### SNOW QUEEN

**Snow Fairy (Ire)** (Intikhab) further enhanced her top European form with a dominant victory in Sunday's G1 Queen Elizabeth II Commemorative Cup at Kyoto Racecourse. Squaring off against Japan's filly Triple Crown heroine **Apanane (Jpn)** (King Kamehameha {Jpn}), who was backed down to 2-1 favoritism, Ed Dunlop's dual Oaks winning filly made short work of her rivals, recording her fourth victory of the year. "She put the race to bed in a couple strides," said jockey Ryan Moore. "She was very

good-looking today. I was drawn beside Apanane, and I thought she was the best filly, so we kept an eye on her. We had a lovely spot. She jumped smoothly, was in a nice position and she traveled very well." Settled near the early pace in fourth, Snow Fairy remained tucked along the inside as Apanane was asked to go wide at the head of the straight. "We got [to the front] sooner than I thought," confirmed Moore. "It just opened up, a big gap [along the inside]." Snow Fairy, scraping the paint with Moore only showing her the whip, rocketed past the leaders and sprinted away late to score by an impressive four lengths. **Meisho Beluga (Jpn)** (French Deputy) rallied past Apanane for second. **Ave (GB)** (Daneshill Dancer {Ire}), winner of Belmont's G1 Flower Bowl Invitational S. earlier this season, was never involved, finishing second to last. Earlier this term, Snow Fairy, campaigned by Anamoine Ltd, registered victories in the G1 Investec Oaks at Epsom and the G1 Irish Oaks at The Curragh. With the win, Snow Fairy not only pocketed the ¥90 million first-place prize, she also secured the special JRA bonus offered her as Oaks winner.

 ferent, and I'm looking forward to the 2000 [metres of  
 the G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Cup here Dec. 12]. I

# RACETRACK Round-Up

## *GSW Buddy's Saint Breaks Down; Euthanized...*

Dual graded stakes winner **Buddy's Saint** (Saint Liam) broke down during a workout at Belmont Park Sunday morning and had to be euthanized. Trained by Bruce

Levine and campaigned by Kingfield Stables, the winner of last season's GII Nashua S. and GII Remsen S. was reportedly nearing a return to the races when the incident occurred. According to Dr. Anthony Verderosa, chief examining veterinarian of the New York Racing Association, the sophomore fractured his left shoulder while breezing

over Belmont's main track. In his sole start in 2010, Buddy's Saint came home a well-beaten ninth behind winner Eskendereya (Giant's Causeway) in the Feb. 20 GII Fountain of Youth S. at Gulfstream. Following that effort, he was benched after sustaining a bone chip to his right front ankle and underwent surgery.

## *Cigar Mile Candidates Work...*

**Bribon (Fr)** (Mark of Esteem {GB}) and **Friend Or Foe** (Friends Lake) worked Sunday morning in preparation for next week's GI Hill 'n' Dale Cigar Mile H. at Aqueduct. Bribon, winner of Belmont's GIII Bold Ruler H. in his most recent start Oct. 30, covered a half-mile in :47.23 over Belmont's training track. "Bribon seems to be in really good form," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "He had a very good work this morning." Winner of the GII True North H., the French-bred also won last season's GI Met Mile H. and was runner-up in the Cigar. Also working over Belmont's training track, Friend Or Foe--victorious in his latest start in the state-bred Empire Classic Oct. 23--completed five panels in 1:00.82, the second fastest of 20 moves at the distance Saturday. "He's a happy camper," said trainer John Kimmel. "I would have to say that he came out of the Empire Classic probably the best he's ever come out of a race. Attitude-wise, he was right back into the feed tub, very solid on the racetrack, and it looks to me like he might have put some weight on after the race. His work [Sunday] was very pleasing to watch. He set off kind and, when he came back, wouldn't have blown out a match. He's very sharp right now, so we'll come back [and work] next weekend with a couple of days to play with if we get some inclement weather, and then we'll have a date on the 27th."

## *Qualia to GII Top Flight; Grand Couturier to France...*

Marc Keller's **Qualia** (Saarland), a close second behind Rightly So (Read the Footnotes) in the July 5 GIII Bed O' Roses H., is likely to make her next start in the one-mile GII Top Flight S. at Aqueduct Nov. 26, according to trainer Bobby Ribaldo. The four-year-old is also nominated to the six-panel GIII Fall Highweight H. on Thanksgiving Day. "She's kind of between both those distances," said Ribaldo. "But we're thinking the Top Flight. We'll keep an eye on the other race, in case something develops." Multiple Grade I stakes winner **Grand Couturier (GB)** (Grand Lodge), who was recently retired, shipped out of trainer Ribaldo's barn last Thursday, and is expected to be shipped to France for stud duty. Also campaigned by Keller, the seven-year-old recorded his biggest victories in the 2008 GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic S and the 2007 and 2008 editions of the GI Sword Dancer S. "He'll be going to Darby Dan Farm for a 30-day quarantine period, and go to France from there," confirmed Ribaldo, adding, "He was my first stop every morning for four years at the barn."

## *First Dude and Paddy O' Prado Done for Season*

A pair of Dale Romans runner--**First Dude** (Stephen Got Even) and **Paddy O' Prado** (El Prado {Ire})--are likely done for the remainder of the season, according to the trainer. In his latest start, First Dude was eighth in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. He was nominated to the Nov. 26 GI Clark H. The powerful bay has hit the board in six graded stakes I events this season, five of those recorded against Grade I company. "I don't think he'll run," said Romans of the Clark. "He came out of the race good, but we just nominated him to see what was in there." Paddy O'Prado, who was fifth in the Classic, scored earlier this summer in the GI Secretariat S. "He won't run again until Gulfstream," the conditioner confirmed.

## *New Acquisition High Level Jeff to Prevue...*

**High Level Jeff** (Vindication), unbeaten in two starts at Calder, will make mark his debut for new owner J. Paul Reddam in the Hollywood Prevue S. Saturday. "I got him five days ago," confirmed trainer Doug O'Neill. "My brother [Dennis] and Paul Reddam learned about him and did their homework." Joel Rosario has the Prevue call. Reddam bought a 75-percent interest in the colt, with previous trainer Steve Dwoskin retaining a 25 percent share. High Level Jeff, who broke his maiden at first asking by eight lengths Oct. 10, took a six-furlong allowance over a sloppy track Oct. 28.

## SF SWOOPS LATE FOR NONSUCH BAY

SF Bloodstock's Tom Ryan stayed around for a rare gem buried deep in Book 4 and walked away with a Grade I-winning mare for \$210,000. Sitting in the back

corner of the sales pavilion, Ryan locked horns with Paragon Farm's Brandon Perry, on the phone just under the press box, for **Nonsuch Bay** (Mr. Greeley--Brighter Than Gold, by Light Idea) ([hip 2496](#)). The pair exchanged \$5,000 salvos up to \$200,000, at which point Perry put up a finger to ask for more time as he talked things over. "We'll make it nice and quiet in here," quipped auctioneer Chris Caldwell. Perry finally bid once

more, but Ryan answered quickly and Perry shook his head that he was through.

"I'm delighted to have her--she's a beautiful mare," said Ryan, an advisor for SF Bloodstock. "She was a very nice racehorse, and I'm very happy to get her at that level. I was very surprised to find her this far deep in the catalogue, and I was hoping that not too many other people had stayed around for her. There's been a changing of the guard, as far as people go, and that worked out for us. She's a beautiful young mare."

Ryan, sporting a Super Saver jacket, said the mare would be heading to this year's GI Kentucky Derby hero. By Maria's Mon, Super Saver was recently retired to WinStar Farm, where he'll stand his initial season for \$20,000.

"I love him as a stallion prospect," said Ryan. "He's got the pedigree, and physically he's gorgeous. I'm not sure how many mares we'll send to him, but we'll support him."

An earner of nearly \$750,000, Nonsuch Bay registered a career-best in the 2002 GI Mother Goose S. at Belmont Park. She also won the GII Nassau County Breeders' Cup S. over Big Sandy and was placed in 10 other graded events. Selling as a broodmare prospect in 2004, she was hammered down to Richard and Audrey Haisfield's Never Tell Farm for \$1.15 million. Her first foal, the three-time winner Greater Glory (Empire Maker), was a \$320,000 FTKJUL yearling; her next, the current three-year-old Medaglia Bay (Medaglia d'Oro), was a \$270,000 KEESEP yearling. Nonsuch Bay sold in foal on a Mar. 8 cover to A. P. Warrior.

The Haisfields own Stonewall Farm Stallions, which is currently in bankruptcy proceedings. Meg and Mike Levy's Bluewater Sales sold Nonsuch Bay as receiver for the Stonewall.

Numbers were once again down considerably at Keeneland. Session average was down 25.2 percent to \$17,366, while session median was down 40 percent, to \$12,000. The cumulative average of \$79,537 is down 15.5 percent; the cumulative median of \$35,000 is down 22.2 percent. The eighth of 13 Keeneland November sessions gets underway today at 10 a.m.

**Wygod Bertrando Mares Sell Well...**

Two mares by longtime Californian sire Bertrando from Pam and Marty Wygod's respected breeding operation helped set the pace during Sunday's Book 4 opener at Keeneland November. Both horses sold from the draft of the Farish family's Lane's End Farm. The 15-year-old **Gentle Words** hammered down to Josham Farms Ltd. for \$85,000, the session's top price. The mare is the dam of a pair of the six-year-old Rush With Thunder (Tribal Rule), winner of the El Cajon S. in 2007 and runner-up to Zensational (Unbridled's Song) in the GI Triple Bend H. in 2009. Gentle Words produced foals by the Wygods' top turfer After Marker (Storm Cat) in 2009 and 2010 and sold in foal to another Lane's End stallion, the red-hot Candy Ride (Arg), whose weanlings have brought \$320,000, \$260,000, \$250,000, \$140,000, etc. at November. Gentle Words sold as [hip 2369](#) and was the session's second-highest-priced lot.

Lane's End also sold [hip 2344](#), the six-year-old Bertrando mare **Double Major**, a daughter of the Storm Cat mare Common Hope. Northwest Stud Stable Co. signed the ticket for \$82,000, co-third-highest price Sunday. From the immediate family of Key Phrase (Flying Paster), Yankee Gentleman (Storm Cat) and Half Ours (Unbridled's Song), Double Major placed third in the 2007 renewal of the Sunshine Millions Oaks. She also was offered in foal to Candy Ride. In addition to the appeal of that young sire, Bertrando is the damsire of last weekend's GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic heroine Unrivaled Belle (Unbridled's Song).

Also selling for \$82,000 Sunday was [hip 2498](#), the 11-year-old broodmare **Knotting Hill (Brz)** (Jules--Light Lida, by Alleged). Brookdale Farm, agent, signed for the mare, who is in foal to Aragorn (Ire) on an Apr. 1 cover. Taylor Made Sales Agency, agent for the complete dispersal of Jerry Bailey and Lance Robinson's Gulf Coast Farms, consigned.

**SEVEN DAYS IN NOVEMBER**

Stability is a big plus, I have no doubt, in any market, and the good news from the first seven days of the November sales--Fasig last Sunday and Keeneland's first three books, which ended Saturday this year--is that the market continues to behave in a stable manner. Though, as you'll see in the Weekly Sales Ticker, gross receipts for virtually the same number of horses catalogued and sold have dropped by a whopping 54 percent since the 2007 editions of these sales, the combined Fasig--Keeneland Books 1-3 gross (\$155.5 million) has declined by just seven percent (or \$12 million) from last year (\$167.9 million). Considering that Overbrook's dispersal last year grossed over \$31.7 million, there is a definite case for saying the sales so far are most probably up, in spite of the gross, average, and median being down. As always in mixed sales, the results require serious scrutiny before conclusions are reached precisely because, as Overbrook demonstrates, of the differences in the catalogues from year to year.

Analysis we have done over the past couple of years indicates the Thoroughbred market in North America has dropped by half, in Europe by a third. But markets break down into tiers, and further evidence suggests the top of the market in North America has in fact dropped by half; the broad middle tier has dropped by 'only' a third, while the bottom tier has collapsed by around two-thirds. The tiers can probably be described as the top encompassing around ten percent of horses sold (may be generous), the middle tier probably 60-70 percent, and the bottom tier the lowest 20-30 percent. This year's Week 1 November results primarily encompass that middle tier, and here demand has been brisk -- though always, as one seems to never tire of saying, for the 'good stuff.' One prominent consignor told me there are very few buyers for mares ("no one wants to be a breeder these days," he commented), while demand for weanlings continues unabated. Of course, if you take the view that the market has stabilized, and that in future there will be reasons for prices to level off if not increase as supply slackens, now is just the time to buying mares--quality mares, that is. The Australians and Japanese, with highly favorable exchange rates for their currencies, are right in the thick of it for the good fillies and mares, but from Book 4 on, the mare market is rather at the mercy of regional programs and smaller breeding countries. Regardless of how the second week plays out, though, there was plenty of reason at least not to be more discouraged about the market's middle tier in the first week. *Cont. p10*

One feature of the current downturn has been the swing away from unproven to proven sires, but the first two finishers in 2009 GI Breeders' Cup Classic, Raven's Pass and Henrythenavigator, did defy the commercial trend. 'Henry,' who stands at Coolmore's Ashford Stud in Kentucky, slightly out-averaged Raven's Pass, who stands for Darley at Kildangan Stud in Ireland. Henrythenavigator may or may not have benefited from quite a few 'outs,' but all five of those sent through the ring were sold, averaging \$208,000. Raven's Pass had six sell, of seven offered, for an average of \$196,666 (all figures through the end of Book 3 on Saturday, per Instatistics). 'Henry' is done for the moment, with none catalogued at the upcoming Goffs' or Tattersalls' foal sales, but Raven's Pass has two catalogued at Goffs and seven at Tatts'.

The American sires with first foals didn't fare so well. Six Kentucky sires with four or more sold averaged between \$55,000-\$70,000, but the top two, Three Chimneys' Big Brown (11 sold/13 offered, averaged \$70,181) and Lane's End's Curlin (4/6, averaged \$61,000) both stood for \$65,000 in 2009. The real surprise package was Spendthrift's Tiz Wonderful (6/7), who averaged \$57,083 off a \$12,500 entering stud fee. Hill 'n' Dale's Midnight Lute (15/20, \$56,400), Darley's Street Boss (17/20, \$55,911), and Coolmore/Ashford's Majestic Warrior (8/11, \$55,125) all turned in solid middle-market performances considering unproven sires aren't top of the Hit Parade at the moment.

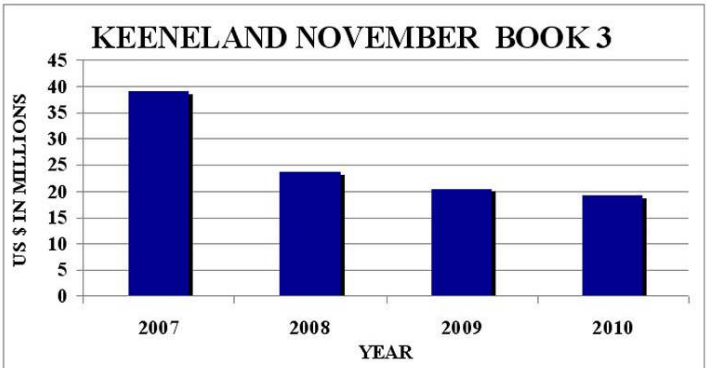

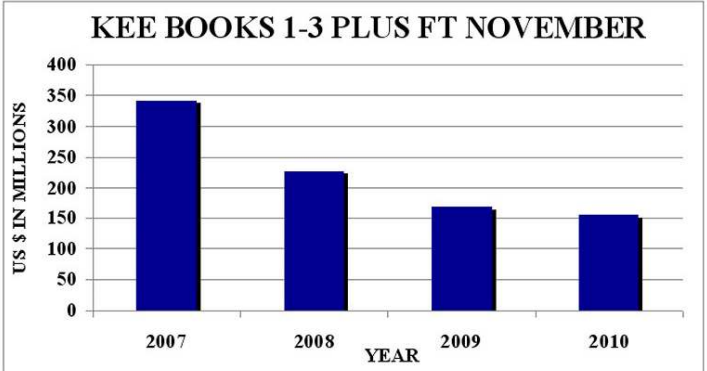
# Weekly Sales Ticker

"Book 3 is a bellwether as these mares and foals still have pedigrees it's easier to make a case for; after Book 3 the first-dam black type falls off pretty dramatically. This year's Book 3 saw 10 percent more horses sold than last year (4 percent more catalogued) and the 65 percent clearance rate from the catalogue was the highest for the last four years. Overall, including Fasig, the first seven days were down seven percent from last year (including Overbrook) but with 111 more horses sold (eight percent). Compared to 2007, though, when the number catalogued and sold were almost identical, gross receipts have dropped 54 percent." - Bill Oppenheim

It's also informative to look at the table which shows the 14 stallions which had five or more sell in the first seven days and averaged \$100,000-plus. There are some notable new faces on that list, including three of

the four F2006 sires (first four-year-olds 2010) who look headed straight for the top. Best of the four commercially in the sales' first seven days was Tapit, who had 14 weanlings from his first crop at a fee above \$15,000 (he was \$35,000 in 2009) average \$188,357. I reckon he's vying with

Candy Ride (15, \$110,100) for Hottest Sire on the Planet honors right now. Medaglia D'Oro, another from this powerful sire crop, had 17 weanlings average \$118,352; only Speightstown (11, averaged \$78,545), of the four, didn't hit a six-figure weanling average.

Aside from newcomers Henrythenavigator and Raven's Pass, leading 2010 commercial Freshman Sire Bernardini

(\$124,333), and new top-10 weanling-sire commercial players Indian Charlie (\$133,545) and Malibu Moon (\$101,055, with 18 sold of 19 offered), one horse who has thrust himself into the commercial spotlight a little bit is

Street Sense (nine, averaged \$145,555), the only GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner to follow up in the next year's GI Kentucky Derby.

None other than Coolmore's Demi O'Byrne bought a yearling by him in September, which must show what he thought of him as a racehorse; and a good judge who has seen quite a few by both sires told me he thought, if anything, the Street Senses might be a little bit nicer than the first foals by his own sire, Street Cry, were. He doesn't figure to be one of your speedball sires, but there are a couple of market clues, including his \$145,555 first-week weanling average, which suggest Street Sense might be a horse to follow.
