WASHINGTON BRIDGE STRIKES IN BAYAKOA

Washington Bridge (Yankee Gentleman) closed furiously and hit the front in the final strides of Sunday's GII Bayakoa H. at Hollywood Park en route to a 1 3/4-length victory over pacesetter **Sister Dawn** (Indian Charlie). Sent off at 5-1, Washington Bridge settled at the back of the pack as Sister Dawn took the field through measured fractions of :23.79, :47.73 and 1:12.53. Widest of all into the stretch, the bay filly was flying late to earn her first graded victory. "Sometimes the horse gets the idea, turns around and starts doing things right," said co-owner and trainer Jerry Hollendorfer. "This is the third time in a row that she put it all together. She was very nervous earlier in her career, but she's settled down quite a bit lately. We just took our time, schooled her a lot and stood her at the gate a lot." *Cont. p2*

TRANSCENDENTAL PERFORMANCE

Transcend (Jpn) (Wild Rush) went quickly to the lead and left enough in the tank to hold off **Glorious Noah** (Jpn) (Precise End) to win yesterday's G1 Japan Cup Dirt at Hanshin by a neck. Coming off a win in the G3 Miyako S. at Kyoto Nov. 7, Transcend was the 5-2 choice to secure this valuable prize. The bay broke well and immediately dashed to the lead, securing the early advantage from his inside post and forcing several others to take up the chase. Pilot Shinji Fujita was able to slow things down on the front end, keeping plenty in reserve for the stretch drive. **Birdie Birdie** (Jpn) (Brian's Time) came to challenge the leader around the 200-meter mark, but Transcend quickly disposed of that rival and had built enough of a lead to account for Glorious Noah's late run. ARQANA BREEDING STOCK SALE

SHEMISSA TOPS ARQANA DAY TWO

Nearing the end of yesterday's second session of Arqana's Breeding Stock Sale, His Highness The Aga Khan's **Shemissa (Ire)** (Fairy King) stole the show when topping trading at €130,000. Consigned as hip 471, the 12-year-old dam of the 2007 G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere third Shediak (Fr) (Selkirk) and two other winners was offered in foal to Monsun (Ger). Crispin de Moubray secured the daughter of the 1993 G1 Prix de Diane heroine Shemaka (Ire) (Nishapour {Fr}). Prior to that headline-maker was hip 415, the five-year-old **Masque Rose (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) who was carrying a foal by Muhtathir (GB). From Haras de Meautry, the winning bay has obvious broodmare potential as a relative of the great Miesque, Kingmambo and Six Perfections (Fr) (Celtic Swing {GB}). Her half-brother Nid d'Abeilles (Ire) (Green Desert) was a scorer at listed level and was also third in the 2006 G3 Prix du Palais-Royal. Richard Brown of Blandford Bloodstock prevailed with a bid of €125,000. "She was an absolutely gorgeous mare, one of the nicest I have seen at the sale," Brown told the *Racing Post*. "Masque Rose will stay in France for the time being until we have decided which stallion she will go to next year." Two lots beforehand, Stephen Hillen snapped up Haras de Bernesq's **Liberty Chery (GB)** (Statue of Liberty) for €105,000. Placed twice at listed level last term, the half to the 2005 G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud runner-up Fauvelia (Fr) (Polish Precedent) is in foal to Invincible Spirit (Ire) and will race for Sheikh Al Thani. During a fertile spell of trading in early afternoon, three consecutive lots created a stir. The first was hip **355**, the nine-year-old **Grosgrain (Diesis {GB})**. Consigned by Haras du Mezeray, the daughter of the listed-winning and group-placed Green Lady (Ire) (Green Desert) is the dam of the borderline black-type duo of Granitik (GB) (Intikhab) and Gwenhwyfar (Ire) (Cacique {Ire}) and was knocked down to Highflyer Bloodstock, in foal to Peintre Celebre, for €65,000.

Next into the ring was Gestut Ammerland's hip 356, the three-year-old **Grey Lily (Ire)** (Boreal {GB}), bought by Patricia Boutin's Suprina Agency for €95,000. She is out of the 2004 G1 Prix du Moulin winner and G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches runner-up Grey Lilas (Ire) (Danehill), whose unbeaten juvenile Golden Lilac (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) looks one to follow for next term. "The filly has been bought for Edouard de Rothschild's Haras de Meautry," Boutin told the *Racing Post*. "She is quite small, but has a fantastic pedigree, and I thought, compared to yesterday's prices, she might have made more." Haras d'Ommel was responsible for the last of the trio and the top-priced foal overall on the day when hip **357**, a son of Dylan Thomas (Ire), sold for €70,000. Out of a half to the dual group scorer and three-times top-level placegetter Carribean Sunset (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}), the February-foaled bay was snapped up by Thierry Storme for €70,000. That buyer also paid €45,000 for the top-priced filly foal of the session from the first crop of the 2008 G1 Eclipse hero Mount Nelson (GB) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}). Also from the d'Ommel draft, hip **307** is out of a half to the top-class Sarafan (Lear Fan), winner of the 2002 G1 Eddie Read H. before being nosed out by Falbrav (Ire) in that year's G1 Japan Cup. **Cont. p4**

Moments later, Haras du Cadran's hip [318](#), the three-year-old **Miss Quality** (Elusive Quality), sold to Ballynahinch Farm for €62,000. Her stakes-winning close relative Desert Gold (Seeking the Gold) is now the dam of Godolphin's juvenile sensation of 2010 White Moonstone (Dynaformer). Hip [292](#), from Ecurie des Clos, was the listed-placed four-year-old **Black Rose (Fr)** (Sagacity {Fr}) who sold to PB Bloodstock for €57,000. Yesterday's session saw the average of €21,085 increasing by 20 percent on 2010 and the median of €16,000 jumping up by 23 percent. Over the first two days, the gross of €15,115,500 far exceeds last year's €12,449,500. Selling continues today at 11 a.m. Full results are available on www.arqana.com.

STARLET HOPEFULS ON WORK TAB

Likely favorite **Turbulent Descent** (Congrats) was among a trio of contenders for Saturday's GI Hollywood Starlet to work yesterday at Hollywood Park. The filly, two-for-two after her victory in the Nov. 21 Moccasin S., worked five furlongs in 1:00.80 with jockey David Flores in the irons. "Perfect; she's ready to go," trainer Mike Puype said after the drill. Turbulent Descent will be stretching out from seven furlongs to the Starlet's distance of 1 1/16 miles. "I'm not even worried about two turns, not with her," Puype continued. "She's so relaxed and tactical, she does everything like a distance horse. And she likes to win." Also working yesterday, Nov. 7 Sharp Cat S. winner **May Day Rose** (Rockport Harbor) worked a bullet six furlongs in 1:11.80 under Rafael Bejarano. **Big Tiz** (Tiznow), third in the Sharp Cat, went five furlongs in 1:01.80.

New Team Valor Acquisition Eyes Futurity

Crimson China (Giant's Causeway) was recently acquired by Team Valor International and is expected to ship from England to California for the Dec. 18 GI CashCall Futurity at Hollywood Park. "He will be coming on the 16th," said Team Valor president Barry Irwin. "We just bought him last weekend." The colt, the first foal of stakes-winning Parisian Affair (Mr. Greeley), made two starts for trainer Brian Meehan, most recently breaking his maiden by three lengths at Wolverhampton Nov. 25. "He has run two times, both on the all-weather tracks in England," Irwin said. "He came flying in his first race at one mile at Kempton and got beat by a nose by a horse that came back to win a Group 3. Then he won easily in his second start at a mile and a sixteenth at Wolverhampton. We're hoping he's a Kentucky Derby-type horse, and if he could finish first or second in this race, that would give him a lot of earnings for the Derby and take some of the stress of needing more earnings next spring." After the Futurity, Irwin said Crimson China would head to the Palm Meadows barn of trainer Graham Motion.

"Yeah, we hit a bit of a dry spell," laughed Ward Williford yesterday, explaining the gap between graded wins for his and wife Roberta's stable. The couple's five-year-old gelding Aggie Engineer posted the slight upset in Saturday's GIII Native Diver H. at Hollywood, winning at 3-1 over a field that included GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile winner Dakota Phone (Zavata) (fourth).

Their last graded winner before that? The four-year-old Come Summer (Junius), who captured the GIII Clark H. at Churchill as a 24-1 longshot...in 1986.

Ward Williford is an attorney based in Dallas, Texas, where he and Roberta call home. They claimed their first horse in 1979, and have maintained a small stable since. The Willifords currently have six horses in training, all in California with trainer Paddy Gallagher.

"We came out here a while ago and really enjoyed our California experience, so we just decided to race here all the time," said Williford, who made the trip to California with Roberta to watch the Native Diver.

"It was tremendously exciting," he said. "Winning a graded stakes out here, where the competition is so tough, was really about as thrilling as anything we've done in the business."

The Willifords purchased Aggie Engineer's dam Papalma privately earlier in the decade. The mare's dam was a half-sister to GI Hopeful S. winner Papal Power (Miswaki), while her second dam was a half to the top racehorse and sire Silver Hawk (Roberto). Papalma produced three other horses for the Willifords, including the winner Sound Barrier (Lear Fan), before being sold privately. Papalma produced a full-brother to Aggie Engineer this spring who was bred by Jim and Pam Robinson's Brandywine Farm.

POLLARD'S VISION

The Willifords currently have two broodmares based in Kentucky, including the 12-year-old mare Angel Gift (Allen's Prospect). Angel Gift was purchased by Gallagher, for a partnership that included the Willifords, for \$70,000 as a KEESEP yearling in 1999, and the bay went on to win two black-type events and place in three graded events in the Golden State, including a runner-up finish to Azeri (Jade Hunter) in the 2002 GII Clement L. Hirsch H. at Del Mar. Angel Gift has now produced \$410,000 worth of sales yearlings for the partnership, which includes Delahoussaye Enterprises and Richard C. Strauss, including the \$240,000 KEESEP yearling Groovitude (Dixie Union), a three-year-old filly who won a NW1X at Laurel Nov. 24; and a Hard Spun colt named Easter Gift who was hammered down to Whitehorse Stable/Foye Genetics, agent, for \$90,000 at the Keeneland September Sale three months ago.

Nicole H cruised home clear by 2 1/2 lengths to register a popular first black-type success in Saturday's Garland of Roses S. at Aqueduct. The filly, the crowd's 8-5 chalk, was bred by Dennis Narlinger and family's MJM Racing Stables LLC, which came by the filly's dam Hot Chipotle by way of a keen eye and the claim box.

In January of 2004, the Narlingers purchased Hot Chipotle's dam--Nicole H's second dam--Cajun Cat (Storm Cat) in partnership for \$67,000 at Keeneland January while in foal to Officer. At the time, Hot Chipotle was a placed three-year-old filly, but within a few months would become the winner of a \$15,000 maiden claiming event at Churchill. That summer, in August of 2004, Hot Chipotle's two-years-younger half-sister Miss Norman (Artax) brought \$300,000 at Fasig-Tipton Saratoga, a healthy sum that convinced the Narlingers they were sitting on a very live family.

"We had the mare, and we went out and looked for siblings [of Miss Norman], and I stumbled across Hot Chipotle," said Michael Narlinger, Dennis's son and MJM racing manager. "She was a winner, and we found her running for \$10,000 at Mountaineer. We had a guy named Will Hall look at her in the paddock, and he said she was a nice physical, so we claimed her."

That was in February of 2005. That \$10,000 tag quickly looked like a bargain when Miss Norman, now two, won at second asking at Del Mar in August of 2005, finished fourth in the GI Del Mar Debutante, then shipped to be second to eventual champion Folklore (Tiznow) in the GI Matron S. at Belmont. At three, Miss Norman added a runner-up finish in the GII Fantasy S.

Hot Chipotle, meanwhile, was retired directly to the breeding shed and sent to Officer, a stallion in which the Narlingers owned a majority. The resulting foal, the 2006 filly Apollo Lyra, made \$90,000 at the Keeneland September Sale. Hot Chipotle visited Mr. Greeley the following season, and the result was Nicole H.

"We probably over-bred her a little bit, going to Mr. Greeley, but I knew the family was coming on, and it was during the heyday of the market, and you could afford to over-breed a bit. And Mr. Greeley was good value; I think he was standing for \$35,000. He got a good-looking foal, and even though she was a claiming mare, we thought she had the family to support the stud fee. And I was pretty confident in her physical that we'd get a good-looking foal."

Michael said that indeed is what they got in Nicole H. "She was very muscular--very sprinter-ish looking," he said.

"I remember being at the sale, and our good friend and former trainer Kelly Breen was the underbidder. He's got a good eye for horses, and he liked her a lot. She was a touch short in the neck and maybe a bit coarse, but really well-built. She had a big hip and was very strong."

The Narlingers sent Hot Chipotle back through Keeneland January in 2009, where she was hammered down to William L. Jones, agent, for \$37,000. Previously, at the 2006 Keeneland November Sale, they sold her and Miss Norman's dam, Cajun Cat, to John and Martha Jane Mulholland for \$365,000.

The Narlingers, who partner with Becky Thomas on many endeavors, got into racing seriously in the mid-1990s and through the next decade built up a sizeable stallion portfolio and broodmare band.

"We were up to 100 broodmares at one time," said Michael. They also owned a majority interest in Officer, who they later sold to Taylor Made, as well as interests in the sires Sunday Break (Jpn), Read the Footnotes, Ten Most Wanted, Freud, Hook and Ladder and Closing Argument.

"Like a lot of people, we've done a lot of consolidating over the past year or two," said Michael. "We're down to about 20, high-quality mares, and we have our stallion interests in Freud and Read the Footnotes. Both of those stallions are doing exceptionally. Frankly, I think both produce the caliber of horses to stand in Kentucky, but given our foothold in New York and the loyalty of New York breeders, as well as with the VLTs coming, we felt it was in our best interest to keep the horses there."

Read the Footnotes and Freud currently stand at Sequel Stallions in New York. They both sired Grade I-winning fillies in 2010. Read the Footnotes was represented by GI Ballerina heroine Rightly So, while Freud had GI Prioress S. winner Franny Freud. The former provided the Narlingers and Thomas a huge score at Keeneland November. Together they owned Rightly So's dam Fit Right In (Out of Place), whom MJM signed for for just \$3,000 at the NYBSEP sale in 2006. On the strength of Rightly So's success, Fit Right In, in foal to Curlin, realized a bid of \$1.05 million from Katsumi Yoshida in November. -LM

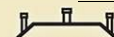
