### BLOOMSBURY FOAL TOPS TATTS' DAY THREE

A son of Darley's one-time flagship sire Singspiel (Ire), who died in July, looks set to race for the Coolmore team after selling for 320,000gns at yesterday's penultimate session of the Tattersalls December Foal Sale in Newmarket. Offered in the dispersal from Henrietta, Duchess of Bedford's Bloomsbury Stud, the March 12-foaled half-brother to dual listed winner Perfect Stride (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) walked into a ring packed full of admirers.

Yeomanstown Stud's David O'Callaghan threw in some early bids before the likes of Paddy Twomey and Ted Voute helped upped the price into six figures, at which point John Ferguson entered the fray. A classic Coolmore-Maktoum duel followed, as

Paul Shanahan took on--and ultimately outlasted--Ferguson, with M. V. Magnier signing the buyer's docket. "He's a lovely colt from a great family, and the plan at the moment is to bring him home and keep him to race," said Magnier. [Hip 979](#) descends from Bloomsbury foundation mare Mrs. Moss (GB) (Reform {GB}), who cost just 2,100gns at auction 40 years ago, but far exceeded expectations at stud, dropping 11 winners, including G1 Japan Cup winner Jupiter Island (GB) (St Paddy {GB}) and SW and GSP Krayyan (GB) (Tower Walk {GB}). **Cont. p9**

### GIANT OAK PUT UP IN CLARK

He was winless in 14 starts since taking the Arlington Classic in May of 2009, but **Giant Oak** (Giant's Causeway) joined the ranks of Grade I winners with the help of the stewards, getting moved up to first in yesterday's GI Clark H. at Churchill Downs. The unofficial winner, **Successful Dan** (Successful Appeal) bumped show horse **Redding Colliery** (Mineshaft) several times when trying to shift out for running room in the lane. He drove to the front and outgamed Giant Oak by a head, but was demoted to

### NINE GO POSTWARD IN CIGAR MILE

A contentious field of nine will go postward in today's GI Hill 'n' Dale Cigar Mile H., the final New York Grade I of the year. Todd Pletcher saddles **Bribon (Fr)** (Mark of Esteem {Ire}), second in this race a year ago and coming off a 1 3/4-length win in the Oct. 30 GIII Bold Ruler H. "I think the Cigar Mile is always a very difficult race to win," commented Pletcher, who has won the race three times. "It's the last significant Grade I on the East Coast, and always attracts the best sprinters, the best middle-distance horses, and horses backing up as well. Given that, I think Bribon fits in very well." **Cont. p6**

### TO HONOR AND SERVE HEADS REMSEN

The much-touted **To Honor and Serve** (Bernardini) looks for his second graded stakes victory in today's GII Remsen S. at the Big A. The handsome bay flew to an 8 3/4-length maiden win in a 1 1/16-mile off-the-turfer at Belmont Oct. 2. He was never threatened when a front-running four-length victor of the Nov. 6 GII Nashua S. last time out, and came out of it in good order, working a half in a sprightly :47 3/5 on the Belmont Park inner track Monday. "He worked in company with a maiden called Dream Man (Unbridled's Song), and it was very easy for him," said Leana Williford, assistant to trainer Bill Mott. Giant Oak closed out his 2009 campaign with a rallying fourth behind Blame (Arch) in the Clark. He came back to be third in the Feb. 20 GIII Mineshaft H. at Fair Grounds and, two starts later, filled the same spot in the Apr. 18 GIII Ben Ali S. at Keeneland. Off the board in his next three attempts, including another fourth to divisional leader Blame in the June 12 GI Stephen Foster H. over this track, the chestnut came back after a summer break to finish second in the Sept. 4 GIII Washington Park H. at Arlington. A 3/4-length runner-up to Redding Colliery in the Oct. 2 GIII Hawthorne Gold Cup, he finished fifth, but moved up to fourth, in the eventful Nov. 5 GIII Breeders' Cup Marathon. Giant Oak was rated off the pace while on the outside and was clear of the traffic as he hit the lane. Successful Dan, rank early, had bulled his way through the traffic, soundly bumping Redding Colliery to make his way to an open lane. He drove to the front and held off Giant Oak to the wire, but the stewards took a look at the tape and demoted him to third. "He slammed me pretty hard," said jockey Rosie Napravnik, aboard Redding Colliery. "He knocked us completely off stride, and I don't see how they couldn't take him down." The winner will race again as a five-year-old. "Oh yeah, he's coming back next year," trainer Chris Block said. "No doubt about it. He's going to Ocala on Sunday for probably about 45 days rest, then probably back to Fair Grounds to get him ready for 2011. Sent off a well-backed 7-2, Gypsy's Warning tipped out at the top of the stretch and roared past the leaders to win going away. The bay ran third after setting the pace in the Oct. 2 GI Yellow Ribbon Invitational S. going 10 panels on the turf, but changed tactics here. Rated in fifth as Wasted Tears took them through six furlongs in 1:10.83, she shifted off the rail to find running room when they hit the stretch and, responding to left-handed encouragement, powered to the front in the final yards before pulling clear. "She's a class, class filly," said Team Valor International rep Aron Wellman. "It could not have gone any better than how we planned it today." Five-for-11 in her native country, Gypsy's Warning captured the G1 South African Fillies' Classic and was third in the G1 Woolavington 2000 S. in 2009. She had been off for nearly a year when she made her U.S. bow in the May 31 GIII Eatontown S. at Monmouth Park, but was firing on all cylinders for her return and scored by a nose over Maram (Sahm).

The mare was beaten just 1 1/2 lengths when fifth in the July 18 GII Dance Smartly S. at Woodbine, then finished third from off the pace in the Aug. 21 GI Beverly D. S. and after leading early in the Yellow Ribbon. As for the strategy in the Matriarch, Joel Rosario said, "I didn't really take her back, I just let her relax and get comfortable. She seemed like she was going to be a little rank, but she settled herself down. When I asked her to go, she really kicked. The only instructions I got were to let her relax, keep her covered up and make one run. I don't know how good she is, but she really showed me something today."

Spacy Tracy could've been claimed for just \$25,000 last year, but she climbed all the way into the graded ranks here. A maiden winner for that moderate tag at Hollywood in May of 2009, she was beaten a neck in a starter allowance the following month, then disappeared for 10 months. The bay was fifth in her return, an optional claimer on the Aqueduct turf in April, but followed up with a decisive starter-allowance score going a route at Belmont in May. Back after a break to take an allowance going 7 1/2 furlongs on the Delaware turf Aug. 2, she ran second at Parx in a five-furlong test Sept. 12. The five-year-old was looking to make it three in a row after taking an off-the-turf allowance going two turns at Parx Oct. 2 and the Justakiss S. on the Delaware main track Nov. 6. The second-longest shot on the board, she was taken in hand to trail the field early. Spacy Tracy eased closer as they approached the turn and was on the heels of the leaders as they came into the lane.
