**FAST FORWARD**

Jockey Yasunari Iwata, recently returned from injury, rode lucky number 13 **A Shin Forward** (Forest Wildcat) to a course-record victory in a thrilling blanket finish to Sunday's G1 Mile Championship at Kyoto. Let go at odds of 51-1 after running eighth as the favorite in the G2 Swan S. in late October, A Shin Forward was reserved in midpack on the rail until midway on the turn. He found an opening as the field turned into the straight, powered to the lead with 100 meters left and just held sway over favored

**Danon Yoyo (Jpn)** (Dance in the Dark {Jpn}). "I've only been back riding since last week, and I never thought I'd win a Group 1 race so soon," said an elated Iwata, who spent two months on the sidelines after fracturing a collarbone and ankle in a spill

at Sapporo Sept. 4. "It was a really easy race. The pace and the trip were just right." But, he added, "I was out there alone [on the lead] thinking, 'Isn't it over yet?!'" The final time of 1:31.80 for the 1600 meters established a new course record, shaving .30 seconds off the mark set by Hat Trick (Jpn) (Sunday Silence) five years ago. **TATTERSALLS DECEMBER KICKS OFF**

Tattersalls officials believe today's December Yearling Sale boasts its best catalogue in recent times, as buyers get their final chance to pick up a two-year-old for next season. Alongside the traditional group of horses that either missed or failed to changed hands at previous sales are a handful who have not previously been catalogued, most notably the 11 who hail from the dispersal of Peter Harris's Hertfordshire-based Pendley Farm. Harris, a leisure entrepreneur and former trainer, has been a breeder for over three decades. He is also dispersing his foals and mares at the December Sales, through the Genesis Green Stud, owned by his son-in-law Walter Swinburn's family. Among Pendley's yearlings are [hip 162](#), an Exceed And Excel (Aus) half-sister to G1 Middle Park S. winner Primo Valentino (Ire) (Primo Dominie {GB}); [hip 163](#), a Cape Cross (Ire) half-sister to Group 1-placed Marzelline (Ire) (Barathea {Ire}); and [hip 236](#), an Exceed And Excel half-sister to four black-type performers out of the veteran mare Why So Silent (GB) (Mill Reef). Stewards were unable to separate Singapore invader  
 Rocket Man and One World at the wire in a thrilling  
 inaugural running of this event. Several minutes passed  
 as an anxious Sha Tin crowd awaited the official result,  
 and general opinion seemed to hold that One World had  
 won narrowly, but a roar went up when it was deter-  
 mined that both horses had run too good to lose. **Click**

The pair were the two-three finishers in the G1 Dubai  
 Golden Shaheen in March, with Rocket Man just a half-  
 length behind Kinsale King (Stormin Fever) in the 1200-  
 meter sprint, and One World another two lengths back  
 in third. In the Jockey Club Sprint, a prep for the  
 G1 CXHK Sprint at Sha Tin Dec. 12, Rocket Man raced  
 under cover along the rail in fourth as One World estab-  
 lished a mid-pack position. The former, used to running  
 on left-handed courses, looked to be spinning his  
 wheels once straightened for home, but kicked into  
 gear 200 meters out as several challengers lined up to  
 his outside. Rocket Man split rivals in deep stretch to  
 gain the advantage, but One World, coming from out of  
 the clouds, closed fastest of all to share the spoils.

"I was a little bit concerned when he was a bit green  
 going into the first turn," said Rocket Man's trainer  
 Patrick Shaw. "He wasn't running as freely as he usu-  
 ally does--he was switching leads and pricking his ears.  
 But I'm always confident when this horse runs. I don't  
 think I can get him any fitter, but I do think we can do  
 some work in the next few weeks to get him used to  
 the right-hand turn." Rocket Man's South African owner  
 Alfredo Crabbia enthused, "I flew in last night, and I'm  
 just overwhelmed with the racecourse and the welcome  
 we've had, as well as by the way Rocket Man per-  
 formed. He's the best horse I've ever had." One World,  
 in receipt of five pounds, delighted rider Darren  
 Beadman. "It's just in the last week and a half that he's  
 begun to come back to his old self," said the jockey.  
 "That run showed he's just about there."

Able One's rivals allowed the champion miler an easy lead and paid for it in end, as the gelding cruised home a much-the-best winner. Away alertly under Darren Beadman, Able One emerged with the lead and settled into a fluid stride with his head tucked to his chest. He cut the corner for home and quickly lengthened away, and had built too much of a cushion as Thumbs Up came on well. Able One was turning the tables on that rival, having finished second to him in the Million Hills Sha Tin Trophy Oct. 24. "I couldn't believe it when he was just allowed to go out there and dictate like that," said winning trainer John Moore. "When you give Able One that sort of lead, you've got a hard job in front of you." 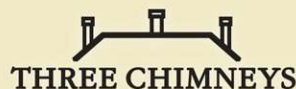

**RUNNING THE GAMUT AT TATTS DECEMBER**

The 306-lot Tattersalls December yearling catalogue features offerings at every level, from one that made 800gns earlier this year to another out of a mare who cost \$7.1 million. The latter is [hip 244](#), one of six Galileo (Ire) yearlings still in the sale last night. The colt is out of 1999 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies' winner Cash Run (Seeking the Gold), who was sold for that seven-figure sum in 2003. Others by Galileo include [hip 237](#), a half-sister to GISW Toccet (Awesome Again) who was bought back at €180,000 at Arqana in August; and [hip 238](#), a half-brother to GI Beverly D. S. winner Gorella (Fr) (Grape Tree Road {GB}), offered as part of the Breeding Capital dispersal. His mother Exciting Times (Fr) (Jeune Homme) was sold, in foal to Sea the Stars (Ire), for \$900,000 at Keeneland November.

"This is as good a December Yearling catalogue as any of us can remember," commented Tattersalls Marketing Director Jimmy George.

"Not only are there over 30 horses eligible for the Tattersalls Millions races, but we also have some very smart individuals that haven't been catalogued in earlier yearling sales. All of the top British- and Irish-based sires have horses catalogued."

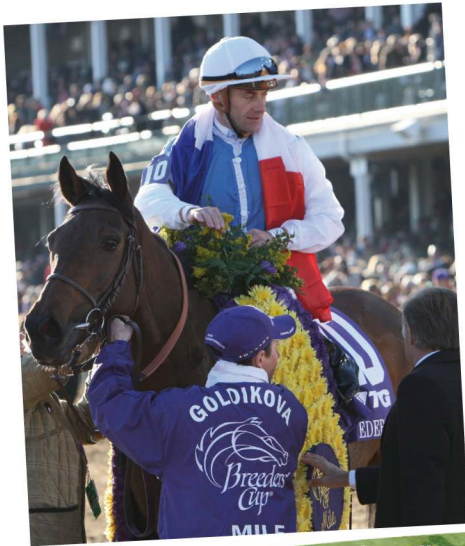
Yearlings to have already caused a big splash in the sale ring are led by [hip 207](#), a Giant's Causeway full-sister to multiple Grade II winner Naissance Royale (Ire), who was withdrawn from the Arqana August Yearling Sale having made \$280,000 as a weanling at Keeneland last year. She appears from Ciaran 'Flash' Conroy's Glenvale Stud. Two Camas Park Stud offerings with dear foal prices are [hip 218](#), a Nayef colt who made 100,000gns a year ago at Tattersalls, and the following [hip 219](#), a daughter of Lemon Drop Kid who cost \$100,000 at Keeneland last year and was a \$90,000 RNA at the same venue in September. [Hip 57](#), a Jamie Railton-consigned Shamardal colt, made 110,000gns as a foal last year, although was not sold at €120,000 at Deauville in August.

**MONMOUTH MEET CLOSSES** *(Edited Press Release)*

The 2010 racing season at Monmouth Park came to a close Sunday with dramatic across-the-board gains. With a new racing schedule that consolidated all Thoroughbred racing at Monmouth, the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority offered two meets--the Elite Summer Meet, which spanned 49 days, and the 22-day Monmouth Fall Meet. During the Elite Summer Meet, presented by IZOD, Monmouth offered the highest purses in the nation, averaging \$797,079. Those record purses led to an astonishing 213-percent increase in average daily handle, as well as a 79-percent increase in on-track handle, a 47-percent rise in attendance and a 25-percent gain in field size. Monmouth Park's Fall Meet, which got underway Sept. 11 and ran through Nov. 21, saw an average daily handle of \$3,841,848, on-track handle of \$299,778 and attendance of 4,277.

By comparison, during the 47 live Thoroughbred racing dates at the Meadowlands in 2009, average daily handle was \$1,342,884, on-track handle \$139,378 and attendance 3,325. Average field size during the 2010 fall meet at Monmouth was 8.81 per race.

At the Meadowlands in 2009 that same figure came in at 7.29. "It's clear that concentrating Thoroughbred racing at Monmouth Park proved a very wise investment," said Dennis R. Robinson, president and CEO of the NJSEA. "Not only did we realize dramatic gains in all categories, we substantially reduced our operating costs by shifting all Thoroughbred racing to Monmouth." When taking the raw numbers from last year's 140 Thoroughbred dates at the Sports Authority's racetracks and comparing them with just 71 live programs this year, a substantial net gain remained in total handle, and a near wash in on-track wagering. In 2009, (handle on) Thoroughbred racing at Monmouth Park and the Meadowlands totaled \$354,867,156. In 2010, with nearly 50-percent fewer dates, that number reached \$477,375,167. On-track handle in 2009 was \$44,623,515, with 2010 coming in at \$44,153,896.

"While in some instances it's difficult to compare the results of 2009 to 2010, one thing is certain--less proved to be more," said Robinson. "Our racing schedule, along with the quality of our product, resonated with racing fans from coast to coast. I hope it proves to be the cornerstone of a new racing model." Winning top honors at the Elite Meet were jockey Paco Lopez (69 victories); trainers Bruce Alexander, Steve Asmussen and Todd Pletcher (20 wins apiece); and owners George and Lori Hall (13 wins). The award for top jockey at the Monmouth Park Fall Meet went to Paco Lopez (44). Trainers Ben Perkins Jr. and Gregg Sacco tied with 10 wins apiece, while Red Oak Stable and Patricia Generazio led all owners, each with seven victories.



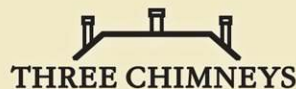

In 1970, the year Secretariat was born, the average number of starts per runner per year was a healthy 10.22. Forego, born that same year, ran 57 times, including 18 starts in 1973. But even those numbers, remarkable by today's standards, don't put the mighty Forego in the same league with some of the true iron horses in the sport's history. Hall of Famer Stymie started 131 times. In 2009, the average number of starts per horse was down to 6.23, a 39-percent decline over the 1970 numbers. The TDN takes a comprehensive look at why.
