## WINSTAR GETS THE POINTE

WinStar Farm has been an active buyer of mares at Keeneland this week and the farm made its biggest splash yesterday, going to \$400,000 to bring home **Grosse Pointe Anne** (Silver Deputy--Playa Maya, by Arch), a half-sister to

GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner Uncle Mo (Indian Charlie). Recently appointed WinStar President Elliott Walden signed the ticket on the three-year-old filly, who was selling as a broodmare prospect. For Walden, it was easy to identify Grosse Pointe Anne's appeal. "Uncle Mo," he

said succinctly with a chuckle. "We think the world of Uncle Mo, and just thought she'd be a good addition to our broodmare band." A day after her son captured the Breeders' Cup Juvenile, Playa Maya sold for \$1.65 million at the Fasig-Tipton November sale. Grosse Pointe Anne was purchased for \$170,000 by trainer Ken McPeck as a Keeneland September yearling. She won once in six starts while racing for Grosse Pointe Farm, and was consigned to the sale yesterday by Three Chimneys as agent for the operation. Walden said no decision had been made on who to send Grosse Pointe Anne to, but he did mention Indian Charlie and Tiznow as possibilities. The dark bay filly was the 13th purchase of the week for WinStar. "We've been active all week, wanting to ramp up our broodmare program and we felt she does just that," Walden explained. Also yesterday, WinStar spent \$110,000 for the seven-year-old mare Coli Bear (Formal Dinner), in foal to Harlan's Holiday. Among the farm's other purchases this week are **Moonbow** (Distorted Humor) ([hip 451](#)) (\$270,000); **Superhalf** (A.P. Indy) ([hip 290](#)) (\$270,000), and **Empire West** (Empire Maker) ([hip 144](#)) (\$230,000). -J Martini

## EMPIRE MAKER SOLD TO JBBA

Juddmonte Farms announced Friday that 2003 GI Belmont S. winner and successful sire **Empire Maker** (Unbridled--Toussaud, by El Gran Senor) has been sold to the Japan Bloodhorse Breeders' Association. Terms of the deal were not disclosed. A homebred son of Juddmonte's Broodmare of the Year Toussaud, the dark bay stood for \$50,000 at the Lexington, Kentucky, nursery in 2010. This year, the 10-year-old stallion has been represented by Grade I winner Acoma, as well as Grade II winners Acting Happy and Battle Plan. The latter was sold to Japan for stud duty earlier this year. From four crops of racing age, Empire Maker has sired top-level winners Country Star, Icon Project, Mushka and Pioneer of the Nile, and his progeny have earned over \$15.3 million to date. Among the stallions currently standing at the JBBA's Shizunai Stallion Station are Bago (Fr), Johannesburg and Aldebaran.

**Modification Goes for \$195,000...**

Bill Betz, sitting in the sales pavilion, saw off a rival sitting across the aisle to land the day's second-highest-priced mare, the five-year-old **Modification** (Vindication --Swift Alliance, by Afleet), for \$195,000. Betz signed the ticket for Betz Thoroughbreds.

It was Modification's second trip through the ring at Keeneland. As a yearling, she sold here for \$85,000 in 2006. Niall Brennan resold her to Dennis O'Neill for \$360,000 as a Barretts March juvenile, and she proved her worth with several good efforts. In 2009, she was beaten just a length by subsequent GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic heroine Life is Sweet (Storm Cat) when fourth in the GII La Canada S., and was just 1 1/4 lengths back of champion Informed Decision (Monarchos) when third in that year's GI Humana Distaff at Churchill Downs. She raced for J. Paul Reddam and Mark Schlesinger, and was trained at times by Mark Hennig and Doug O'Neill.

Selling in foal to Reddam's young Grade I-winning sire Spring at Last (Silver Deputy), Modification was being offered by Roderick Wachman's Kingswood Farm.

"She's a beautiful mare," said Wachman. "She had good performance--one was Grade I-placed--and she has a great pedigree. And she's in foal to a nice young stallion. It was very straightforward. She was a big fish in a small pond. There's a reason we placed her in Book 3."

Wachman described Kingswood, in existence for nine or 10 years, as a small commercial operation based on a few hundred acres near Lexington. "I think we bred about 90 mares or so last year," he said. -LM

**Glidawn Stud Active at Keeneland...**

Gerry Burke was a busy man at Keeneland this week. Flanked by his wife Patricia and 11-year-old daughter Gillian, the Irishman darted between the back walking ring and the sales pavilion before ultimately signing the ticket for four weanlings. The four are destined for European sales rings in a pinhooking migration that Burke has em-

employed for several years now. "We came out to America about 15 years ago," Burke said yesterday. "The first year, we bought a filly by Woodman who turned out to be Hula Angel, and she won the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas." Hula Angel was a \$40,000 purchase at the 1996 Keeneland November sale. Burke's Glidawn Stud resold the filly the following year at Goffs for £85,000. "That got us going," he said. "We specialize in buying well-bred fillies. We buy foals and sell yearlings and race the odd ones if we can't sell them." Buying American foals to sell in Europe may sound a little bit like swimming upstream, but Burke sees plenty of opportunity. "America is the horse capital of the world, and we always consider it a great pleasure and a great privilege to come here," he said. "We're a very small operation--most of the time we'd have maybe about 20 horses. We just feel very fortunate to be able to do this." Recent successes from the Waterford-based Glidawn pinhooking operation include a Strong Hope filly bought for \$25,000 at the 2008 Keeneland January sale who brought \$119,068 at that year's Tattersalls October sale. A Stormy Atlantic filly bought for \$25,000 at the 2008 Keeneland November sale resold for the equivalent of \$130,229 at Tattersalls October the following year. Burke purchased a Medicean (GB) filly for \$27,000 at Keeneland January in 2009 and resold her for \$190,372 at Goffs and an Awesome Again filly bought for \$72,000 at last year's November auction brought \$182,940 at Tattersalls this October. "Obviously, we try to go for pedigrees that will be appealing back home," Burke explained. "Sometimes we buy one or two, sometimes we get six or seven."

Burke's purchases this November include a filly by Bernardini out of Shade Dance (Nureyev) ([hip 525](#)) for \$75,000; a Speightstown filly out of Unrestrained (Unbridled) ([hip 594](#)) for \$27,000; a Mr. Greeley filly out of Victorica (Exbourne) ([hip 600](#)) for \$90,000; and a Tapit filly out of Catlike Dancer (Tale of the Cat) ([hip 5013](#)) for \$22,000.

Asked if he was finding the market competitive this November, Burke said, "A nice horse is still hard to buy." As for where these weanlings will next see action, Burke added, "We sell at Goffs and Tattersalls, we sell at Arqana in France--those are three main places. We also sell at Doncaster. We try to spread them around." --JM

**Average, Median Down For Session Five...**

Action concluded Friday with an 11-percent drop in average, from \$42,004 to \$37,361, and a 15.6-percent drop in median, from \$32,000 to \$27,000, from last year's corresponding figures. **Fairlawn Farm Strikes Again...**

Dr. William and Terry Baker's Fairlawn Farm turned in an epic score during Tuesday's second session, selling a mare they claimed for \$15,000 for \$1.85 million. The mare was Lucky One (Best of Lucky), whose first foal is the brilliant Blind Luck (Pollard's Vision), winner of this year's GI Kentucky Oaks and GI Alabama S. and runner-up in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. Terry Yoshida's Shadai Farm made the winning bid. The Bakers celebrated with friends at Malone's that night, but kept things relatively tame, because, as Terry Baker said, "We still had to be at work the next day."

Yesterday, work produced another nice transaction for the Bakers. [Hip 1314](#), a Speightstown filly produced by their homebred mare Saratoga Humor (Distorted Humor), was hammered down to Boulder High Equine for \$180,000. That was the top price for a weanling Friday.

"She's a big, tall beautiful filly with a big walk on her," said Terry Baker. "She has a great hip and a beautiful shoulder, her X-rays were clean, and she's got a great mind. She's going to grow into a beautiful yearling."

And to think, the Bakers nearly turned the filly's dam, Saratoga Humor, into a show horse.

"We had tried to sell her as a yearling, but she was a bit sickle hocked and had long pasterns," Terry explained of the mare who RNA'd for \$22,000 at the 2001 Fasig-Tipton Kentucky Sale. "So my husband said, 'What are you going to do with her?'"

Terry, who grew up on the East Coast with a show horse background, replied, "Well, she's still a beautiful filly--I'll make her a show horse."

Saratoga Humor was thus on track for a career in the ring, not the track, when a trip to the polo field one day changed Terry's mind.

"We used to play polo and brought her out to the field, and it wasn't long before I thought, 'You know, this filly has some talent--we need to get her to the track,'" said Terry.

Sent to trainer Joe Cain, Saratoga Humor lived up to Terry's impressions. She broke her maiden in special weight company in December of her juvenile year, added a pair of allowance races at Ellis Park the following summer, and became one of her sire's earlier black-type winners when she took Mountaineer's New Year's Eve S. in 2003. She added Turfway's Wishing Well S. 10 days later, and when she was retired for the 2005 breeding season, she'd amassed earnings of over \$165,000.

Saratoga Humor's been an even better sales producer for the Bakers. Her first foal, Louisiana Style (Stormin Fever), sold for \$82,000 as a FTKJUL yearling. She ran into some trouble in 2006 and 2007 and didn't produce a live foal, but was back to it the next year, when her More Than Ready weanling filly Aster Humor sold for \$200,000 at KEENOV.

Aster Humor is currently an unraced two-year-old. Saratoga Humor produced a colt by Tale of the Cat in 2009; he was recently bought back for \$37,000 at Keeneland September.

The Bakers purchased Saratoga Humor's dam, the stakes-placed Saratoga Ack (Saratoga Six), for \$44,000 at the 1998 Keeneland November Sale, and sent her to Distorted Humor. Dr. Baker was part of the team that purchased an interest in Distorted Humor as a stallion prospect for Jack and Art Preston's Prestonwood Farm, which later became WinStar.

Fairlawn yesterday also sold [hip 1522](#), a weanling filly by Corinthian--Emblem's Glory (Our Emblem), for \$40,000. -LM

William Shively's Dixiana Farm, buying under the banner Woodland Farm, went to \$80,000 to acquire stakes winner S W Aly'svalentine as a broodmare prospect at Keeneland November in 2008. The now-eight-year-old mare was bred to the late Dixie Union and produced this miss earlier in the year. Selling yesterday, she recouped the cost of the mare, stud fee and a bit more. Dixiana registered a similar score 110 hips later when it sold a colt by Stormy Atlantic--Carocita for \$100,000. The operation bought Carocita carrying the colt in utero for \$100,000 at last year's November Sale and got out on the stakes-placed eight-year-old with yesterday's transaction.

**GRASS IS GREENER AT HOLLYWOOD**

While the GI Hollywood Turf Cup wasn't contested in 2009 due to a purse shortage, it has been brought back this year while moving from its traditional December date. Eight runners will go postward in today's \$250,000 renewal, which serves as something of a consolation prize for runners that didn't make it to the Breeders' Cup. Juddmonte's **Treat Gently (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire}), the lone female in the field, is the slight favorite on the morning line at 5-2, but the five-year-old will need her running shoes on to earn her first Grade I trophy. The lightly raced **Where's the Remote** (Unbridled Native)--one of two California-breds in the field--has risen swiftly through the class ranks since making his career debut this past May.

After taking an open NW1X test at Del Mar Aug. 28, the grey gelding stretched out to 10 furlongs for the GI Clement L. Hirsch Turf Championship S. over this course Oct. 3, and came up just 3/4 of a length short of running down Champ Pegasus (Fusaichi Pegasus); that horse went on to finish second in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf last Saturday. Where's the Remote tried his luck in a 10-furlong allowance washed off the turf Oct. 21, but wound up third as the 2-5 chalk, and should appreciate this return to the weeds. Gustav Schickedanz's **Marlang** (Langfuhr) wired the field in the GIII Sunset H. over this course and distance July 18, but faded to ninth when attempting to do the same in the GI Sword Dancer Invitational at Saratoga Aug. 14. The five-year-old resurfaced in the Clement Hirsch and once more made the running, but was caught in the final furlong and settled for fourth, beaten 1 1/4 lengths.

**CHURCHILL ANNOUNCES PURSE INCREASE**

*(Edited press release)* Effective Wednesday, Nov. 17, Churchill Downs will raise overnight race purses 6.3 percent because of higher-than-expected all-sources wagering levels through the early stages of the 21-day Fall Meet. Overnight purses will be increased 10 percent, but projected Kentucky Thoroughbred Development Fund (KTDF) award money will be reduced by 20 percent because of a shift in the wagering mix; the net result will be a 6.3-percent increase for the final 10 days of the meet. Purses for overnight races--which include allowance, maiden special weight, claiming and maiden-claiming events--will rise by an approximate blended average of \$3,000 per race. Total overnight purses for the meet are projected to be \$6.4 million, up from the original forecast of \$6.2 million. The daily average purse distribution (not including the Nov. 5-6 Breeders' Cup World Championships programs) will be approximately \$437,000. The KTDF is administered by the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission (KHRC) and consists of money allocated to the fund through an excise tax imposed on all tracks conducting pari-mutuel wagering under the jurisdiction of the KHRC. "There's been a recent shift in the way purse money is being earned and the funds are being reallocated accordingly," said Kevin Flanery, president of Churchill Downs race-track. "While we're delighted that our horsemen will be competing for larger-than-anticipated purses over the final 10 days of the Fall Meet, our purses remain well shy of their highest levels of recent years, and the pressure to compete against racetracks that have their purses fueled by slot machine and casino revenues continues to intensify." He added, "This 6.3-percent increase in overnight purses is good news because it stems from a stronger than anticipated wagering in the early stages of our boutique Fall Meet. However, these slight increases aren't long-term solutions to the problems facing Kentucky's signature industry; it merely eases the growing pressure on our horse industry as we wait for the Kentucky legislature to authorize slots at our state's tracks, allow us to invest in Kentucky jobs and take on those out-of-state tracks that now possess a huge competitive advantage." Churchill's Fall Meet runs through Nov. 28.

**MILLS RESIGNS AS MID CEO; STRONACH NAMED TO POST**

In a press release issued late Thursday, MI Developments revealed that Dennis Mills had resigned from his post as CEO, and that the Board of Directors had named Frank Stronach to replace him. Mills will retain his roles as vice-chairman and director of MID. Stronach will remain chairman of the board. "I would like to thank Dennis Mills for his extraordinary efforts during his time as chief executive officer of MID," Stronach said in the release. "I look forward to working with Dennis as he continues to assist MID going forward." There has also been restructuring within the company, which has formed separate real estate and racing and gaming divisions. Appointed to head up the racing and gaming division were: Lyle Strachan, executive vice president of finance; and Mike Rogers, vice president of operations. MID acquired a number of racing assets, including Santa Anita Park, Golden Gate Fields and Gulfstream Park, and a 50-percent share in Laurel Park and Pimlico Race Course, from its bankrupt subsidiary Magna Entertainment Corporation earlier this year.

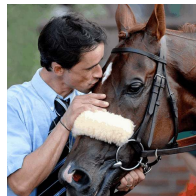

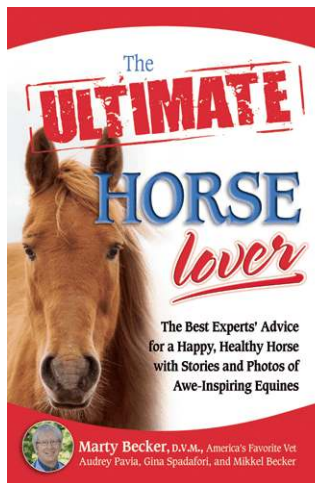
