETT'S CAL CUP**

Tuesday's session kicked off with Pam and Marty Wygod's Breeding Stock Dispersal. The dispersal was led by the stakes-placed four-year-old mare Digestivo (War Chant--Gastronomical, by Sunshine Forever),

who went to H & E Ranch Inc. for \$52,000. Selling in foal to Dixie Chatter as [hip 77](#), the mare is a daughter of GSW & MGISP Gastronomical and is a half-sister to SW Hippogator (Dixieland Band). From the breeding stock portion of the Wygod dispersal, 88 horses sold for \$823,100, an average of \$9,353. The median was \$5,500.

Wednesday's second and final session was topped by [hip 214](#), a yearling filly by Unusual Heat--Sarah's Echo (Compliment). The half-sister to SW Guiding Hand (Helmsman) elicited a bid of \$70,000 from James P. Abel. Havens Bloodstock Agency, Inc., agent, consigned.

In total, the yearling portion of the sale--which included members of the Wygod dispersal--saw 160 horses sell for \$2,260,400. The average was \$14,128, up 13.8 percent from last year's average of \$12,413. The median enjoyed a significant boost, from \$5,000 to \$9,000, an 80-percent increase. Thirty-eight horses failed to meet their reserves, an RNA rate of 19.2 percent. The RNA rate a year ago, when the yearling sale was held over a single session, was 31 percent.
