Chalk up another big win for team Calder. Our Sugar Bear Stable's **Gourmet Dinner** (Trippi), hero of Calder's Dr. Fager S. Aug. 7 and Affirmed S. Aug. 28, took his show on the road to Louisiana and lit up the toteboard at 20-1 with a decisive 2 1/4-length tally in Saturday's Gill Delta Downs Jackpot S. "We decided that we'd take a chance because of the money involved," trainer Steve Standridge said of the \$1-million Jackpot. "We could've run in Florida, but you don't get a chance to run for this kind of money very often, so we took a shot." Has Standridge caught Derby fever yet? "No plans--we're just going to enjoy tonight," he offered.

**KEENELAND NOVEMBER CONCLUDES**

The marathon, 13-session Keeneland November Sale concluded yesterday in Lexington, Kentucky, with double-digit declines in average and median. At sale's end, the average was \$50,322, a 12.4-percent slide from a year ago. The median was \$17,000, a 15-percent drop. Keeneland November was topped by Dreamtheimpossible (Giant's Causeway), a stakes-winning and Group 1-placed daughter of multi-millionairess Spain (Thunder Gulch) who was purchased by Frank Stronach's Adena Springs for \$2.55 million. Mt. Brilliant Farm's Greg Goodman was the underbidder. Eaton Sales consigned the four-year-old, who sold in foal to leading sire Galileo (Ire) during the sale's second session, as [hip 378](#). Other highlights included Coolmore's purchase of multiple Grade I winner Society Selection (Coronado's Quest), in foal to Medaglia d'Oro, for \$1.85 million. That price was equaled by Lucky One (Best of Luck), the dam of pro-tem champion three-year-old filly Blind Luck (Pollard's Vision), who went to Shadai Farm. She sold carrying a full-sibling to Blind Luck. Three weanlings shared top billing, each eliciting bids of \$450,000. Shadwell purchased a Street Sense--Time For a Crown colt, M. V. Magnier landed a Dynaformer--Sometime (Ire) filly and D.M.I. bought a Henrythenavigator--Versailles Treaty colt. **Cont. p3-7**

Most recently second as the 3-5 chalk in his two-turn debut in the Oct. 16 In Reality S., Gourmet Dinner sat close to the early leaders in sixth here through fractions of :22.66 and :46.56 while sporting blinkers for the first time. With regular pilot Sebastian Madrid in the irons, the Florida-bred began to roll on the turn for home, hit the front in the stretch and poured it on late. "I was very happy that he was a lot closer-- he was on the bit, which isn't

normal for him," Standridge continued. "I think the blinkers did the trick." Madrid added, "The horse had been training good since we got here. The race set up perfectly for me. He put me in a good position. I was confident in this horse. Steve did a good job getting him ready." **Aces N Kings** (Jet Phone), with Calvin Borel aboard, bolted on the turn for home tossing his rider, and subsequently took out **Blue Laser** (Bluegrass Cat) and **Dreamsrunwild** (Offlee Wild). **State of the Market...**

Not surprisingly, there were different opinions about the current state of the bloodstock market. Keeneland Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell believes conditions have stabilized following the steep declines brought on by the world financial downturn in 2008. "I think the best way to describe the sale is that it's very solid and the market is very resilient," Russell said yesterday from his office at Keeneland. "We had a very strong international presence, and considering the availability of credit in the domestic market, I think the domestic market performed very well. I think the foal market was especially strong--there was strong participation by end users, as well as pinhookers. If anything, the market has become more polarized, and I thought the top end was very strong." Though numbers were down across the board, Russell pointed out that the quality of bloodstock sales can differ vastly from year to year. Last year, for example, the November Sale benefitted from the dispersal of Overbrook Farm, which generated some \$31.7 million. "As we have discussed in the past, there is no comparison to previous breeding stock sales, because they're not comparable," said Russell. "We're selling factories, not product. When you're selling products, you can compare year-to-year--when you're selling factories, you can't." **Keeneland coverage cont. p4**

Pete Bradley of Bradley Thoroughbred Brokerage saw varying degrees of strength through the sale. "At the top end, I thought things were pretty good," Bradley said. "But I thought the rest of the market was down significantly." Taylor Made Sales Agency's Mark Taylor had a similar take. "At the top, let's say the top 15 percent or so, I thought the market was surprisingly strong. I don't mean it was like 2007, but it was better than I anticipated. The upper middle was realistic--it wasn't bad. The lower 50 percent, however, just dropped--by the final quarter, it had just dried up. I thought the domestic buying was light, but the Europeans, Japanese and Australians really stepped up and were very active. And all the way through--the Japanese were especially strong early."

Geoffrey Russell also noted the activity of internationals. "Foreign buyers, particularly Australians, were bolstered in their spending by quickly recovering economies and thriving racing programs at home. Their buying power made it difficult for Americans to compete. And yet, despite a lack of available credit, Americans stepped up and bought. It was very encouraging that both the buyer and under bidder on the saletopper were North American-based breeders."

Four of the top seven buyers were indeed operations with international roots, not counting Coolmore. Australia-based Waratah Thoroughbreds, owned by Paul Fudge, was second behind only Coolmore as the leading buyer at November. Waratah bought seven horses for a total of \$2,920,000 (\$417,143 average), while members of Japan's powerful Yoshida family were next in line. Katsumi Yoshida bought four horses for \$2,710,000 (\$677,500 average), and Terry Yoshida's Shadai Farm bought three for \$2,700,000 (\$900,000 average).

Shawn Collins, who runs Mare Solutions and works with Taylor Made, also saw pockets of strength in regional markets in the U.S. "I had a number of people come to the barn and ask what New York-breds we had," he explained. "With the slots coming, people are anticipating the \$75,000 maiden special weights and allowance races. That's also true of the stallion market --there are people looking for stallions here that are perhaps just a bit out of fashion, but who would be popular there." **Cont. p5**

At the end of the day, Mark Taylor said a seller's success at Keeneland November had as much to do with realistic expectations than anything. "If you have an 11-, 12-year-old mare, and she's hasn't produced much and is in foal to a less-the-desirable stallion, you need to go up there with the idea that you're just cutting expenses," he said. "You can't go in thinking you're going to make a profit--or keep her and foal her out and hope to get lucky--you have to cut your losses and hope to make it up down the line." Taylor Made concluded November as leading consignor. It sold 340 horses for \$26,923,800--an average of \$79,188.

**Blackberry Road Tops Final Day...**

**Blackberry Road** (Gone West--Strawberry Reason, by Strawberry Road {Aus}), a half-brother to champion Vindication (Seattle Slew) selling as a racing or stallion prospect, topped the final day of selling at Keeneland November. Jose Luis Miglietti purchased the five-year-old, who sold from the Three Chimneys Farm draft as [hip 4682](#), for \$46,000. Purchased by Cot Campbell's Dogwood Stable for \$235,000 as a Keeneland September yearling in 2006, Blackberry Road finished third in the GIII Kentucky Cup Juvenile at Turfway and second in the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. at Churchill as a juvenile. At three, he ran second in the GIII Lecomte S. at Fair Grounds. Most recently third in a Laurel optional claimer for trainer Christopher Grove, he has earned over \$270,000.

Aruna could muster only one win from five chances while racing in France, but has been unstoppable since making the trip across the pond. Heroine of a Saint-Cloud allowance last October, she returned with a pair of attempts at Longchamp this term to place fourth in the G3 Prix de la Grotte Apr. 25 and sixth in the G1 Prix Saint-Alary May 23. Favored in her U.S. bow in a Saratoga allowance Sept. 6, the Niarchos homebred just got up by a head over a speed-favoring grass course, then added Belmont's Pebbles S. by a good-looking three lengths Oct. 11. The choice to make it three straight, Aruna raced in fifth under a tight hold through fractions of :23.88 and :49.49. With Ramon Dominguez aboard, she was produced while five wide at the head of affairs, and kicked clear late over a very game runner-up. "I was impressed with her today because she was just so much sharper earlier," trainer Graham Motion offered. "She's been very relaxed in her races, and I just thought Ramon did a great job to keep her settled long enough so that when he did finally turn her loose, she had plenty left." As for what's next, Motion added, "I'll speak with Alan Cooper, who manages Flaxman Holdings, and we'll come up for a plan for next year. I definitely won't run her again this year, and I won't be in a hurry to run her next year. We'll probably look for something, maybe even Keeneland in the spring. ## Do We Need a Sturdier Racehorse?

In 1970, the year Secretariat was born, the average number of starts per runner per year was a healthy 10.22. Forego, born that same year, ran 57 times, including 18 starts in 1973. But even those numbers, remarkable by today's standards, don't put the mighty Forego in the same league with some of the true iron horses in the sport's history. Hall of Famer Stymie started 131 times. In 2009, the average number of starts per horse was down to 6.23, a 39-percent decline over the 1970 numbers. The TDN takes a comprehensive look at why.

"We've just kept him ticking over since that win," said trainer Ricky Yiu. "He's drawn gate six. I'm really happy with the barrier, and I'm expecting another very good run." Singaporean sensation Rocket Man, runner-up in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen in March, brings his punishing speed to Sha Tin for the first time. Next to untouchable at home, he was touched off by Hong Kong's Green Birdie (NZ) (Catbird {Aus}) in the G1 KrisFlyer International Sprint in May, but has since recorded daylight scores in domestic G3s, including a 4 1/4-length success in the Garden City Trophy Oct. 15. "The eight draw isn't perfect," admitted trainer Patrick Shaw. "I'd have preferred him to be further in so that he'd have more horses to help him get round the right hand bend. But I'm going to leave that and the tactics entirely to Felix who knows Sha Tin better than I do." **Lucky Nine** has never missed the top three in eight local appearances, including a last-out score over top miler Able One (NZ) (Cape Cross {Ire}) when in receipt of 18 pounds in the National Day Cup H. Oct. 1.
