Taking on Pathfork (Distorted Humor) just two weeks after a Tipperary debut win in the G1 Vincent O'Brien National S. at The Curragh Sept. 11, the chestnut put up a spirited effort to go down by a head to that unbeaten colt, with the G1 Phoenix S. winner Zoffany (Ire) (Dansili {GB}) five lengths behind. Supplemented for the G2 Beresford S. back there 15 days later, he ground out a four-length success in workmanlike fashion on his first try at this trip, and connections were prompted to pay another fee to add him to this endgame. Keen early tracking the leading duo as the pace was tepid, he was sent to the front by Frankie Dettori approaching the quarter pole and, despite veering right soon after, was always holding Ballydoyle's **Seville (Ger)** (Galileo {Ire}) in the run to the line. "I personally always thought he might have enough speed for a Guineas, as although he stays, he's not slow either," Halford continued. "He has a wonderful attitude and there is plenty more left, so he's a horse with a tremendous future. Maybe with another run under his belt, he may have won the National S. as well and he was a pleasure to train." Dettori added, "It was a great performance. He's a lovely horse and I think he's probably more of a Derby than Guineas horse, but we'll see." Aidan O'Brien was delighted with the efforts of the second and third. "They've both run crackers," he told *PA Sport*. "Seville was on his own for a big part of the race and Master of Hounds also ran a good race. The form ties in with the best two-year-olds in Ireland, and I'd imagine they'd both progress well next year."

Clowance, who took the Listed Swettenham Stud Fillies' Trial S. over 10 furlongs here at three, had raced only four times subsequently in a frustrating spell for connections. After a fourth in the 2008 G1 Epsom Oaks, the bay returned from a 15-month absence to run Alandi (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) to a half-length when second in the G1 Irish St Leger at The Curragh, and was fourth again on her next start in the G1 Prix Royal-Oak at Longchamp. With just the one start under her belt this term when unplaced in this venue's G3 John Porter S. Apr. 17, Clowance defied any rustiness to deliver in suitable conditions and register a career-best win. Settled towards the rear early by Richard Hughes, she was full of run inside the final quarter as Poet was committed and after grabbing that rival at the furlong marker quickly asserted. Successful here in a five-furlong maiden Apr. 16, Klammer has thrived on a lengthy campaign and came off a third in the G2 Superlative S. over this trip at Newmarket July 9 to win Deauville's valuable Listed Criterium du FEE over a mile Aug. 21. No match for Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) when a 10-length runner-up in Ascot's G2 Royal Lodge S. when last seen Sept. 25, the Hong Kong-bound bay signed off his European career with this late show. Held up in last early, he threaded through the pack under Jamie Spencer to collar the positively ridden Elzaam and closer Dux Scholar in the shade of the post. "We crawled at Ascot and then it turned into a sprint and Kieren [Fallon] said that didn't suit him at all," trainer Jane Chapple-Hyam explained. "There were so many speed horses in there and Jamie is brilliant coming off the pace, so that's why he was ridden that way today. If I had my way, I'd be going to the Breeders' Cup, but Mr Yan Wah Wu wants him on the next plane to Hong Kong."

Spencer added, "I rode him in a work the other day and didn't think much of him, as the lead horse hampered me, but Jane said he is better in the afternoons. He registered a front-running success at odds of 12-1 in the 2009 renewal, but So You Think made odds-on favoritism look like a gift Saturday, becoming the first horse since the late Sunline (NZ) to go back-to-back. Runner-up in the G1 Emirates S. following his success 12 months back, the bay posted a first-up score over Whobegotyou in the 1400-meter G2 Memsie S. at Caulfield Aug. 28 before decisioning Dariana (Aus) (Redoute's Choice {Aus}) by two lengths in that track's G1 Underwood S. over nine panels Sept. 18. He ran his winning streak to three with a three-length victory in the G1 Yalumba S. back at Caulfield Oct. 9, and was a warm item to defend here. Quickly away from the stalls, So You Think took up a stalking position in second, as More Joyous (NZ) (More Than Ready)--the only market rival in single digits--took the field along. The top two spots remained unchanged as they reached the three-furlong pole, but from there So You Think laid it down to his female foe, going clear before easily holding off Ziping and Whobegotyou.

Romans Troops Gearing Up

Trainer Dale Romans sent out GI Breeders' Cup Classic hopefuls **Paddy O'Prado** (El Prado {Ire}) and **First Dude** (Stephen Got Even) for breezes at Churchill Downs Saturday. The former, owned by Donegal Racing, worked five furlongs in 1:01. With exercise rider Tammy Fox aboard, the GI Secretariat S. hero and GI Kentucky Derby third-place finisher rattled off fractions of :12.40, :24.40, :36.20, and galloped out six furlongs in 1:15.40. The sophomore heads to the \$5-million main event following a second-place finish in the grassy GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic Invitational S. at Belmont Oct. 2. “It

It was the tail end of session 8 at the 2009 Keeneland September sale and another day at the office for trainer Philip Sims, who was in the process of purchasing his second of three horses from the sale, the most expensive of which cost him \$9,000. The object of his affection on that afternoon was hip [2787](#), a

Stonerside-bred filly by Congaree out of Lost Expectations (Valid Expectations). Sims landed her for the sale upset price of \$1,000.

"I think it was the middle of the sale and a transition day, and it was just the case that people that were there that day were looking for the more expensive horses," Sims recollected. "She was just a nice, sensible filly that was very well-balanced. It looked like she'd make a nice two-year-old and seemed bred for endurance, which is also something I was looking for."

For Sims, the recipe was a pretty simplistic one and not the least bit complex.

"I went there just trying to buy racehorses," he explained. "I have bred the occasional horse, but a lot of times it's just easier to go and buy one."

The filly he would come to name Don't Tell Sophia was broken by Sims himself on his Scott County farm, and it was soon evident that the she was probably worth a lot more than the \$1,000 he'd given for her.

"I broke her, gave her some time away, and then, I'd say after she got up to a half-mile in her breezes, that's when I started thinking I had something," he commented. "She refused to let the other horses go by her and she always did it effortlessly."

Brought into Sims's Keeneland barn in early July, she trained along steadily at first, then posted a bullet half-mile in early September.

Her five-furlong move over the Keeneland Poly Oct. 4 got the attention of track clockers, who said in their daily report, "strong finish, broke several lengths behind two breezers from another stable and easily caught them in the stretch."

Following an easy prep over three-eighths of a mile, the bay was ready for her debut. Originally, Sims was pointing Don't Tell Sophia for an opening-day maiden over 8 1/2 furlongs, but she had coughed a few days earlier and "didn't seem quite right," so she was re-routed to an Oct. 17 event over the about seven-furlong distance. And the word was out. From a morning-line quote of 15-1, Sims's filly was sent off as the 3.70-1 favorite. Breaking from the 12 hole beneath James Graham, Don't Tell Sophia wasn't quickest away from the stalls, but recovered to race in touch to the leaders while three or four off the fence on the backstretch. She made up good ground on the turn, but her inexperience caught to catch up with her in the stretch, as she drifted in under urging while managing a strong runner-up finish ([video](#)).

"I was very happy with that effort," Sims confirmed. "She ran on very well, but it looked like she was a little green in the lane."

Sims, whose best horse Hot Cha Cha (Cactus Ridge) was third in the GI Juddmonte Spinster S. and is scheduled to run next in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf, does not have a specific spot in mind for Don't Tell Sophia.
