ARQANA FINALE KICKS OFF

Europe's major sales season comes to an end by Arqana next week, with their four-day Breeding Stock Sale getting underway at Deauville today. In total, a catalogue of 871 lots, including 216 foals, sit alongside shares in stallions Anabaa Blue (GB), Diableneyev and Panis. Among the vendors are His Highness The Aga Khan's Studs, Wertheimer et Frere, Haras du Mezeray, Haras de la Louviere, Haras du Quesnay, Haras de Fresnay-le-Buffard, Haras d'Etreham, Darley and Shadwell. In recent months, endorsements for this auction include the former Aga Khan runner **Shemriyna (Ire)** (King of Kings {Ire}), whose €58,000 purchase by Norris/Huntingdon Bloodstock two years ago was

preceded by the G2 Prix Eugene Adam success of her first foal Shimraan (Fr) (Rainbow Quest); Mathieu Daguzan-Garros's €24,000 buy **Genevale (Fr)** (Unfuwain), now responsible for this year's G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains third Shamalgan (Fr) (Footstepsinthesand {GB}); **Algoa (Fr)** (Common Grounds {GB}), who brought a handsome return on her €20,000 tag via her G3 Prix du Calvados-winning daughter Mambia (GB) (Aldebaran); and **Lady Vettori (GB)** (Vettori {Ire}), who made her €500,000 purchase by Crispin de Moubray look like value when producing this year's Poule d'Essai des Poulains and Prix du Jockey-Club hero Lope de Vega (Ire) (Shamardal). Another who has gone on to make a profit is **Alpine Rose (Fr)** (Linamix {Fr}), who was bought for €550,000 in 2008 before annexing the following year's G1 Prix Jean Romanet. Two standouts this year are Haras du Mezeray's hip **137**, the 2004 G1 Premio Lydia Tesio, G2 Prix de Malleret and G2 Prix de Pomone heroine Lune d'Or (Fr) (Green Tune) in foal to Galileo (Ire); and the Coulonces Consignment's hip **22**, the Grade 1-placed 13-year-old **Premiere Creation (Fr)** (Green Tune). She has already produced the group performers Anabaa's Creation (Ire) (Anabaa) and Leo's Starlet (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), and is carrying a foal by Sea the Stars (Ire). FROM SMALL GAME TO BAGGING GRADE IS

Equilete Stable's Robert and Michele Billings enjoyed another big score last Saturday care of their five-year-old ridgling **Victor's Cry** (Street Cry {Ire}), who unleashed a dazzling stretch run in the GII Citation H. at Hollywood Park. It was Victor's Cry's third win in eight starts this term and his second career score at the graded level. In May, he established a new high-water mark winning the GI Shoemaker Mile over the same Hollywood course. Bred by Legacy Farm in Virginia, the Eoin Harty-trained horse has compiled a record of 21-6-3-2, \$564,021.

Victor's Cry is the first graded stakes winner for the Billingses, who now call Naples, Florida, home. The husband-and-wife team has been in the racing business for some 30 years now, though Michele says her love of the animal pre-dates that by a good margin.

"I always loved horses, and when I was young, I would ask my mother to buy me one," she laughed Thursday. "She'd say, 'When you're married, your husband can get you one.' So my husband was really elected into the position."

The couple was living and working in the New York/New Jersey area when they first got into racing, while also dealing with critters more petite. "We were small-game hunters," quipped Michele. "We were involved in commercial pest control, and had a very successful business. In 1985, we sold the business to a major corporation, and now we're just in the horse business."

An early arrival led the couple to ownership. Michele was taking riding lessons at a farm that also was preparing Thoroughbreds for the Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Sale when Robert came to pick her up one day. While waiting, he got to walking around and looking at the Thoroughbreds. When Michele was finally done, he was intrigued enough to ask if she was interested in taking a trip to Saratoga to attend the auction.

"I said, 'My bags are already packed,'" Michele remembered. "At the sale, we met Terence [Collier, now Fasig's director of marketing], and told him we knew nothing about Thoroughbreds. He assigned a trainer to take us around and show us the process--it was O.D. Lee [one-time trainer of Pleasant Colony], I believe. He taught us a little about conformation, a little about pedigrees..."

After attending a few sales, the Billingses felt comfortable enough to make their first purchase--a weanling whom famed bloodstock agent Joss Collins bought on their behalf.

"That was like watching grass grow," Michele said of the weanling. "It was not the best first purchase to make."

Their interests soon multiplied, however, and through the 1980s and '90s, the Billingses became active in racing, breeding and stallion ownership.

"At one point, we were up to 36 horses, which is a lot for anyone," Michele said. They even stood a trio of stallions at Doc and Suzie O'Cain's Highcliff Farm in New York, including the Mr. Prospector sire Prosper Fager.

New York fans may also remember a string of uniquely named horses bred and/or raced by the Billingses.

"We are big fans of jazz and of Jelly Roll Morton, so we named all the foals out of one mare we had beginning with 'Jelly Roll,'" Michele said. The best of the bunch was Jelly Roll Jive, a stakes winner who finished third to Mecke in the GIII Widener H. at Hialeah in 1996.

"We didn't have any 'big' horses at the time, but we had a lot of horses who were runners and made money and did very well," said Michele.

In the late '90s, Robert took ill for a time, and the Billingses scaled back their holdings, particularly the stallions and breeding stock. But they never had any intention of leaving racing. In 2006, they sent bloodstock advisor Mark McEntee, manager of Miacomet Farm in Georgetown, Kentucky, to the Fasig-Tipton July Sale to specifically hunt down a son of Street Cry (Ire). McEntee came away with Victor's Cry, produced by the Clever Trick mare Short Time, whom he acquired for \$150,000. Needham/Betz Thoroughbreds consigned.

"Street Cry was just starting out as a sire, and my husband thought that he was going to produce some really good horses," said Michele.

Robert was right. Four months later, a colt from Street Cry's first crop, Street Sense, won the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile on his way to GI Kentucky Derby glory, and today, no sire in the U.S. stands for more than Street Cry's \$150,000 fee at Darley. Victor's Cry, though just a year younger than Street Sense, needed more time to come to hand than the juvenile champion.

"We take a lot of time with our horses," said Michele. "We let him progress at his own pace and let him tell us when he was ready to race." Victor's Cry debuted in March of his three-year-old year, but didn't break his maiden until six starts later--a track-record-setting win going 6 1/2 panels over Del Mar's Poly in July. He took another six starts to make his graded debut in the 2009 GII Del Mar Mile, where he finished fourth. Now a month away from his sixth birthday, Victor's Cry has established himself as one of California's best turf horses, and he'll be back in 2011 to show what he can do.

"With the [stallion] market way it is, it's too hard to determine where to stand a horse like 'Victor,'" said Michele. "There are lot of foreign countries who are interested, but I'm not sure we'd want to do that, unless we know he's going to be sent to a place where he'll always be safe and sound. Right now, he's extremely sound--I'm biting my tongue right now saying that--and he's just a wonderful horse. He's a beautiful horse, too. He has outstanding conformation, and everyone who sees him just comes away awed."

Michele said a return to the main track could even be in the cards. Since breaking his maiden, Victor's Cry has made just two starts on the main track--both on synthetics.

"He loves California and Eoin and his team have done such a great job, so he'll stay out there, of course," said Michele. "But Eoin thinks he'll run on dirt, and with Santa Anita going back to dirt, who knows? He's a very versatile horse."

Since recently selling a broodmare prospect at Keeneland November and a racing prospect privately, the Billingses are down to a stable of one: Victor's Cry. Michele said they will replenish the stable presently, but for now, they are just enjoying have a Grade I winner in their shedrow.

"It took us 30 years to get a horse like Victor," said Michele. "And we just love him."

Girls Can Run Fast Too...

Yesterday, the American Graded Stakes Committee announced their official upgrades and downgrades. I'm sure, if you looked carefully enough, you could make plenty of arguments about races that were rewarded for their importance and races that were penalized for their loss of impact. However, there is certainly one race that sticks out amongst them all. The committee decided that the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf, for colts, was worthy of a promotion from Grade II to a Grade I. I wholeheartedly agree and applaud this move upward. However, the female counterpart of that same race, namely the Breeders Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf, remains a Grade II.

Clearly, this is a short-sighted mistake that can only be labeled as sexist. In the year of 2010, the American Graded Stakes Committee needs to catch up with the rest of society and start treating our Thoroughbreds with equality.

Why in the world would anyone think the colt race is more important than the filly race?

Let's take a quick look at this year's editions. Pluck, the winner of the colt race, ran a courageous and exhilarating race. He had to overcome a bad start and, on the clubhouse turn, avoided a horse that went down in distress, and he still passed them all in the stretch like they were standing still. I know it is sometimes unfair to compare one race against the other, but when a committee is awarding grades that's exactly what they are doing.

So, here we go...The colt race was run in 1:36.98, and the fillies ran it in 1:36.61. By a loose estimation, that's about two lengths, which means that the first three finishers--More Than Real, Winter Memories and Kathmanblu--all could have finished in front of Pluck if they'd been in the colt race. Even more resounding was the results of the very consistent and reliable Thorograph sheet numbers--More Than Real ran five points faster than Pluck.

Moreover, the fields beaten by More Than Real and Pluck stacked up very evenly. There were four prior graded/group winners in each field.

I want to reiterate that I was wowed by Pluck's performance, as was the crowd at Churchill Downs that day. Ironically, as a new member of the Breeders' Cup trustees, I was honored to represent them in the trophy presentation to Team Valor and Pluck. Some of you will realize that as the author of this editorial, I am also the very proud owner of More Than Real. I was thrilled that day to win a Breeders' Cup Championship, no matter what the grade.

However, in my opinion, if we are trying to make the Breeders' Cup Championships truly "World" Championships, then every Breeders' Cup race has to be a Grade I, no matter what sex they are.

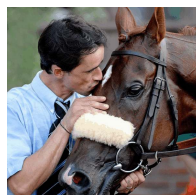
