BLAME WORKS AT KEENELAND

Claiborne Farm and Adele Dilschneider's **Blame** (Arch) yesterday put in his penultimate work in advance of the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Churchill Downs Nov. 6. The four-year-old breezed five furlongs in company with

stablemate **Apart** (Flatter); both horses were timed in :58.80, co-second fastest of 16 moves at the distance. "[Blame] always works well," trainer Al Stall Jr. offered afterward. "The time was fast, but that's Keeneland this time of year, so we weren't too surprised by the time. He was very well within himself--comfortable.

It looks like he's cooling out fine, which is the most important thing. So as we speak right now, I'm happy." Apart, winner of the GII Super Derby in his latest, is being pointed toward the GIII Ack Ack H. at Churchill Nov. 5, and Stall said it only made sense to work the two horses together. "They both run around the same time, they both needed good works, and they've worked together on numerous occasions, so this is old hat to [Blame]," said Stall. "It's a luxury we have right now." Clockers caught Blame and Apart in fractions of :23.4 and :47 and galloping out six furlongs in 1:11.60. "They just took us around," said exercise rider Casey Chavez, who was aboard Blame. "It was as easy as it can get. Just relaxed enough, not dragging us, just comfortable all the way." Jockey Garrett Gomez is slated to be in the irons in Blame's final Breeders' Cup work, and Chavez believes Gomez will inherit a horse who is peaking at the right time. "He looks like he's getting better, if you ask me," Chavez said. "He's in good form, as good as you can really ask for. I'm really happy. I can't get the smile off my face. Except I'm a little sad, that's the last time I'm going to be working him." Claiborne Farm's Dell Hancock was on hand for the work. "I thought he worked as good as he could work," Hancock said. "He's such a fun horse to watch, because he does it so easy, and I thought he worked great."

Overcoming some traffic issues here, Gentoo was ultimately a convincing winner to become the third to complete the Prix du Cadran-Prix Royal-Oak double since this was opened to older horses in 1979. Royal Gait (GB) (Gunner B {GB}) first achieved it in 1987 before France's recent staying star Westerner (GB) (Danehill) recorded the double twice in 2003 and 2004. While he still has a way to go to match the latter, Gentoo is a marathoner scaling the heights quickly now that connections have discovered his forte. One of the season's bargain tales, the bay had shown this summer that he was ready to step out of handicap and conditions company and made an instant impact when beating Watar (Ire) (Marju {Ire}) by two lengths in the G3 Prix Gladiateur over course and distance Sept. 12. With some rivals caught up in scrimmaging in behind on that occasion, the gelding had to prove the worth of that form in the G1 Prix du Cadran over 2 1/2 miles here on Arc day and made light work of the task with a fluent defeat of Winter Dream (Ire) (Act One {GB}) and the high-class yardstick Kasbah Bliss (Fr) (Kahyasi {Ire}). Under restraint early settled on the inner in mid-pack by Christophe-Patrice Lemaire, he needed some space on the final turn, but was initially denied it by old rival Watar as Celtic Celeb shook off the challenge of Flying Cross (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) in a bid to capitalise on the easy lead he had been granted throughout. When the gap came with 300 metres remaining, Gentoo ate up the ground and dominated the long-time leader in the final 50 yards. "Over this trip on heavy ground, he is a great horse, and next year it could be the G1 Ascot Gold Cup for him," said winning trainer Alain Lyon.

Relatively unconsidered entering this test, Aoife Alainn took a marked jump forward to upset the hot favorite Antara and derail the blue train of Godolphin. Unraced at two, the chestnut stepped up off maiden and conditions wins at Pisa Mar. 14 and the San Siro Apr. 7 to register a first black-type success in the nine-furlong Listed Premio Zanoletti di Rozzano back at the latter venue 10 days later. Only fourth returned there for the 10-furlong G3 Premio Mario Incisa June 27, she paid a third visit to Milan to fill third spot when dropped to a mile in the Sept. 19 Listed Premio Pietro Bessero before finishing 2 3/4 lengths fifth behind She Is Great (Ire) (Dalakhani {Ire}) in the Listed Premio Archidamia over this track and trip last time Oct. 3. Held up with only one behind early, she worked her way into contention in early stretch as the long-time leader Soberania was tackled by Antara. As the latter began to win that war, Aoife Alainn delivered the killer blow with a furlong remaining, and the favorite had no answer to her surge in the final yards. **For video, click [here](#).**

Successful over seven furlongs on debut at Hanover Oct. 3, Djumama kept her perfect tally in place in testing conditions to capture this prestigious prize which crowns the "Winter Queen." Keen on the front end early before taking a lead from Lips Poison (Ger) (Mamool {Ire}), the bay was hard at work when angled over to the stand's side at the top of the stretch and looked to face a hopeless task as the leader kicked into a clear advantage. Keeping up the chase along with Aigrette Garzette, she found a final surge as the eventual fourth started to tread water close home and rolled to the front in the final 50 yards. Winning jockey Adrie de Vries said, "I thought we were going to be second or third, but when I switched her further to the outside she really got into gear again." Trainer Andreas Lowe added, "I bought her on looks and not on paper, and I am sure that she has enough stamina to run in the Preis der Diana [German Oaks] next year."

Big Week demonstrated his staying ability to claim the final leg of Japan's three-year-old Triple Crown. After breaking his maiden in July, the Bago colt was third behind Rose Kingdom and Japanese Derby winner Eishin Flash (Jpn) in his first graded stakes attempt, the G2 Kobe Shimbun Hai. Sent postward as the seventh betting choice for his Group 1 debut, the dark bay broke sharply and was eased in third position close to the rails as Cosmo Laputa (Jpn) shot past for the lead with Kamidanomi (Jpn) chasing the pace-setter in second. With a little more than 1000 meters left to negotiate, Big Week overtook Kamidanomi, then gradually made his move exiting the third turn before shifting into gear to nail the leader and drawing off to record a comfortable victory. BREEDERS' CUP BULLETIN

Pletcher's Breeders' Cup Brigade Hits Track

Todd Pletcher had a busy Sunday morning with a number of his Breeders' Cup-bound horses hitting the training track at Belmont Park. Included was the big horse, the Ned Evans homebred **Quality Road** (Elusive Quality), who will be one

of the favorites for the GI Breeders' Cup Classics. The four-year-old breezed five furlongs in 1:01.41; it came seven days after he worked six panels in 1:13 2/5. "It was a similar type of work [to last week's]," said Pletcher. "Last week

we went three quarters, and this week we went five eighths. The big gallop out was another step towards having him prepared for a mile and a quarter. Based on the way he's been finishing his breezes and galloping out, I think we've got him just where he needs to be for that type of race." Pletcher said that, thus far, everything has gone to plan for **Quality Road**, who is coming off a win in the GI Woodward S. at Saratoga Sept. 4. "Every breeze has been on the day we wanted, and every one has been executed the way we've wanted," said Pletcher. "We've got the bulk of our training done. It's just a matter of shipping in safely. He'll have a maintenance-type drill over the track at Churchill. He'll probably have two or three gate schooling sessions there." Pletcher's string is slated to ship to Churchill Tuesday.

Meanwhile, Mike Repole's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile contenders, ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie) and **Stay Thirsty** (Bernardini), put in separate works Sunday. The undefeated **Uncle Mo**, coming off a win in the GI Champagne S. in just his second career start at Belmont Oct. 9, went four furlongs in :49.97, while **Stay Thirsty**, second in the GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. Sept. 6, got five panels in 1:01.38. "[Uncle Mo's breeze] was just very easy," said Pletcher. "I thought he galloped out the first eighth well. We'll see how he ships in, and might do something a little longer next time, perhaps five eighths. We'll just play it by ear. [Stay Thirsty] is obviously on a different program, having not run since the Hopeful."

Paul Pompa, Jr.'s three-year-old filly **Rose Catherine** (Speightstown) is set to take on the boys in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint. Yesterday, she breezed five furlongs on the main track in 1:04.26. "She finished up OK, and it was a what-I would-expect-her-to-do type of work on the dirt," said Pletcher.

Derrick Smith's **Bribon (Fr)** (Mark of Esteem {Ire}), third in the six-furlong GI A.G. Vanderbilt S. at Saratoga Aug. 8 and then sixth in the seven-furlong GI Forego S. at Belmont Sept. 4, is under consideration for the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, but would have to be supplemented. He put forth a five-furlong move in 1:01.06 yesterday. "I think the horse is training as well as he ever has," said Pletcher. "We'll talk to Mr. Smith in the morning and see if he wants to put up the supplement. Our other option would be to stay here and run in the GIII Bold Ruler [Oct. 30] and the [GI Hill 'n' Dale] Cigar Mile [at Aqueduct Nov. 27]."

Japan's Espoir City Breezes at Churchill

Japan's hope for the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Churchill Nov. 6, **Espoir City (Jpn)** (Gold Allure {Jpn}), worked for the first time at Churchill Downs yesterday. The five-year-old breezed an easy six furlongs in 1:18.20 under jockey Tetsuzo Sato. Espoir City spent about 20 minutes loosening up in the mile chute before beginning his work. Clockers caught him through splits of :14.20, :28.40, :41.60, :54.20, 1:06.40 and out seven furlongs in 1:33.60. "We are coming to this race with the image of a mile and a quarter race, and today was a step in that direction," Sato said through an interpreter. "The work this morning went as planned. We are not here to pursue speed, just conditioning." That Espoir City switched leads several times in the stretch did not concern Sato. "He is up front in most of his races, and sometimes he loses a little focus and fools around a bit because he knows he has no competition," Sato explained. After the work, Espoir City walked around outside Barn 42 in the grassy area of the quarantine section for another 20 minutes.

Espoir City brings fine credentials to the Classic. He romped by 3 1/2 lengths in last year's G1 Japan Cup Dirt ([video](#)) and took this season's G1 February S. ([video](#)) by a similar margin. The chestnut, runner-up in the Oct. 11 Mile Championship Nambu Hai at Morioka in his first start in five months, arrived at Churchill last Tuesday, and seems no worse for wear after the long trip. "Much better than I had imagined," Sato said when asked how he felt Espoir City handled the shipping. "He has shipped within Japan and become accustomed to it. He was a little tired when he got here, but he is over it now." Trainer Akio Adachi is scheduled to return to Louisville from Japan for Espoir City's final work. Sato, who also has been getting on horses for trainers Dale Romans and Todd Pletcher, was scheduled to return to Japan Monday, but would return for the final work, the date of which hasn't been finalized. Espoir City is by Gold Allure, a son of Sunday Silence.

Stall Unsure on J. B.'s Thunder's Destination

Trainer Al Stall Jr. said he was still undecided on whether Columbine Stable's **J. B.'s Thunder** (Thunder Gulch), winner of the GI Dixiana Breeders' Futurity at Keeneland Oct. 9, will run in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Churchill Nov. 6 or the \$1-million GIII Delta Downs Jackpot at Delta Downs in Louisiana Nov. 20. "He's in a rare spot--rare for me, rare for him," Stall said. "He's an undefeated Grade 1 winner at two. If he happens to win the Juvenile, he'd be a two-year-old champion. Switch Tunes up for Turnback

C R K Stable's **Switch** (Quiet American) worked five furlongs at Churchill Downs Sunday in 1:00.20. The three-year-old filly is coming off a near upset of Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}) in the 1 1/16-mile GI Lady's Secret S. at Hollywood Park Oct. 2, but will be turning back in distance for the Breeders' Cup as she targets the seven-furlong GI Sentient Jet Filly & Mare Sprint. "I am not sure she wants a mile and eighth as a three-year-old," trainer John Sadler explained. "If the Sprint was six furlongs, she would not run, but it is not really a 'sprint' sprint. Seven-eighths to a mile is her best distance. Next year, we can come back in the [Ladies'] Classic at a mile and an eighth. She was fourth earlier in the year at a mile and eighth when she shipped to Gulfstream Park, but she didn't get the right trip that day." Yesterday, under exercise rider Lupillo Alferez, Switch laid down fractions of :12.20, :23.80, :35.40 and :47.40; she galloped out six furlongs in 1:13.80. The time was the second fastest of 32 at the distance and comes on the heels of a bullet half-mile move in :47 flat Oct. 17. "It was nice and smooth and she looked good doing it," Sadler said. "I told him to go in a minute, so that was fine." In the Lady's Secret, Switch cut the corner turning for home and quickly opened a daylight lead on Zenyatta, but was caught in the last jump. "It is etched in my mind," Sadler said with a laugh. "The thing about it was the place went quiet for a few seconds when Switch spurted clear. And then Zenyatta came on and the place erupted."

Hometown Girl Acoma Works at Churchill

Helen Alexander and Helen Groves's **Acoma** (Empire Maker), on course for the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic, worked for the first time yesterday since her breakthrough win in the GI Juddmonte Spinster S. at Keeneland Oct. 10. The five-year-old covered five furlongs at Churchill Downs in 1:01.60--the 11th fastest of 32 at the distance. Working just after the renovation break under jockey Tony Farina, Acoma was caught through fractions of :12.60, :24.80 and :37.20; she galloped out six furlongs in 1:15.40. "It was a nice work and she did it well within herself," trainer David Carroll said. "I was going to work her a half, but she went five-eighths to get the edge off. Tony knows her and will give me good feedback." Acoma has a home-field advantage at Churchill, where she's been based for the majority of the last three years. She has raced at Churchill seven times, going two-for-two on the dirt and winning three graded stakes on the grass. "It's huge," Carroll said. "If it were anywhere else, we would not be running. She has trained here, had a lot of success here, and is very happy here. She has never had a bad race here. She was fourth once [in this summer's GIII Locust Grove H.], but she was right there at the wire [beaten a half-length]." Robby Albarado will ride Acoma in the Ladies' Classic.

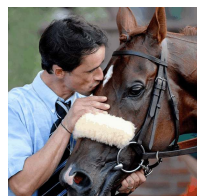

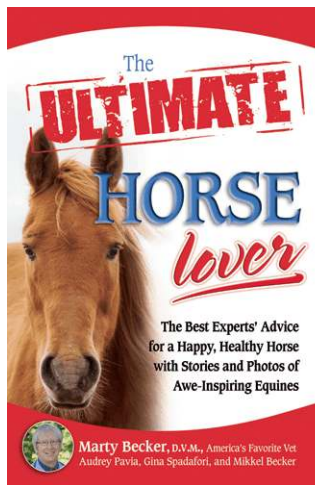
