'FIRE' SALE AT TATTERSALLS

Last season's G1 Gran Criterium winner **Hearts Of Fire (GB)** (Firebreak {GB}--Alexander Ballet {GB}, by Mind Games {GB}) lit up the Tattersalls Autumn Horses

In Training Sale in Newmarket last night when selling for 550,000gns (US\$908,573) to Qatari interests ([hip 405](#)). Trainer Ibrahim Al-Malki came in with one late decisive bid to secure the three-year-old, who had attracted the interests of many other buyers.

Tattersalls representative Jason Singh, acting for Form Bloodstock of South Africa, was underbidder, with New Zealand trainer and agent Paul Moroney lasting just shy of 500,000gns. California-based handler Ben Cecil offered 350,000gns, while Sheikh Mohammed's former racing manager Anthony Stroud, shopping for the Dubai Carnival, also made a major play for the colt. Al-Malki, who trains in Qatar, was buying for owner Hassan Ali Abdul Malik, although his purchase could resurface in Europe next year. "He just ticked all the boxes and we thought he was the best horse in the sale," said Al-Malki, who was seated with racing manager Conrad Allen and Newmarket-based advisor Armando Duarte while bidding. "He'll be based in Qatar and, although he could run at the Dubai Carnival, he'll be coming back to race in Europe next season." Hearts Of Fire was acquired by trainer Pat Eddery for just £13,000 at the 2009 Doncaster August Sale and, after his Gran Criterium exploits, went on to finish third in this year's G1 St James's Palace S. He was offered from Eddery's stable to dissolve his 12-strong ownership syndicate.

Dubawi Colt Cassidy's Star of the Show...

Californian handler Jim Cassidy, buying through agent Gordian Troeller, headed the U.S. purchasing when buying the black-type-placed two-year-old Surrey

Star (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}) for 200,000gns. Agent Guy Mulcaster, acting for Sydney-based trainer Chris Waller, was underbidder for [hip 62](#). "He was my pick of the day, and I'm pleased to get him for that

money," said Troeller. "He has pulled quite hard, but settles when there is a bit of pace, which he will get in America. He battles and his form is solid." Cassidy could run his purchase, bought for Tom Arndt's Class Racing, off the plane when arriving next month. "We could run him in the [Nov. 27] G3 Generous S. at Hollywood, or otherwise wait for the start of the Santa Anita meet after Christmas," said Cassidy.

Stroud Gets Lost in the Moment for 130,000gns...

Anthony Stroud, accompanied by Sheikh Mohamed's former trainer David Loder, made several purchases for the Dubai Carnival, headed at 130,000gns by **Lost In The Moment** (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}), a three-parts brother to G1 winner **Luas Line** (Ire) (Danehill) who landed a handicap at Newbury on Saturday in Michael Tabor's colours. "He was our pick of the day, and we thought he was just a progressive three-year-old with the right profile for the Carnival," Stroud said of [hip 375](#). "Suitable horses for the meeting are short on

the ground at this year's sale."

Another heading to Qatar is the G2 **May Hill S.** second **Al Madina** (Ire) (Noverre), for whom local agent Richard Frisby paid 120,000gns on behalf of owner Khalifa Alkuwari. "George Mikhalides is going to train her in Qatar, and she was a filly with a proper pedigree who should progress well from two to three," said Frisby.

Results were mixed Monday. The strength of the sale topper helped push up average 22.8 percent, to 19,762gns, while the median was down 12.5 percent, to 8,750gns. The RNA rate was a reasonable 24.1 percent, which nonetheless was up from last year's very good 17.5 percent. 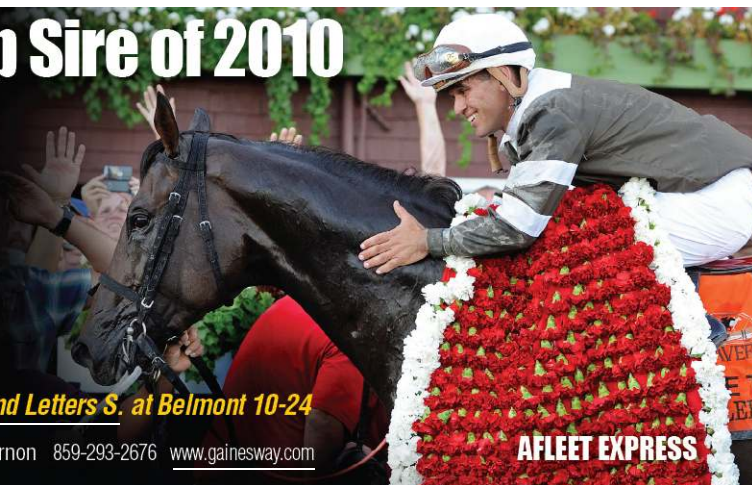



DELIGHTFUL MARY TO BC; 'LASER' UNLIKELY

A pair of Canadian-based two-year-olds conditioned by Mark Casse got a taste for the Churchill Downs main track Monday morning. WinStar Farm's **Blue Laser** (Bluegrass Cat), with Calvin Borel aboard, and John Oxley's **"TDN Rising Star"** **Delightful Mary** (Limehouse), worked together after the renovation break. Delightful Mary, partnered by Shaun Bridgemohan, broke off in front while on the outside and completed five furlongs in 1:00, a length in front of Blue Laser, who was clocked in 1:00.20. Fractions for the work were :11.80, :24, :36 and :47.40 with Delightful Mary galloping out six furlongs in 1:13.80 and Blue Laser in 1:14.40. "I thought the works were excellent," confirmed Casse. "Neither of them had worked on dirt before. Blue Laser is not as good a workhorse as she is, but he is a fighter. He got passed and came back to win twice." Delightful Mary, a winner of two of three starts on Polytrack, will be pre-entered in the GI Grey Goose Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, with Bridgmohan to ride. Blue Laser, winner of the Oct. 10 GIII Grey S. at Woodbine, may wait until the GIII Delta Jackpot S. at Delta Downs Nov. 20 instead. "We [Casse and WinStar General Manager Elliott Walden] are going to talk about it later, but I think we will probably pass the Breeders' Cup [Juvenile] and go to the Delta Jackpot," said Casse. Explaining the decision to wait for Delta's marquee event for juvenile, Walden said, "One of the factors is timing. He just ran three weeks ago and ran really hard and our program is geared to the three-year-old season." WinStar won the Delta Jackpot last year with Rule (Roman Ruler), who is currently in training at Churchill Downs.

UNRIVALED BELLE PREPARES FOR LADIES'

Gary Seidler and Peter Vegso's **Unrivaled Belle** (Unbridled's Song) tuned up for a run in the Nov. 5 GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic by working five furlongs in 1:00.60 under jockey Kent Desormeaux. Starting off several lengths behind her workmate, she reeled off

fractions of :23.60, :35.40, :47.20 and galloped out six furlongs in 1:14.80. Unrivaled Belle, who was about nine lengths in front of her workmate at the wire, recorded the fourth-fastest time of the morning at the distance. "She worked fantastic; she's a happy

lady," said Desormeaux. "She has no lack of desire. She wants to run; she likes to run." Trained by Bill Mott, the filly won a pair graded stakes earlier this season, including the Apr. 30 GII La Troienne S. over 2009 Horse of the Year Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro). In her most recent start, the grey was runner-up behind Life at Ten (Malibu Moon) in the GI Beldame S. at Belmont Oct. 2.

JORDY Y WORKS AT KEENELAND

Darrell and Evelyn Yates' **Jordy Y** (Congrats) worked for the first time since she finished third in the Oct. 8 GI Darley Alcibiades here, breezing over the Keeneland turf course yesterday morning. Clockers caught the juvenile filly, who was accompanied by Larry Melancon, in 1:01.40 for five furlongs around the dogs. The turf course, which received a small amount of rain overnight, was listed as good. "[Melancon] really liked the way she went," said trainer Wayne Catalano. "She handled the turf good and she finished up good." According to Catalano, Jordy Y will be pre-entered in the GI Grey Goose Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies and the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf, both set to be contested Nov. 5 at Churchill Downs. "We're not leaning anywhere," Catalano confirmed. "We're going to cross-enter; that was the plan the whole way. We wanted to get the workout over [at Keeneland], because they're calling for rain in Louisville, so we didn't want to get caught over there where we can't work on a muddy racetrack. We'll knock it out right here, get the turf underneath our feet and see where we're at. She looks good on it."

AUGUSTIN TEAM PREPARES AT KEENELAND

A pair of past Breeders' Cup champions headed out to the Keeneland track for trainer Jonathan Sheppard Monday morning. Under jockey Julien Leparoux, **Informed Decision** (Monarchos), winner of the 2009 GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint, worked five furlongs in :59.40 in preparation for another tilt at the seven-furlong event. The five-year-old reeled off splits of :12.40, :24.20, :36.20, :48 before galloping out six furlongs in 1:11.80. "Julien seemed to be happy with her," Sheppard said. "I told him just to go off nice and easy, but to make sure she finished up well. She finished strongly." **Forever Together** (Belong to Me), the 2008 GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf heroine, worked in company with Filly & Mare Turf candidate **Fantasia (GB)** (Sadler's Wells), covering five furlongs on the main track in :59.40. Fantasia, with Barry Wiseman in the saddle, began four lengths in front with Forever Together--who was accompanied by Leparoux--cutting the deficit in half at the wire in fractions of :13.40, :25.40, :37.40 and :49.20. All three distaffers are owned by Augustin Stable. "I was very happy," Sheppard said. "They were supposed to be working at the same time, but one behind the other. Sometimes they finish together, but that's not what we planned. Actually, Forever Together seemed to be going so strongly she kind of eased up a little bit closer to the other horse in midstretch." Sheppard indicated Informed Decision, who will ship to Louisville in the next few days, would gallop over the main track for several mornings before working Nov 1. Stablemate Forever Together is also likely to work next Monday, while Fantasia is also nominated to the GIII Cardinal at Churchill Downs Nov 7.

NO BREEDERS' CUP FOR BRIBON

Trainer Todd Pletcher, who said yesterday that he pre-entered 11 horses for the 2010 Breeders' Cup at Churchill Downs, confirmed that GI Met Mile winner **Bribon (Fr)** (Mark of Esteem {Ire}) was not among them. In addition to the fact that the seven-year-old will have

to come from off the pace in what appears to be setting up as a sizable field in this year's GI BC Sprint, Pletcher indicated that the \$180,000 entry fee was another important deciding factor. "He'll run well at Belmont," Pletcher told *Daily Racing Form*. According to Pletcher, the chesnut will contest Saturday's

GIII Bold Ruler H. as a prep for the GI Hill n' Dale Cigar Mile Nov. 27. "We just felt like the two-race program [at Belmont] is a better option for him." Third in the 2008 GI Cigar Mile for Marc Keller, the French bred scored in last year's GIII Westchester H. in addition to the Met Mile, and finished runner-up in the Cigar Mile. All three of those victories were registered at Belmont Park. This term, the gelding won the GII True North H. at the Elmont oval in June before finishing third in the Aug. 8 GI A.G. Vanderbilt H. at Saratoga.

ALL SYSTEMS GO FOR WORKFORCE

Khalid Abdullah's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe yesterday moved to silence fears about the ground ahead of the bid of **Workforce (GB)** (King's Best) in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Churchill Nov. 6. While the G1 Epsom Derby ([video](#)) and G1 Arc ([video](#)) hero had been officially committed to a visit to Churchill Downs on Saturday, connections had stated that his participation was dependant on the turf not being too firm. However, Lord Grimthorpe was giving only positive signals yesterday. "I gather there has been a new turf strip or a fairly new strip laid, and they've hardly used it, so it will be a pretty good track, and I'm not anticipating any problems with it," Grimthorpe said. "The way he has been after the Arc and his general demeanor and work have all been very good--he showed us in his work on Saturday that he's in very good form both physically and mentally, so the Prince was happy to give him the go-ahead." He added of the 2009 GI Filly & Mare Turf heroine **Midday (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}), who warmed up for her repeat bid with a win in the G1 Prix Vermeille at Longchamp Sept. 12 ([video](#)), "Everything has gone really well for her. She came out of the Vermeille in good nick, has started up again and she's her old familiar self."

Dubai Prince's reputation preceded his debut in a mile maiden at Gowran Park on debut Sept. 25, and he duly obliged as the 6-4 favorite there, accounting for the Ballydoyle duo of Seville (Ger) (Galileo {Ire}) and Obligation (Fr) (Galileo {Ire}), with the first three pulling 14 lengths clear of the remainder. The strength of that form had been underlined by the subsequent efforts of the runner-up, who was in the same spot after Saturday's G1 Racing Post Trophy, and the third-place finisher, who has since run out an easy winner at Tipperary. It was no surprise, then, that Dubai Prince attracted strong support to remain unbeaten in this often informative end-of-year staging post.

Capping a highly successful season in Ireland for his sire Shamardal and owner Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, the dark bay tracked the generous early pace in third and, after sweeping to the front with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining, drew away to best the Listed Star Appeal S. first and second Warning Flag and Park Avenue with authority. "We have always liked him, and I think he's out of the top drawer," jockey Pat Smullen commented. "He won what turned out to be a very hot maiden first time and was very impressive there over a trip that is not ideal. He's definitely going to make up into a middle-distance horse next year, and could end up going a mile and a half. But the good ones over that trip also have to have pace, and he showed that today." Demot Weld added, "He's an exceptionally good young horse and a class act who has a bright future. He has tremendous speed and has everything a top-class horse should have. There is no reason why he shouldn't stay the Derby trip next year and I think he could be very good. That is probably it for the year, as the [Nov. 13] G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud is unlikely and he'll join Godolphin now. It was a pleasure to train him for Sheikh Mohammed and he is certainly the best two-year-old I've trained since Grey Swallow (Ire), who went on to the win the Irish Derby for me." Dubai Prince was produced by half-sister to the good triple Grade/Group 1 winner Storming Home (GB) (Machiavelian); his third dam is the U.S. champion juvenile filly It's in the Air (Mr. Prospector). **Click for the [Racing Post chart](#) or [Video, courtesy attheraces.com](#).**

For any horse to develop into a major force as a stallion, it is essential that he is able to shine with the most widespread bloodlines in his nation's broodmare band. In the Anglo-Irish industry, the Danzig branch of the Northern Dancer line is undoubtedly the male line with the most representatives, thanks largely to its reputation for precocity and speed.

It is therefore no surprise that Galileo, who has his second championship in the bag, owed his Dewhurst Stakes one-two with Frankel and Roderic O'Connor to two grand-daughters of Danzig, by Danehill. Similarly, the increasingly impressive Dubawi owes his best winners, Makfi and Poet's Voice, to other grand-daughters of the legendary Claiborne stallion, their dams respectively being by Green Desert and Chief's Crown. Pivotal, one of England's highest-priced stallions, has two Group 1 winners from his 2007 crop out of Danehill mares, and three in all.

Now Shamardal, another who very definitely has what it takes, has won the G1 Racing Post Trophy with the admirable Casamento, yet another whose dam is a grand-daughter of Danzig. It is worth remembering that Shamardal, like Dubawi, is still only eight years old, but his list of good winners out of Danzig line mares is becoming increasingly impressive. In addition to Casamento, he has sired the Group 3 winners Dunboyne Express and Elle Shadow from mares by Polish Precedent and Roi Danzig respectively. For good measure he has two Australian group winners with second dams by Danehill, including that fine filly Faint Perfume.

Casamento's dam Wedding Gift had a classic background, finishing a five-length fifth in the 1996 Prix de Diane. She had earlier won a listed race over a mile at the end of an eight-race juvenile career. Even so, one doesn't expect to see the name of her sire Always Fair in the pedigree of a potential classic star.

Always Fair was a 400,000-dollar acquisition at Keeneland in 1986. With a Buckpasser mare as his dam, this son of Danzig represented a cross which was later to enjoy Graded/Group 1 success with Versailles Treaty, Easy Now and Polish Precedent. As Polish Precedent is the broodmare sire of Dunboyne Express, Shamardal's two runners in the Racing Post Trophy are bred along similar lines.

Always Fair didn't rise to quite such exalted heights, but he was also well above average. He looked as though he was potentially top class after he'd won his first three starts as a two-year-old, including the G3 Coventry S. and Acomb S. Indeed punters couldn't choose between him and the future champion Warning when they met in the G2 Champagne S.

Always Fair added another success when he took the G3 Prix Quincey over a mile at three but he cracked a cannon-bone before he could win at four. He retired to stud in France, where he ended up at Jean-Luc Lagardere's Haras du Val Henry. He sired just over 300 foals, of which three became Group winners and another eight won at listed level. None of his offspring managed to win at Group 1 level, but it is reassuring that Casamento isn't the first Group 1 winner out of one of his daughters. The colt's predecessor was that fine mare Terre A Terre, winner of the Prix de l'Opera and the Dubai Duty Free.

As neither of Casamento's parents was ever asked to tackle more than 1 5/16 miles, it is a little surprising that so much emphasis is being placed on the colt being a potential Derby winner, rather than a possible 2,000 Guineas horse. One thing Shamardal didn't lack was speed, as he showed in wiring the field in four Group 1 events--the Dewhurst S., Poule d'Essai des Poulains, Prix du Jockey-Club and St James's Palace S. His son Lope de Vega also showed plenty of pace when he emulated Shamardal's victory in the Jockey-Club, having earlier taken the Poulains.

Lope de Vega seemed not to stay a mile and a half in the Arc, but Casamento's pedigree contains much more stamina, thanks to his second dam, Such Style.

This mare's pedigree harks back to the days when stamina wasn't a dirty word. Her sire Sassafras inherited a fair measure of the stamina which enabled his sire Sheshoon, to win the Ascot Gold Cup over two and a half miles. Sassafras will always be best remembered for his victories in the Prix du Jockey-Club and the Arc, in which he became the first horse to defeat the great Nijinsky. However, Sassafras had warmed up for the Arc by finishing second in the Prix Royal-Oak over nearly two miles (and was awarded the race by the stewards).

Such Style's broodmare sire, Relko, had a similar record, as he won the Derby and the Prix Royal-Oak. Both Sassafras and Relko combined stamina with a degree of speed, though, as they both scored at around a mile early in their second season. Such Style's dam Regal Lady also had the distinction of being a half-sister to the great Vaguely Noble.

Coincidentally, Vaguely Noble first shot to fame in the Observer Gold Cup, the equivalent to the Racing Post Trophy, in 1967. In similar style to this year's star Frankel, Vaguely Noble had highlighted his potential with a very wide-margin victory at Ascot before stepping up in company at Doncaster, where he coasted home seven lengths clear.

The tragedy of Vaguely Noble's brilliant win was that he held no classic engagements, so he was auctioned at the end of the year. Although his price of 136,000gns was more than three times higher than the previous record for a horse in training at auction, he still proved a bargain, as he showed with his decisive victory over Sir Ivor in the 1968 Arc.

Casamento has also changed stables following his Doncaster victory, and he is Dubai bound for the winter. It will be interesting to see whether Sheikh Mohamed adopts a similar policy with Shamardal's unbeaten son Dubai Prince, who won the G3 JRA Killavullan S. in fine style yesterday.

Incidentally, it is tempting to concentrate solely on the Dewhurst S. and Racing Post Trophy as Britain's most prolific sources of classic winners. The last ten Dewhurst winners feature Rock of Gibraltar, Shamardal, Sir Percy and New Approach, whereas the Racing Post's roll of honour features High Chaparral, Brian Boru, American Post, Motivator and Authorized. Spare a thought, though, for Dubai Prince, as the Killavullen's previous winners include Grey Swallow (2004 Irish Derby) and Footstepsinthesand (2005 2,000 Guineas).

starts at two, and annexed the Gill Lane’s End S. at Turfway before finishing second in the GI Bluegrass S. at Keeneland early in his sophomore season. He also ran second in the GI Travers S. behind subsequent champion three-year-old Summer Bird (Birdstone) and ahead of leading older horse in 2010 Quality Road (Elusive Quality) that August. The dark bay’s main accomplishment this term was a score in the July 1 Gill Dominion Day H. over Woodbine’s Polytrack. He was last seen finishing fourth in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Oct. 2. Conditioner Bill Mott commented, “Standing every bit of 16.3 [hands], he is a very fluid mover and an imposing individual. TAPIT COLT TOPS F-T KY FALL OPENER A colt by Gainseway sire Tapit led the way at Monday’s opening session of the Fasig-Tipton Kentucky Fall Yearlings sale at the Newtown Paddocks in Lexington. Led through the ring as hip 189, the bay out of the stakes-winning mare Classic Woman (Storm Bird) was secured for \$280,000 by trainer Mark Casse, agent. A member of the Dapple Stud consignment, the Mar. 11 foal is from the family of stakes winners Classic Go Go (*Pago Pago), Melo Melody (Mr. Leader), Aironlass (Proud Clarion) and Premium Win (Lyphard), the dam of champion turf horse Tight Spot (His Majesty). The only filly to secure six figures of yesterday’s session was hip 156, a bay by Dixie Union, bringing \$120,000 from Cary Frommer, agent. Offered by Baccari Bloodstock, the Feb. 11 foal is the first foal produced by the seven-year-old Aptitude mare Cash Storm. In 2010, the session topping Tapit colt far surpassed last year’s opening leader--a colt by Wildcat Heir--that brought an \$85,000 final bid. Additionally, the increase in number of yearlings catalogued this year led to a 57-percent rise in gross to \$3,078,000, while average also grew by 24.2 percent, up from \$11,065 in 2009 to \$13,741 this year. Median dipped 16.7 percent from \$6,000 last term to \$5,000 during Monday’s session. Edition Farm's Henry Malloy Passes Away

Henry "Harry" Malloy, who owned Edition Farm in Hyde Park, N.Y. with his wife, Vivien, died Friday at his home in Waccabuc, N.Y., with his family at his bedside after a battle with cancer. He was 79 years old. With Vivien, Malloy campaigned Thoroughbreds for almost three decades on the New York circuit under the Edition Farm banner. Mrs. Malloy was named New York State Breeder of the Year by TOBA in 2007, and serves on the board of the New York Thoroughbred Breeders. The Malloys began Edition Farm in 1971 with a small barn in Purchase, N.Y., primarily for show horses. They purchased their first Thoroughbred mare in 1981 and began their Thoroughbred breeding operation. Notable stakes winners bred by Edition Farm include the Group 3 winner and Group 1-placed A Shin Forward (Forest Wildcat), a winner of over \$2 million in Japan. Harry Malloy worked for Hearst Publishing, the BBD&O advertising agency, served as the head of customer service for Bergdorf Goodman, and retired from Republic Hogg Robinson (currently known as Wells Fargo Insurance). He is survived by Vivien; his brother, John; five children; and 11 grandchildren and step-grandchildren. A mass of Christian Burial will be held at the Church of the Resurrection, 910 Boston Post Road, in Rye, N.Y. on Tuesday at 10 a.m. Donations may be made to the charity of the donor's choice in honor of Henry L.
