Kinsale King Readies for Return

Kinsale King (Yankee Victor), who captured the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen at Meydan in March, prepped for the Nov. 6 G1 Sentinet Jet Breeders' Cup Sprint with an out-of-town work over the dirt track at Fresno Saturday. Since winning in Dubai, the well-traveled bay ran a good third in the June 19 G1 Golden Jubilee at Royal Ascot and has been off since finishing 12th in the July 9 G1 Darley July Cup at Newmarket. from those two starts over the turf in England, Kinsale King has made all of his 10 starts over synthetic tracks. "The Fresno work was for my own piece of mind, I guess," trainer Carl O'Callaghan, who was aboard for Saturday's five-furlong work, said. "Just to work him on the dirt and make sure that he felt comfortable to me. He worked on the dirt at Belmont before Ascot, but I didn't ride him there. Kieren Fallon rode him there, and I wanted to see for myself how he felt. It all worked out grand. He took to it real good." Working between the second and third races at Fresno Saturday, Kinsale King went five furlongs in :59 and galloped out six in 1:10 2/5. "He got a good workout, got a good blow out of it, and seemed to handle the dirt just fine," O'Callaghan said Monday. "He came back good this morning and jogged today and was bouncing out of his skin." The Irish native followed the same routine before heading to Dubai in March. "I tried [working] at Golden Gate before he went to Dubai," O'Callaghan explained. "Because he hasn't run in a while and he's a very laid back type of sprinter, I just wanted to get the blood pumping through his veins. And it seemed to work. I think he's getting a sense now. It's not like you can tell the horse, 'Listen, I want you ready Nov. 6. We're going to a big race.' I know him and this works for him." **Cont. p2**

As mentioned in Sunday's TDN report on Twice Over's repeat victory in the Emirates Airline Champion S., 2010 is proving the most successful campaign for Juddmonte Farms since 2003. With a current total of 16 Grade 1/Group 1 victories, Prince Khalid is only two short of his total of 18 in 2003, when he was leading owner both in Britain and France and earned the breeder's Eclipse Award for a third consecutive year.

An interesting aspect of his success in each of these bumper years is the part played by Juddmonte's former stallion Distant View, who was pensioned at the age of 15 in 2006. His contribution in 2003 came via his magnificent daughter Sightseek, who gained the first four of her seven Grade I successes, only to lose out to Azeri for the older mare Eclipse Award.

Kinsale King is scheduled to work six furlongs at his Hollywood Park base Saturday and, after another work the following week, ship to Churchill Downs Oct. 31. While the Sprint is his most likely target, O'Callaghan left open the possibility his charge could start in the Turf Sprint. "It's crossed my mind," O'Callaghan said of the turf option. "We have a couple more days before we pre-enter and we may enter in both races. I think he's better on the dirt, but we know he likes the turf, so we can always use that option if we have to." The long layoff doesn't concern O'Callaghan. "I take you back to Oct. 30, 2009, when I ran him off an eight-month layoff [in a Santa Anita optional claimer] and he ran a 1:08 flat or something, and he ran the best race that I've ever had him, his best number," O'Callaghan explained. "He bounced in England in the July Cup. I think he likes to run fresh and we've done it before. I think he's better now than when he was going into Dubai. I think he's got a lot of conditioning in him and he knows what it's all about." Should Kinsale King run well in the Breeders' Cup, plans call for another international venture. "The plan would be, if he's first, second or third in the Breeders' Cup, he'll go on to Hong Kong for the G1 Hong Kong Sprint [Dec. 12 at Sha Tin], and then back to L.A. to prep for Dubai," O'Callaghan said. "He wouldn't run in between in anything, he'd just go to Dubai next year fresh."

Espoir City Arrives Today for Classic Tilt

Three-time Group 1 winner **Espoir City (Jpn)** (Gold Allure {Jpn}), who made the trip from Japan to Chicago yesterday in advance of the GI Breeders' Cup Classic Nov. 6. He was slated to arrive in Louisville earlier this morning, according to Mikki Tsuge of the International Racing Bureau, who will serve as interpreter for trainer Akio Adachi and jockey Tetsuzo Sato at the Breeders' Cup. "The trainer is coming in [today] and the jockey will be here [Oct. 22]," confirmed Tsuge. The five-year-old, who finished second in his latest start in the Nambu Hai Mile Championship Oct. 11, will remain in quarantine at Churchill Downs for 48 hours.

Plans Take Shape for Atta Boy Roy

Atta Boy Roy (Tribunal), slated to contest the GI Sentient Jet Breeders' Cup Sprint, will have a pair of works at Churchill Downs prior to the Nov. 6 race, according to trainer Valerie Lund yesterday. Winner of the May 1 GII Churchill Downs S., the Washington-bred is currently preparing for the six-furlong test at Trackside Training Center. "He will probably work [at Churchill] Friday or Saturday with Calvin [Borel] up, and then on Saturday, [Oct.] 30," confirmed Lund. First or second in his first five starts of the season, the bay came home a lackluster eighth most recently in the 5 1/2-furlong GIII Woodford S. over Keeneland's turf course Oct. 9. "He has done really well since that race," said Lund. "The timing of the [Woodford] was right, but after the race, he told me, 'No grass,' and 'don't run me in the Turf Sprint.'"

No Breeders' Cup for To Honor and Serve

To Honor and Serve (Bernardini) is unlikely to compete in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Nov. 6 and appears headed to Aqueduct's GII Nashua S. on the same afternoon instead, reports the *Daily Racing Form*. Second in his career debut at Saratoga Sept. 4, the Live Oak Plantation colt aired by 8 3/4 lengths most recently in an 8 1/2-furlong, off-the-turf event at Belmont Oct. 2. "We'll keep a watchful eye on it, and see how [the Juvenile field] shaping up, but at this point, our first inclination is to go to the Nashua," trainer Bill Mott told *DRF*. The juvenile worked five furlongs in 1:02.14 over Belmont's training track in company with stable-mate Heat Shield (Distorted Humor). "It is a big jump for any horse, particularly on the dirt," Mott told *DRF*. "I've seen it happen [successfully] more on the turf. I think the horse needs a little more seasoning if it's a dirt race." Mott indicated that a start in the Nashua would serve to collect graded stakes earnings. This year, Mott's GI Belmont S. winner Drosselmeyer (Distorted Humor), missed the GI Kentucky Derby due to insufficient graded stakes earnings. "Seconds and thirds don't get [a berth in the Derby lineup] in the spring," Mott told *DRF*.

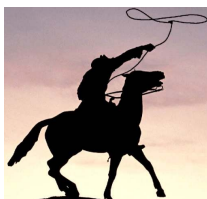

Casamento Added to Trophy Field...

Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **Casamento (Ire)** (Shamardal) was the most notable of three supplementary entries at the six-day stage ahead of Saturday's G1 Racing Post Trophy. Trainer Mick Halford paid £17,500 to add the Sept. 26 G2 Beresford S. winner and Sept. 11 G1 National S. runner-up to Doncaster's mile contest. "He's quite fit, so we just wanted to see that he was well," Halford told *PA Sport*. "We checked him out, checked his blood and had him scoped. He's fine. Frankie [Dettori] rides, and it's terrific to have him. I've spoken to Doncaster about the ground this morning. They say it's good-to-soft, so that will be fine." Also added yesterday were Andrew Tinkler's surprise Oct. 9 Ascot conditions scorer **Dubawi Gold (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) from the Michael Dods stable, and Fhad Al Harthi's Sept. 11 G2 Champagne S. fourth **Karam Albaari (Ire)** (King's Best) from the John Jenkins barn. From Ireland are a trio from Ballydoyle, including Derrick Smith, Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's Sept. 25 G2 Royal Lodge S. third **Treasure Beach (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) and John Connaughton's homebred July 18 G3 Anglesey S. scorer **Dunboyne Express (Ire)** (Shamardal) from the Kevin Prendergast stable. Ed Dunlop is set to run the unbeaten Aug. 21 G3 Solario S. winner **Native Khan (Fr)** (Azamour {Ire}).

This year has seen Sightseek's younger sister Quest to Peak enjoy Classic success, as the dam of Special Duty. This dual Guineas winner is one of four 2010 group winners for Juddmonte out of daughters by

Distant View--a significant achievement in view of the fact that Juddmonte had only a dozen of his daughters in its broodmare band in 2005. The other group winners include the progressive three-year-old filly Emulous, who rounded off a great weekend for her

owner-breeder when she added the Listed Garnet S. to her recent success in the G3 Concorde S. She is by Dansili, who also sired last year's high-class miler Zacinto from another of the dozen Distant View mares.

The Juddmonte quartet is completed by two sons of Selkirk, namely Tranquil Tiger, winner of the G3 Winter Derby, and Cityscape, a seven-length winner of the G3 Joel S. earlier this month. Cityscape's half-brother Bated Breath--another by Dansili--has earned *Racing Post* ratings of 110 and 111, so he can also be expected to make his mark at stakes level next year. Perhaps Sightseek will soon be adding to this success story, as she has a two-year-old son by A.P. Indy with Bill Mott, plus youngsters by Giant's Causeway and Awesome Again.

It is worth mentioning that Distant View wasn't heavily used as a stallion, even though he never stood for more than \$20,000. Perhaps he wasn't helped by having made his name on turf in England, where he defeated Baratheia and Grand Lodge to take the G1 Sussex S., or perhaps breeders were simply deterred by his crooked near-fore, which bore the Mr. Prospector hallmark. Whatever the reason, his 11 seasons yielded 480 foals, of which 13 became group or graded winners, the latest being Rezif, who took the GIII Kentucky Cup Turf S. last month.

Although he has only around 150 broodmare daughters, they have had a good year--and not just for Juddmonte. Distant View is also responsible for the dams of Afleet Express (G1 Travers S.) and Sole Power (G1 Nunthorpe S.). Another daughter is the dam of Cochabamba, who failed by only half a length to become Hurricane Run's first group winner in the G2 Rockfel S. three days ago.

Distant View's pedigree almost guaranteed he would enjoy plenty of success in the role of broodmare sire. He is, after all, by Mr. Prospector, whose broodmare daughters have racked up numerous championships. Distant View also had the attraction of being out of Seven Springs, one of the most accomplished daughters of that successful broodmare sire Irish River. Seven Springs' grandsires, Riverman and Lyphard, were two other celebrated sires of broodmares.

But it isn't only Distant View's daughters to which Juddmonte owes a debt of gratitude in 2010. His top-class son Observatory, who will always be best remembered for his defeat of Giant's Causeway in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S., has supplied two of Juddmonte's 2010 group winners. The star of the show is undoubtedly Twice Over, whose toughness and equable temperament have endeared him to trainer Henry Cecil and jockey Tom Queally, but there is also a lot to like about Helleborine. This filly briefly looked to be on her way to victory in the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac, only to be outstayed by the resilient Misty For Me. Despite losing her unbeaten record, Helleborine remains one of the leading fancies for next year's 1,000 Guineas.

There's no point in my pretending that Observatory is everyone's idea of a good stallion. The bare facts are that he had only 28 foals in his third crop and 15 in his fifth crop, which includes Helleborine. Clearly he has struggled to win widespread support, but he has had his moments for Juddmonte. Twice Over has built up considerable earnings, thanks to three Group 1 victories, and he also defeated Raven's Pass, winner of the 2008 Breeders' Cup Classic, in the G3 Craven S. He confirmed his own versatility when third to Zenyatta in the 2009 Classic. Helleborine's sister African Rose also won at the highest level, in the G1 Sprint Cup.

Distant View owed some of his best winners to mares with Nijinsky blood. Distant Music, his winner of the G1 Dewhurst S., had a Nijinsky mare as his dam, while Sightseek has a second dam by the 1970 Triple Crown winner. Observatory has followed suit. African

Rose and Helleborine are out of a half-sister to Distant Music, so have a Nijinsky mare as their second dam, and Twice Over is out of a mare by Nijinsky's handsome son Caerleon.

Twice Over's female line was introduced to the Juddmonte studbook with the purchase of his third dam

Lost Virtue for \$375,000 as a nine-year-old in 1986. The daughter of Cloudy Dawn had already been represented by two stakes winners and another of her early foals, Quack A Doodledo, became the second dam of the top American filly Banshee Breeze.

Lost Virtue produced two notable daughters for Juddmonte. One was the Oaks second All At Sea, whose legacy includes the smart miler Stronghold and the 2009 Pretty Polly S. winner Take The Hint. The other daughter, Quandary, was one of the last stakes winners by the great Blushing Groom. Quandary's first two foals are Clepsydra, the accomplished dam of Passage of Time, Father Time and Timepiece, and Double Crossed, the Lingfield Oaks Trial winner responsible for Twice Over.

LIVELY START AT DEAUVILLE Arqana's October Yearling Sale kicked off yesterday, with the revamped format and buoyant trade resulting in major hikes in the figures from 2009. At the end of the first session, the gross was €3,619,000, up from €2,397,000 last year, while the average of €36,929 and median of €27,000 represented jumps of 39 percent and 23 percent, respectively. According to an Arqana release, the statistics should be viewed in light of the change in format that resulted in an opening section--yesterday and today--composed of the more commercial prospects. Late in the session, a colt from the first crop of Dylan Thomas (Ire) proved the main draw when selling to Fiona Shaw of Citywest Investments, acting on behalf of Earle Mack, for €195,000. [Hip 98](#), from Anna and Etienne Drion's Coulonces Consignment, is out of a close relative of the sire Roi Gironde (Ire) (Fairy King), and marks another foray into the French market by the former ambassador, who paid €310,000 for this year's Saint-Cloud breeze-up topper by Shirocco (Ger). "The French-bred premium program is very friendly for owners," Mack remarked. "I already have three French-breds in training, and look forward to expanding my racing stable there." The second-highest price at the session was the €180,000 paid by Shadwell for [hip 59](#). Shadwell's Angus Gold won the bidding war with David Redvers and Charlie Gordon-Watson for the son of Oasis Dream (GB) and the listed-winning and group-placed Cattiva Generosa (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}). That sale capped a successful session for Andreas Putsch's Haras de Saint Pair, which was also responsible for a colt by Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) out of the group-placed Anna Mona (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}) that sold to Paul Nataf, acting on behalf of Salah El Mabruk of the Telesi Group, for €95,000. Marc-Antoine Berghgracht's MAB Agency signed for the day's two top-priced fillies, by Anabaa and Refuse To Bend (Ire). The former, consigned by Haras d'Etream, was secured for Red Square, a syndicate of Russian owners run by Eduard Mordhukovitch, for €130,000. The daughter of Refuse To Bend is a half-sister to GSW and MG1SP Xtension (Ire) (Xaar {GB}) from the draft of La Motteraye. She was bought for €87,000 for Spanish-based owner Anthony Forde. Dubawi (Ire) continued to make waves, and his son, consigned by Haras de Grandcamp as [hip 109](#), was knocked down to Gerard Augustin-Normand's Racing Manager Sylvain Vidal for €115,000. He is a half-brother to last year's G1 Prix d'Ispahan scorer Never On Sunday (Fr) (Sunday Break {Jpn}). Selling continues at 4 p.m. today. Full results are available on www.arqana.com.
