## RECORD BREEDERS' CUP PRE-ENTRIES

A record total of 184 horses--a near 11-percent increase over the 166 from 2009--have been pre-entered for the 2010 Breeders' Cup World Championships at Churchill Downs Friday and Saturday, Nov. 5-6. The individual pre-entries will be announced Wednesday. "Based on the commitments received by our racing department, if the fields hold together as projected, we're looking at perhaps the deepest, most talented group of horses in the history of the event," said Greg Avioli, Breeders' Cup president and CEO. "With Arc de Triomphe and English Derby champion **Workforce**

(GB) (King's Best), French champion **Goldikova (Ire)** (Anabaa), and Japanese champion **Espoir City (Jpn)** (Gold Allure {Jpn}) joining our reigning U.S. champion **Zenyatta** (Street Cry {Ire}), we have an unprecedented number of the greatest horses in the world competing in this year's championships."



## BREEDERS' CUP BULLETIN

### Zenyatta Full of Pep at Hollywood

Unbeaten **Zenyatta** (Street Cry {Ire}) proved a handful for exercise rider Steve Willard during her 1 1/2-mile gallop on Hollywood Park's Cushion Track yesterday morning. "She did great," Willard said of the GI BC Classic favorite. "Just terrific. She didn't want to pull up and said, 'Hey, let's do some more.'" Trainer John Shirreffs added, "That was a good gallop. No concerns at this point. Although, I do want to get her on the [dirt] training track again this week and off the synthetics." The six-year-old is slated to breeze at Hollywood Saturday, and will be flown to Kentucky Tuesday.

### Goldikova at the Top of Her Game

Alain and Gerard Wertheimer's **Goldikova (Ire)** (Anabaa) was the subject of a positive bulletin from trainer Freddy Head as she attempts third victory in the \$2-million GI TVG Breeders' Cup Mile next Saturday. Reported to have thrived since her 11th Group 1 win in Longchamp's Prix de la Foret on Arc day, the bay homebred is giving all the right signals as she bids to become the first to win three races at the meeting. "Goldikova's work has been good and she seems in great form," Head said. "We haven't changed anything this year and had the same prep race. It was even better this year, as we won the Prix de la Foret, so for the moment all is well. I don't think she can do better than she is." Of the change of venue, Head offered, "Going to Churchill Downs this year does not change much--all the American tracks are about the same. The weather may be a little cooler. I don't want too much rain. They have been having a very dry spell there and I hope it lasts. Even if it does rain, the ground is not going to be as soft as it was at Longchamp the other day." **Cont. p2**

Head added, "She is travelling to America on Saturday--it takes 12 hours--she ships to Louisville or Lexington with a stop at Stansted to put the English horses on the plane. She is a very good traveler and does not sweat much. We had a very bad draw last year--we had ridden from the front in the Prix de la Foret and got beat and so I told Olivier [Peslier] to wait a bit with her--he was a bit further back than we wanted, but that is the way races turn out. This year we led again in the Prix de la Foret, but she did not fight with him--that was the big difference. She is very fast--she loves the speed. There is no doubt that is why she is so brilliant in the States, because they start fast which we do not do here--the stalls open and everybody stops and holds back. The faster they go, the better she is, and firm ground is good for her. Her last good work will be on Thursday with Olivier, but she does not need much--she is very forward in her preparation. She will then just tick over in America. She is extraordinary. For a trainer to have a horse like her is unbelievable. I don't think I will train a better horse--she is very special. She is a dream to train--you can do whatever you want with a horse like that. It is a bit stressful to train her sometimes but, touch wood, she has been very, very easy. She has never had anything wrong and has been very sound. There is a bit of pressure, but I am relaxed. Things are going well at the moment. It is a bit special trying to win three Breeders' Cup races. It would be great to happen. I have been lucky enough to both ride and train winners at the Breeders' Cup."

**Koriner's Californians Work Under Twin Spires**

Defending BC Turf Sprint hero **California Flag** (Avenue of Flags) breezed five panels in 1:00.80 over the Louisville lawn yesterday. "That was fine," said trainer Brian

Koriner. "We will train him light this week, and maybe blow him out three-eighths next Monday." The Hi Card Ranch homebred is coming off a desultory last-of-11 finish in the GIII Woodford S. at Keeneland Oct. 9. "It was depressing to watch," Koriner admitted. "He ran to the top of the lane and then slowed

down. But I have had assistants to Bobby Frankel and Neil Drysdale tell me their horses would get on that sandy turf at Keeneland and not try, but they would come over here and return to form." The grey was attired with front bandages in his Lexington appearance. "He had hit himself before the race and we put the bandages on him and maybe he thought he was just going to work," Koriner offered. "I'll tell you one thing; he won't have bandages on Breeders' Cup day."

Stablemate **Sweet August Moon** (Malibu Moon) tuned up for the GI BC F/M Sprint with a five-furlong drill in 1:00.80 over Churchill's main track. Her splits were :12.20, :24.20 and :35.80 before galloping out six furlongs in 1:15. "She got a little tired, but this was the first time she has worked on dirt," Koriner said. "It was fine and I will probably come back with her next Monday for three-eighths." Victor Espinoza has the call aboard both of Koriner's runners.

**Dubai Majesty Drills on Churchill Grass**

**Dubai Majesty** (Essence of Dubai), prepping for the GI BC F/M Sprint on dirt, recorded :49.80 for her half-mile breeze on the Matt Winn Turf Course yesterday. "I am not sure if [trainer] Bret [Calhoun] has done this in the past before a dirt race," said Dennis "Peaches" Geier, Calhoun's assistant at Churchill Downs. "But the turf is a lot easier on her." The five-year-old, who has twice won the GIII Winning Colors S. at Churchill, is coming off a victory over defending champion Informed Decision (Monarchos) in the GII Thoroughbred Club of America S. at Keeneland Oct. 9.

### Midge Has Meehan Excited

Brian Meehan was yesterday relishing saddling **Dangerous Midge** (Lion Heart) against Workforce (GB) (King's Best) and company in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf next Saturday. Iraj Parvizi's G3 Newbury Arc Trial winner received glowing praise from his Manton-based trainer. "He was impressive at Newbury and he's come on a lot since," Meehan said. "He's a horse that is improving, has had lots of time and has the perfect profile for the race. He's got lots of speed, travels and quickens and I think the track will suit him."

Meehan also plans to run Andrew Rosen's G3 Prestige S. winner and G1 Fillies' Mile third **Theyskens' Theory** (Bernardini) in the GI BC Juvenile Fillies.

"Theyskens' Theory has been entered in the turf and the dirt race, but I think she's more likely to go for the Juvenile on the dirt," Meehan explained. "She's really well and, although we were tempted to go for the G2 Rockfel S. [at Newmarket Oct. 16], this made more sense. She's bred for it, and I think it

will really suit her." The bay filly is a half-sister to 2005 GI BC Juvenile hero Stevie Wonderboy (Stephen Got Even).

### Frontieres Ruled Out of Turf

Sir Robert Ogden's G1 Irish St Leger winner **Sans Frontieres (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) will not run in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf, trainer Jeremy Noseda announced yesterday. Bound for the G1 Melbourne Cup initially before suffering a setback, the four-year-old had been under consideration for a diversion to Churchill Downs, but that was also ruled out. "Sans Frontieres suffered a setback in quarantine, so it has been decided to finish him for the year," Noseda commented. "I have been delighted with his performances this year, winning three group races which culminated in the Irish St Leger. I do feel that he can improve again next year and it will be great to have him around."

Martin Garcia has picked up the mount on GI BC Sprint contender **Kinsale King** (Yankee Victor) after Garrett Gomez took off the G1 Golden Shaheen winner. “[Agent] Ron Anderson called me Tuesday morning and said that Garrett Gomez thought that Kinsale King might not like the dirt and he had opted to go with another horse [in the Sprint],” trainer Carl O’Callaghan said yesterday. “So, I went right back to the kid that won three races in a row with him.” Garcia rode Kinsale King to wins in the GIII Vernon Underwood S. and GII Palos Verdes H. last winter before Gomez rode the five-year-old to victory in Dubai in March. Kieren Fallon rode the bay in two starts in England. “Martin is on a high right now,” O’Callaghan continued. “He’s riding real good. If Bob Baffert can ride him in the Classic, Carl O’Callaghan can surely use him in the Sprint.”

### THE CAT TOPS AT TATTS

The regally bred **Cat Junior** (Storm Cat--Luna Wells {Ire}, by Sadler's Wells) set the highest price on day two of Tattersalls' Autumn Horses In Training Sale in Newmarket last night when realising 220,000gns as the result of an international bidding battle. Cat Junior has been second in three Group 2 events this season for trainer Brian Meehan, most recently in the G2 Challenge S. at Newmarket, and looks set to head off to a sunnier climate. Badr Al Hajri, who had travelled from Saudi Arabia purely to buy Cat Junior, struck the successful bid. Nils Petter Gill, a Norwegian owner who runs many of the country's Subaru dealerships, tried hard for the five-year-old, but the underbidder was Iran-based owner Farid Borbar.



It was a busy day for those shopping for the Dubai Carnival, with Anthony Stroud and David Loder, whose purchases are expected to race for members of the Maktoum family, much in evidence. Stroud paid 215,000gns for Philip Newton's homebred four-year **Jedi (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}), who was fourth at Newbury for trainer Sir Michael Stoute last Saturday in the G3 St Simon S. Jump trainer Donald McCain was underbidder on the four-year-old.

"He cost a bit more than we were expecting, but I think that's because there's a big shortage here of horses that are highly enough rated to go to Dubai," said Stroud.

This month's G3 Cornwallis S. winner **Electric Waves (Ire)** (Exceed And Excel {Aus}) is also likely to appear at the Dubai Carnival after agent Bertie Butler, acting for Saudi trainer Naif Altawi, fought off California-based handler Jim Cassidy at 200,000gns.

"She's likely to be pointed at the UAE Guineas and it would be great to win it," said Butler. "She could be bred from, eventually."

Australasian buyers were out in force and New Zealand-based agent Paul Moroney, whose brother Mike trains at Flemington in Australia, paid 210,000gns to see off Danny Murphy, acting for Singapore clients, for the promising Aidan O'Brien-trained three-year-old **Don Carlos (Ger)** (Galileo {Ire}).

"He missed a lot of the season after pulling a muscle, but has put in two reasonable performances since then. He could be more a [G1] Cox Plate than a [G1] Melbourne Cup horse, and is going to be trained by my brother Mike," confirmed Moroney. Moroney later paid 155,000gns for the three-year-old **Kaptain Kirkup (Ire)** (Captain Rio {GB}), offered by trainer Michael Dods for owner Kevin Kirkup.

"This one's likely to go to our stable in New Zealand, where there is a dearth of good sprinters, so he could be competitive in Group 1s there," added Moroney. Agent Guy Mulcaster, acting for Sydney trainer Chris Waller, successfully bid 190,000gns for the two-year-old **Marden (Ire)** (Daneshill Dancer {Ire}), a recent maiden winner for the Sangster family.

Domestic jumping buyers were out in force and Robbie Hennessy, who trains in Ireland's County Meath, spent 200,000gns on **Table Mountain (Ire)** (Milan {GB}), a recent easy handicap winner for trainer Aidan O'Brien.

"He'll be gelded pretty much straightaway and has been bought for my father, William, to go hurdling," said Hennessy. "We hope he might get to Cheltenham for the Triumph Hurdle in March."

She occupied the same berth in the Sept. 1 Listed Prix de Liancourt at Longchamp, hit the board in the Oct. 1 Listed Prix Charles

Laffitte here last time and caused a stir at long odds while recording a career high in this. Restrained off the pace in eighth after a smart exit from the gates, she was shaken up passing the two pole and quickened smartly once finding an additional gear inside the closing panel to inhale pacesetter Board Meeting in the shades of the post. **Rosanara (Fr) (Sinndar {Ire})**, winner of last term's G1 Prix Marcel Boussac and runner-up in this year's Prix de Diane, settled in the wake of stable-mate Valasyra throughout and closed well in the latter stages to finish a never-nearer fourth.

"I knew Valasyra had improved and that was a pleasing performance coming from off the pace," commented trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre. "I'm unsure if she will remain in training as a four-year-old next year and there are no immediate plans for her this season." Winning rider Gregory Benoist added, "I'm very happy to win in the colors of His Highness The Aga Khan. I didn't know her beforehand and even though she may have been the least fancied of the two [Aga Khan] runners, she is a good filly in her own right. We had a perfect trip, she was very relaxed and quickened nicely on the [very soft] ground."

**Rosanara (Fr) (Sinndar {Ire}--Rosawa {Fr})**, by **Linamix {Fr}**, winner of last year's G1 Prix Marcel Boussac, has been retired after finishing fourth in yesterday's G3 Prix de Flore at Saint-Cloud. Only fourth there, His Highness The Aga Khan's grey, who was also third in the 2009 G1 Criterium International and runner-up in this year's G1 Prix de Diane, was the winner of two of her eight starts and over €450,000 in prizemoney. "Rosanara has had a long season and is tired, which she showed today--the filly will now go to stud," trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre told *Racing Post*. "She was unlucky this season, especially [when fifth before being promoted to fourth] in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches and, unfortunately, never quite achieved the results we had hoped for this year."

**WORLD TOP 30  
 (North America & Europe)**

Each year there are between 1,000-1,100 sires in North America, Europe, and Japan who are assigned APEX ratings. In order to qualify, a sire must have 10 or more three-year-old foals in the last racing year tabulated; in other words, in 2010 a sire must have had 10 or more foals of 2007. Somewhere between 600 and 700 of these sires will have had 200 or more 'year-starters' (a horse counted as one runner each year it ran) in the previous seven years. So, when we last ran the data, on Aug. 1, it covered racing from Jan. 1, 2004 to Aug. 1, 2010.

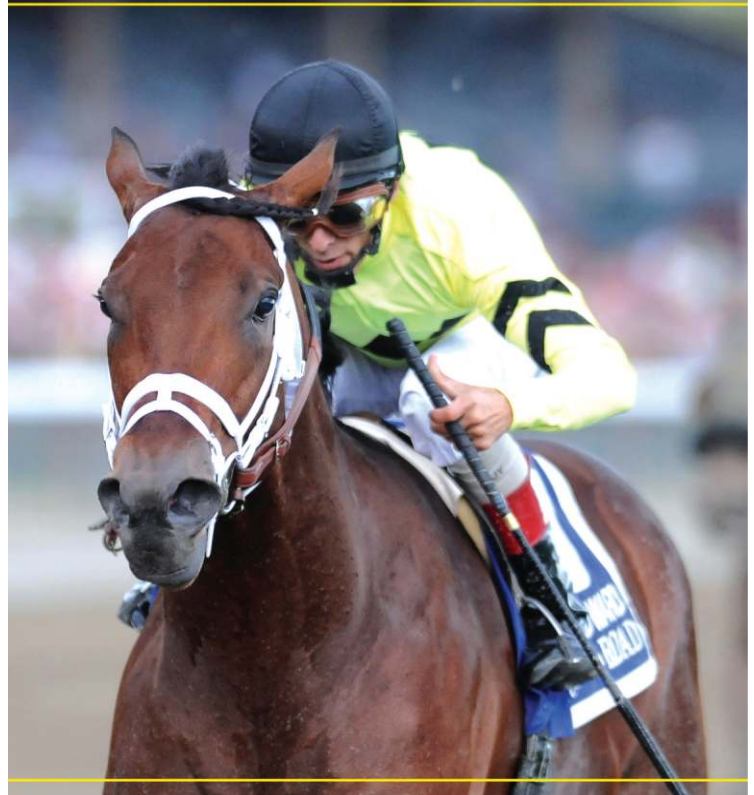
When we talk about a 'World Top 12', therefore--given that we do know we're really only talking about North American and European sires on the world's number one international circuit--we are essentially saying, these are the top two percent of sires. When we say 'World Top 30,' practically speaking it is the top five percent of sires. I don't mean to diss the top Southern Hemisphere and Japanese sires, but they aren't really on this number one international circuit, so, practically speaking, the 'World Top 30' is the top five percent of available proven sires in North America and Europe with foals three years old and up.

You'll see in the attached table (*see p11*) that we've included two APEX-based statistics on the sires listed. The APEX A Index, which is the more familiar statistic, is an improved cumulative average-earnings index covering the last seven years. Translated, it means A.P. Indy sired 9.76 percent top-two-percent earners in the major racing countries covered; Galileo sired 7.50 percent top-two-percent earners; Dynaformer, 5.32 percent; Elusive Quality and Invincible Spirit 3.62 percent (you double the index figure to get the percentage of A Runners to year-starters). The second figure is the career percentage of 'unique' A Runners (counted only once) to named foals of racing age. So, since his first foals raced in 1996, 14.15 percent of the named foals of racing age by A.P. Indy became A Runners in at least one year. That's an astronomical percentage. As you can see, most younger sires from the 'Big-Book Era' have considerably lower percentages. A Runners roughly equate to listed winners and above. A few years ago, if you'll remember, our research indicated 'six percent is the new 10 percent,' and six percent is the yardstick I use now for this category, 'percentage of unique A Runners from named foals of racing age.'

But, as I said last week when discussing the latest version of the World Top 12, there is no hard-and-fast correlation between either of those APEX numbers and which list, if either, a sire is selected for. I will note that all of the current World Top 12 have A Runner indices above 2.50, and, with a couple of exceptions, their percentage of unique A Runners to foals is above seven percent. The two exceptions are Coolmore sires Danehill Dancer (6.77 percent with huge crops starting with impossible mares--this is a lifetime statistic, remember) and Montjeu (6.63 percent, but with a severe colt bias). Obviously those numbers don't guarantee you a spot among the World Top 12, but you just about can't get there without them. They are what are called 'necessary, but not sufficient' conditions for inclusion.

As you'll see from my (admittedly subjective) table, the first four Kentucky sires I've listed in the 'World Next 18' portion of the table all do have A indexes of 2.50-plus, and all have eight percent-plus unique A Runners from foals. I can't really explain the voodoo which tells me where a sire really rates, but there must be hundreds of industry professionals who are compiling similar lists, using their own voodoo. As noted last week, I now think the balance of power among the world top 12 has shifted from North America (now five of the top 12) to Europe (now seven). But in the second tier, I counted 12 Kentucky sires, against five from Europe. Oh yes, that means one slot is open for reader input. There are 30 slots in the World Top 30, and I have only filled 29 of them. Who else deserves to be in (and no, you can't kick out some of mine to make more room--just one opening for now)?

It's also interesting that the two F2005 sires (first foals now five-year-olds) are both European, top 12 sire Oasis Dream and top 30 sire Dalakhani. Then the four top F2006 sires (first foals now four-year-olds), all Top 30 sires at the moment, are all North American: Medaglia d'Oro, Speightstown, Tapit, and Candy Ride; and the two F2007 sires (first three-year-olds; rarely are sires from this category included in these lists), both Darley European sires, are: newest world top 12 sire Dubawi, and newest world top 30 sire Shamardal. Interesting, too, that Coolmore (Galileo, Montjeu, Danehill Dancer, Giant's Causeway) leads Darley (Street Cry, Dubawi) four to two among the World Top 12, but in the remainder of the World Top 30, there are four Darley sires (Elusive Quality, Medaglia d'Oro, Cape Cross, and Shamardal), but none for Coolmore. Darley does also own 'legs,' too, of top 12 sires Distorted Humor and Pivotal, and top 30 sire Invincible Spirit.



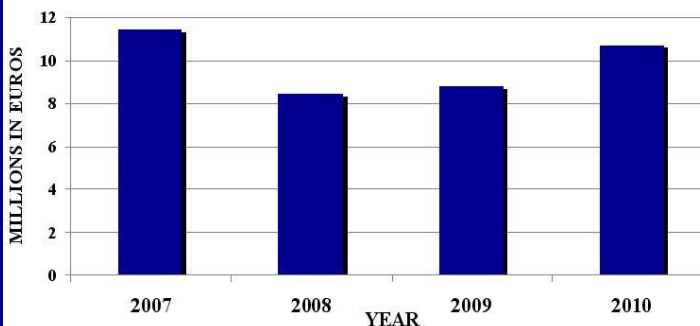

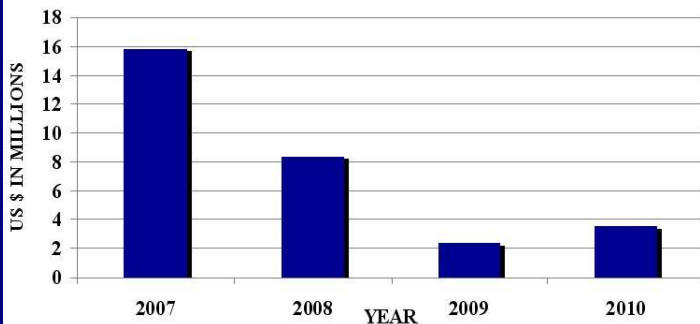

The specific composition of the world top 12, or the world top 30, is of course open to discussion and disagreement. But the whole discussion does raise again, at least in my mind, the question of what is going to happen to stud fees. Already we've seen the Irish National Stud's John Osborne unapologetically announce that Invincible Spirit will be going up, to €60,000 from €45,000, not down. I fear breeders who dig their heels in and refuse to patronize sires whose stud fees don't drop significantly are going to be cutting off their noses to spite their faces. It really does come back to supply and demand--that, and an appreciation of class. Breeders know who the top sires are--some version of my top 30 table--and those are the horses they are still going to be clamoring to breed to. No doubt there is going to be fantastic value further down the scale, and for unproven stallions, but I'd be surprised to see any of these top 30 cut by more than a third. Some will be: \$50,000 is going to be plenty to breed to some sires who now stand for more; so will \$75,000 be plenty for a few more. There could be, and should be, significant reductions among a few of these, but not that many, and plenty of others among this top 30 will stay the same or even go up, like Invincible Spirit. Breeding horses is, as I'm sure you've noticed, an extremely competitive, high-stakes pursuit in which an impressive corps of bright, clever, highly trained professionals (yes, that's you, dear reader) are forming opinions and acting on them. As a stallion manager, if you have one of the 30 or so stallions that a lot of people want, the supply and demand equation is in your favor. If not, yeah, that's probably a stud fee that's going to fall.

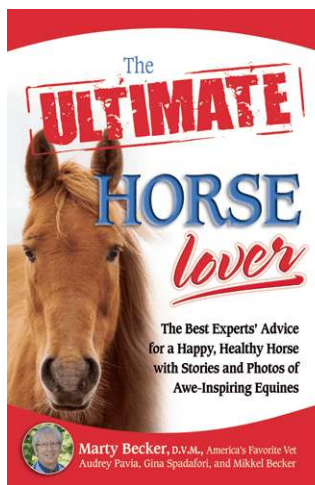
