It's been labeled the "Two-Year-Old Race of the Century," and that may not be far off the truth if **Frankel (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}), **Dream Ahead** (Diktat {GB}) and **Saamidd (GB)** (Street Cry {Ire}) live up to the lofty

expectations in today's G1 Dubai Dewhurst S. at Newmarket. All three are unbeaten, all have exalted group-race form and all will lay it on the line here. Khalid Abdullah's Frankel, a **"TDN Rising Star"** from the word go, heads the betting, and represents the Henry Cecil stable so steeped in this town's history. In 1982, Warren Place put forward Diesis (GB) in a supposed match with Gorytus and benefitted from the much-hyped latter's total eclipse. This time, it is Cecil who is hoping the reputation of his star colt, so impressive in Ascot's G2 Royal Lodge S. three weeks ago, stays intact. Tom Queally is charged with guiding him through this test, and he is finding the excitement infectious. "I will try and treat it as any other race, but that's easier said than done, given what he's been doing in his home work over the last week or so," Queally commented. "He's taking on a dual Group 1 winner in Dream Ahead and then Saamidd, who has been hailed as one of the best Godolphin juveniles for many a year. Frankel is the one for me, though. He does everything so easily and is so straightforward and relaxed--he is just a dream to sit on."

**Living the Dream...**

Trainer David Simcock has a colt of a lifetime already in Dream Ahead, who in three starts has registered two wins at the top level, including a staggering nine-length verdict in the G1 Middle Park S. over a panel shorter last time Oct. 1. The aforementioned Diesis was the last to complete the Middle Park-Dewhurst double. His one negative at present is a tendency to hang when in front, but that may be down to greenness, and did not diminish his total superiority over the likes of the proven Strong Suit (Rahy) at this track last time, and Tin Horse (Ire) (Sakhee) in the Aug. 22 G1 Prix Morny at Deauville. "He'll go out there and do his best, and it's a very, very good race," Simcock told *PA Sport*. "I don't think it's just a three-horse race as everyone is saying--there are six more-than-capable horses in there. He seems to have come out of the Middle Park absolutely fine. Two weeks between Group 1s isn't ideal for any horse, never mind for a two-year-old, but his well-being seems excellent, and we're happy to take our chance. He's won two Group 1s and has achieved a lot already, so his form is there for everyone to see on paper. Frankel is the talking horse and it should be a good spectacle. It will be lovely ground tomorrow, and we just need to enjoy it now."

### Hailing "Pegasus"...

When a two-year-old has the nickname of the winged wonder, it is always worth taking notice, and ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ Saamidd (GB) (Street Cry {Ire}) has looked nothing short of top-class this far in easy wins at Newbury on debut Aug. 13 and in the G2 Champagne S. at Doncaster Sept. 11. Godolphin are palpably excited about their newfound talent, but that is tempered by a grounded view of his chances in this company. "We can't wait," Racing Manager Simon Crisford said yesterday. "It's a massive race and he's been chalked up as the third favorite, and that is a realistic slot for him. He has to step up a huge amount against Dream Ahead and Frankel, and he still has plenty to prove. He doesn't do a huge amount in the mornings and is a little bit lazy, which is often a good thing, and he seems well in himself." Frankie Dettori added, "He was very impressive at Doncaster, and we know what he can do. I am as confused and as excited as everyone, as he's so laid-back at home and doesn't really get motivated. He is unfazed by everything and is very quiet, but has a great cruising speed and turn of foot."

### Not Making Up the Numbers...

It is a measure of the quality of the leading trio that representatives of the Aidan O'Brien and Jim Bolger stables--which between them have been successful in the last four renewals--are trading at huge odds. Ballydoyle are represented by **Roderic O'Connor (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), who followed a debut third behind the subsequent impressive G3 Anglesey S. winner Dunboyne Express (Ire) (Shamardal) at Leopardstown June 10 with a convincing defeat of highly regarded stable companion Master of Hounds (Kingmambo) at The Curragh last time June 26. "He won very nicely at The Curragh, and we always liked him--he was always highly rated," Aidan O'Brien said yesterday. "A lot of winners have come out of that race, but obviously this is a very competitive Dewhurst, and I suppose everyone is going to have learned a lot after it. He's had a break, and this was always going to be his target as long as everything went the right way." Bolger, who recorded three consecutive wins from 2006-2008 with Teofilo (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), New Approach (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) and Intense Focus (Giant's Causeway), saddles the maiden **Glor Na Mara (Ire)** (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}) this time. In four starts at The Curragh in the space of little over a month in August and September, he was runner-up to Zoffany (Ire) (Dansili {GB}) in the G1 Phoenix S., to Pathfork (Distorted Humor) in the G2 Futurity S. and in the G3 Round Tower S. before earning a break following a fifth in the G1 National S. Brian Meehan also has a smart prospect who is out of the limelight in **Waiter's Dream (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}). Successful in York's G3 Acomb S. Aug. 17, he was put in his place by Saamidd when third in the Champagne last time, and his trainer is aware of his task here.

### Tester On Tenterhooks...

Britain's Two-Year-Old Handicapper Matthew Tester helped set the scene at Newmarket yesterday as the countdown to the Dewhurst gathered pace. All three of the leading contenders have left a deep impression on him, and he anticipates a rousing spectacle. "If you are mad about your two-year-old racing, this is a race to savor, and I just hope nothing disappoints and we get that head-to-head with a resulting champion we can all get behind," Tester said. "In Frankel, we have the best Royal Lodge winner of the last 20 years, and Dream Ahead appears the best Middle Park winner of the last nine years, so for them to go head-to-head is almost unprecedented. You can pick holes in either of them, and I love the fact that Saamidd has a stable name of 'Pegasus,' and can only get better as an unbeaten winner of the Champagne. In the 15 years I've been looking after the two-year-old handicapping, Xaar's 127 rating is the best and, prior to that, the gold standard was Arazi's 130. We are already saying that these horses are right up there with those. I really want to believe the hype about Frankel, and I've had a report today that Henry Cecil has said he's the best horse he's ever trained."

Juddmonte Farms's homebred **Redwood (GB)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) seeks his second straight win following his exploits in the GI Northern Dancer S. over course and distance Sept. 19. The four-year-old made his initial trip across the pond following a win in the G3 Glorious S. at Goodwood July 30 and a second-place finish in the G2 Grand Prix de Deauville Aug. 29. Geoffrey Snook, the travelling head lad for trainer Barry Hills, said, "Before we left this time, he was exactly the same weight as he was when he left the last time. I think, although we were more than happy with him last time, he's travelled and looks even better this time. He looks terrific."

Snook continued, "He travelled over good and I think he's an improving horse; he's improving with age and I think there's more to come from him." **Chinchon (Ire)** (Marju {Ire}), hero of the GI United Nations S. July 3, returns to North America following a sixth-place finish in the G2 Prix Foy at Longchamp Sept. 12. He reunites with Garrett Gomez, who guided him home in the Monmouth centerpiece. **Marsh Side** (Gone West), fourth in this contest last year, disappointed at 2-1 with an eighth-place finish behind Redwood in the Northern Dancer. He was an impressive winner in the GII Sky Classic S. in his previous trip to post. Local hero **Fifty Proof** (Whiskey Wisdom) nearly pulled it off at 29-1 in the Northern Dancer, leading throughout before getting nailed late by Redwood by a half-

length.

There are only two local runners, **Miss Keller** and **Mekong Melody**, facing a swarm of European invaders. They'll have their hands full with the likes of **Contredanse**, who kicked off the year with three straight wins, capped by the G2 Oaks d'Italia May 30. The black filly faltered to fifth behind Middy (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) et al in the G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood July 31, but came back to finish a head behind subsequent Group 1 winner Lily of the Valley (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G3 Prix de la Nonette at Deauville Aug. 22. Last year's G1 Prix de l'Opera heroine **Shalanaya** began 2010 with a close second in the G1 Prix Ganay May 2, but disappointed in her next two cracks at the big time, finishing eighth against the boys in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. June 16 and seventh against her peers in the G1 Prix Jean Romanet Aug. 22. The Aga Khan's homebred was beaten about four lengths in both of those efforts. "Her last race at Deauville is best forgotten as there was no early pace," trainer Mikel Delzangles told *Racing Post*. "All has gone very well with her since and she's in great form which she hasn't quite yet shown on the racecourse so far this season." Both of the local ladies are coming off wins on the Woodbine sod. Mekong Melody captured the 12-furlong Flaming Page S. Sept. 26, while Miss Keller saw her way home in the GII Canadian S. Sept. 19.

This 27th renewal features an excellent group of fillies. **Check the Label** is in the midst of a four-race winning streak, all in graded company, including the GI Garden City S. at Belmont Sept. 18. "It's a great race," said trainer Graham Motion. "That's what it's all about. "I kinda wish some of them weren't in there." Shipping in from California is the gritty **Evening Jewel**, the GI Ashland S. heroine who edged GI American Oaks winner Harmonious in the GI Del Mar Oaks last out Aug. 21. In recent times, Brigadier Gerard (GB), Triptych and Alborada (GB) have recorded back-to-back victories in this race, which is to be moved to Ascot in 2011. Enter Khalid Abdullah's **Twice Over**, whose place in trainer Henry Cecil's enduring affections was already guaranteed before his first top-level success in the 2009 edition of this prestigious contest. He added in Sandown's G1 Eclipse S. this term July 3. Subsequently runner-up in the G1 Juddmonte International S. at York Aug. 17 and third in the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown Sept. 4, the five-year-old is at a physical peak at this point of his career. "I am very fond of Twice Over, and he has done so much for my career," jockey Tom Queally said. "I think he has a great chance in following up last year's win." The owner/breeder's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe told *PA Sport*, "He's been very straightforward all season, and is thoroughly genuine and very enthusiastic. He's been in very good form and is going into the race in good shape." Jacques d'Etre and Eric Libaud's **Vision d'Etat**, who bids to become the fifth French-trained winner since 1991, has valid claims for being favorite over Twice Over, having won four times at this level. Successful in the 2008 G1 Prix du Jockey-Club at Chantilly, he added the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot, G1 Prix Ganay at Longchamp and G1 Hong Kong Cup to his tally last year, and showed he retained ability when scoring in Deauville's G3 Prix Gontaut-Biron last time Aug. 14. "I think he's ready to run and he's in good form," Libaud told *PA Sport*. "He ran well at Deauville, and I think now he is ready for a bigger race. Good ground will be okay for him." Also adding Gallic flair is **"TDN Rising Star"** **Fuisse**, who also came to the fore in the Prix du Jockey-Club despite losing out by 1 1/2 lengths when runner-up to Le Havre (Ire) (Noverre) in the 2009 renewal of that Chantilly Classic. **Cont. p7**

Trained by Criquelette Head-Maarek for her parents Alec and Ghislaine Head, the four-year-old came of age when beating subsequent G1 Premio Vittorio di Capua scorer Rio de la Plata (Rahy) in the Sept. 5 G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp over a mile, despite getting upset and loose in the preliminaries. Head-Maarek, who is looking for a second success in this contest following the 1993 exploits of Hatoof (Irish River {Fr}), is hoping those antics were a one-off. "He felt good and was a bit fresh at Longchamp, which is why he got loose before the start--he whipped round very quickly and there's no chance of staying on his back when he does that," she explained. "We will try to avoid a repeat at Newmarket, and we will have a lead horse to take him down to the start. Fuisse has done well since his victory in the Prix du Moulin de Longchamp, and I think that the race looked quite a strong renewal, especially with Rio de la Plata winning a Group 1 in Italy over the weekend. He is a very good miler, but the step up to 10 furlongs is a bit of an unknown. He lost last year's Prix du Jockey-Club due to his lack of stamina, but he is a year older now and, if he can wait in his race, then I am hopeful that he can stay the trip." Godolphin, yet to collect in this race, have supplemented the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. scorer **Poet's Voice**, who downed Rip Van Winkle (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in Ascot's mile feature Sept. 25. "I wouldn't say we are over-confident that he'll stay, but it's necessary for us to find out with his 2011 campaign in mind," Racing Manager Simon Crisford commented. "He's very switched off at the moment, which is going to count in his favor and, on pedigree, he is bred to stay a mile and a quarter. He is out of a Chief's Crown mare and there is much more staying than sprint blood, so it shouldn't really be a problem. His run at Ascot last time demanded extra stamina and courage, and he managed to achieve that. We've never won this and would love to--there is a little empty place in our cabinet waiting." Jockey Frankie Dettori added, "Now that he has got his head right, he's on an upward curve and has fresh legs. The trip is the question mark, but he's playing at home and this is the time to try. He's a bit like his grandfather Dubai Millennium (GB), who used to pull like a train, but he's a horse we always liked and is maturing now."

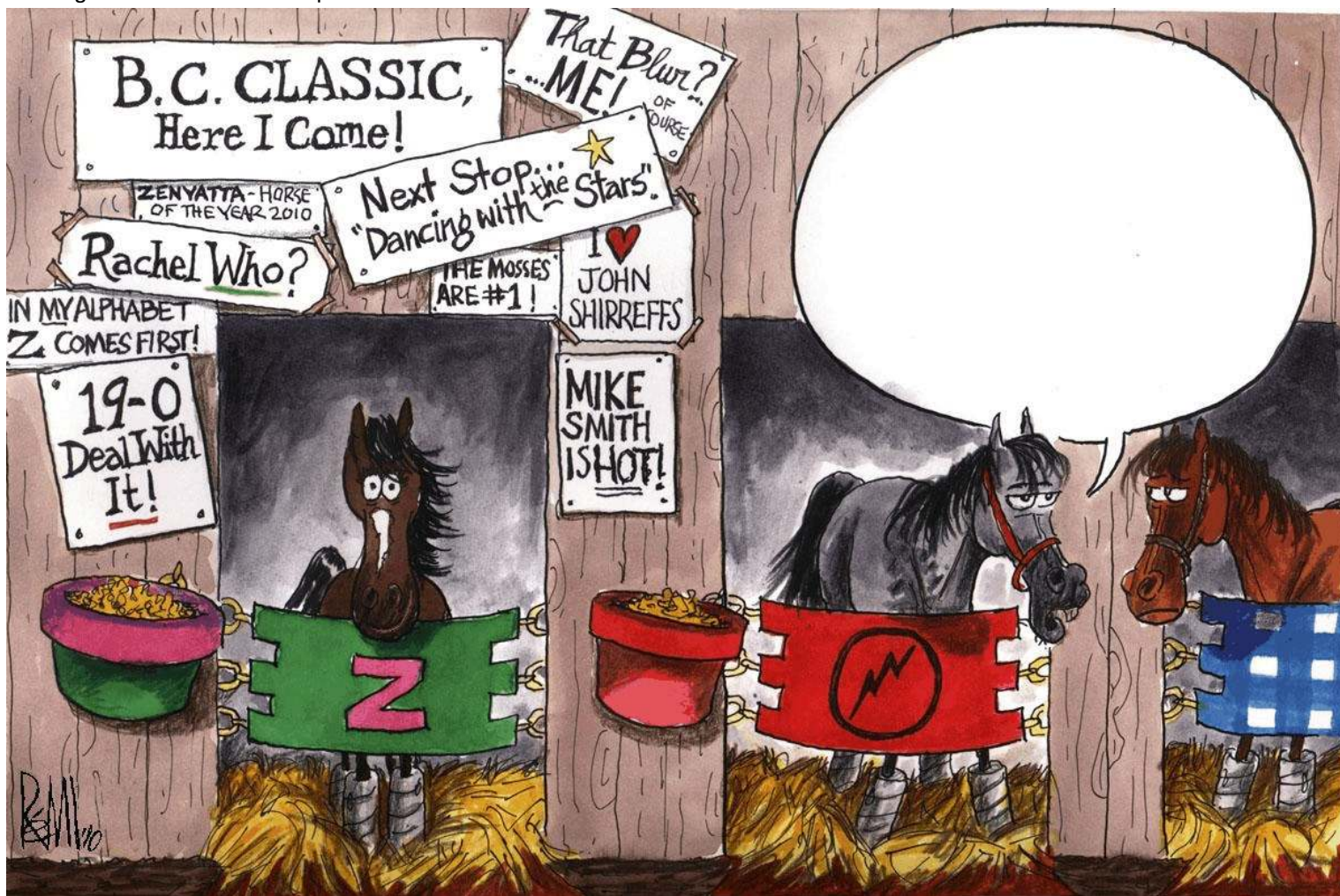

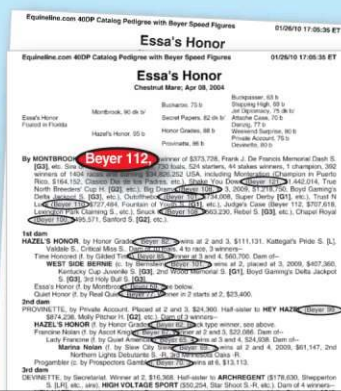

Trainer Todd Pletcher saddled him to victory in the GII Woody Stephens S. and GII Tom Fool H. in 2009. He also finished third that year in the GI Haskell Invitational, GI King's Bishop S. and GI Vosburgh S. This year, Munnings captured the GII Gulfstream Park Sprint Championship H., and also finished third in the GI Carter H. A grandson of Grade I winner and top producer La Gueriere (Lord At War {Arg}), he earned \$742,640 while compiling a 14-4-2-5 record. "Munnings is a terrific-looking individual who showed brilliant speed on the track and had an explosive kick at the end of his races," said Ashford Stud Manager Dermot Ryan. ### Fame and Glory Doubt...

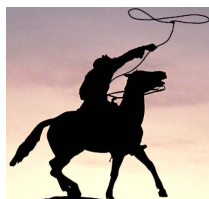

## Retirement for Fuisse After Champion Bid...

Haras du Quesnay's **Fuisse (Fr)** (Green Tune--Funny Feerie {Fr}, by Sillery) will be retired to his owner/breeder's Normandy establishment after his run in today's G1 Emirates Airline Champion S. at Newmarket. Successful in the G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp Sept. 5, the four-year-old has won seven of his 13 career starts prior to today, including this term's G3 Prix Messidor at Maisons-Laffitte and G3 Prix du Chemin de Fer du Nord at Chantilly. According to *Racing Post*, subsequent options have been ruled out for the half-brother to the 2007 G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud winner Full of Gold (Fr) (Gold Away {Ire}). "Win or lose, the Champion S. will be Fuisse's last race," Alec Head told the trade daily. "He has had a terrific season, winning four times, and while one mile, two furlongs is his maximum distance, he has got a huge stride. After Newmarket, we had the option of running him in the Far East, but the journey is complicated, and he has done enough racing for one season. We are looking forward to him coming home."

## St Nick Back Next Year...

Aidan O'Brien yesterday revealed that ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **St Nicholas Abbey (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) was almost certain to return in 2011. After missing last Sunday's Listed Finale S. at The Curragh, the impressive 2009 G1 Racing Post Trophy hero will sign off his current campaign with a sole sixth-placing in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 1. "We felt if he ran in the Finale and everything went well, he could step into a big race anywhere, but he missed it, and, as it looks as though he'll stay in training next year, it's very likely that he won't run again this year," O'Brien explained. "The race the other day just came a bit too quick for him, and although he seems to be fine, he just couldn't step into a big race without a run. We look forward to him next year--he's always been very exciting."

Acoma, a half-sister to Grade I winner and top sire Arch (Kris S.), is also a multiple graded stakes winner on grass for trainer David Carroll.

PECK TURNING TO THOROUGHBREDS

Standardbred trainer Greg Peck announced earlier this week that he is branching out and adding thoroughbreds to his stable. Peck, best known in harness racing for his work with champion trotter winner Muscle Hill (Muscles Yankee), said his goal is to become the first trainer to win both the Hambletonian and the Kentucky Derby. Peck won the Hambletonian in 2009 with Muscle Hill, who many consider the greatest American trotter ever. "This is something I've always wanted to do and now is the time to do it," Peck said Thursday night at the Fasig-Tipton sales grounds in Lexington, where he was buying Standardbreds at the 2010 Lexington Select sale. "To be honest, I don't think it will be that hard. After all, a horse is a horse." To start his thoroughbred operation, Peck bought nine horses at the recently concluded Keeneland September Sale. He spent modestly as the group cost a combined \$84,400. The most expensive horse he purchased was a Johannesburg colt that cost \$30,000. Peck said he will race his thoroughbreds at tracks in the Mid-Atlantic region. He added that he has had talks with the team at Taylor Made and has sought their assistance in helping him launch his Thoroughbred operation. "I am not going to be leaving harness racing, no matter how well this goes," Peck said. "I trained Muscle Hill who I believe was the greatest trotter ever. I'd give anything to have the opportunity to train a Thoroughbred at that level." Muscle Hill won 20 straight races and earned \$3,273,342.
