NO ONE IS TO BLAME

With Horse of the Year honors on the line in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Churchill, even-money **Zenyatta** (Street Cry {Ire}) attempted one more last-to-first rally, but couldn't run down **Blame** (Arch), who hit the wire a half-head in front of the big mare. After racing in seventh early, Blame went through a narrow seam and got first run on Zenyatta, who trailed the field from the start. The GI Whitney H. and GI Stephen Foster H. hero dug in gamely to deny the favorite.

"He really had his game face on today," said jockey Garrett Gomez, who was winning his third race of this year's Championships. "I was just trying to hold the wonder horse off and give her her first defeat." Gomez added, "I really do have mixed emotions about that. She's been an ambassador for racing. We had a lot of people out here supporting her. She's been great for Thoroughbred racing; for fans who didn't know anything about racing. She was going for 20-for-20, and she came up a head short. I'm glad I was able to give her the defeat, but, at the same time, I wish she could have gone out 20-for-20 at the expense of somebody else. Like I said, she's been nothing but wonderful for horse racing. For me, this is the best win I've ever had." Cont. p2-3

GOTTA GO WITH 'MO

Repole Stable's **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie) was favored in yesterday's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile on the strength

of two brilliant wins in New York, but the "TDN Rising Star" made his 7-5 odds look like an overlay. After bidding his time in second, the bay colt took command entering the stretch and quickly opened up daylight. Jockey John Velazquez took him in hand late as **Boys At**

Tosconova (Officer) did his best to cut into the advantage, and Uncle Mo secured Eclipse Award honors with his 4 1/4-length victory. "I don't get goose bumps very often watching a horse race, and that's not because I'm not a huge horse racing fan," admitted winning trainer Todd Pletcher. "But that was a pretty special performance. You know, I was literally shaking a little bit after the race. It was just unbelievable. I'm super happy for Mike [Repole]." Cont. p6-7

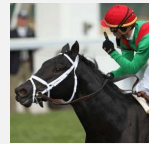
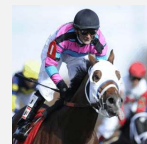

THE LURE OF THE CUP

Claiborne Farm's colors have been carried to victory on Breeders' Cup day twice, with the brilliant Lure (Danzig) taking the GI BC Mile in 1992 and again in 1993. But the experience never gets old. Yesterday, it was the partnership of Claiborne and Adele Dilschneider who rejoiced in the victory of the gallant **Blame** (Arch), who hung tough as the great **Zenyatta** (Streey Cry {Ire}) came at him to win the GI BC Classic by a head. "It's just an unbelievable feeling," said Claiborne's Seth Hanock. "We made a game plan a year ago to point for this, and usually when you make plans like that in the horse business, it never works out. You don't even make the race. But then, the closer we got to the race, we realized we were going to make it. We knew who we were running against, but were just were filled with anticipation of what might be. And then to see it come true, it's a feeling that I can't describe." But there were mixed feelings from the winning camp about ending the super mare's undefeated streak at 19. "I take no pride in beating Zenyatta," Hancock said. "She is what she is --she's awesome. She's been great for racing. Her connections are wonderful people, and I feel bad for them. But we owe it to ourselves and to the racing public to send our horse out there and try to give him the best chance we can." Added trainer Al Stall Jr., notching his first BC victory, "I don't think you'll find anybody criticizing anything she's ever done, much less today. Everybody talked about it coming down to these two for a long time, and it played out that way. We were fortunate enough to have the right horse on the right day at the right time." Claiborne and Dilschneider had one previous BC starter--Blame's sire, Arch (Kris S.), who ran ninth in the 1998 BC Classic.

Stunning in Defeat

Zenyatta dropped so far back in the early going that it seemed impossible she would impact the race in any way, let alone come within inches of winning it. Her

connections were justifiably admiring of her last-gasp attempt to preserve her perfect record. "We're real proud of our girl," Jerry Moss said in a statement. "She tried hard and ran a tremendous race only to get beat by the slimmest of margins. We congratulate Blame and his connections. He beat

a superstar." A teary Mike Smith faced the press after the race, and pointed the finger at no one but himself for her defeat. "She just wasn't leveling out like I wanted to," Smith said. "There was the dirt, of course, hitting in her face--a lot of it. She just wasn't used to that part, it just left her with too much to do. I truly believe I was on the best horse today. If I had to blame anybody, it would be me." He added, "She's my everything; she's just amazing. I just wish I would have been in the race a little earlier, because I think the outcome would have certainly been different."

virtue of her Mile wins in 1987 and 1988 at Hollywood and Churchill Downs, respectively. Head turned to training when he hung his tack, and became the first person to ride and train a Breeders' Cup winner when **Goldikova** (Anabaa) took her first Mile in 2008. "It's quite unreal," exclaimed Head. "She's amazing, she can do anything. I'm very emotional. I was the first jockey to win this race twice with a mare, and now I'm the trainer of a mare winning [this race]

Goldikova secured her first Breeders' Cup Mile as a three-year-old in 2008, when, sent postward as the 9-5 choice, she parlayed a stalking trip into a 1 1/4-length score over defending champion Kip Deville (Kipling). After collecting three more Group 1 wins in Europe in 2009, the popular bay returned to Santa Anita and rallied from the back of the pack to justify 7-5 favoritism. She was sportingly kept in training by her owner/breeders, Alain and Gerard Wertheimer, and rewarded that decision with another trio of top-level wins. Second in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville Aug. 15, Goldikova rebounded to take the G1 Prix de la Foret at Longchamp Oct. 3, defeating Paco Boy (Ire) (Desert Style {Ire}) and, in the process, surpassed Miesque's mark of Group 1 wins with her 11th such success. **Cont. p5**

Outside Chance

Having drawn the 10 hole for this third trip to the States, the 6-5 favorite took the overland route while racing in seventh, and California-based Sidney's Candy

(Candy Ride {Arg}) showed the way up front through splits of :24.02 and :47.49.

Goldikova still had a ton of ground to make up on the far turn, but it really didn't matter.

Given her cue by Olivier Peslier, the five-year-old quickened past her rivals in a matter of strides, and flashed under the wire safely in front of the valiant Gio Ponti. Paco Boy (Ire) (Desert Style {Ire}) came flying from the back of the pack, but was a whisker short of The Usual Q.T. at the line.

"I think she has everything an athlete can have," Head offered. "I mean, she's got tremendous nerves--she's very cool. She's got great speed. She's very fast, and she can carry that speed for a long time. She has always another gear. She can always change gear, and finishes faster than the others."

Goldikova is a great-granddaughter of Gold River (Fr) (Riverman), who captured the 1981 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe for father Jacques Wertheimer. The Wertheimer brothers didn't rule out their star returning for another season.

"I think that it was important to try to make history to have a horse that can win the same race three times the same race," said Alain Wertheimer. Gerard added, "At the moment, I think we're enjoying the race and the win."

Cry Uncle

Uncle Mo, tabbed a 🌟 "TDN Rising Star" 🌟 off a gaudy 14 1/4-length in his debut at Saratoga Aug. 29, was giving his owner his first-ever graded stakes win in the GI Champagne S. at Belmont Oct. 9, and was the public's choice to close out his juvenile campaign unbeaten. Connections had to be pleased early when the colt broke alertly, but then relaxed well under John Velazquez and sat a chilly second while longshot Riveting Reason (Fusaichi Pegasus) set fractions of :23.57 and :47.27. Velazquez took a look under his arm to see what the competition behind him was up to, but it proved a token gesture. Uncle Mo hit the top of the lane with a full head of steam, dispensed with the pacesetter and drew away easily.

"That was as impressive as they get," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "It was an unbelievable performance; crazy fast like he's been doing all along. He runs really fast for a long time. Johnny pushed the button on the turn and he had another gear. I don't get goosebumps very often, but I had them today." Said Velazquez, "That was definitely special. We had so much hope for this horse, and for him to come out here and do it the way he did it today, that was special." Repole called it an incredible experience. "To share with 50 friends and family [at Churchill], and probably 10,000 people watching at home, is just amazing," he said. "It's just a great, great moment." Asked he if was allowing himself to dream of the Kentucky Derby next May, Repole responded, "I did that 30 years ago, and I've done it every day for 30 years. So I'll probably do it tomorrow, also." It looked like he was the only one to have a shot at beating us. I was hoping he wouldn't, but he did. We just have to hope that our horse stays good and keeps developing the right way." Third-choice Jaycito (Victory Gallop) finished seventh after bolting on the first turn. "He left the gate with getting away from everybody on his mind," said jockey Mike Smith. "From the word go he did that. I literally went to the outside fence."

Workforce Scratched

His connections had been sounding off all week that the Churchill Downs turf course was too hard, and Saturday morning the decision was made to scratch Juddmonte Farms' G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe hero **Workforce (GB)** (King's Best) from the GI Breeders' Cup Turf. The three-year-old was the 7-5 morning-line favorite. "The ground has not gone our way," said Teddy Grimthorpe, racing manager for Juddmonte Farms. "There has been no rain, and the ground is firmer than we would like for Workforce. We have absolutely no complaints, but the welfare of the horse is paramount. Prince Khalid has always been a great supporter of the Breeders' Cup, and no one is more disappointed than he."

He pulled Frankie Dettori up to press Champ Pegasus through the early going. Racing on his left lead all the way down the stretch the first time, he tracked the leader around the clubhouse turn, then edged closer as they raced down the backstretch. 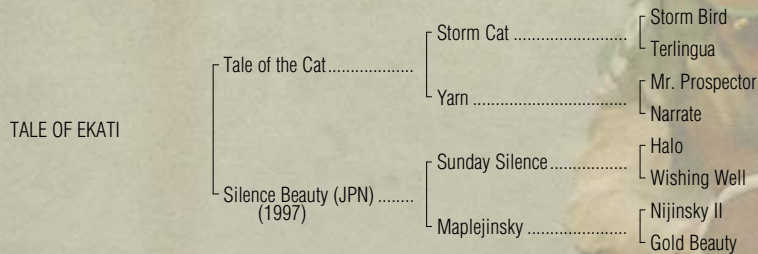

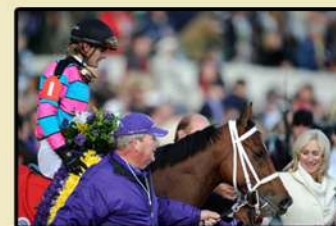

A distant third over a muddy strip at Belmont in his debut June 10, Pluck switched to the turf and graduated by 1 1/4 lengths in a six-furlong test July 11. The dark bay stepped up for the Aug. 14 Continental Mile S. at Monmouth and closed late to be second, beaten a neck, but he drifted in during the stretch run and was disqualified and placed fourth. Bet down to 5-2 favoritism in the Sept. 18 GIII Summer S., the Team Valor homebred closed from sixth to win by a length. He came from dead last to get the money yesterday. Pluck bobbled badly at the break from his far outside post and, finding himself at the back of the pack, jockey Garrett Gomez made a heads-up decision to take the colt in hand and angle him over to the fence. Last as they hit the turn, he was forced to check to avoid jockey Rosie Napravnik, who was thrown when **Rough Sailing** (Mizzen Mast) went down. Pluck was better than five lengths behind the next-to-last horse as they entered the backstretch and still trailed coming around the final bend. Fortunately, as he geared up at the top of the lane, the field spread out in front of him, and he found the gaps when he needed them, firing to the front inside the final furlong and galloping clear. Asked what a mic would've picked up had he been wired during the race, Irwin said, "Well, you would have heard a lot of words that started with the letter F. My main thought was, 'geez, I hope this horse isn't hurt,' because every time we get a horse that stumbles at the start, something happens. I was really worried." He added, "When I saw him making the move, my thought was, 'nah, you're just dreaming. This isn't going to happen.'" GIII Arlington-Washington Futurity runner-up Rough Sailing was near the back of the pack when his hind feet slipped sideways as he tipped into the first turn. The chestnut went down hard, but jumped right to his feet and galloped away. Initial reports were promising; both the colt and Napravnik had seemingly escaped serious injury. But X-rays back at the barn revealed that he had broken his right shoulder in the spill, and he had to be euthanized. FASIG-TIPTON NOVEMBER SALE TODAY

After two days of world-class action on the racetrack in Louisville, the Thoroughbred industry shifts its focus to Lexington today for the Fasig-Tipton November Sale at the Newtown Paddocks beginning at 4 p.m. The royal purple catalogue of 55 mares and 48 foals is littered with superstar racemares and producers, including plenty of horses who competed at Churchill Downs during the two-day Breeders' Cup championships.

The firepower of the catalogue was boosted Friday at Churchill by the exploits of **Awesome Feather** (Awesome of Course) and **Dubai Majesty** (Essence of Dubai). **Awesome Feather** ([hip 10](#)), a Jacks or Better Farm homebred, likely secured championship honors with her 2 1/4-length victory in the G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, while **Dubai Majesty** ([hip 47](#)) scored by that same margin in the G1 Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Sprint. F/M Sprint runner-up **Switch** (Quiet American) ([hip 162](#)) also goes through the Fasig sales ring this afternoon.

A pair of juvenile colts did their part for the Fasig-Tipton sale at Churchill yesterday. Dominant G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie) is out of **Playa Maya** (Arch), who sells as [hip 122](#). Juvenile runner-up **Boys of Tosconova** (Officer)'s dam **Little Bonnet** (Coronado's Quest) sells as [hip 93](#).

"Overall, it's a very strong catalogue," confirmed Fasig-Tipton President Boyd Browning, Jr. "There are a number of graded stakes winners, including a number of Grade I winners and serious producers."

Like many in the industry, Browning is hopeful that the excitement from the racetrack will carry over to the sales ring.

“Traditionally with the Breeders’ Cup in Louisville, with its proximity to the sales arenas, has provided a little bit of a boost--a little bit of momentum and excitement--and we sure hope and anticipate for that trend to continue in 2010,” he said.

Last year’s November sale saw marked decreases from 2008 figures. In all, 80 horses sold for \$28,905,000 in 2009. The average decreased 53.2 percent to \$361,313, while the median fell 32 percent to \$170,000.

Browning is not expecting any major shift in this year’s results.

“I think the market will be very similar to what we’ve seen throughout the other sales this year and in recent years,” he commented. “I think there will be high demand for the quality offerings, but overall the buyers are going to be selective. There’s not going to be multiple bidders on every horse, but the quality horses are going to attract a lot of attention, and people are probably going to pay more for them than they had hoped. The theme word of the sale is going to be quality.”

One bright spot at last year’s sale was the strong international buying bench. Seven horses sold for \$1 million or more at the 2009 November sale.

Three of those were purchased by Japanese interests. Australasian buyers were also a major presence. That trend could continue this year.

“I just escorted a group of four Australians through our new office, and it was the second group from overseas that I’ve seen today,” Browning reported earlier this week. “We’ve had a lot of preliminary interest. I think, given where the dollar is today, there will be some strength from both the Australian and Japanese markets. There are a number of horses throughout the catalogue that have European appeal. I think the Americans have a better feel for the overall marketplace, so hopefully they’ll bid more aggressively this year.”

Zayat Stable's homebred **A Z Warrior** (Bernardini), winner of the GI Frizette S. at Belmont last month, and **MGISW Life At Ten** (Malibu Moon), who was eased in Friday's GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic, have both been withdrawn from Sunday's Fasig-Tipton November Sale. Life At Ten reportedly suffered an adverse reaction to Lasix, causing her to cramp up during the race. A Z Warrior was also unlucky on "Filly Friday," finishing unplaced as the second choice in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. Of the two-year-old, Brad Weisbord, the operation's racing and finance manager, said, "Mr. Zayat felt she never got a chance to run her race after a poor start. She's very special to him because he bred her, and he looks forward to racing her next year." Trained by Bob Baffert, the daughter of Carson Jen (Carson City) has bankrolled \$239,600 in five career starts. In addition to her Frizette victory, the dark bay also finished second in the GIII Sorrento S. at Del Mar. She is a half-sister to GSW E Z Warrior (Exploit) and MSW J Z Warrior (Harlan's Holiday). Candy DeBartolo's Life At Ten was in some distress after trailing the field around in the BC Ladies' Classic. "She came back and she presented herself like a classic tie-up," trainer Todd Pletcher told Louisville *Courier Journal*. "She was just very tight, stiff. We treated her like we normally would. It's very unusual to have one tie up before the race. Usually it's an exercise-induced thing." He added that the mare has fully recovered and, "could go back training tomorrow. It's just one of those really bad windows of timing." The five-year-old, who captured the GI Ogden Phipps H. and GI Beldame S., has compiled a record of 17-8-5-2 for earnings of \$1,149,267.

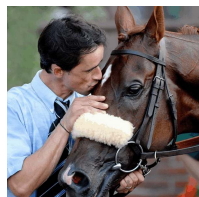
