BIG THREE STAND THEIR GROUND

Just six will line up for tomorrow's G1 Dubai Dewhurst S. at Newmarket, with the leading trio of Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}), Dream Ahead (Diktat {GB}) and Saamid (GB) (Street Cry {Ire}) set to go head-to-head in a fascinating renewal. Saamid, the least-rated of the unbeaten triumvirate, will be ridden by Frankie Dettori, who was relishing the spectacle yesterday. "This year's Dewhurst is what racing is all about," Dettori said. "Frankel takes the eye, and his gallop reports have been fantastic, but what Dream Ahead did in the Middle Park was amazing, and he's also won the Morny, so he's got the best form. It's all to play for, and I like my fellow, even though he's still a little bit on the weak side behind. We know he's going to improve a bit, and this is the obvious step, so we want to see where we stand. He's very lazy at home, so he doesn't give you the same vibe as he does on the track, but we know what he can do in afternoon." As expected, there were a raft of scratches, including Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's Elzaam (Aus) (Redoute's Choice {Aus}) and the Aug. 21 G3 Solario S. winner Native Khan (Fr) (Azamour {Ire}), who will head to next Saturday's G1 Racing Post Trophy instead. "I have had a long chat with the owners, and we have decided to opt out of what looks a very strong Dewhurst," Native Khan's trainer Ed Dunlop explained. "They say never be afraid of one horse, but it seems that there are three to be wary of in Saturday's race and, with the weather forecast for Doncaster next week being favourable, we will sit tight and wait for Town Moor. The horse worked very well for Kieren Fallon on Tuesday morning, and I am very happy with him. Stepping up to a mile will not be a problem." **G1 Dewhurst S. field p4**

SNOW FAIRY TO SKIP CHAMPION

Trainer Ed Dunlop has decided against running Snow Fairy (Ire) (Intikhab) in tomorrow's G1 Champion S., and instead will point his dual Oaks victress at the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Commemorative Cup at Kyoto Nov. 14. "Snow Fairy is in great shape, but this year's Champion looks a strong renewal, and it would not be right going to Japan on the back of a hard race," commented Dunlop. "With the bonus that the Japan Racing Association is offering, we could pick up just short of £1.4-million if Snow Fairy happens to win. They also double the prize money if she finishes second or third, and we want her to be at her peak when she arrives out there, so we have decided to give Newmarket a miss."

Pathfork to Miss Breeders' Cup...

The Silverton Hill Partnership's **Pathfork** (Distorted Humor) will miss his intended engagement in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Churchill Downs Nov. 6, after suffering a slight setback, trainer Jessica Harrington announced yesterday. His condition is not serious, but the unbeaten winner of this year's G2 Futurity S. and G1 Vincent O'Brien National S. will not run again this season. "Unfortunately

Pathfork won't be going to the Breeders' Cup," Harrington told *Racing Post*. "He's had a minor setback, and he just won't be ready in time to travel. It is only a very minor problem."

Zenyatta Prepares for Classic...

Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}) worked five panels in 1:02.60 in her first drill since winning Hollywood's GI Lady's Secret S. Oct. 2. With regular rider Mike Smith in the irons, the Amazon worked in company with stablemate El Vino (Include). The Jerry and Ann Moss representative reeled off internal fractions of :25.80, :38.40 and :51.20 before galloping out six furlongs in 1:16.40. "It was perfect for what you want in a first work back," confirmed Smith. "Not too fast-- Not too slow. Her energy level is great. I tipped off the turn there and kinda let her run. Two jumps and she caught [El Vino]. Whooo. She's like driving the most incredible sports car, and today we didn't even need to get out of second gear. I let her run, she got past [El Vino] and then she just went right back to cruise control. Just incredible!" According to trainer John Shirreffs, the six-year-old will work two more times (Oct. 22 and Oct. 30) before being shipped to Louisville to try and defend her title in the Classic. "Nice work for her first one back," added Shirreffs. "It was just to get her focus back on a routine. It's not how fast. It's about getting back to work and letting her know that another work will be coming. It's about getting the proper spacing."

Kinsale King to Work At Fresno...

Kinsale King (Yankee Victor), winner of the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen at Meydan in March, will be shipped to Fresno Saturday to prepare for a tilt at the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint at Churchill Downs Nov. 6. "I'm taking him to Fresno Saturday to work between races on the dirt," confirmed trainer Carl O'Callaghan. "I want him to see the crowd and get pumped up. He only needs one work on the dirt." Third in the G1 Golden Jubilee S. at Ascot's Royal meeting June 19, the five-year-old was 12th in his latest start in the G1 Darley July Cup July 9. According to O'Callaghan, the gelding's poor performance was due to the brief three-

week period between races, and to the unusually hard Newmarket course. O'Callaghan indicated that Kinsale King would be shipped to Kentucky Oct. 31.

Cash Refund...

Richard, Bertram and Elaine Klein's ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Cash Refund** (Petionville) worked five furlongs in :59.60 over Keeneland's Polytrack Thursday morning. With jockey John Velazquez in the irons, the Steve Margolis trainee worked in company with his stakes-winning stablemate Country Day (Speightstown). With Cash Refund on the inside, the tandem carved out splits of :12.60, :24.20, :35.80, :48 before galloping out six panels in 1:12.40. "Johnny liked him," Margolis said. "He said he just sat on him and didn't do anything." The four-year-old is being considered for the GI Sentient Jet Breeders' Cup Sprint at Churchill Downs Nov. 6. Brian Hernandez has been aboard Cash Refund in all of the gelding's eight previous career starts, which includes five wins. "We've been loyal to Brian, but if you get a chance to get a rider like John in a race for a lot of money, you look at it," said Margolis, who saddled 2003 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint winner Cajun Beat. "John doesn't have a mount in the Sprint. We are going to keep our options open." Margolis, usually based at Churchill Downs, has 20 stalls at Keeneland this fall. "There were a couple of races we were looking at with Cash Refund and we wanted to see how he handled the Polytrack," offered Margolis. "He may have one more work here and then work him one time at Churchill." Additionally, the owner-trainer combination may have another Breeders' Cup starter in **Due Date** (El Prado {Ire}), who finished third in Saturday's GIII Woodford S. "I don't know if he can get in, because that race is usually over-subscribed, but we may run Due Date in the [GII] Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint," added Margolis. "Five furlongs is not his best distance, but he beat a bunch of horses the other day that may be in there."

Here Comes Ben Preps for BC Dirt Mile...

Jockey Alex Solis made a trip out to Keeneland Thursday morning to partner Marianne and Brandon Chase's **Here Comes Ben** (Street Cry {Ire}) in a five-furlong work over the Polytrack. Working in company with Wildomar Springs (Even the Score), Here Comes Ben started off three lengths behind and tracked his stablemate to the head of the stretch before forging past late to complete five furlongs in 1:01.20. Internal splits for the move were :12, :23.80, :35.80 and :49.60. The multiple stakes winner galloped out six furlongs in 1:14.80. "He's very smooth," Solis upon his return to the barn. "He loves this track." Trainer Charles Lopresti was also pleased with the morning's task. "This was just a maintenance work for him," Lopresti said. "He's not going to go in :59. He's not like [GIII Phoenix S. winner and GI Breeders' Cup Sprint possibility] Wise Dan, who works black type. [Here Comes Ben] worked three-quarters in 1:15 at Saratoga, a half in :48 at Saratoga, and then won a Grade I [Forego S. Sept. 4]." Lopresti has two more Keeneland works planned for Here Comes Ben, who is slated to run in the GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile. "He'll work three-quarters next Thursday," Lopresti confirmed. "Then he will work a half or five-eighths and let him roll with Alex."

Agent Rachel Boffey, acting for Australian-born Londoner Stuart Stuckey, fought off John Ferguson for the colt, who will

join Luca Cumani. "He was a nice, scopey colt with a great walk, and I was delighted to get him. We've got together a good team for next year," said Boffey.

Angus Gold, acting for Sheikh Hamdan Al Maktoum, landed a colt from the first crop of Dark Angel (Ire) (Acclamation {GB}) for 140,000gns. The colt, consigned from the Cashman family's Rathbarry Stud as [hip 1676](#), showed a good advance on the 50,000gns RBS paid for him as a foal.

Meanwhile, Cumani himself--acting on behalf of an undisclosed existing client--bid 100,000gns for a filly by the red-hot Dubawi (Ire). "We know how well Dubawi is doing, and this was a very nice filly who looked racy," said Cumani. The filly, purchased by Margaret O'Toole for €29,000 as a Goffs November foal, was consigned by Lynn Lodge Stud as [hip 1667](#).

The 25,000gns Book 2 median was unchanged compared with last year, although the 32,470gns average dropped by four percent. The turnover increased by eight percent to 22.2-million guineas. **Cont. p7**

“At the end of Book 1 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale, we reflected on the strength and depth at the top of the market, and the trade at Book 2 has been very similar in that respect,” Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahony commented. “Turnover for Book 2 has risen, the number of six-figure lots has increased, and the key indicators of average and median have held up well. Buyers have consistently remarked all week that quality yearlings have been hard to buy, and it has been wonderful to see some major pinhooking triumphs throughout the sale, as well as a truly cosmopolitan crowd at Park Paddocks from start to finish.

“Nevertheless, the increased numbers catalogued for Book 2 have had an impact on the clearance rate, which has not matched the outstanding level achieved last year,” Mahony continued. “The demand for places in Book 2 was unprecedented, and reflects an enormous vote of confidence in the sale, but the sheer numbers have been daunting. The market continues to show resilience considering the prevailing economic climate, but the extra 210 yearlings catalogued has, without doubt, placed a strain on the lower levels of the Book 2 market. This year’s British and Irish foal crop has reduced significantly, which will make the task of managing the numbers less challenging in 2011, and we would be looking to keep next year’s October Book 2 to its traditional three-day format.”

The previous Book 3 record price of 72,000gns was passed last night when David Redvers fought off Paul Cole for an 82,000gns Iffraaj colt sold from Peter Stanley’s New England Stud. “Willie Browne is going to prepare him for the breeze-ups, and I think he would have made 150,000gns earlier in the week,” said Redvers.
