Jersey Town, on the board in 10 of his 11 prior starts and runner-up in the GIII British Columbia Derby last year, kicked off the season out at Emerald Downs. The chestnut colt came back after a 10-month layoff to take an optional claimer at that track July 25, and was second in the GIII Longacres Mile H. Aug. 22. Jersey City was then shipped to trainer Barclay Tagg, who saddled Charles Fipke homebred Tale of Ekati (Tale of the Cat) to hit the line second by a nose in this race two years ago, only to have him elevated to the victory via the stewards' booth.

Tagg sent out Jersey Town to a third in the GII Kelso S. going a mile on the Belmont main track Oct. 3 and second behind Bribon (Mark of Esteem {Ire}) in the seven-panel GIII Bold Ruler H. Oct. 30, and the Fipke colorbearer gave his owner/breeder another Cigar photo finish, and another trophy. Settled in third as Vineyard Haven (Lido Palace {Chi}) cut out rapid splits of :22.69 and :45.27, he floated out to the center of the track and forged to the front as

Haynesfield came through to his inside. Haynesfield took over briefly between calls, but Jersey City battled back despite drifting wider still and got the nod. "It was a miracle," Tagg enthused. "I liked him, I just didn't think the race would come up that tough.

Mr. Fipke had him out west, and wanted to go to the Breeders' Cup. I talked him out of that, and said the Cigar Mile would be a lot easier, and it's still a Grade I. Then the race came up so tough, and I thought we made a mistake. But he was doing well, so we were happy with that. He's all business--he just goes out there with his game face on every day, no fooling around, just does everything the way you like a horse to do." Tagg added, "I have no idea what's next; hopefully, we'll keep him around for a little bit."

No Such Word has been on the go all year, starting the campaign in January and racing at least once every month but September. The B.C. Jones production captured an optional claimer in February and the GIII Honeybee S. in March at Oaklawn Park, then finished third in the GII Fantasy S. in Hot Springs in April. The runner-up after an eventful trip in the GII Black-Eyed Susan S. at Pimlico in May, she got it done as the 3-5 choice in the June 5 Go for Wand S.

at Delaware Park. The bay was beaten just 2 3/4 lengths by Blind Luck (Pollard's Vision) in the GII Delaware Oaks July 10, but came home 1 1/2 lengths to the good in the Aug. 14 GII Monmouth Oaks, and romped by 6 1/2 lengths in the Oct. 10 Remington Park Oaks. Favored to add to her skein, No Such Word rated in fourth off the moderate splist set by Awesome Maria. She collared the pacesetter from the outside before they hit the headwind in the stretch and pulled clear. "That was the way we planned it--to win, absolutely!" trainer Cindy Jones said. "She had been training so awesome into this race. It looked like she was galloping down the backside and, when he asked her to go, it was all over. To Honor and Serve ran into trouble late in his career opener at Saratoga Sept. 4 and had to settle for second, but came back to romp by 8 3/4 lengths in an off-the-turf maiden test at Belmont Oct. 2. The Live Oak colorbearer led every step of the way to take the Nov. 6 Gill Nashua S. by four lengths, and he was odds-on to extend his streak as he made his two-turn bow here. Johnny V. sent the colt right to the front, thus avoiding the scrimmage that saw Bandbox (Tapit) clip the heels of Mucho Macho Man on the first turn and Buffum (Bernardini) take up in traffic as they neared the backstretch. Mucho Macho Man chased the winner in second and got within a length as they hit the final bend, but To Honor and Serve was shaken up when they straightened for home and opened up to win handily. "It would have been nice to see him to have to pass somebody, but that's just the way the race turned out," trainer Bill Mott remarked. Looking ahead, Mott added, "As with any horse like him, we'll nominate him for everything, in case there's a hiccup anywhere." Third in her career opener at Delaware Park Aug. 4, Dixie City came back to graduate at Parx Aug. 31, and made it two in a row with an allowance tally at that

track Oct. 2. She was bet down to 6-5 favoritism in the Nov. 6 GIII Tempted S. over this track, closing late to be third, but changed tactics and got it done trying two turns for the first time here. The Ned Evans homebred broke sharply from her

rail post and cut out splits of :24.20 and :48.19. Jose Lezcano turned her loose when she hit the turn and she scampered clear, then easily held crowd's choice at bay late. The final eighth was a wind-hampered :14.10.

"[Trainer Tony Dutrow] told me, 'Do whatever you have to do,'" Lezcano said. "She broke so sharply I wasn't about to take hold of her. On the backside, I went inside, and she gave me a big run. When I saw [Ramon Dominguez, on Believe in A.P.], I didn't know how much horse he had, but I knew I had more." Added Dutrow, "I didn't think the distance was much of an issue, as she's bred to go long. She had running on her mind, and they let her set a nice, easy pace. Santiva was a maiden going into the gate, but he emerged from the race a graded winner. A distant third in his career opener at the Spa July 24, the bay tried turf and two turns at Saratoga Aug. 21 and improved to be second behind J. B.'s Thunder (Thunder Gulch). He faced that rival again in the GI Dixiana Breeders' Futurity on the Keeneland Poly and was again the runner-up, finishing four lengths adrift of the winner that afternoon. He was well-backed as he returned to conventional dirt yesterday. Rated just off easy early fractions in second, Santiva took a short lead after six furlongs in 1:14.25. Odds-on Astrology was looming boldly to his outside, and Major Gain slipped through to come at him from the rail, but Santiva was dead game from between horses, fighting back and edging ahead late. Could he be back under the Twin Spires on the first Saturday in May? "He's got the pedigree," trainer Eddie Kenneally said. "here's all the stamina in the world in his pedigree. He's got the profile for the race here in May. That's the goal, for sure." As for what path he might take to the Triple Crown, Kenneally offered, "There are some races in Florida with him this winter, so we'll look at some of those and take it from there. Kathmanblu showed little in a 4 1/2-furlong maiden test on the Churchill dirt June 12, finishing eighth. Switched to the turf at Ellis Park July 17, she graduated by a half-length, then shipped to Saratoga and was runner-up in the P.G. Johnson S. at 15-1. The homebred was the 2-1 favorite to get it done in the Oct. 14 Jessamine S. at Keeneland, and came through for the crowd with a rallying four-length success. A 7-1 chance in the Nov. 5 GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf, she had to fight her way through traffic, and still managed a solid third-place effort. The bay was favored as she returned to the main track here. She probably won't run until late February or early March. ### TATTERSALLS FOALS WRAP UP

Tattersalls' December Foal Sale finished last night in Newmarket with a 17,491,400gns turnover, down 13 percent on last year. The 31,235gns average dropped by five percent while the 20,000gns median rose by 25 percent. The clearance rate of 75 percent was a decline from 78 percent last year. "The continuing economic uncertainties, especially in Europe, have not made for encouraging reading in recent weeks, but foal buyers, particularly from Ireland, have yet again been out in force at Tattersalls, and we have had good, solid trade throughout the past four days," Tattersalls Chairman Edmund Mahony commented. "We have offered less foals compared to last year, which has not surprisingly resulted in lower turnover, but the key indicators of average, median and percentage of lots sold have held up well. The median has shown a significant increase, the average a small decrease and, while the clearance rate has not quite matched the 2009 figure, it has comfortably exceeded the levels of 2008 and even 2007 when the market was at its height." He continued, "As last year, the December Foal Sale has produced the highest-priced foal sold in Europe or North America, and it was fitting that the 320,000gns sale topping Singspiel colt should be from the Bloomsbury Stud dispersal. Both the Bloomsbury Stud and Pendley Farm dispersals continue at the December Breeding Stock Sale starting on Monday, and they look set to be amongst the highlights of a week of typically international trade." The mare sale begins tomorrow.

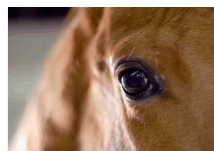

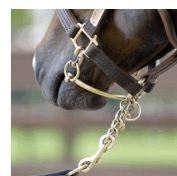
