LET THE GAMES BEGIN

A loaded field of 16, headed by unbeaten **Zenyatta** (Street Cry {Ire}), was pre-entered for the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Churchill Downs Nov. 6, it was announced yesterday. The defending Classic heroine will face leading older horses **Quality Road** (Elusive Quality) and **Blame** (Arch), top three-year-old **Lookin At Lucky** (Smart Strike), and Japanese invader **Espoir City (Jpn)** (Gold Allure {Jpn}) in the \$5-million centerpiece. Turf champion **Gio Ponti** (Tale of the Cat) was cross-entered in the Clas-

sic and the GI Breeders' Cup Mile, while **Goldikova (Ire)** (Anabaa) seeks a remarkable third straight win in the Mile. **Workforce (GB)** (King's Best), victor of the G1 Qatar Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe and G1 Epsom Derby, will make the trip across the pond for the GI Breeders' Cup Turf. Leading two-year-olds **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie) and **Boys At Tosconova** (Officer) are set to do battle in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. **Blind Luck** (Pollard's Vision) renews her rivalry with **Havre de Grace** (Saint Liam) in the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic. Last year's Breeders' Cup champions **California Flag** (Avenue of Flags) (Turf Sprint), **Informed Decision** (Monarchos) (F/M Sprint) and **Midday (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) (F/M Turf) are back to defend their titles. A record 184 horses, 26 from overseas, were pre-entered for the two-day Breeders' Cup World Championships. The 14 races will be televised live on ABC and ESPN. "The overall depth and quality of this year's pre-entered fields are higher than at any previous occasion," said Tom Robbins, Chairman of the Breeders' Cup Racing Directors/Secretaries Panel. "The international contingent is particularly strong and is bolstered by high ratings for Zenyatta, Workforce and Goldikova."

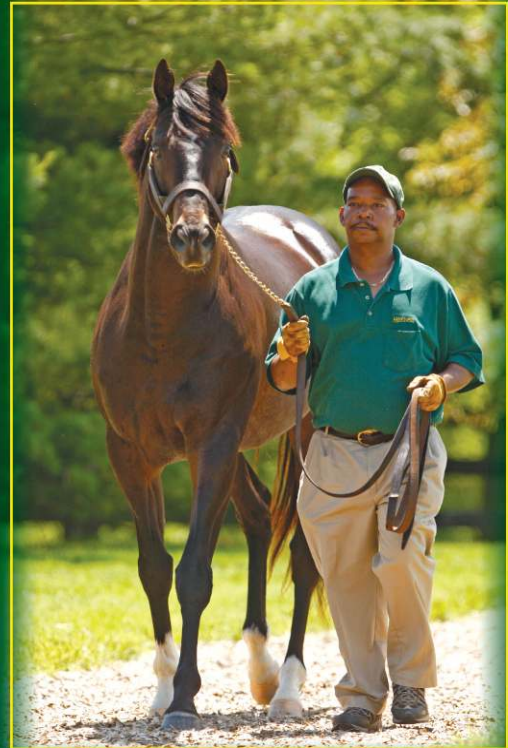

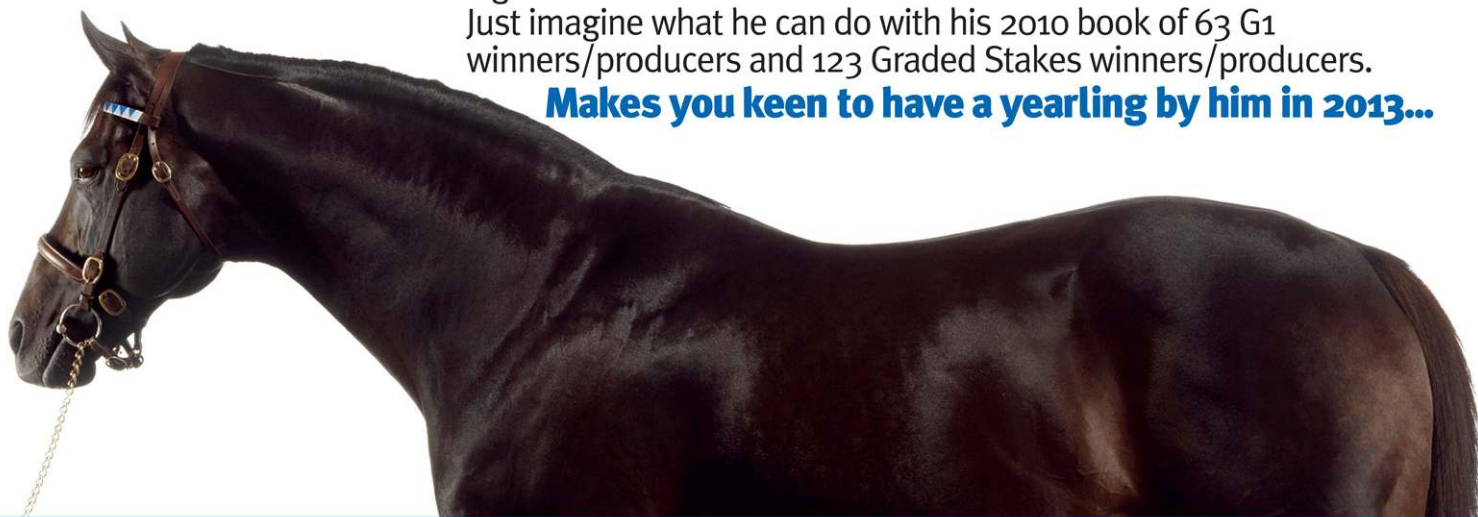

Head Relishing Return to Louisville...

Freddie Head knows about history-making accomplishments in the Breeders' Cup. A year after guiding the great Miesque to victory in the 1987 GI Mile at Hollywood Park, the then 41-year-old ventured to Churchill Downs and rode the filly to a repeat success in the Mile, becoming the first horse to go back-to-back on Championship Day. Now 63 years old and fully 13 years into his career as a trainer, Head stands on the brink of another milestone achievement, and will attempt to win the Mile for the third straight season with Wertheimer et Frere's **Goldikova (Ire)** (Anabaa). Head is looking forward to his return to the Twin Spires.

"Of course I am very excited about coming back to Churchill," he commented from France during a national media teleconference Wednesday. "For me, it's going to be a special day. When I won with Miesque at Churchill, that is one of my best souvenirs as a jockey, so to come back here with a horse like [Goldikova], there is something very special about that."

Still, despite being on record as saying that Goldikova is as good or better than she was in 2008 and 2009, Head is taking absolutely nothing for granted.

"I think it's going to be a great race," he opined. "Paco Boy (GB) (Desery Style {Ire}) is a hell of a horse and Gio Ponti (Tale of the Cat) is the same. They could be the best milers in the world right now, so it's going to be a fascinating race, I suppose. It's always hard to win a race like this. We need a bit of luck, but if all goes well, I think she'll do her best."

While some horses are over the top by the age of five, such is not the case with Goldikova, who enters the mile off a smashing score in the G1 Prix de la Foret on the Arc undercard Oct. 3.

"All she wants is to run, run, run," Head explained. "No matter what horse you put her with [in trackwork], she wins her gallops by 10 lengths. She's kept her freshness that, sometimes with age, horses start to lose a bit."

So, is it tougher to ride top-class horses like Miesque and Goldikova, or is it trickier to train them? No one is better qualified to answer that question than Freddie Head.

"I think it's tougher to ride a horse like Goldikova," he offered. "When you are on the back of a horse like that, there is a lot of pressure. You have to think quick. You can get beat by missing the start or losing momentum at any point in the race. I think training her is much easier. She does whatever you want and you just have to keep her happy."

Euros Trying to Catch Lightning in a Bottle...

Churchill Downs has been the scene of some memorable near-misses in addition to the numerous successes of European-based horses in the Breeders' Cup. In 1998, Swain (Ire) nearly won the Classic beneath Frankie Dettori, but drifted out badly in deep stretch and lost to Awesome Again in a four-horse photo. Just two years later, Giant's Causeway hooked up with Tiznow at the head of the stretch, and the two engaged in a captivating duel, won ultimately by the American in a ride which haunts the now-retired Mick Kinane. The Irishman dropped the reins on the "Iron Horse," perhaps making the difference in the tightest of finishes. A total of 26 foreign-based horses, including a pair from Japan, were pre-entered for this year's event in a bid to follow in the footsteps of Miesque, Arazi, Barathea (Ire), Kalanisi (Ire), Ouija Board (Ire) and Red Rocks (Ire), all of whom scored beneath the Twin Spires. "The level of the Europeans is extremely encouraging," said Alistair Donald, managing director of the International Racing Bureau. "I think the fact that we are on a traditional dirt surface at Churchill, rather than a synthetic surface like we were the past two years at Santa Anita, has impacted slightly on the numbers, but we are massively well-represented in the turf races, and we have juveniles on the main track as well, and I think that's very encouraging."

After supplying just 12 runners when the 2007 Breeders' Cup was held at Monmouth Park, a total of 65 foreign-based horses competed at Santa Anita in 2008 and 2009, the highlights of which were Raven's Pass (Elusive Quality)'s upset of the 2008 Classic and the Mile performances of Goldikova.

"The Works is the ultimate insider's preview of the Breeders' Cup presented in a format that offers insights to racing fans at all levels," said Tony Allevato, TVG's executive producer and senior vice president.

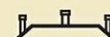

Anthony Stroud, thought to be buying for the Maktoum family, continued shopping for the Dubai Carnival. Topping his list yesterday was the classy three-year-old handicapper **Rock N Roll Ransom (GB)** (Red Ransom), who was sold from Luca Cumani's stable for 240,000gns.

NTRA REPORT FROM CAPITOL HILL



TIGHT HOUSE RACES IN NEW YORK, KENTUCKY FOR DEMOCRAT INCUMBENTS

Voters in major Thoroughbred racing states New York and Kentucky will decide two tight House races featuring Democrat incumbents during next week's midterm elections. At stake for Democrats on November 2 is retention of control of the House.

Freshman Congressman **Scott Murphy (D)** faces retired Army Colonel **Christopher Gibson (R)** in New York's 20th district, the home of Saratoga Race Course, Saratoga Gaming and Raceway and numerous Thoroughbred farms. On Tuesday, **Siena (College) Research Institute** released a poll that revealed Gibson with a 9 point edge over Murphy after trailing by 17 points in September.

Murphy expects a boost from former President Bill Clinton, who will campaign with him on Monday in Saratoga County. He also may benefit from the surge in popularity of Democrat Andrew Cuomo over Republican Carl Paladino in the race for governor.

In Kentucky's 6th district, home to Keeneland Race Course and many of the world's leading Thoroughbred farms, four-term incumbent **Ben Chandler (D)** faces attorney **Andy Barr (R)**. A poll last week of 525 likely Kentucky voters showed Rep. Chandler with a narrow 46.6-42.3 percent lead over his challenger, after holding a 14 point lead in September when Chandler eclipsed the 50 percent threshold.

Jumping trainer Donald McCain was underbidder on the colt, with Alastair Donald of the Kern Lillingston, standing with new trainer and Cumani's former assistant Ed Walker, coming just behind in the pecking order. Donald had been underbidder earlier on three-year-old **Mount Athos (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}), a York handicap winner for trainer John Hills. Stephen Hillen, acting for owner Dr. Marwan Koukash, was the successful bidder this time at 190,000gns.

"He is going to David Wachman's yard in Ireland. He was my pick of the sale, although we probably paid a premium for him," said Hillen, who acts as Koukash's racing manager. "I think he might start off next year in the Chester Cup [handicap] in May, but we hope he could go on to perform in the top staying races."

Chris Waller's stable in Sydney, Australia, gained two six-figure additions thanks to agent Guy Mulcaster. He paid 180,000gns for **Contract Caterer (Ire)** (Azamour {Ire}), on whom McCain was again underbidder. Waller also paid 100,000gns for **Foreteller (GB)** (Dansili {GB}).

"Contract Caterer could be one to go over 10 or 12 furlongs, and we've got a lot of races for those types of horses," said Mulcaster.

The 2008 G2 Prix Robert Papin **Lui Rey (Ity)** (Reinaldo {Fr}) will bid to earn prize money globally for a partnership including Newmarket-based owner Tom Morley after making 100,000gns. Trainer Robert Cowell struck the successful bid.

"We'll probably keep him ticking over before he heads out to the Dubai for the Carnival," Cowell said. "He could then go globetrotting to places like France and Germany."

For years, he has devoted substantial time and resources to developing an industry funding program and this development brings that concept closer to reality." Pressman, who received an L.L.B. from Georgetown University Law School and obtained a B.S. in Accounting from New York University, is a member of the New York County Bar Association and New York State Bar Association. He is currently Chairman of the Board of Directors of Savage Universal Corp., a private corporation, engaged in the manufacture of paper and board products for the photographic, picture frame, and graphic arts industry.

NINE U.A.E RACES UPGRADED Nine races that take place during the Dubai International Racing Carnival--all but one at Meydan Racecourse--have been upgraded, the Emirates Racing Authority announced yesterday. Seven of the races that were upgraded are group events, while another three became listed events. A total of four races are now Group 2 races: the Al Quoz Sprint and Al Rashidiya for males, and the Cape Verdi and the Balanchine for females. The UAE Oaks and DRC Gold Cup have risen to Group 3 level, while the Meydan Classic, Firebreak S. and Nad Al Sheba Trophy will be run at listed level for the first time. The Al Quoz Sprint was moved to the Dubai World Cup program for the first time, but with the established 1200-meter G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen also on the card, the Dubai Racing Club decided to amend the distance of the Al Quoz 1000 meters. The Abu Dhabi Championship, a turf race run over 2200 meters at Abu Dhabi Equestrian Club, has risen from listed to Group 3. "The quality of horses racing in the UAE, both locally based and international, has substantially grown over the years, and we are pleased the racing fixtures now reflect that caliber of competition," said ERA Board member Malih Lahej Al Basti. "The Carnival races continue to grow in strength, and this has been mirrored at other racecourses. It is pleasing to see the elevation of the Abu Dhabi Championship at Abu Dhabi."

Wide's Andy Williams said. "Just an outstanding two-year-old who looks a great racetrack prospect."

The top-priced filly on the day was [lot 131](#), by O'Reilly (NZ) out of Ultima Vita (Aus) (Canny Lad {Aus}), who sold to Cameron Cooke Bloodstock for A\$150,000. Oakwood Farm, as agent, consigned the bay, who breezed in :11.44 at the Sept. 20 under-tack preview ([video](#)). The filly is a half-sister to the black-type winner Sister Havana (NZ) (General Nediym {Aus}).

In all, 15 prospects sold for A\$100,000 or better Wednesday. The average was A\$43,427, down 20.4 percent from last year's session one figure of A\$54,534. "Things started off a tad slowly, but the bidding picked up as the session continued, and the final figures from the session were quite encouraging," Magic Millions Managing Director Stephen Silk said.
