

RODERIC'S INTERNATIONAL

Runner-up in Newmarket's G1 Dewhurst S. two weekends ago, **Roderic O'Connor (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) paid a handsome compliment to his Dewhurst conqueror Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) when charting a wayward, yet ultimately successful, path to victory in yesterday's G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud. Prominent throughout the one-mile contest, the 14-5 second-favorite assumed full control at the top of the straight, but veered badly when administered one left-handed slap entering the final furlong before recovering to defeat **Salto (Ire)** (Pivotal {GB}), with plenty in hand, by 1 1/2 lengths. "Before the race I was concerned about the [heavy] ground and the [outside] draw, but he did it very well in the end," commented trainer Aidan O'Brien. *Cont. p2*

QUALITY ROAD WORKS FOR CLASSIC

Edward Evans' **Quality Road** (Elusive Quality) tuned up for Saturday's GI Breeders' Cup Classic with a four-furlong work in :48.60 at Churchill Downs. The four-year-old, working in company with Dogwood Stable's GI Dirt Mile hopeful **Aikenite** (Yes It's True), covered the distance in fractions of :12, :24.20 and :36 and galloped out five furlongs in 1:02. He finished about a length in front of Aikenite, who completed his work in :48.40. "I thought both horses worked very well," reported trainer Todd Pletcher. "Quality Road is obviously an exceptionally talented horse and does things very easily. I thought it was a good progressive work. He picked it up down the lane, galloped out well and seemed to get over the ground extremely well."

Roderic O'Connor hit the board in a hot maiden at Leopardstown on debut June 10 before breaking through at The Curragh 16 days later. He finished a clear second to European Champion Juvenile elect **Frankel (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) in a stellar renewal of Newmarket's G1 Dewhurst S. last time Oct. 16, and overcame the deep mud and a late scare when wandering under pressure in the closing stages of this to register a career high. The eventual winner was away swiftly from the outside box to claim a slender lead after the initial strides.

Increasing his advantage off the home turn, he veered sharply right when coming under pressure entering the final eighth, but was quickly on an even keel and kept on strongly under a drive in the closing stages to secure a deserved win from Salto. Godolphin France's hitherto unbeaten French Navy (GB) (Shamardal) raced in midfield for most of the contest, but was unable to land a blow and finished a distant fifth. "Because of his outside draw, [jockey] Johnny [Murtagh] had no other choice than to go on and ride him positively," explained trainer Aidan O'Brien. "He drifted right because he was probably alone in front and was looking around, but he took off again nicely and won very well. We liked his race in the Dewhurst where he most likely needed the run having been off the track for [almost] four months. At home we think he is a very nice horse and he's a nice prospect for next year's [G1 2000] Guineas [back at Newmarket]." Dancinginherdreams was tabbed a **★ "TDN Rising Star" ★** after an effortless five-length debut victory at Keeneland Oct. 10. The gray filly settled into stride through a quarter in :22.75, but pulled herself into contention after a half in :46.59. She cut the corner into the stretch and gamely forged through an opening along the rail to take charge in upper stretch and powered clear under a motionless Julien Leparoux. "She ran good," Leparoux said. "I was in tight and she had a great pull; she does everything good." Winning trainer John Ward added, "That's the way she trains in the morning, so to see her come back and do it in the afternoon is pretty good. I thought the racetrack was very difficult today, but she obviously overcomes what's in front of her. I wouldn't call it easy, but she handled everything well." The lanky Dancinginherdreams will now head south for the winter. "We will see her again in Florida and she needs to put some meat on her bones," Ward said. "But that's what you're looking for and I think she will run as far you want her to go." Astrology, third in his six-furlong debut at Saratoga in July, graduated at second asking over seven furlongs at the Spa Sept. 4. The bay colt was third behind Sweet Ducky (Pulpit) in the Sept. 25 Garden State S. at Monmouth Park over a mile last time out. Astrology chased pacesetting Maybesomaybenot through fractions of :23.09 and :46.78 before striding past that rival turning for home. He opened a clear advantage despite racing greenly and held sway over the late-closing Ribo Bobo. "He is a beautiful horse with tons of pedigree," trainer Steve Asmussen said of the winner. "This is a very important two-year-old win, but he does childish things. It's his first day here with a new paddock and he was wound up, a lot more excitable than you would like. Garret [Gomez] said he carries you beautiful, then when Robby [Albarado]'s horse [Maybesomaybenot] dropped the bridle, he found himself in front. He just needs to get to the next step. This will help. I think he's a little too childish, but he's got a ton of ability. Briecat, second behind Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}) in last year's GI Vanity H., won the Adoration S. over the Del Mar all-weather surface last September, but was off the board in her next five outings. She returned to the winner's circle in Fairplex's La Madrinas H. Sept. 25 and returned to the turf to run second in the Oct. 10 Swingtime S. over course and trip. Briecat angled out and bumped rivals at the break, but straightened out to gain the early lead. She set fractions of :24.20, :47.93 and 1:11.19 and opened up slightly into the stretch before holding on determinedly as Westwood Pride attempted to reel her in down to the wire. "She paced her own pace and picked it up nice on the turn," said winning rider Pat Valenzuela. "I think she won it on the turn when she got away from the horses, because when she picked it up everybody else had to pick it up. Through the stretch they didn't have as much finish when she did that. She stuck her head down and fought them off." Trainer Vladimir Cerin added, "She's very, very tough on the lead. The key with her is to open up when she turns for home and hope they can't get her. Rajsaman finished ahead of G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere victor Siyouni (Fr) (Pivotal {GB}) and subsequent dual Classic hero Lope de Vega (Ire) (Shamardal) when a shock winner of the Apr. 25 G3 Prix de Fontainebleau. He finished behind both of those rivals when 10th in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains May 16 and came off a break to finish a close third in the G3 Prix du Pince d'Orange last time Sept. 18. Rajsaman was just €10,000 short of topping the sheets at Arqana's Arc sale Oct. 2, and that investment paid an immediate dividend here. He missed the break completely and raced in rear until turning for home. Making headway under pressure in the straight, he challenged at the distance and was driven out to prevail in cozy fashion nearing the line. "He broke slowly, but maybe that was a blessing in disguise as it allowed him to relax and save his turn of foot," explained new trainer Freddy Head. "I don't really know him that well yet as I bought him at the Arc Sale just four weeks ago. He's been doing well since I got him and, being by Linamix, he probably liked the softened going. We might take him to Sha Tin for the [Dec. 12 G1] Hong Kong Mile if we get an invitation. Looking at Lucky (Smart Strike) completed his major preparations for Saturday's GI BC Classic with a five-furlong drill at Hollywood Park yesterday. Last year's juvenile champion went the distance in :59.60 under Martin Garcia. It was the 11th fastest of 108 at the distance at Hollywood yesterday. "He went really well," trainer Bob Baffert said after the work. "I wanted him to go in about a minute. It was perfect for him. Everything is a go." Garcia also worked GI Frizette S. winner **A Z Warrior** (Bernardini) for Baffert. The GI BC Juvenile Fillies hopeful went four furlongs in :49.

Uncle Mo Preps for Juvenile

Also among the five Breeders' Cup hopefuls from the Todd Pletcher barn to work yesterday at Churchill Downs were GI BC Juvenile hopefuls **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie) and GI Hopeful S. runner-up **Stay Thirsty** (Bernardini). The juveniles, working in company, both completed four furlongs in :50.60. The pair worked in fractions of :12.60, :25.40 and :37.40 and galloped out five furlongs in 1:03.60. "We were not looking for a whole lot from either one," Pletcher said. "I kind of let them get a little feel for the track. I thought it was a little slower than I wanted it to be, but it was the right kind of slow. They went each eighth a little faster than the previous one. I thought Uncle Mo galloped out particularly well. He was all the way back to the half-mile pole before he actually pulled up." Pletcher also sent Paul Pompa Jr.'s Turf Sprint contender **Rose Catherine** (Speightstown) to work four furlongs around the dogs on the firm turf in :49.60. "She's a superior workhorse and would work as fast as a horse could possibly work if you allowed her to," Pletcher said. "But when you're going five-eighths on the grass, they need to be ready to roll and that's her game. I thought she worked very well."

Godolphin Pair Work at Belmont

Godolphin's **Vineyard Haven** (Lido Palace {Chi}) and **Gayego** (Gilded Time) completed preparations for Saturday's GI BC Dirt Mile with drills at Belmont yesterday. Gayego, coming off a win in the Presque Isle Mile S. Sept. 10, went four furlongs in :48.88. "He finished up great and galloped out good and he's another one we're real happy with," reported Godolphin assistant trainer Rick Metee. "That Presque Isle race looks pretty good now that [Saturday's GI Fayette winner] Successful Dan (Successful Appeal) has come back and won two starts. The one-turn mile should be perfect for him." Vineyard Haven, most recently third in the Sept. 4 GI Forego S., breezed five furlongs in 1:01.42.

Vineyard Haven and Gayego will join fellow Godolphin runners **Girolamo** (A.P. Indy) and **Sara Louise** (Malibu Moon) on a van to Belmont today. The four Breeders' Cup runners are expected to arrive at Churchill Downs on Tuesday and will go to the track Wednesday.

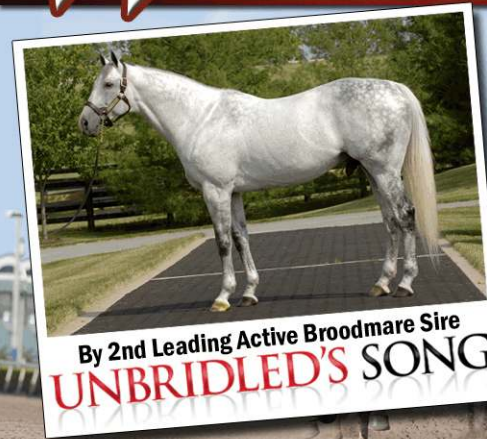
