“ANGEL” FLIES HOME IN VALLEY VIEW

Looking for her fourth straight victory, **Fugitive Angel** (Alphabet Soup) swept past **Ice Mist** (Forest Danger) in the stretch and pulled away late to take Friday's GIII Pin Oak Valley View S. at Keeneland by 3 3/4 lengths. The Augustin homebred started her run with a maiden win going 5 1/2 furlongs on the Colonial turf June 19, and followed up with a state-bred stakes score at 1 1/16 miles on the Penn National sod Aug. 6.

She was stepping up to the graded ranks after taking the restricted Malvern Rose S. on the synthetic at Presque Isle Aug. 19 by 7 1/4 lengths, and got the job done as the 9-2 third choice. It was the third win on the card for George Strawbridge's Augustin Stable, and the eighth Keeneland graded score for the owner, earning him a coveted gold tray. Strawbridge was unable to attend yesterday, but trainer Jonathan Sheppard said, "Last weekend, he seemed slightly frustrated when we had two very close [races] and didn't quite get there. Now I think I know why. I am very happy for him. He's put a lot into the game, and I know [Keeneland] is one of his favorite tracks. It is great he could do this here." **Cont. p3**

EIGHT IS ENOUGH

Midwest Thoroughbreds' **My Irish Girl** (Closing Argument) bids for an eighth straight victory in today's GII Lexus Raven Run S. at Keeneland. The Florida-bred filly was in for a \$30,000 tag when she ran fifth in her career opener against maiden claimers at Remington Park last December. Off for two months after that start, she came back to best \$15,000 maiden claimers at Oaklawn in February, and hasn't been

beaten since. The dark bay was haltered for \$15,000 after taking her next outing Mar. 12, and scored for a \$25,000 claiming price two weeks later. She added an allowance tally at Delaware Park May 5, romped by 6 1/4 lengths in an optional claimer at Penn National July 3 and scored in one of the Claiming Crown events at Canterbury July 24. In her latest, she was sent off at 3-1 in the Miss Woodford S. at Monmouth Aug. 28 and did what she had been doing, rallying from just off the pace to take it by 2 3/4 lengths. **My Irish Girl** makes her graded and all-weather bow against 13 rivals in the seven-furlong Raven Run. **Cont. p2**

EMERALD EXPRESS

While it was a minor surprise that the Irish horses featured prominently last Saturday in the G1 Dewhurst S., they are expected to dominate today's G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster, and John Connaughton's **Dunboyne Express (Ire)** (Shamardal) holds the premier Irish form lines. The Kevin Prendergast trainee accounted for the re-opposing **Master of Hounds** (Kingmambo) on debut at Leopardstown June 10 before doubling his tally with an eight-length romp in the G3 Anglesey S. over an extended six furlongs at The Curragh July 18. On that occasion, he had the Dewhurst third **Glor Na Mara (Ire)** (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}) back in a distant fourth and, despite a subsequent setback, he arrives here with stable confidence behind him. Jockey Declan McDonogh, who has also ridden chief market rival **Casamento (Ire)** (Shamardal), remarked, "They are pretty similar horses--they show great heart and great toughness, and it's going to be a good race. **Dunboyne Express** is a very uncomplicated horse--A to B is pretty simple, and you can ride him anyway you want, plus the ground doesn't really matter. I don't think the trip will be a problem, as he's not a free horse, and his pedigree suggests he'll get a mile, no problem." **Cont. p3-5**

Platinum Perfect?

Unbeaten in two prior synthetic track outings, **Platinum Exchange** looks to make that three-for-three this afternoon. The chestnut filly went gate to wire to break her maiden on the Woodbine Poly in her second career attempt Apr. 18, then switched to the turf and ran second in an allowance May 16 and the Alywow S. June 13. She has not been out since returning to the all-weather to annex an allowance test July 10. **Katy Now** has also shown an affinity for the surface, breaking her maiden by two lengths at Keeneland last October. The dark bay followed up with a Churchill allowance tally in November, then came back after a six-month layoff to make it three in a row in an optional claimer going six panels at Belmont May 28. Stretched to 1 1/16 miles for the GI Mother Goose S. June 26, she set the pace before fading to fourth. Katy Now was the 2-1 chalk to the Gill Victory Ride S. Aug. 28 at Saratoga last time and ran fourth after racing wide.

Trainer Mick Halford commented, "It's very exciting to have a horse like him and although it's all happened quite quickly for him so far, he was up to it and has been in tremendous form since the Beresford. We always thought a lot of him, and he's got a wonderful temperament and a high cruising speed. He's tough and genuine, enjoys his job and stamina is probably his forte. I have a lot of respect for the other Irish horses, and there is a great word going around for Dunboyne Express, who Kevin Prendergast is very sweet on, but I wouldn't swap mine and he has had a great preparation." One who might get in the way of an overseas

victory is Vefa Ibrahim Araci's **Native Khan**, who went two-for-two in a renewal of Sandown's G3 Solario S. Aug. 21 that may not have been the strongest based on subsequent evidence.

Trainer Ed Dunlop said, "Being such a good-ac-

tioned individual, Native Khan will appreciate it if the going continues to dry out. On paper it might not look so tough as the Dewhurst, but it is still very competitive and both the Irish horses have solid credentials, as does Brian Meehan's Titus Mills (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire})." The latter runs in the silks of the Sangster family and is also unbeaten after two starts, with the most recent coming in Goodwood's Listed Stardom S. Sept. 7. "He is a very talented horse and is very well," Meehan commented. "Things didn't go quite right for him at Goodwood, as he was out in front too long, and that may not be the ideal way to ride him in the future. I have been pleased with him and his work has been excellent--Kieren [Fallon] rode him in work and loved him--and the timing couldn't be better. We have a good record in the race and I would say he is a good as anything we have run in the event." Aidan O'Brien is another who has a fine tally in this race, with five wins since 1997 and, while Johnny Murtagh has opted to partner Master of Hounds, the impressive Oct. 3 Tipperary conditions scorer **Seville** warrants respect bearing in mind that High Chaparral (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) was the supposed second-string in 2001.

Zenyatta Works at Hollywood

Defending GI BC Classic champ **Zenyatta** (Street Cry {Ire}) worked seven furlongs in 1:27 1/5 at Hollywood Park Friday with Mike Smith in the saddle. The six-year-old mare, breezing in the company of two stablemates, clicked off fractions of :38 4/5, :50 4/5, 1:03 1/5 and 1:15 1/5. She got her final quarter in :24 ([video](#)). "The objective today was to not have her pass anyone," said trainer John Shirreffs. "We wanted to keep her focused throughout the entire work, because she tends to slack off when she gets by another horse. We wanted her to have a fresh horse with her the whole time. It went pretty much as we had planned." Added Smith, "I got a great response from her. She was a little aggressive leaving there, which is good because it shows that she wants to do more. The goal was to keep her focused, and she did that. She caught the first horse pretty easily, and then took a breather around the turn. I asked her to focus again and go after [the second stablemate], and that horse was really focused. She got to him pretty nicely." Zenyatta is scheduled to work again Saturday, Oct. 30, and will ship to Churchill Tuesday, Nov. 2.

Paddy O'Prado to Target Classic

Paddy O'Prado (El Prado {Ire}), third in the GI Kentucky Derby over a sloppy Churchill strip, but a Grade I winner on the grass, will be pointed for the GI BC Classic and not the GI BC Turf, connections announced yesterday. The grey was switched to the turf after finishing sixth in the GI Preakness S. and reeled off wins in the GII Colonial Turf Cup, GII Virginia Derby and GI Secretariat S. Trying 1 1/2 miles for the first time in the GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic at Belmont Oct. 2, he yielded late to be second, beaten a length by Winchester (Theatrical {Ire}). "My personal belief is his chances of hitting the board were about the same in either race," Jerry Crawford, managing partner of owner Donegal Racing, told the *Des Moines Register*. "We're not going to short-change Paddy O'Prado by playing it safe. We're going to swing for the fences."

Atta Boy Roy Preps for Sprint

GII Churchill Downs S. winner **Atta Boy Roy** (Tribunal) worked a half in :48 under the Twin Spires yesterday as he gets ready for the GI BC Sprint. Jockey Calvin Borel was at the reins. "Calvin was very happy with him," trainer Valorie Lund said. "He said, 'He's back in his house.' He loves the track here." The five-year-old finished second in the May 29 GIII Aristides S. over the track four weeks after his Grade II score, then was runner-up again in the June 25 Iowa Sprint H. He romped by 5 1/2 lengths in the Remington Park Sprint Cup Aug. 21, but was unsuccessful when trying the turf in the GIII Woodford S. Oct. 9 and ran eighth. "We had planned to run him in the Breeders' Cup last year at Santa Anita, and we took him out there and ran him [in the GI Ancient Title S. where he was seventh], and he hated the track," Lund said. "So, we said, 'No Breeders' Cup for us this year,' and started planning for next year." She added, "We have been focusing for the one race and getting him there. There have been no bumps in the road, and everything has gone well."

RACETRACK Round-Up

A Little Warm Injured...

Daily Racing Form reports that GII Jim Dandy winner **A Little Warm** (Stormin Fever--Minidar, by Alydar) suffered condylar fractures to both front legs during a routine gallop at Delaware Park Thursday.

The three-year-old underwent surgery at New Bolton Friday, with screws inserted in both legs. While the injury does not appear life-threatening, it is unlikely the colt will race again. Chris Baker, racing and

farm manager for owner Edward P. Evans, told DRF that the prognosis indicated A Little Warm would not return to stakes-winning form, and added, "Based on that, if we had to make the decision today, it'd be unlikely he'd return to racing. We'd be looking to retire the horse, and would be seeking outside interests to stand him at stud." Bred by Evans in Virginia and trained by Tony Dutrow, A Little Warm also captured the Spectacular Bid S., ran second in the GII Louisiana Derby and GII Hutcheson S. and was most recently third by a neck in the GII Pennsylvania Derby. He compiled a record of 11-4-4-1 and earned \$752,280.

But the filly had come out as she neared the wire, forcing Ramon Dominguez, aboard the runner-up, to alter course in the final strides. The stewards looked at the tape and took Palooza down.

"The call could've gone either way," trainer Tom Albertrani recalled. "She drifted out in front of the second horse, but Ramon saw she was drifting out and went inside. There was no interference and, in my opinion, it didn't affect the outcome of the race. That caused a lot of chatter on the racetrack the next day, but that's the way it goes. It was a judgement call, and I guess the stewards ruled she didn't maintain a straight course. But, from my perspective, she didn't really need to come down."

Shaking off the experience, Palooza made her second appearance at Belmont Park Oct. 14, and this time put on a performance worthy of ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ status. The two-year-old once again went right to the front, dueled through an opening quarter in :21.83 under a motionless Javier Castellano, then opened up down the lane to score by six lengths

([video](#)). The result came as no surprise to Albertrani.

"She had been doing all her work very easy," he offered. "We always kept her hard-held, on the bridle, because she always wanted to show a lot of speed. We never set her down where she might do too much."

Albertrani added, "We were very confident the first time she ran. She worked one morning out of the gate, and she zipped away from a couple of stablemates. She showed us she was a pretty fast filly. And she got a lot of education in her first race. She really moved forward."

The chestnut did drift a bit in her second start as well, but her conditioner was not overly concerned.

"I think it's just being immature," he said. "She's still looking at things. With racing, she'll overcome that."

Palooza is out of a 3/4-sister to GI Kentucky Derby winner Fusaichi Pegasus, and second dam Angel Fever (Danzig) is a full to GI Preakness hero Pine Bluff, but expectations are that the speedster will be better suited to sprinting rather than Classic distances.

"We think she might be limited in distance to three-quarters or maybe seven-eighths," Albertrani commented. "Of course, you don't know until you try, but we're not going to rush her into her next race." Looking a little down the road, he added, "We may give her a little time and campaign her in Florida. The long-term plan--well, it sounds long term, but it's really not that far off--is the Old Hat S. [GI, Jan. 5] opening weekend at Gulfstream. That's the long-term objective, if she stays healthy and all goes well. Maybe we will stretch her out after that race." Lifetime Record: 2-1-1-0, \$40,600. RCI LOWERS BUTE THRESHOLD *(Edited press release)* In an effort to improve the pre-race examinations of racehorses, the Board of Directors of the Association of Racing Commissioners International gave final approval Friday to lower the allowable level of phenylbutazone. The board voted 16-0 in favor of lowering the threshold for penalty from five micrograms of phenylbutazone per milliliter of plasma or serum to two micrograms, paving the way to improved pre-race examinations conducted by regulatory veterinarians. RCI President Ed Martin said, "Absent a compelling and convincing medical reason to the contrary, the RCI has concluded that it is in the interest of the horse that the proposed change be adopted." He noted that RCI will now review the current penalty guidelines to address concerns that have been raised pertaining to potential first-time violations of the new rule. RCI's Model Rules Committee, in supporting the change, recommended that jurisdictions work with local horseman's groups to transition to the new policy and consider a grace period so trainers can adjust. The change to the Model Rule comes after months of research and discussion, beginning with the RCI Regulatory Veterinarian Committee, who voiced concerns that phenylbutazone could interfere with pre-race examinations due to the possibility of analgesic effects of the drug. RCI asked the Racing and Medication Testing Consortium to review the research on the topic, and the Scientific Advisory Committee of the RMTC voted without objection to support the lowering of the threshold. The lowered threshold received formal support from groups such as the American Association of Equine Practitioners, The Jockey Club, The Jockeys' Guild, and the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association. Because the proposed new racing regulatory compact is not yet in existence, the adoption of the model rule change will occur in different jurisdictions at different times, as individual commissions commence formal rule making on an individual basis.

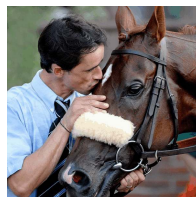
