**RECITAL WINS IN MURTAGH'S SWANSONG**

**Recital (Fr)** (Montjeu {Ire}) yesterday followed in the footsteps of stable companion Fame and Glory (GB) (Montjeu {Ire}), who took a Navan maiden en route to victory in the G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud. It was the fourth win for trainer Aidan O'Brien, and marked the final Coolmore ride for John Murtagh. Having won in workmanlike style on good ground on debut at Navan Oct. 20, the bay took significant strides forward when making light of very testing conditions

here to record an impressive victory. Detached under a cool ride with only two behind early, he cruised through rivals as his stablemate **Exodus (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) and **Rigolieto (Ire)** (Ad Valorem) disputed the lead approaching the final turn. Taking over with a surge approaching the quarter pole, he kept pulling away from **Bubble Chic (Fr)** (Chichicastenango {Fr}) and that rival's G3 Prix de Conde conqueror and favorite **Prairie Star (Fr)** (Peintre Celebre) in the run to the line. "We have high hopes for him," O'Brien commented. "We were confident before this race, because he had shown lots of improvement since his debut. Next year, he should follow a path leading up to the Epsom Derby, but he has loads of speed, too." **Chart p3**

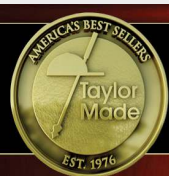

Coming into the Turf Cup, Unusual Suspect had just one win in 22 starts dating back to 2009, that coming in the 2009 Cougar II H. at Del Mar. He finished runner-up to Temple City in this year's renewal, a Grade III held July 30 prior to a ninth in the GI Pacific Classic Aug. 28. Returned on just six days' rest for the Sept. 4 Windy Sands H. at the Seaside oval, the dark bay was a decent third. He followed that with a non-threatening sixth to subsequent GI Breeders' Cup Turf runner-up Champ Pegasus (Fusaichi Pegasus) in the GI Clement Hirsch Turf Championship Oct. 3 at this track, and was most recently along for second in the Oct. 30 California Cup Classic. Temple City was hustled away from the gate by Joe Talamo and set the pace from Marlang (Langfuhr), as Unusual Suspect took up a stalking position in fourth. The eventual winner took closer order while racing three wide into and around the final turn, and the battle was joined in earnest at the three-eighths marker. Temple City still had the call as they came for the stretch and actually opened it up to about a length after cutting the corner, but Unusual Suspect came back with gritty determination to win his race in the final two strides. "He broke really well and I was in a pretty good position," said winning rider Corey Nakatani. "They were going slow, so I just let him do his own thing. The horse just inside me (Temple City) was keeping my horse interested. I didn't want to blow by him but wanted him to stay there to keep my momentum carried. I just wanted to use him the last quarter. He had tremendous acceleration. It worked out well."

**THIS WEEK IN HISTORY...**

**November 15, 1990...**Alydar, runner-up to Affirmed in all three 1978 Triple Crown races, died at Calumet Farm in Kentucky.

**November 15, 1995...**Jockey **Julie Krone** rode her 3,000th career winner, taking the fourth race at Aqueduct with Dustin's Dreamer.

**November 16, 1951...**The **Pimlico Special**, then a winner-take-all \$15,000 contest, became the first race to be televised nationally. The winner was C.T. Chenery's Bryan G.

**November 17, 1894...**The first issue of the **Daily Racing Form** was published.

**November 18, 1961...**Pimlico...Jockey **Eddie Arcaro** rode the last race of his career, finishing third aboard Endymion in the Pimlico Futurity. He retired with a then-record \$30,039,543 in purses.

**November 18, 1972...**Two-year-old **Secretariat** capped his Horse of the Year season with a 3 ½-length in the Garden State S. The winner's share of the purse \$179,199, the most Secretariat ever won in a single race.

**November 18, 1979...**Jockey **Laffit Pincay Jr.** picked up his 4,000th career victory aboard Gladiolus in the eighth race at Aqueduct.

**November 19, 1995...**Jockey **Russell Baze** became the first rider to win at least 400 races a year for four consecutive years, riding Royal Boutique to victory at Golden Gate Fields.

Mekong Melody was sent to the U.S. in early 2009, and put together a concise, but productive seasons, with three wins from four tries, including a score in Woodbine's Flaming Page S. in September. Off nearly 10 months thereafter, the bay landed in a seemingly difficult return spot in the GII Dance Smartly S. July 18, but struck from close range to defeat Ave (GB) (Danhill Dancer {Ire}) and give trainer Roger Attfield a one-two result. 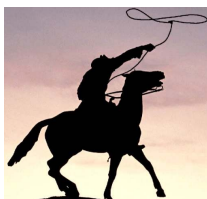

**Putting the 'Hert' on November...**

Call it a fitting tribute to an old friend or simply a great week of business, but Fred W. Hertrich III can seemingly do no wrong at the November sales. Or, as one observer put it: "Fred Hertrich is the smartest man in the pavilion right now." A commercial breeder through his and late partner Dr. Philip F. McCarthy's Watercress Farm, Hertrich kicked off the week at Fasig-Tipton, where he sold Little Bonnet (Coronado's Quest), the dam of GISW Boys at Toscanova (Officer), for \$725,000. Then on Thursday at Keeneland, Hertrich sold three of the top four weanlings. A colt by Street Sense--Autumnal brought the day's highest price at \$330,000, while a colt by Candy Ride (Arg)--Finding Aurum made \$260,000, and a colt by Speightstown--Fifth Avenue Ball fetched \$240,000. All of Hertrich's horses were consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency.

"We've got a great crew at the farm, and they did a superb job in getting the weanlings ready," said Hertrich, who opined that the Street Sense colt was as good a weanling as he's brought to the marketplace. "For a weanling by an unproven sire to bring that...that's how good he was," Hertrich offered. "Our operation and partners sold three weanlings for more than \$1 million [each] back in the day, and not one of those three had a walk like this horse, or had a presence like this horse. He's special. But we felt we were well-paid for all three."

The prices aren't the only noteworthy thing. It's what Hertrich had invested in the horses, too. He acquired the Candy Ride colt in utero for just \$65,000 at last year's Fasig-Tipton February Sale. He bought the dam of the Street Sense colt for \$260,000 in 2007. And he bought Little Bonnet, Boys at Toscanova's dam, with McCarthy and partner John Fielding, for \$65,000 back in 2005.

Buy low, sell high is a doctrine instilled in Hertrich from his self-described 'day job'--running the Hertrich Family of Dealerships--which boasts auto dealerships in Delaware, Maryland and New Jersey. It's a family business that stretches back two generations; Hertrich's father, Fred Jr., sold cars door-to-door in pre-World War II Detroit.

Hertrich hasn't only been a seller. Through the end of selling Saturday, he had acquired no fewer than 15 horses at Keeneland for \$1,564,000 (\$104,267 average)--putting him as the 10th leading buyer midway through the auction. Hertrich's purchases--all mares bar one weanling--have ranged in price from \$40,000 to \$200,000.

"We'll sell anything we think we're making a profit on, and we'll buy anything that we think is good value," stated Hertrich. "I'll buy a \$50,000 mare one day, and a \$300,000 mare the next. If we value a mare at \$100,000 and she goes for \$60,000, we're very happy. But if we value her at \$100,000 and it goes to \$150,000, we won't bid past \$100,000. We're very disciplined. That's not to say it's right, but it's the business model we've adopted."

Hertrich said most of his new purchases have been for himself and Fielding, an Ontario-based businessman who also races and breeds Standardbreds. The soft marketplace has spurred his buying, said Hertrich.

"That's why we've been so active," he explained. "We think it's a tremendous opportunity to buy breeding stock. I won't say the economy is robust and we're going up the hill, but I think at least we're flat. In today's market, you have to buy and be able to make money if the market stays the same, and even if it goes down a bit, you're all right because you've been astute enough to make proper purchases. If the market goes up, you should benefit greatly."

Hertrich got into Standardbred racing 30 years ago, and was an accomplished breeder in that realm, with champions Allamerican Native and Eternal Camnation hailing from his operation. He even purchased a farm in Paris, Kentucky--Watercress--with the intention of relocating his Standardbred mares there. But he became close friends with Phil McCarthy, a world-renowned veterinarian in equine reproduction, and the two began investing in Thoroughbred stock.

“Phil came in as a partner on the farm, and we bought a number of mares during the last downturn in the market [in the late 1990s],” said Hertrich. “We partnered with two other guys, Ben Walden and a Standardbred guy named Lou Guida. I was too stupid to know that we were getting in during a downturn, but we did well.”

Hertrich and McCarthy remained partners after the foursome dissolved their partnership, and the two registered some spectacular successes over the past decade, often breeding under the banner Brilliant Stables. They bred and sold Shamardal (Giant’s Causeway), who won six of seven starts for Godolphin, including the G1 Poule d’Essai des Poulains. The colt’s success in Europe prompted them to send both his dam Helsinki (GB) (Machiavellian) and weanling half-sister Diamond Necklace (Unbridled’s Song) through the 2004 Keeneland November Sale, and they were richly rewarded. Helsinki sold to Christy Grassick for \$3.9 million, while John Sikura signed for Diamond Necklace, who made \$1.15 million. The two grossed \$5.05 million.

Such transactions typically fall in the once-in-a-lifetime category, but it took just 12 months for Hertrich and McCarthy to ring up a similar success. They privately acquired the winning Storm Cat mare Zing and bred her first foal, subsequent Grade II winner Half Ours (Unbridled’s Song). On one \$5.3-million afternoon at Keeneland, they sold Zing for \$3.6 million while carrying a full-sibling to Half Ours, and sold her weanling colt, also by Unbridled’s Song, for \$1.7 million.

Hertrich and McCarthy also teamed to breed dual Grade I winner Street Boss (Street Cry {Ire}), and the graded winners Even the Score (Unbridled’s Song), Sir Greeley (Mr. Greeley), Mighty (Lord At War {Arg}), Got the Last Laugh (Distorted Humor), Paradise Dancer (Langfuhr), Snow Dance (Forest Wildcat) and La Chunga (More Than Ready).

Almost exactly a year ago, McCarthy lost a battle with cancer. He was 58. Hertrich’s regard for his business partner and friend are evident.

“He was our secret weapon,” said Hertrich. “He was one of the finest reproductive veterinarians in the world. He was called on by major farms everywhere to work on their stallions. He was not only my partner, but one of my very best friends, and we’re here today doing what he taught us to do. He’d be very proud of us this week.”

Hertrich said he’ll continue to apply the lessons he learned from McCarthy.

“If you’re in the breeding business, you can’t be faint of heart,” said Hertrich. “You’re going to have a foal break a leg, a red-bag birth. You’re going to have a mare die and a yearling go through the fence. Sadly, it’s part of the business. But that’s all part of the equation, too--you need to have that resolve.” -LM

**Mercedes Lands ‘Wonderful’ Weanling...**

Mercedes Stable’s bloodstock advisor Dennis Yokum, sitting in the sales pavilion, outlasted weanling-to-yearling pinhookers Brian and Bill Graves to secure [hip 1768](#), a colt from the first crop of MGSW Tiz Wonderful (Tiznow). Yokum won the battle on his \$200,000 offer, which was the second-highest price paid for a weanling yesterday. The colt was produced by the winning five-year-old Stormy B (Cherokee Run), a half-sister to GSW Rush Bay (Cozzene).

The transaction was another feather in the cap of Jody and Michelle Huckabay’s Elm Tree Farm, which consigned the Jan. 10-foaled bay. On Thursday, Elm Tree sold both the session-topping broodmare and the session-topper weanling. Conchita (Cozzene), a half-sister to Group 1 winner White Moonstone (Dynaformer) and carrying a foal by More Than Ready, sold to Peter Blum for \$370,000, while a Candy Ride (Arg)--Enchanted Spell weanling filly went to Waratah Thoroughbreds for \$320,000. During the same session, Elm Tree also sold a Tale of the Cat--Biblical Point weanling colt for \$210,000.

“We’ve had a phenomenal sale,” said Jody Huckabay, a native of Louisiana who was supporting 11th-ranked LSU football with an emblazoned purple windbreaker yesterday. “We thought we had a nice group coming out, and everything worked out for us.”

Elm Tree’s ties to yesterday’s Tiz Wonderful colt went beyond consigning. The operation sold the weanling’s dam Stormy B for \$67,000 last year at Keeneland November. The ticket was signed Audrey & Emily. Brookfield Stud bred the Tiz Wonderful colt.

“We sold her to clients, and they were nice enough to let us sell this colt,” said Huckabay. “We still have the granddam and great-granddam on the farm. We also keep a lot of the Mercedes mares, and Dennis asked me if this was a nice colt, and I said that he’s very straightforward and a very, very good horse. We expected him to sell well. He’s a good combination of both the sire and dam. Tiz Wonderful is probably one of the most gorgeous stallions you’ll lay eyes on--he’s beautiful. But the dam of this horse is very good-looking, too.”

It was Mercedes’ third purchase at Keeneland November. Earlier in the week, Ernie Moody’s operation bought the broodmare Subtle Aly (French Envoy) for \$320,000, and a Holy Roman Emperor (Ire)--Scoop of Gold weanling colt for \$150,000. -LM

**S.F. Bloodstock Building on the Future...**

While still in its infancy, S.F. Bloodstock is quickly establishing a formidable commercial broodmare band. Founded by Gavin Murphy in conjunction with Neil Bowden, S.F. Bloodstock has taken advantage of a down market to acquire an impressive global roster of Grade I winners and producers, including the dams of European stars Canford Cliffs (Ire) (Tagula {Ire}) and Mastercraftsman (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}), as well as the dam of American champion Forever Together (Belong to Me). Murphy is an Australian working in New York city.

"We're not trying to reinvent the wheel or anything like that," bloodstock agent Tom Ryan, taking a short break from a busy week in Lexington, said yesterday. "We're just basically trying to buy quality bloodstock, and we feel that we've been able to buy in what has been a suppressed market for the last few years. Hopefully, we've bought well."

Ryan estimated S.F. Bloodstock, which also includes Australian Henry Field, has between 40 and 50 elite broodmares. The group signed for eight mares at Keeneland November this week, and an additional three at Fasig-Tipton last Sunday. Its Fasig purchases were led by **Unbridled Belle** (Broken Vow), who sold for \$900,000, while **Gold Canyon** (Mr. Prospector) led the Keeneland list at \$250,000.

"We feel like we've been buying pretty well," Ryan continued. "Not to say we've stolen anything. I think we've paid what is reality in today's market. We bought within our comfort level--we don't chase things. We have the confidence to appraise things privately and come out where we come out. We'll buy where we feel there is some upside."

S.F. Bloodstock has horses in Ireland, England, France, Australia and America and is flexible in its game plan.

"We'll sell when the market is right and when the individual is right," Ryan said. "And we don't have to sell everything, which is a good way to be. But we look forward to selling, and we'll be genuine sellers on the day."

The mares purchased this week will stay in America, and Ryan thinks their foals will have an advantage in the U.S. market.

"One thing I've found in America recently is so many of these high-class mares are going out of the country," the Irishman observed. "If you look at Book 1 and Book 2 in September, there are just not that many first, second or third foals of Grade I winners. They've gone to Japan or they've gone to England. And the Australians are so strong now, they're coming in and buying at the highest level, as well. Hopefully, we can keep a lot of the stock at home and keep the market fair."

S.F. Bloodstock's European broodmare band includes Starlight Dreams (Black Tie Affaire {Ire}), the dam of multiple Group 1 winner Mastercraftsman, and Mrs Marsh (GB) (Marju {Ire}), the dam of G1 Irish 2000 Guineas winner Canford Cliffs. Both mares are in foal to superstar Sea the Stars (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}).

"Those mares are very exciting," Ryan said. "Both of them have already produced champions, and they are our foundation mares. We look forward to nurturing them along over the coming years and, hopefully, trading out of them successfully. And we'll also race a few fillies, too."

Of the American broodmare band, Ryan said, "We've probably got six or seven Group 1 winners and we're going to continue to try and get that quality of mare. We've gotten some older, more proven mares, like Constant Companion (Relaunch), the dam of Forever Together, and younger mares like Diamondrella (GB) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}), who is a beautiful, exciting young mare in foal to Tapit. Just exciting mares that anyone would be glad to own."

The group is quick to take advantage of the opportunities that present themselves. Cashing in on the popularity of young stallion Sea the Stars, S.F. Bloodstock sold Love to Dance (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), in foal to the Arc winner, for \$1.05 million at Fasig-Tipton.

"Love to Dance was bought as a long-term mare," Ryan explained. "But, when we were approached by Fasig-Tipton, we had four mares in foal to Sea the Stars, and we thought that there had been some very big updates in her pedigree. It wasn't necessarily on the program, but it was the right conditions. It was exciting to sell the first mare in foal to Sea the Stars--it was exciting to have four mares good enough to go to Sea the Stars last year. We went over there confident that we could sell in that range, and mission accomplished."

So far S.F. Bloodstock has been able to take advantage of the market as buyers, but soon it will have to deal with conditions as sellers.

"The market also has to work with us now when we're selling," Ryan confirmed. "We need to see the market improve. And I think it will improve."

Ryan keeps up a whirlwind schedule, following the yearling sales through Lexington, Ireland, England and France and returning to his Kentucky home briefly before heading out on a similar tour of bloodstock sales. But he is enjoying the opportunity and thriving on the challenge.

"It's exciting," he said. "The other side of it is it's nerve-wracking, it takes a lot of management. It's a big effort from everyone to make it work. We're very focused on keeping a very close eye on things and watching these horses. I see them probably every month and, in Australia, Henry Field does the same. Our farm manager in Australia is Craig Anderson, and he does a tremendous job. We have a good team in place."

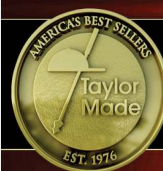
