## RIP VAN WINKLE RETIRED

European champion **Rip Van Winkle (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire} --Looking Back {Ire}, by Stravinsky), who was set to make another trip to the Breeders' Cup, has suffered an undisclosed minor injury and will instead be retired.

Trainer Aidan O'Brien told the *Racing Post*, "Rip Van Winkle has had a very slight set-back and, while it is very minor, it would have meant forcing him to get him to Churchill Downs. So the decision has been made to retire him." A €170,000 ITYSEP yearling in 2007, the four-year-old made 14 starts for Susan Magnier, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith, with five wins and four seconds. The bay captured the G3 Tyro S.

at two, then was named highweight three-year-old miler in England and Ireland in 2009 after taking the G1 Sussex S. and G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. Rip Van Winkle added a half-length score over Twice Over (GB) (Observatory) in the G1 Juddmonte International S. this term. He earned \$1,913,649. "Everyone knows how good I always thought he was," O'Brien continued. "His big thing was his incredible speed. We knew he had that from the first day he worked. He did win the Juddmonte International over a mile and a quarter this year, but he was a miler first and foremost." The colt will retire to Coolmore Stud in Ireland. A stud fee has not yet been set.

## BREEDERS' CUP BULLETIN

### Aikenite Added to Dirt Mile Hopes

Dogwood Stable's **Aikenite** (Yes It's True) has been added to the list of contenders for the Nov. 6 GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile. The three-year-old, second in last year's GI Dixiana Breeders' Futurity and this year's GIII The Cliff's Edge Derby Trial S., is coming off a 5 1/2-length allowance victory over seven furlongs at Keeneland Oct. 15 ([video](#)). "After Aikenite's spectacular race at Keeneland, we feel he must be given the opportunity to run in the Breeders' Cup," said Dogwood President Cot Campbell. "He received a 97 Beyer in his race and he's training better than he ever has in his life. Aikenite is stabled at Churchill and we know he loves the track--he finished a solid second in The Cliff's Edge Derby Trial there last spring. Our colt will be ridden by Garrett Gomez." Dogwood will also be represented by **Atoned** (Repent) in the GIII Breeders' Cup Marathon. prepping for that 14-furlong event, the four-year-old worked one mile in 1:44 at Churchill Downs yesterday. Fractions for the work were :13, :26, :39, 1:18 and 1:30.80, with a gallop-out time of 1:58.40 for nine furlongs and 2:13.60 for the mile and a quarter. "He is doing good," reported trainer Neil Howard. "He is one of those horses that can get the distance and horses like that are in the minority, so we figured we'd take a shot." Atoned is coming off a third-place finish in the 1 1/2-mile GIII Turfway Park Fall Championship Sept. 11.

### Warrior's Reward Works for Sprint

GI Carter H. winner **Warrior's Reward** (Medaglia d'Oro) worked a half-mile yesterday at Churchill Downs in :48.80 in preparation for the Nov. 6 GI Sentient Jet Breeders' Cup Sprint. The four-year-old posted fractions of :25.60 and :37 and galloped out five furlongs in 1:01.80 and six furlongs in 1:16.20. Since winning the Carter H. in April, Warrior's Reward was second in the GII Churchill Downs S., sixth in the GI Metropolitan H., fourth in the GI Forego S. and, most recently, third in the Oct. 8 GIII Phoenix S. "I messed up [running in the May 31 Met Mile] and made a bad decision to run there," admitted trainer Ian Wilkes. "We gave him a break and freshened him with [the Breeders' Cup] in mind." Wilkes thinks the Sprint fits Warrior's Reward better than the GI Dirt Mile. "It is just my gut feeling," he commented.

### 'Summit' Likely to Supplement to Sprint

Owned Joseph Lacombe will supplement GI Ancient Title S. runner-up **Supreme Summit** (Cactus Ridge) to the GI Sentient Jet Breeders' Cup Sprint for \$100,000, trainer Mike Puype told *Daily Racing Form*. "It's a big hit and we'll give it a try," Puype told the publication. Runner-up in the Damascus S. on the Breeders' Cup undercard last year, Supreme Summit was third in the GII San Carlos H. and fourth in the GII Gulfstream Park H. in his final two starts for Doug O'Neill. The dark bay was a Del Mar allowance winner in his first start for Puype Sept. 5 prior to his Ancient Title effort, in which he made up most of a near seven-length deficit to just miss behind Smiling Tiger (Hold That Tiger). "He was running great," Puype told *DRF*. "He just ran out of ground. He went right past them after the wire."

### Acting Happy to Ladies' Classic

Jay Em Ess Stables' **Acting Happy** (Empire Maker), the GII Black-Eyed Susan S. winner who was third to Blind Luck (Pollard's Vision) and Havre de Grace (Saint Liam) in the GI Alabama S. Aug. 21 at Saratoga, will rematch with her two peers in the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic. "She's flying to Kentucky on the 31st," trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. told *Daily Racing Form*. "She'll be on that plane if she keeps going the right way. She's been breezing every six days like clockwork."



# RETIRED

## CLOUDY'S KNIGHT

S J Stables LLC's **Cloudy's Knight** (Lord Avie--Cloudy Spot, by Solar City) has been retired after suffering recurrence of a suspensory injury. The 10-year-old was scheduled to defend his title in today's GIII Sycamore S. at Keeneland. A minor stakes winner at four and five, the chestnut celebrated his most productive season at the age of seven, winning the GIII Fair Grounds Breeders' Cup H. in the winter of 2007 before closing the year with victories in the GII Sky Classic S. and the GI Canadian International S., both at Woodbine and good enough to earn him a Sovereign Award as Canada's top turf horse. Following his head success over Winchester (Theatrical {Ire}) in last year's Sycamore--his second start off a one-year layoff--Cloudy's Knight was sent to Santa Anita for the Breeders' Cup Marathon.

He made a bold early move to the lead before getting nabbed on the wire by Man of Iron (Giant's Causeway). He made two subsequent appearances at nine, winning Woodbine's Valedictory S. over 14 furlongs and the 1 1/2-mile GII W.L. McKnight H., and returned from an injury-enforced absence to run second in the GIII Kentucky Cup Turf at Kentucky Downs Sept. 11. "He's a trooper," commented trainer Jonathan Sheppard. "He did come back and ran a good race at Kentucky Downs. Bringing him back seemed like it was worthwhile." Cloudy's Knight retires with a record of 42-14-10-4 and earnings of \$2,547,835.

### TENTATIVE ADW AGREEMENT IN NEW YORK

In a joint statement, New York Governor David Paterson and the New York City Off Track Betting Corporation announced that NYCOTB has entered into an agreement which will allow the New York Racing Association and several other racetracks to take over the operation of the advanced deposit wagering system run currently by NYCOTB. "This agreement is a tremendous achievement and will help to reassure communities in New York that rely on the horse racing industry," Governor Paterson said. The agreement will allow NYCOTB to continue to operate, though on a reduced basis. Under the terms of the agreement, approximately \$95 million in pre and post-petition debt owed by NYCOTB to its debtors will be resolved. Approximately \$65 million will be forgiven by the New York-based racetracks including Empire Resorts/Monticello Raceway, Yonkers Raceway and Finger Lakes Racing Association in exchange for the transfer by NYCOTB of its advanced deposit wagering operations and certain essential changes to the New York racing laws.

The legislative changes will include provisions to help video lottery terminal operators, located at several harness tracks and Aqueduct Race Track, generate additional revenue, measures that will increase aid to education, according to the release. Added NYCOTB Chief Executive Officer Greg Rayburn said, "This is an agreement that involves shared pain across all of the participants in the process in order to arrive at a viable solution. I would like to thank the employees, our Board of Directors, the unions and the creditors for their diligence and willingness to be a part of the solution. We believe that the concessions made by all parties involved are in the best interests of the State and the racing industry, and we look forward...to continue strengthening horse racing in the Empire State."

## NTRA REPORT FROM CAPITOL HILL



### FLORIDA, NEVADA SENATE RACES ARE BELLWETHERS FOR NOV. 2 ELECTIONS

With the mid-term elections less than two weeks away, Senate races in Florida and Nevada bear watching. Democrat control of the Senate hangs in the balance as these and 35 other races are settled on November 2.

Republican candidate [Marco Rubio](#) continues to lead in Florida's tightening U.S. Senate race, according to a recent [Rasmussen Reports](#) statewide telephone survey of Likely Voters. Rubio, a former speaker of the Florida House, garnered 43 percent of the vote to Republican Florida Governor and independent candidate [Charlie Crist's](#) 32 percent. Democrat U.S. Rep. [Kendrick Meek](#) trails with 20 percent of the vote.

Just last week, Rubio led 50-25 percent over Crist while Meek's support has risen from 15 percent of the vote in July polling. Independent voters will be the key to either Crist or Meek overtaking Rubio on Election Day.

Senate Majority Leader [Harry Reid](#) and his Republican opponent [Sharron Angle](#) continue their close battle for Reid's Nevada Senate seat. This week's Rasmussen Reports telephone survey showed Angle leading Reid 50-47 percent. Neither candidate has led by more than three points - the standard margin of error - in seven of eight surveys since July.

Content to take back off the pace as Duchess S. winner Sharp Secretary (Cactus Ridge) engaged in a pace battle up front, Sugar Again accelerated nicely for Luis Contreras into the stretch and ran down the Ontario Colleen S. heroine for the victory. **RMTC Makes Therapeutic Withdrawal Time Recommendations, Announces Progress of Drug Testing Initiatives Task Force** *Edited Press Release*

Based on the recommendation of its Scientific Advisory Committee, the Racing Medication and Testing Consortium (RMTC) board of directors has recommended scientifically identified withdrawal guidelines and plasma thresholds for the short-acting bronchodilator glycopyrrolate, the muscle relaxant methocarbamol and four anabolic steroids, three of which are endogenous (naturally occurring) in the horse. A recommendation for the non-steroidal anti-inflammatory medication firocoxib has also been approved pending resolution of one outstanding issue.

“Administration studies on these medications were developed and funded by the RMTC over the past few years in an effort to provide horsemen and practicing veterinarians with withdrawal guidelines that will enable the therapeutic use of these medications without compromising the integrity of racing competition or the welfare of our human and equine athletes,” said Dr. Rick Arthur, chair of the RMTC Scientific Advisory Committee and equine medical director for the California Horse Racing Board.

“The results of these studies have been eagerly anticipated by the industry, and we will continue to conduct important research on other therapeutic medications that are commonly used in managing the health of racehorses.”

The board made these recommendations at its meeting at the University of California-Davis on October 12, 2010.

The specific recommendations are as follows:

- Glycopyrrolate: Threshold concentration of 3.5 picograms/ml in serum or plasma, which regulates a 24-hour withdrawal guideline for a single, intravenous total dose of 1 mg.
- Methocarbamol: Threshold concentration of 1 nanogram/ml, which regulates a 48-hour withdrawal guideline for a single intravenous dose of 15 mg/kg.
- Firocoxib: Threshold concentration of 40 nanograms/ml in serum or plasma, which regulates a 7-day withdrawal guideline when administered at the FDA-approved label dose, pending a review of clinical effects by the RMTC Scientific Advisory Committee.
- Boldenone: Screening limit no greater than 100 pg/ml in serum or plasma with a confirmatory threshold no greater than 25 pg/ml for all horses regardless of sex, which regulates an 82-day withdrawal time.
- Nandrolone: Screening limit no greater than 100 pg/ml in serum or plasma with a confirmatory threshold no greater than 25 pg/ml for geldings, fillies and mares, which regulates a 35-day withdrawal time. Male horses other than geldings will not be tested for nandrolone in blood.
- Stanozolol: Screening limit no greater than 100 pg/ml in serum or plasma with a confirmatory threshold no greater than 25 pg/ml for all horses regardless of sex, which regulates a 47-day withdrawal time.
- Testosterone: Screening limit no greater than 100 pg/ml in serum or plasma with a confirmatory threshold no greater than 25 pg/ml for geldings, fillies and mares and a confirmatory limit of 2 mcg/ml for male horses other than geldings, which regulates a 30-day withdrawal time.

In addition, the RMTC board of directors approved a plasma threshold of 10 micrograms/ml for DMSO, which would allow for the use of DMSO as a topical leg paint but would not allow for the oral or intravenous administration of the drug. The board also recommended that DMSO be reclassified by the RCI Drug Testing Standards and Practices Committee to a Class 4 substance when appearing in samples in excess of the threshold concentration.

Based on a report provided by the Scientific Advisory Committee, the RMTC board expects to be able to issue recommendations for acepromazine, pyrilamine, mepivacaine, lidocaine, procaine and butorphanol at its next full meeting in March 2011.

The next five highest-priced offerings were all of a national hunt bent, and it was trainer Joel Boissard who claimed seventh place on the sheets when going to €44,000 for [hip 353](#). Offered by Haras de Saint Faust, the April-foaled son of Gold Away (Ire), already named Vert et Blanc (Fr), is a half-brother to two winners and hails from the extended family of L'Emigrant (The Minstrel), Salpinx (Northern Dancer) and Zalazl (Roberto). Domestic trainers were to the fore throughout, and it was another from among their ranks, Eric Libaud, who was responsible for the winning €42,000 bid to secure Martine van de Kerchove's [Hip 337](#), a son of Poliglote (GB) named Maghero (Fr). Offered under the banner of Haras du Camp Benard, he is a half-brother to the dam of this semester's Listed Prix du Pont-Neuf and G3 Prix Paul de Moussac winner Sormiou (Fr) (Califet {Fr}). Aggregate yield for day three slipped one-sixth on last year, but the sale's overall gross, including private sales, surged through the €10-million barrier, and eclipsed 2009's three-day sale by almost 13 percent. The sale average and median witnessed even bigger jumps, with the former advancing over 15 percent to €29,690, and the latter over 22 percent to €22,000.
