TATTS BREEDING STOCK SALE STARTS

Tattersalls' year reaches its conclusion this week with the breeding stock session of the December Sale, which has provided the foundation to many great broodmare collections over many decades. This year's 1,097-lot catalogue, which gets underway at 10 a.m. this morning, does not look to feature any lot that will endanger the sale's 4.6-million guineas record price, although there are no shortage of breeding prospects with great appeal. Following the withdrawal of Group 1 winners Gilt Edge Girl (GB) (Monsieur Bond {Ire}) and Stacelita (Fr) (Monsun {Ger}), it is likely to be lot [1715](#), last season's G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches heroine **Elusive Wave** (Ire) (Elusive City), to be the sale's standout. Racing in the colours of Martin Schwartz, she also won the G3 Prix Quincey at Deauville in August. Both 11-year-old Diary (Ire) (Green Desert), lot [1650](#), and her three-year-old daughter Lady Darshaan (Ire) (High Chaparral {Ire}), lot [1753](#), are likely to make an impact. Lady Darshaan (Ire) finished second in last year's G1 Fillies' Mile, while Diary (Ire)--covered by Galileo (Ire)--is the dam of G1 Prix de l'Abbaye winner Total Gallery (Ire) (Namid {Ire}) and a Tamayuz (GB) foal who sold for 200,000gns to Blandford Bloodstock Saturday. **Tatts Dec cont. p2**

Registered to William de Burgh and Hill 'n Dale Equine Holdings, the Highclere Stud-consigned five-year-old is a half-sister to six-time Group 1 winner Duke Of Marmalade (Ire) (Danehill). Dual Italian Group 3 winner Exhibit One (Silver Hawk) is another covered by Sea The Stars and appears as lot [1652](#).

Pachattack (Pulpit), a stakes winner at Woodbine earlier this month, is offered by trainer Gerard Butler as lot [2039](#), while last season's G3 Anglesey S. winner Walk On Bye (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) is offered from Tommy Stack's stable today as [lot 1469](#).

Lot [1743](#), Grace O'Malley (Ire) (Refuse To Bend {Ire}) finished fourth in last year's G1 Irish Oaks and is offered in foal to Shamardal, while [lot 1328](#), Belle Allure (Ire) (Numerous), is a Group 3 winner in France and the US, a half-sister to Group 1 winner Jukebox Jury (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) and covered by Giant's Causeway.

A winding-up of the Breeding Capital investment scheme includes lot [1704](#), Bayalika (Ire) (Selkirk), dam of Group 2 winner Vital Equine (Ire) and covered by Oasis Dream (GB), and lot [1705](#), Group 1-placed Musicanna (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}), sold with a Pivotal (GB) cover.

Buyers from across the world were at Tattersalls yesterday including several parties from India, who are allowed to buy in Britain for the first time in recent years after an export ban has been lifted.

"The Tattersalls December breeding stock sale is always one of the highlights of the calendar and arguably the most international sale of its type in the world," said Tattersalls Marketing Director Jimmy George yesterday.

"We've had a lot of interest from the moment the catalogue came out, and we've two quality dispersals from Bloomsbury Stud and Pendley Stud to look forward to. Last week's foal sale as also given us plenty of encouragement."

The sale runs today through Thursday, starting at 10 a.m. each morning.

Three Chimneys Make Transatlantic Trip...

Not only is there an International group of buyers in Newmarket for this week's breeding stock sale at Tattersalls, there is one draft of fillies and mares that has crossed the Atlantic to be at the auction and selling tomorrow.

Case Clay, president of his family's Three Chimneys Farm, is overseeing a team of six European-bred fillies as well as the broodmare Stunning (Nureyev) in a new venture for the famous Kentucky stud.

The draft includes GII Providencia S. winner Missit (Ire) (Orpen); GIII La Habra S. winner Pasar Silbano (Ire) (Elnadim); Group 2-placed Rosa Grace (GB) (Lomitas {GB}); six-year-old Bahama Mama (Ire), a listed winner in Britain who went on to be stakes-placed in California; Meydan Princess (Ire) (Choisir {Aus}), winner of Del Mar's Osunitas H.; and Rosy Mantle (GB) (Daylami {Ire}), a four-year-old who was listed-placed in Britain and offered with a War Chant cover.

"We bought the fillies in Europe to run for Three Chimneys Racing in America and we just figured that the European turf racing was better than in America," explained Clay, who is at Tattersalls with a team including Three Chimneys' British representative Ed Sackville, Kern Lillingston, U.S. agents Lincoln Collins and Joe Miller as well as International development advisor Jean-Marie Callier. "We bought fillies with form that may have been just below the top stakes level with the aim of winning graded stakes in America this year."

Clay, who stated the logistics were relatively straightforward, added, "The partnership expires at the end of this year and we thought that we would bring the suitable horses back here. Then a couple of clients have added to the draft. They shipped over fine last week and boarded with Brian O'Rourke, a friend of mine, at the National Stud in Newmarket. Ed Sackville, our European representative, organized everything and it all went smoothly. Meanwhile, Stunning [who is in foal to Shamardal] has shipped over from Ireland."

As for some of the particulars of the draft, Clay said, "Missit was the first graded-stakes winner for the partnership, so she's pretty special and Bahama Mama is in foal to Arch and obviously Blame [Arch] winning the G1 Breeders' Cup Classic is a nice update there."

"We've bought two so far for our new partnership and will be looking for more this week, Lincoln Collins heads up the buying team. We bought the stakes-placed two-year-old Whisper Louise (Ire) (Chevalier {Ire}) from trainer Pam Sly and she's a really tough filly. Three Chimneys Racing 3 bought Miss Keller (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) from Three Chimneys Racing 2 at Keeneland [she was knocked down to Kern Lillingston for \$700,000]."

Clay is no stranger to the European scene, having undertaken the Irish National Stud course in 2003, and was also over in Newmarket in July.

"I've been coming over to Tattersalls for the December Sale for a long time and I find I actually catch up with more people here than at Keeneland in November, because I'm always so busy then."

Odds-on favorite Buena Vista and sophomore Rose Kingdom--both carrying the colors of Sunday Racing--raced in mid-pack early behind a slow pace. The former, a champion at two and three, was coming off a win in the G1 Tenno Sho Autumn here Oct. 31. Rose Kingdom, last year's champion three-year-old, was seeking his first top-level win after a runner-up performance in the G1 Kikuka Sho Japanese St. Leger at Kyoto Oct. 24. As they straightened for the sprint for home, Buena Vista was moving best, but came in slightly on Rose Kingdom inside the final furlong before drawing off by 1 1/2 lengths. After a 24 minute stewards' inquiry, the favorite was demoted to second for interference in the stretch. "To be honest, I have mixed feelings about this race," admitted Rose Kingdom's conditioner Kojiro Hashiguchi. "[Rose Kingdom] has been extremely consistent this fall. To the eye, he hasn't changed much since before the summer, but his ability to keep up with his physical condition tells me that he's matured during the season. Today, being bumped a few times didn't faze him, and he put in another effort even after that to finish second. He's always had guts, but the determination he showed today was amazing. His win today gives us a lot of confidence towards his future career." G1 Prix de L'Arc de Triomphe runner-up Nakayama Festa (Jpn) (Stay Gold {Jpn}) came under a ride early and finished 14th. This term, he emulated his sire by registering a Classic double in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains at Longchamp and the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club at Chantilly, earning a Timeform rating of 125 in the latter contest. Lope de Vega re-

tires with a career record of 9-4-0-1, and earnings of €1,188,085. His first season fee has been set at €15,000 (1st October), and he will also shuttle to Pattinack Farm in Australia. 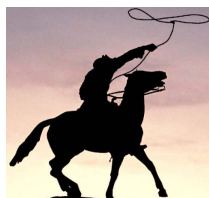

Santiva, Major Gain Head to Florida

Tom Walters' **Santiva** (Giant's Causeway) exited his winning effort in Saturday's GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. in fine fettle and is expected to ship to Florida promptly. "He is doing well this morning and he will leave for Florida [Monday]," said Brendan Walsh, assistant to trainer Eddie Kenneally. "That was a nice way to end the meet." On the board for trainer Ken McPeck in his first two starts at the Spa, the bay was runner-up in the GII Dixiana Breeders' Futurity S. at Keeneland Oct. 9. "We got him in about mid-October after he had run in the Breeders' Futurity at Keeneland," Walsh said. "He's a nice colt." Also heading to Florida on Monday will be Linda Shanahan's **Missyoulikecrazy** (Lion Heart), who finished second for Kenneally in the GII Golden Rod S. Saturday. "She ran a nice race," said Walsh. "We have a lot to look forward to next year." Additionally, **Major Gain** (More Than Ready) will ship South this week following a third-place in the Kentucky Jockey Club, according to Lisa Sloan, assistant to trainer Wayne Catalano. Gary and Mary West's charge made his dirt track debut Saturday.

Plans for McPeck Juvenile Team

Kathmanblu (Bluegrass Cat), an 8 1/2-length winner in the GII Golden Rod S. Saturday, was no worse for wear following her monumental effort and is expected to ship to trainer Ken McPeck's Florida base this week. "She got back to the barn and dove right into her feed tub," said Philip Bauer, McPeck's assistant at Churchill Downs. "She is doing great [Sunday] morning and will head to Florida on Wednesday." Owned by Five D Thoroughbreds and Wind River Stables, Kathmanblu was making her second start on the dirt after winning two races from four starts on the grass, including a victory in the Jessamine S. at Keeneland and a third-place finish in the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf. "The first time she ran, it was at 4 1/2 furlongs, and that was too short for her," Bauer said. "The only reason Kenny put her on the grass was to get two turns for her. It is nice to have the versatility. This way you can prep for bigger things on either surface." In addition to Kathmanblu, McPeck also conditions **Rogue Romance** (Smarty Jones), third in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile and **Harlan's Ruby** (Harlan's Holiday), eighth in the GI Juvenile Fillies. "They are both turned out and getting some time off," confirmed Bauer. "They will probably rejoin the barn in Florida in mid-December."

Jockey Jason Gracia, who remained in the intensive care unit at Jamaica Hospital Sunday afternoon, was listed in stable condition yesterday following a spill in the third race at Aqueduct Saturday. According to Gracia's agent Jorge Velasquez, the 28-year-old suffered broken ribs, a broken collarbone and a hairline fracture of his neck. Jose Bermudez, who was also involved in the incident, was released from North Shore Medical Center with bruised ribs and expects to be sidelined for at least one week. Gracia's mount Ryan and Jack (Manlove) sustained a skull fracture and was euthanized, while Bermudez's charge, October Dreams (Legion Field), escaped serious injury.

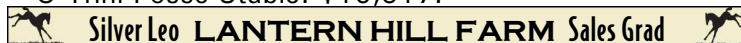
