SNOW STORM AT SHA TIN

Trainer Ed Dunlop has resisted comparisons between his great champion Ouija Board (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}) and the up-and-comer **Snow Fairy (Ire)** (Intikhab), but the latter has earned at least mention in the same breath after a dynamic close to 2010 in Sunday's G1 Hong Kong Cup at Sha Tin. Winner of the G1 Epsom Oaks in June and G1 Irish Oaks in July, the three-year-old filly entered the Hong Kong Cup off a scintillating victory over older males in

the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Commemorative Cup at Kyoto Nov. 14, and once again produced a sterling effort. She was reserved at the tail of the pack under Ryan Moore, who one race earlier was on a disappointing Paco Boy (Ire) (Desert Style {Ire}), last in the G1 Hong Kong Mile. But Moore would enjoy a reversal of fortune, care of Snow Fairy, who, despite a modest pace, began to gear up with a big run in mid-stretch and came flying in the last 200 meters to defeat Irian (Ger) (Tertullian) by a neck. Defending champ **Vision d'Etat (Fr)** (Chichicastenan go {Fr}) was a solid fourth.

Dunlop saddled Ouija Board, who also completed the Oaks double, to victory in the G1 Hong Kong Vase in 2005. "She's not the biggest filly in the world, but she's got the biggest heart," said Dunlop. "Hopefully, she'll come back for this race again next year, because she's going to stay in training as a four-year-old."

INTERNATIONAL FLAIR

Snow Fairy (Ire) was the second European-based runner to register a Group 1 on Hong Kong's biggest day of racing. Earlier on the card, Godolphin's **Mastery (GB)** (Sulamani {Ire}), under a masterful Frankie Dettori ride, glided home well clear in the Hong Kong Vase for trainer Saeed bin Suroor. **J J The Jet Plane (SAf)** (Jet Master {SAf}) struck a blow for South Africa when holding off **Rocket Man (Aus)** (Viscount {Aus}) and favored **Sacred Kingdom (Aus)** (Encosta de Lago {Aus}) in the G1 Hong Kong Sprint, while local longshot **Beauty Flash (NZ)** (Golan {Ire}) gave the home team an upset victory the G1 Hong Kong Mile over **Royal Bench (Ire)** (Whipper).

A paltry €1,800 buyback as a yearling, Snow Fairy began 2010 inauspiciously enough with a victory at 12-1 odds in the Listed Height Of Fashion S. at Goodwood May 19. At 9-1 in the Epsom Oaks June 4, she got her neck down over Meeznah (Dynaformer), then proved that was no fluke with a powerhouse eight-length romp in the G1 Irish Oaks at The Curragh July 18.

There was no shame in losing to Middy (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) in the G1 Yorkshire Oaks Aug. 19, and while a fourth-place effort in the G1 St Leger S. at Doncaster Sept. 11 was less than ideal, she may have been compromised by an overconfident Eddie Ahern ride. Ryan Moore, in the irons for both of Snow Fairy's Oaks wins, but not in her next two, was back aboard for her latest in Japan, and the pair cruised home four lengths clear.

Snow Fairy sat second last in the early going here as Packing Winner laid down modest :25.98, :51.17 and 1:16.66 splits up front. It was wide open as the field made the right-hand turn into the stretch, with six or seven horses lined up across the track, and Snow Fairy still with just one horse beaten. But the filly darted between rivals at the 300-meter mark and proved a different class, unleashing a dazzling turn of foot to sweep to the lead and tag Irian in plenty of time.

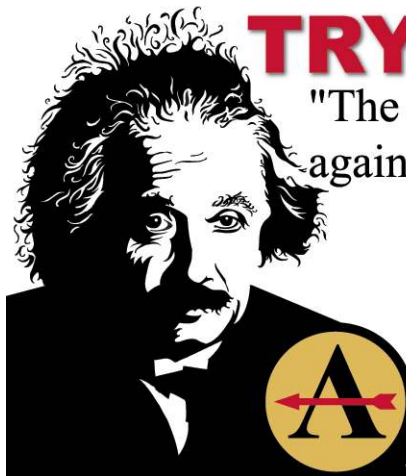
"I thought she had no chance when we were turning in, but she quickened up so well," enthused Moore. "She's got a marvelous turn of foot. Absolutely fantas-

tic to have done that day. She is very special--a machine." Said Brett Prebble of the runner-up, "He's run a super race again. It's taken a really good one to beat him." Defending champion Vision d'Etat also tarried near the

back before putting in a good late run to be fourth. "He missed the start and I had to settle in an awkward position," said his rider, Olivier Peslier. "He did not accelerate as well last year." Snow Fairy became the third filly or mare to win the Cup in the last 10 years, following Alexander Goldrun (Ire) (Gold Away {Ire}) in 2005 and Pride (Fr) (Peintre Celebre) in 2006. Last year, the Aga Khan's three-year-old filly Daryakana (Fr) (Selkirk) beat out Khalid Abdulla's Spanish Moon (El Prado {Ire}) in a thrilling renewal in the Vase, and yesterday it was another Euro invader who denied a Juddmonte runner, as Goldolphin's Mastery proved an authoritative winner over Redwood. While last year's result may have been a heart-breaker for Juddmonte, yesterday's edition was effectively over at the head of the lane. Tucked in smartly in third in the early going by Frankie Dettori as Mighty High (Fr) (Peintre Celebre) led, Mastery was produced at the top of the stretch and strode

away powerfully, never leaving the outcome in doubt. "[Trainer Saeed bin Suroor] told me the horse has been flying the last couple of days," said a jubilant Dettori. "He was going so well as they came into the straight, I knew when I pulled him out that nothing was going to outspurt me from there. For a four-year-old, he's had very little racing, and the fresh legs have definitely helped."

Bin Suroor said G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at next March's Dubai World Cup meeting was the probable next target. "And, as he will stay in training, we may be able to come back and try and win this race again in 2011," added the trainer. Mastery won last year's G2 Derby Italiano prior to a first black-type badge in the G1 St Leger S. at Doncaster in September. He closed out 2009 with a third in the Breeders' Cup Marathon at Santa Anita, for which he was favored and, after a break, he ran well in the G1 Dubai World Cup in March, finishing fifth, but beaten just 1 1/2 lengths. After another break, he finished third in the G3 Darley S. at Newmarket Oct. 15, and prepped for this with a dead-heat win in the Listed Floodlit S. over Kemp-ton's Polytrack Nov. 3. Mas-tery is Godolphin's first winner of the Vase.

Redwood, winner of the G1 Northern Dancer S. at Woodbine Oct. 16, gave a good account of himself to secure place honors, while last month's G1 Melbourne Cup hero Americain, made the favorite by the Hong Kong crowd, rallied late. "The pace of the race was too slow for him, especially at the last bend," trainer Alain Royer-Dupre said of Americain. "He's a very good horse, but it's impossible to catch these faster runners under such conditions. I'm confident he will eventually succeed over 12 furlongs and, with a faster pace, perhaps the G1 Japan Cup could be a race for him next year." **Click for the [HKJC.com chart](#), [HKJC.video](#) or the [free brisnet.com catalogue-style pedigree.](#)**

Off since, but working up a storm for this, J J The
 Jet Plane was in fourth as Dim Sum (GB) (Kyllachy
 {GB}) looked for the upset on the front end. It looked
 as if the pacesetter was still going well in upper stretch,
 but he was soon swept aside by Sacred Kingdom--
 surging through a slim gap--and the rallying Rocket Man
 and J J The Jet Plane. Rocket Man forged to a desper-
 ate lead in the waning strides as Sacred Kingdom
 fought on, but, with a last-gasp effort, 'J J' got up to
 take the photo. "We had a great run," said winning rider
 Piere Strydom. "[He was] always traveling well. When
 we eased out on straightening, I was happy to go after
 Rocket Man early, as I didn't want him to get away. My
 bloke gave me everything, and we got there on the line.
 It's brilliant to win, and I really want to thank the own-
 ers for being loyal to me, as there's plenty of good
 jockeys here they could have chosen." Felix Coetzee, on
 Rocket Man, reasoned, "What can I say? We just have
 to accept it. I thought we had it, but he's run so well
 again." Sacred Kingdom's rider, Brett Prebble, said his
 mount gave a valiant effort. "It's hard to stay on top
 forever," said Prebble. "He had his chance, but just died
 on his run in last bit. He probably can't quite push him-
 self through the pain barrier like he once could, but he
 ran super. There's plenty of good domestic Group 1s at

With the home team in danger of being shut out, Beauty Flash rallied the proverbial troops and edged out Euro invader Royal Bench for the victory. Looking to find the winner's circle for the first time since taking the HK-G1 Mercedes-Benz Classic Mile in January, Beauty Flash entered this off a fourth in the Jockey Club Mile here Nov. 21. His single-digit odds had everything to do with the late scratch of favored Able One (NZ) (Cape Cross {Ire}), who failed his pre-race inspection and was withdrawn just seconds before the field was loaded into the gate, causing a short delay. Sight Winner (NZ) (Faltaat) cut out :24.77 and :47.74 splits, but was overhauled by the stalking Beauty Flash, who got the jump on the field under an enterprising Gerald Mosse ride. With the mare Sahpresa among those giving their best, Beauty Flash kept finding more, and safely held the rallying Royal Bench, who defied the modest pace to close from second last. Mosse said, "It's good to be here and win for Hong Kong, because Hong Kong does a lot for the races. I knew Beauty Flash had won a Group 1 going forward, so we took a good start and, even though I couldn't actually lead, I was happy to be camped on the speed. The more I asked of him, the more he gave." Jockey Olivier Peslier was pleased with the runner-up's effort. "We were pushed wide on the home turn, and yet the horse finished like a train," said Peslier. "It shows how good he is, and I think his connections will have good fun with him in the next few months. I hear he could be headed to Dubai." Paco Boy (Ire) (Desert Style {Ire}), who inherited favoritism with Able One's defection, tarried at the back of the pack and never got going. His jockey Ryan Moore commented, "That wasn't him." 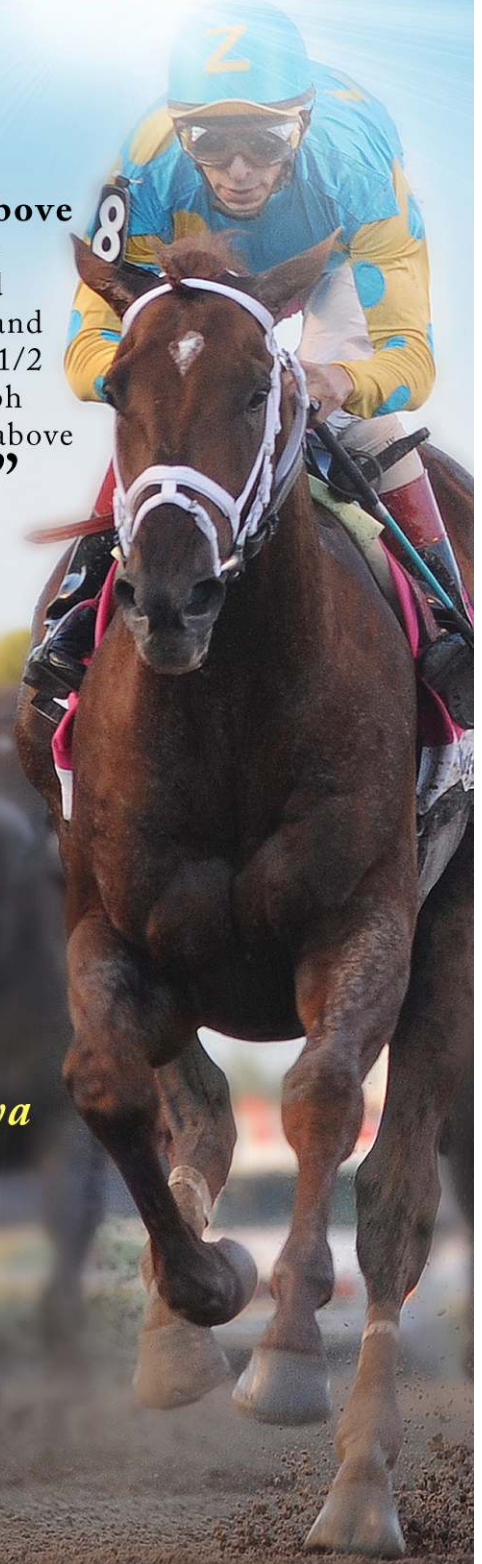

(Edited press release) Vincent Timphony, who trained Wild Again to an upset victory in the inaugural Breeders' Cup Classic at Hollywood Park in 1984, was in grave condition at Arcadia Methodist Hospital, his ex-wife Scarlet confirmed on Sunday. "He was admitted to the hospital a week ago Saturday because of respiratory disease and a series of strokes," she said. "The decision was made to take him off life support [Saturday]." Timphony, 76, spent his whole life around racing. "He was born right behind the Fair Grounds and began going to the track as a little boy," said his wife of 24 years. "Vincent won his first horse in a gin rummy game when he was 18. We are looking at the loss of one of the last Damon Runyan characters in the game." Scarlet said that Timphony's early mentors were trainers Tennessee Wright and Marion Van Berg, who launched him on a career that began on a Midwest circuit of Louisiana, Arkansas and Chicago, and branched into New York, New Jersey and Florida. He came to California in 1983, one year before the exciting and controversial Breeders' Cup that resulted in a three-way photo finish and stewards' inquiry. Timphony has five children, four grandchildren and one great-grandchild. "He's a man who loved horses and loved people," said Scarlet.

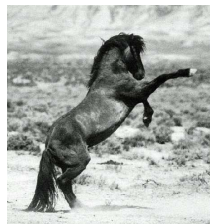

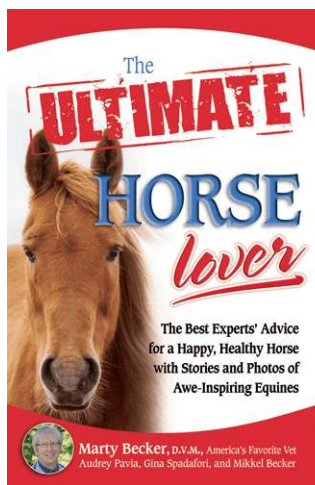
